THE OPENING TIP

- Securing two wins to open the 2024-25 season last week, San Francisco outlasted Cal Poly, 86-78, on Tuesday, Nov. 5 before picking up a statement win over Boise State, 84-73, on Saturday, Nov. 9. With the win over the Mustangs on opening night, San Francisco won their season opener for the fourth consecutive season dating back to 2021-22.
- Enjoying a strong start to the new year, Malik Thomas averaged 22.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.5 steals across both games last week as the guard was named WCC Player of the Week for the second time in his career on Monday, Nov. 11. Notably, the Fontana native tallied a career-high five steals in USF's win over Cal Poly.
- Alongside Thomas, Tyrone Riley IV burst onto the college basketball scene last week as the left hander averaged 18.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 0.5 steals and 0.5 blocks on 55.6 percent shooting across the two games. For these efforts, Riley IV was tabbed WCC Freshman of the Week as San Francisco swept the first WCC men's basketball weekly honors. Notably, Riley IV finished with a game-high 26 points, 24 of which came in the second half, in USF's victory over Cal Poly.
- Helping the green and gold in the win over Boise State, Ndewedo Newbury logged his first collegiate double-double last Saturday as the forward finished with 14 points, 10 rebounds, three assists, one block and one steal in a team-high 36 minutes played.
- Making a jump in the national rankings, San Francisco climbed from 96 to 75 in the Kenpom rankings as of Tuesday, Nov. 12.
- Under third year head coach Chris Gerlufsen, San Francisco is 25-0 when shooting 50 percent or better from the field as a team. Additionally, the Dons are 38-8 when they outshoot their opponent.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS AT SAN FRANCISCO:

Chris Gerlufsen enters his third year as the head coach of San Francisco after being elevated from associate head coach on March 18, 2022. This past season, Gerlufsen guided the Dons to a seventh straight full season of 20+ wins as the Dons finished 23-11 overall and 11-5 in conference play in 2023-24. Notably, Gerlufsen's nonconference winning percentage of 73.3 percent (22-8) is the best through two years of any head coach in program history.

In 2023-24, San Francisco finished in the top three in the WCC for the first time since 2013-14. Additionally, USF's eleven conference victories in 2023-24 were tied for the second-most since 1981-82. Overall, San Francisco's 22 wins during the regular season tied for the sixth-most regular season wins in the program's 97-year history.

In postseason play, San Francisco reached the semifinal round of the WCC Tournament for the third consecutive season in 2023-24. Following this performance, the Dons earned a spot in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) for the first time since 2014. Notably, it was also the second time in three years in which San Francisco competed in a postseason tournament.

For these efforts, San Francisco had a school-record five separate student-athletes selected for All-WCC honors in 2023-24, which included: Jonathan Mogbo (Newcomer of the Year, All-WCC First Team), Ryan Beasley (Freshman of the Year, WCC All-Freshman Team), Marcus Williams (All-WCC First Team) and Ndewedo Newbury (WCC Honorable Mention) and Malik Thomas (WCC Honorable Mention). Overall, San Francisco has now seen its guards named All-WCC fourteen times in the past seven seasons, with seven separate backcourt players garnering All-WCC First Team honors.

In June 2024, Jonathan Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco drafted into the NBA since 1982 as the dynamic forward was selected with the 31st pick overall in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft. With his selection, Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco to be drafted into the NBA since the trio of Quintin Dailey (Round 1, Pick 7/Chicago Bulls), Wallace Bryant (Round 2, Pick 30/Chicago Bulls) and John Hegwood (Round 9, Pick 186/San Diego Clippers) were selected in 1982. Overall, Mogbo became the 39th student-athlete from the university to be drafted into the NBA and the first under Gerlufsen. With his selection by Toronto, he is also the eighth Don all-time to be drafted in the second round. Additionally, Mogbo was the first West Coast Conference player taken off the board in the 2024 NBA Draft. It is just the second time since 2001 that a WCC school other than Gonzaga was the first to have a player selected (2023 - Brandin Podziemski/Santa Clara). Prior to the draft, Mogbo was one of 78 players invited to the 2024 NBA Draft Combine in Chicago from May 12-19.

Gerlufsen's inaugural season in 2022-23 began with a 7-1 start, a stretch highlighted by San Francisco winning the 2022 Hall of Fame Classic championship in Kansas City, MO. The Dons would finish nonconference play with a record of 11-4, which tied the most preseason win total by a first-year head coach at USF since 1980-81.

The team's 2022-23 campaign featured a 37-point win over #25 Arizona State - the largest victory over a ranked team in program history. That final margin also represents the fourth-biggest win for an unranked team over an AP Top 25 opponent in the past 31 seasons.

The Dons have enjoyed an offensive renaissance in Gerlufsen's two seasons on the Hilltop. Dating back to his stint as associate head coach in 2021-22, USF has turned in back-to-back Top 50 finishes in eFG% - a level of efficiency that has only been reached one other time in the last decade at USF.

Gerlufsen's analytically-driven offensive system produced the 17th-most made threes per game in college basketball in 2021-22. When he was elevated to head coach in 2022-23, that number jumped to seventh in the country (out of 363 teams).

San Francisco's starting backcourt of Khalil Shabazz and Tyrell Roberts experienced marked success in 2022-23. Shabazz and Roberts were both selected as All-WCC First Team performers. Each of them improved their scoring outputs by over four points per game under Gerlufsen. Shabazz was named the Hall of Fame Classic MVP and a WCC All-Tournament team selection in his final season on the Hilltop. Roberts was selected to the Hall of Fame Classic All-Tournament team.

Following the 2022-23 season, Gerlufsen and his staff brought in a recruiting class that was ranked 25th nationally in overall transfer activity (via EvanMiya.com). Among the newcomers were two players who graded as five-star transfers in addition to one four-star.

On March 18, 2022, Gerlufsen became the 21st head coach of the storied USF program, which has won two National Championships (1955 & 1956) and one National Invitational Championship (1949). In 2021-22, he was an integral part of San Francisco's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1998, serving as Todd Golden's associate head coach.

During the 2021-22 season, San Francisco won 24 games - the most victories by a Dons team since the men's basketball program was reinstated from shutdown in 1985. The team's at-large NCAA Tournament berth was the program's first since the bracket was expanded to its modern format of 64+ teams.

In Gerlufsen's first year on staff, USF finished among college basketball's elite in many metric-based rankings, including a 23rd place finish in KenPom and 26th in the NCAA's NET rankings. Following a successful 2021-22 campaign, USF star guard Jamaree Bouyea became the first San Francisco Don to play in the NBA since Bill Cartwright in 1995.

PRIOR TO THE HILLTOP:

Prior to Gerlufsen's arrival on the Hilltop, he spent two seasons as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii. During the 2019-20 season, he served as the acting head coach for Hawaii's first 13 games and compiled an 8-5 record (.615). His winning percentage at Hawaii currently ranks 2nd all-time in their school's Division I history. Among Gerlufsen's signature wins was an 85-75 upset victory over previously undefeated San Francisco. While at Hawaii, Gerlufsen coached All-Big West First Team guard Eddie Stansberry.

Before Hawaii, Gerlufsen spent four seasons as an assistant coach in the WCC with the University of San Diego. During his time at USD, the Toreros posted back-to-back 20+ win seasons for the first time ever. Gerlufsen's final season at San Diego saw the Toreros earn a bid to the 2019 NIT - the only NIT invitation in USD history. While coaching with the Toreros, Gerlufsen helped forward Isaiah Pineiro develop into a two-time All-WCC First Team performer.

Gerlufsen was particularly instrumental in San Diego's turnaround from an international recruiting standpoint, signing more than a half dozen foreign players during his tenure. One notable recruit, Yauhen Massalski, would play for Gerlufsen at both San Diego and San Francisco, where he blossomed into an All-WCC First Team selection on the Dons' 2021-22 NCAA Tournament team.

From 2006-15, Gerlufsen spent nine seasons on the bench at the University of Hartford. After seven years as an assistant coach, he was promoted to associate head coach for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. Gerlufsen served as the program's recruiting coordinator during that time. While at Hartford, Gerlufsen designed the team's perimeter-oriented motion offense. His system triggered six consecutive seasons with 225+ made 3's. In 2007-08, Hartford set an America East Conference record by connecting on 312 made 3's - a number which ranked 10th nationally.

From 2001-06, Gerlufsen spent his five seasons coaching at The Citadel under Pat Dennis. On January 2, 2004, Gerlufsen served as interim head coach for one game. He began his head coaching career 1-0 with a 82-58 win over Army.

Before working in the Division I ranks, Gerlufsen got his start with coaching jobs at Southwestern from 1999-2001 and Washington College (Maryland) in 1998-99.

PERSONAL HIGHLIGHTS:

As a player, Gerlufsen was a four-time letter winner for Randolph-Macon College, a Division III school in Virginia. While playing for the Yellow Jackets, he was named team captain for a squad that advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament twice. He graduated in 1998 with a B.A. in business and economics. Gerlufsen currently resides in San Francisco, CA with his fiancée Ila Gombar.

2024-25 SAN FRANCISCO MEN'S BASKETBALL SEASON NOTES/NEWS

MOGBO MADE HISTORY:

For the first time since 1982, a student-athlete from the University of San Francisco was selected in the NBA Draft as 2023-24 West Coast Conference Newcomer of the Year and All-WCC First Team selection Jonathan Mogbo was selected by the Toronto Raptors with the 31st overall pick in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft.

MAGNIFICENT MOGBO - SAN FRANCISCO'S SWISS ARMY KNIFE:

Last season, Mogbo played and started in all 34 games for San Francisco in 2023-24 while averaging 28.9 minutes per game. Overall, the versatile forward led the Dons in scoring (14.2 ppg), rebounding (10.1) and steals (1.6 spg) this past year. At the conclusion of the regular season, he ranked in the top 20 in Division I in total rebounds (318/7th), field goal percentage (64.33, 8th), double doubles (16, 10th), rebounding (10.3, 13th) and offensive rebounds (3.55/19th). Within the WCC, the West Palm Beach, Fla. native finished first in rebounding, field goal percentage and steals while also finishing sixth in scoring and eighteenth in minutes. Looking at the record books on the Hilltop, Mogbo finished the 2023-24 season with a 63.6 field goal percentage (206-324), which is good for the second-highest mark in a single season in program history only to Bill Cartwright's 66.7 percent (168-252) in 1978-79. Impressively, Mogbo tallied double figures in 28 of USF's 34 games and had ten or more rebounds in 19 of USF's 34 games. For these efforts, he was named WCC Player of the Week three times this season (Jan. 8, Jan. 15 + Feb. 5). Additionally, he was named to the Lou Henson Award Mid-Season Watch List on Jan. 10 and subsequently was named a finalist for the award on Mar. 20.

DONS IN THE NBA:

With his selection, Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco to be drafted into the NBA since the trio of Quintin Dailey (Round 1, Pick 7/Chicago Bulls), Wallace Bryant (Round 2, Pick 30/Chicago Bulls) and John Hegwood (Round 9, Pick 186/San Diego Clippers) were selected in 1982. Overall, Mogbo became the 39th student-athlete from the university to be drafted into the NBA and the first under Chris Gerlufsen. With his selection by Toronto, he is also the eighth Don all-time to be drafted in the second round. Additionally, Mogbo was the first West Coast Conference player taken off the board in the 2024 NBA Draft. It is just the second time since 2001 that a WCC school other than Gonzaga was the first to have a player selected (2023 - Brandin Podziemski/Santa Clara). Prior to the draft, Mogbo was one of 78 players invited to the 2024 NBA Draft Combine in Chicago from May 12-19.

NOTEWORTHY SUCCESS:

San Francisco's 22 wins in 2023-24 were tied for the sixth-most regular season wins in the program's 97-year history as the Dons finished in the top three in the West Coast Conference standings for the first time since 2013-14.

EARLY OPPORTUNITIES:

With a chance to make some noise early, the Dons will play a 13-game nonconference slate that features five teams that rank in the top 100 in the preseason KenPom rankings - Boise State (45th, Nov. 9), Memphis (42nd, Nov. 21), Clemson (24th, Nov. 25), Loyola Chicago (78th, Dec. 15), and Bradley (92nd, Dec. 18). For San Francisco, the green and gold head into the season opener at No. 84 in the KenPom rankings.

shutdown in 1985, the Dons notched three wins over Power conference teams in the same season. These wins included: first SEC win since 1981 (Vanderbilt), first Big Ten win since 2004 (Minnesota) and first Big East win since 2013 (DePaul).

GIVE THEM THEIR PRAISE:

San Francisco had a school-record five separate student-athletes selected for All-WCC honors in 2023-24, which included: Jonathan Mogbo (Newcomer of the Year, All-WCC First Team), Ryan Beasley (Freshman of the Year, WCC All-Freshman Team), Marcus Williams (All-WCC First Team) and Ndewedu Newbury (WCC Honorable Mention) and Malik Thomas (WCC Honorable Mention).

BY THE NUMBERS:

For the first time in the NET era, San Francisco finished the regular season without a Quad 3 or Quad 4 loss in 2023-24. They were 1 of 35 teams in the nation with this distinction. Overall, San Francisco finished the regular season ranked nineteenth in the country in scoring margin.

PRESEASON HONORS:

Prior to the start of the season, San Francisco was picked to finish fourth as a team in the 2024-25 West Coast Conference Preseason Poll. Overall, the Dons accumulated 77 points, including one first place vote. Returning for his third year in the green and gold, 2023-24 All-WCC First Team selection Marcus Williams was named to the 2024-25 WCC Preseason All-Conference Team.

BRINGING THE EXPERIENCE:

In the new world of the transfer portal, San Francisco welcomes four transfers to the Hilltop this season in Drew Ardouin (Atascadero, Calif./Cuesta College)Carlton Linguard Jr. (San Antonio, Texas/UTSA), Jason Rivera-Torres (Bronx, NY/Vanderbilt), Isa Silva (Sacramento, Calif./Stanford/Long Beach State).

NEW TO THE HILLTOP:

San Francisco welcomes four freshman to campus this season in Veniamin Abosi (Heraklion, Greece), Karl Markus Poom (Tartu, Estonia), James O'Donnell (Sydney, Australia/Centre of Excellence) and Tyrone Riley IV (Watts, Calif./St. Pius X-St. Matthias).

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR:

In total, seven different countries are represented across this year's roster for San Francisco: United States (9), Australia (1), China (1), Estonia (1), Georgia (1), Greece (1) and the United Kingdom (1).

NATIONAL AUDIENCE UPCOMING:

For San Francisco, the Dons will be featured on a national network seven times, which includes four games on CBS Sports Network (CBSSN) and three games on ESPN networks. Notably, the green and gold will first appear on CBSSN when San Francisco battles Clemson in game one of the Sunshine Slam on Nov. 25. Additionally, both contests against Gonzaga will air on ESPN, including the regular season conference finale between the Dons and Bulldogs at Chase Center on Mar. 1.

SUCCESS IN VEGAS:

Enjoying success in Las Vegas, San Francisco has reached the semifinal round of the West Coast Conference in three consecutive seasons. In 2021-22, the Dons earned the No. 5 seed and defeated BYU (75-63) before falling to No. 1/1 Gonzaga (81-71). In 2022-23, San Francisco earned the No. 6 seed and defeatead Pacific (80-63) and Santa Clara (93-87 in 20T) before falling to No. 9/8 Gonzaga (84-73). In 2023-24, San Francisco defeated Portland (72-51) before falling to No. 17/15 Gonzaga (89-77).

TASTE OF THE POSTSEASON:

Over the past three seasons, San Francisco has reached postseason play twice. Back in 2021-22, the Dons returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1998 as the green and gold earned a 10-seed. In the first round, San Francisco ultimately fell to Murray State, 92-87, in overtime. Last year, the Dons qualified for the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), but the Dons also fell in overtime in the first round on the road at Cincinnati, 73-72.

In their first week of the new season, Long Beach State raced past La Verne, 93-48, on Monday, Nov. 4 before narrowly falling to South Dakota State on the road, 80-79, on Friday, Nov. 8.

Through two games, Long Beach State has seen stellar play from their guards as Devin Askew is averaging 23.5 points and 6.5 assists per game to start the year while TJ Wainwright is close behind averaging 20.5 points per game.

On the glass, the Beach has three forwards averaging 6+ rebounds per game: Derrick Michael Xzavierro (8.5), Austin Johnson (8.0) and Cam Denson (6.5).

Long Beach State made the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24 as the Beach reached March Madness for the tenth time in program history and the first time since 2011-12. Coming off of a five-game losing streak entering the Big West Championship, Long Beach State responded by winning three straight games, including victories over the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds to reach the NCAA Tournament, where the program fell to No. 9 Arizona in the first round.

The Beach welcomed former San Diego State assistant coach Chris Acker to the helm over the offseason as Acker is in his first year as a Division I head coach. Alongside Acker, John Montgomery joined the staff as an assistant coach over the offseason after spending nine seasons at Hawai'i, where he was the associate head coach for the past three seasons. Looking at the roster, three players return from last year's team in addition to twelve newcomers brought in by Acker and his staff.
