NOTABLES

- Saint Louis heads to San Francisco with a 5-2 overall record. This is the Billikens' first true road game of the year. SLU is 5-0 in home games at Chaifetz Arena, while its two losses have come at neutral sites in Sioux Falls, S.D. (Santa Clara) and Kansas City, Mo. (Wichita State).
- The Billikens have won three in a row. They are coming off a 74-66 win against Jackson State.
- **Gibson Jimerson** needs 12 points to break (11 to tie) **Anthony Bonner's** all-time scoring record at SLU (1,972 points). Jimerson is already the Billikens' all-time leader in 3s made with 337, which is the most among active NCAA Division I players as well.
- **Isaiah Swope** averages 19.3 ppg. He was named the CollegeInsider.com Lute Olson National Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 28.0 ppg over a two-game stretch against Quinnipiac and UMass Lowell.
- Through games of Dec. 2, **Kalu Anya** is fifth in the NCAA in rebounds per game (11.4). He recorded double-doubles in the wins against Quinnipiac and UMass Lowell.
- **Robbie Avila** is back after missing three games due to an ankle injury suffered in the season opener against Santa Clara. He is averaging 17 points, 4.5 assists and 2.5 3-pointers.
- Saint Louis leads the A-10 and is among the top 30 in the NCAA in 3-pointers made per game (10.6).
- Head coach **Josh Schertz** is in his first season at SLU. His .786 winning percentage ranks No. 7 among active coaches across all three NCAA divisions.

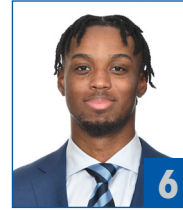

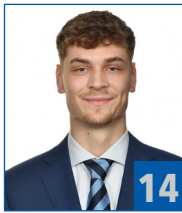

WHAT'S ON TAP?

- Saint Louis plays its first true road game of the season on Thursday night when it travels to face fellow Jesuit institution the University of San Francisco Dons. Game time at the War Memorial Gym at The Sobrato Center is scheduled for 7 p.m. PT / 9 p.m. St. Louis time.
- The Billikens are now in a stretch where they will alternate home and road games for the rest of December. Coming to Chaifetz Arena this month are Chicago State (Dec. 8), Wofford (Dec. 18) and William Woods (Dec. 28). SLU has road games coming up at Illinois State (Dec. 15) and Grand Canyon (Dec. 22).

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- Wednesday's game will be streamed on ESPN+. **Chris Sylvester** and **Ben Braun** will be on the call.
- KMOX 1120 AM is the home for Billiken Basketball on the radio. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action for all SLU games, both at home and on the road. Ramsey is in his 39th season calling SLU games, while Austin is in year No. 34.

LAST TIME OUT

- Saint Louis outscored Jackson State 11-2 over the final 4:38 of the second half and came away with a 74-66 victory Monday night at Chaifetz Arena.
- The Billikens improved to 5-2 with a third consecutive win. Jackson State slipped to 0-8.
- **Gibson Jimerson** poured in 21 points, including 19 in the second half, to lead all scorers. **Isaiah Swope** tallied 18 points, tied for game-high honors with a season-high seven assists and matched his season best of five rebounds.
- **Robbie Avila** flirted with a triple-double before settling for 15 points, eight rebounds and a game-high-tying seven assists. Avila's rebounding and assists totals were season highs, as were his game-high four 3-pointers.
- **Kalu Anya** collected a game-high 11 rebounds, including four offensive boards. Anya has rebounded in double figures in three straight and five of seven games. **Amari McCottry** grabbed six caroms as Saint Louis out-rebounded Jackson State 43-30.
- SLU was 28-of-53 (52.8 percent) from the floor, topping the 50-percent mark for a second straight game. The Billikens connected on 10-of-25 from 3-point range, reaching 40 percent for a second consecutive outing.

ABOUT THE DONS

- San Francisco enters Wednesday's game 6-2 overall and has won two in a row. The Dons' lone losses have come against Memphis and Clemson, two KenPom top 30 squads.
- Metric-wise, this is the Billikens' top nonconference opponent as USF comes in with a KenPom ranking of 62. The Dons also have a good chance of finishing in the top 75 of the NCAA's NET Ranking (they were 65th last year), which would make this a Quad 1 game.
- The Dons have gone with the same starting five in all eight games, and all average 7.0 points or better. Guard **Malik Thomas** leads the way with 17.3 ppg, while guard **Tyrone Riley IV** scores 13.0 ppg and leads the West Coast Conference in FG% (.597). Guard **Marcus Williams** averages 11.6 ppg and dishes out a team-best 4.1 assists per contest.
- Forward **Ndewedo Newbury** is close to double figures with 9.3 ppg. Center **Carlton Linguard Jr.** contributes 7.0 ppg. **Junjie Wang** scores 8.0 ppg off the bench for the Dons.
- Last season, San Francisco went 23-11 (11-5 WCC) and made the NIT.
- Head coach **Chris Gerlufsen** is in his third year at USF with a 49-27 record.

SERIES HISTORY

- The Billikens and Dons are meeting for a sixth time overall and the first time since 1998. SLU leads the series 3-2. The home team has won every game.
- In the game against the Dons in 1997, SLU freshman sensation **Larry Hughes** scored 29 points to lead the Billikens to the win. Hughes would go on to break the SLU single-season scoring record and enjoy a 14-year NBA career. His son, **Larry Hughes II**, is a junior on the Billikens.
- This is the first leg of a home-and-home series. San Francisco will visit Chaifetz Arena next season.
- SLU is 0-2 at War Memorial Gym, which was built in 1958 after San Francisco won back-to-back NCAA titles in 1955 and 1956. The facility underwent a renovation with the addition of the Sobrato Center in 2021.

BILLIKENS ON THE ROAD

- This is the first true road game of the season for the Billikens and the first of three this month. SLU will also travel to Normal, Ill., to take on Illinois State and Phoenix, Ariz., to face Grand Canyon.
- SLU is looking to snap a five-game losing skid in non-conference road games. The Billikens' last non-conference road win came during the 2021-22 season, an 86-82 overtime victory at Boise State.

AVILA DRAWING PRESEASON ACCOLADES

► After taking the college basketball world by storm last year, it's no surprise **Robbie Avila** is collecting quite a list of preseason honors.

► Just to name a few, Avila has been named a preseason AP honorable-mention All-American, first-team preseason All-Conference by the Atlantic 10, and named to preseason Watch Lists for the Naismith Trophy, the Wooden Award, and the Kareem Abdul-Jabaar Center of the Year.

► Avila averaged 17.4 points, 6.6 rebounds and 4.1 assists for Indiana State his sophomore year, shooting 53.6 percent from the field and 39.4 percent from the arc while draining 61 3-pointers. He accumulated 1,007 points in two years across 71 appearances for the Sycamores.

► Avila has played the last three games after missing three games with an ankle injury. He has scored in double figures in every game and averages 17.0 ppg.

TRACKING JIMERSON

► **Gibson Jimerson** continues to climb up the career scoring chart. He is now second all-time with 1,940 career points and is 12 away from surpassing (11 to tie) **Anthony Bonner's** school record.

► For the year, Jimerson scores 19.4 ppg and is a 43.9 percent shooter from 3. His 3.57 3s made per game leads the A-10 and ranks 18th in the NCAA.

► He already holds SLU records for 3-pointers made (337) and 3-pointers attempted (846) in a career, and also ranks third in school history in career free-throw percentage (.849) and seventh in career 3-point field-goal percentage (.398).

► This is Jimerson's sixth season with the Bills. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games, the maximum amount of games allowed for him to play in and still receive the waiver. The 2020-21 COVID season did not count against a players' eligibility.

► Jimerson is second in school history in games played. If he does not miss a game, Jimerson will break the games played record (currently held by Terrence Hargrove Jr. at 144) in the Billikens' game against William Woods on Dec. 28.

► An Academic All-American, Jimerson holds a bachelor's degree in International Business and an MBA from SLU. He is currently pursuing a post-graduate certificate in Organizational Leadership from Saint Louis University.

SWOPE ON FIRE

► **Isaiah Swope** is coming off a big week where he averaged 28.0 ppg in helping the Bills to a pair of victories against Quinnipiac and UMass Lowell. He tied his career high with 30 against Quinnipiac and followed with a game-high 26 points against UMass Lowell. For his efforts, he was tabbed the CollegeInsider.com Lute Olson National Player of the Week.

► For the week, Swope shot 54.5 percent from the field (18-33), 50 percent from 3 (9-18) and 84.6 percent from the stripe (11-13).

► Swope became the seventh Billiken (a list that also includes **Gibson Jimerson**) to score 30 or more points in a game at Chaifetz Arena.

► Swope drilled 113 3-pointers last year at Indiana State to rank fourth in the NCAA. He averaged 15.9 points in 2023-24 despite playing the majority of the year with a knee injury.

► Swope began his college basketball career playing two seasons at Southern Indiana, earning first-team All-Ohio Valley Conference honors as a sophomore.

THAMES THRIVING IN SCHERTZ' OFFENSE

► **Kellen Thames** started the first six games for the Bills and is averaging 10.1 ppg. He has played limited minutes in the last three games after leaving early due to cramping.

►Thames started the season scoring in double figures in the Bills’ first four games, which included back-to-back career scoring highs of 16 points against Santa Clara and Avila.

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

►**Kalu Anya** has stated in the media that it’s a goal of his to lead the A-10 in rebounding, and he is well on his way.
►Anya leads the league and ranks fifth nationally with 11.1 rpg. His 7.9 defensive boards per game are ninth nationally, while his 3.6 boards on the offensive glass puts him 23rd in the NCAA.
►Anya has recorded double digit rebounds in five of the Billikens’ seven games. He also has two double-doubles on the year, the only Billiken who has recorded one this season.

IT’S RAINING 3s

►Saint Louis set a single-game record when it shot 41 3-pointers in the win against Avila.
►For the year (through games of Dec. 2), SLU leads the A-10 and ranks No. 26 in the NCAA in 3-pointers made per game (10.6).
►Two singe-game records to keep an eye on this year include the Billikens’ team single-game record for 3s made (17, vs. Tulane, 12/8/19), and the individual single-game record for 3s made (8, Tommie Liddell III vs. Temple, 1/17/07).

SCHERTZ AMONG NCAAs ELITE

►SLU head coach **Josh Schertz** has a .786 winning percentage, which ranks No. 7 among active coaches in the NCAA across all three divisions.
►Schertz was 337-69 (.830) in 13 seasons at Lincoln Memorial, 66-40 (.623) in three seasons at Indiana State, and is 5-2 (.714) in his first season at Saint Louis.

► **Kellen Thames** is the son of **Kelly Thames**, who from 1993-98 started at the University of Missouri and scored more than 1,600 points for the Tigers.

► Walk-on **Nick Patton** is the son of **Peter Patton**, who played at DePaul from 1992-96. Patton is currently the Director of Player Development for the Chicago Bulls after coaching stints in the NBA with Minnesota Timberwolves and Dallas Mavericks.

HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

► Saint Louis is in its 17th season playing inside the 10,600-seat Chaifetz Arena.

► SLU is 209-76 all-time at Chaifetz Arena, including a perfect 5-0 mark this season.

► The win on Monday against Jackson State gave SLU five straight wins at Chaifetz Arena to start the year for the sixth time in the history of the building.

► Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**. Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded ComPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

QUICK HISTORY LESSON

► The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.

► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).

► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

ON THIS DATE

► The Billikens are 18-12 all-time on Dec. 5.

► **1959:** The Billikens defeated the reigning Big 8 champion Kansas State in Manhattan 67-58. **Bob Nordmann** led SLU with 23 points and 15 rebounds.

► **1994:** Saint Louis knocked off Southern Illinois in Carbondale 72-65. **H Waldman** set career highs in scoring (22) and steals (seven). That win was part of an eight-game winning streak for the Bills to open the season. SLU would go on to make their second-straight NCAA appearance under head coach **Charlie Spoonhour**.

► **2000:** SLU head coach **Lorenzo Romar** took the Billikens to his alma mater, Washington. The Bills defeated the Huskies 69-61 in Seattle. **Maurice Jeffers** led the way with 18 points as Saint Louis extended its winning streak to four.

► **2012:** The Billikens knocked off North Texas 67-63 at Chaifetz Arena behind 17 points apiece from **Cody Ellis** and **Jordair Jett**. Ellis was 8-8 from the stripe, which is still tied for the best perfect FT mark by a Billiken at Chaifetz Arena.

► **2020:** SLU scored a then-Chaifetz Arena record 107 points in a 107-54 win over Arkansas Pine-Bluff, the first time since 1995 SLU scored 100+ in a game. **Jordan Goodwin**, **Hasahn French** and **Javonte Perkins** led Saint Louis with 15 points apiece, followed by **Gibson Jimerson** with 12. Nobody was there to see it, though, as fans were not permitted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

AROUND THE DEPARTMENT...

► The Billikens' women's basketball team is 3-6 heading into their game against Norfolk State on Saturday in Washington, D.C., in the Coaches vs. Racism Roundball Classic. Freshman **Mia Bergstrom** was named the Atlantic 10 Conference Rookie of the Week after pouring in five treys in games last week at Cal Baptist and against No. 6 USC.

► The SLU track and field teams begin the indoor season on Friday at the Saluki Fast Start Meet in Carbondale. It's the first of two meets this semester before they break for the holidays. The indoor season then resumes in January leading up to the A-10 Championship at the end of February in Virginia Beach, Va.

► Both Billiken soccer teams made the NCAA Tournament in 2024. The women's team advanced to the Round of 32 before falling in overtime against top seed USC. The men's team earned an at-large bid the tourney, its NCAA record 51st appearance, but fell in the first round at Hermann Stadium against Kansas City.

Saint Louis University announced Josh Schertz as the head coach of the Billikens' men's basketball program on April 6, 2024.

Schertz comes to SLU after a three-year run at Indiana State. He led the Sycamores to a 32-7 record in 2023-24 and a magical run to the NIT championship game. Prior to his stint at ISU, Schertz spent 13 seasons at Lincoln Memorial, where he led the Railsplitters to 10 NCAA Division II national tournaments, including an appearance in the 2016 NCAA Division II national championship game. Schertz is 408-111 in 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach. His .786 winning percentage entering the season ranked in the top 10 among all active coaches in the NCAA.

Schertz turned around the Indiana State program and led the Sycamores to their best season in several decades in 2023-24 as ISU captured its first Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title since 2000. Indiana State fell in the championship game of the 2024 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and was selected as a No. 1 seed for the NIT after just missing out on an at-large bid to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

Schertz was named the 2024 MVC Coach of the Year and was recently tabbed the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year, which is presented annually to the top mid-major head coach in college basketball. Five Sycamores earned All-Conference honors this season as Indiana State led the league and ranked among the top 10 in the country in scoring offense. ISU leads the nation in effective field goal percentage and was the league leader in assists per game (11th in the NCAA) and 3-point field goals made per game (fourth in the NCAA) as well.

Prior to his stint at Indiana State, Schertz guided one of the most successful NCAA Division II teams in the country, Lincoln Memorial University, for 13 seasons from 2008-21. The Railsplitters registered a remarkable 337-69 record during Schertz' tenure.

Schertz helped Lincoln Memorial (Harrogate, Tennessee) to 10 NCAA Tournaments. The Railsplitters went to the national semifinals three times (2016, 2017 and 2021) and were the national runner-up in 2016. Lincoln Memorial was 32-1 and poised for a national title run when the 2019-20 season was canceled due to the pandemic.

LMU earned 14 South Atlantic Conference championships during Schertz' tenure – nine regular-season crowns and five tournament titles.

Prior to becoming head coach at LMU, Schertz served as either an associate head coach or assistant coach at four different schools over a 10-year span – High Point University (2003-08), Queens University (2001-03), Lynn University (1999-2001) and Florida Atlantic University (GA, 1998-99).

Schertz is a 2000 graduate of Florida Atlantic. He also has a master's degree in education from Lynn. Schertz and his wife, Natalia, have two children, Jordan and Jaden.

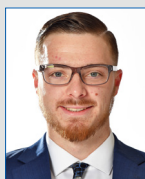

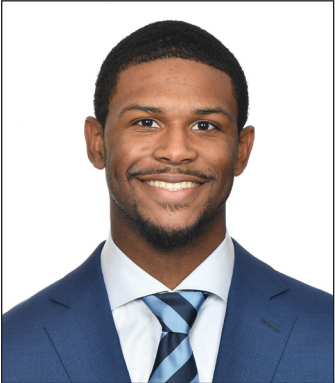
