GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team, coming off a split last week, returns to Southern California when it takes on Pepperdine at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 1, at Firestone Fieldhouse.
- San Francisco enters the fifth week of WCC action in sole possession of fourth place in the conference standings after splitting two home games last week. The green and gold mounted a second-half comeback and earned a 61-48 win over Loyola Marymount on Thursday, Jan. 25, before falling to No. 17 Gonzaga, 73-54, on Saturday, Jan. 25.
- Jasmine Gayles led the Dons in scoring last week, averaging 15.0 points per game in two contests against LMU and Gonzaga. Gayles, who ranks first on the team in scoring, averaging 17.5 points per game, has reached double figures in 11 straight contests, including recording 17 points in the win over the Lions and 13 against the Bulldogs.
- Pepperdine enters Thursday's contest on a six-game losing streak after falling on the road to LMU, 75-59, last Saturday. The Waves, currently in eighth place in the conference standings, have only posted one WCC win this season, defeating San Diego, 53-52, on Thursday, Jan. 4.
- Jane Nwaba leads the team in scoring, averaging nine points per game while 41.2 percent from the field in 20 games.
- San Francisco and Pepperdine have faced off 88 times in program history, with the Dons holding a narrow 46-42 advantage against the Waves.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

HELD STRONG AGAINST A TOUGH OPPONENT: San Francisco faced off against its first nationally ranked opponent this season when it dropped a 73-54 decision to #17 Gonzaga last Saturday. Despite the loss, the Dons held the Bulldogs 73 points, the Zags' second-lowest point total in a game during conference play (Loyola Marymount allowed 72 points to Gonzaga on January 18). The Bulldogs also shot 45.6 percent from the floor against the Dons, their fifth-lowest shooting percentage in a game this season.

AYA HAS BEEN SPECTACULAR: Aya Keita led the team in scoring in the loss to Gonzaga, tallying 14 points in 23 points off the bench. Keita shot an efficient 54.5 percent from the field while tying Jasmine Gayles with a team-high six made field goals. A spark off the bench, Keita is averaging 7.2 points per game during conference play while shooting 54.3 percent in seven WCC games this season.

BACK-TO-BACK GAMES IN DOUBLE FIGURES: Luana Leite posted 10 points against Gonzaga last week, marking the second straight game where she scored in double figures - Leite posted 12 points in the win over Loyola Marymount last Thursday. In 20 games this season, Leite has tallied double-digit points in a game six times.

JASMINE IS STILL LEADING THE WAY: Serving as the team's primary offensive weapon this season, Jasmine Gayles is averaging 17.5 points per game, leading the team and ranking third in the WCC at 17.5 points per game. In seven conference games, Gayles continues to lead the league, averaging 21.1 points per game.

DEB HELD HER GROUND: Debora dos Santos tallied two blocks and two steals in the loss to Gonzaga last week. Her defensive performance marked the fourth time this season and the fifth time in her career that she recorded at least two blocks and two steals in a game.

DOS SANTOS CONTINUES TO BE DOMINANT IN THE PAINT: Debora dos Santos reached double figures for the 12th consecutive game after scoring 12 points against Gonzaga. Scoring the majority of her points in the paint, dos Santos has scored 216 of her 280 points in the paint and is shooting 54.0 percent from two-point range.

AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos remains the lone WCC member averaging a double-double this season with 14.0 points and 10.6 rebounds per game. Dos Santos has recorded a league-high 11 double-doubles this season while reaching double-digit points 17 times and double-digit rebounds 12 times.

THIRD QUARTER IS THE TIME TO PLAY: San Francisco outscored Gonzaga 20-18 in the third quarter last Saturday, marking the 14th time the team has outscored its opponent in the third quarter. In 20 games, the Dons are outscoring their opponents 396-339 out of halftime while averaging nearly 20 points per game in the third.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 13th straight game and 17th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned seven of their eight wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

FORCED GONZAGA INTO A LOT OF TURNOVERS: San Francisco forced Gonzaga into 20 turnovers last week, the most the Dons have forced this season. The previous high was 18 turnovers forced by the Dons, set against Stanislaus State (Nov. 9), Pepperdine (Jan. 11), and Loyola Marymount (Jan. 25). In seven conference games, the Dons rank sixth in forced turnovers per game with 16.4 while ranking first with a 2.86 turnover margin.

SEEKING A SECOND SEASON SWEEP: San Francisco is looking for its second season sweep of a conference opponent this season as it takes on Pepperdine for the second time. The Dons already took care of business against Loyola Marymount, defeating the Lions twice during WCC play.
