GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team concludes its two-game road trip when it takes on San Diego at 2 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 3, at Jenny Craig Pavilion.
- San Francisco is coming off a dominant win over Pepperdine in Malibu last Thursday as the Dons earned a 78-54 victory over the Waves. Jasmine Gayles and Debora dos Santos surpassed the 20-point threshold, with dos Santos scoring a game-high 24 points while Gayles added 23. Freja Werth also helped propel the Dons with 15 points and seven rebounds.
- After the win over Pepperdine, the Dons improved to 5-3 in conference play and are tied with Pacific for third place in the WCC standings.
- San Diego enters Saturday's contest on an 11-game losing streak and in ninth place in the WCC standings after falling to #19 Gonzaga, 80-52, at home last Thursday. Dylan Horton led the Toreros in scoring with 13 points on 42.9 percent shooting while Kylie Horstmeyer added 12.
- Veronica Sheffey leads the Toreros in scoring this season, averaging 12.8 points per game. The second-year guard has reached double figures in 15 of the team's 20 games, including tallying a season-high 23 in a narrow 67-63 loss against San Diego State earlier in the season.
- San Francisco and San Diego have faced off 80 times throughout program history, with the Toreros holding a 45-35 edge over the Dons since the first-ever meeting in 1986.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

A SECOND SEASON SWEEP: San Francisco earned its second conference sweep of the season after defeating Pepperdine, 78-54, last Thursday in Malibu. In two games against the Waves, the Dons averaged 80.5 points per game and allowed just 59 points per game.

A SECOND-QUARTER ONSLAUGHT: San Francisco's offense came alive in the second quarter in the win over Pepperdine as the Dons outscored the Waves 24-9. The 15-point differential in the second quarter marks the fourth time this season the Dons have outscored an opponent by 15 or more points in a quarter. San Francisco outscored LMU by 19 in the second quarter, 23-6, in Los Angeles on January 4, the largest point differential for the Dons in any quarter

THREES WERE FALLING: San Francisco shot 50 percent from the three-point line in the win over Pepperdine, marking the second-highest three-point shooting percentage in a game this season. The Dons shot 62.5 percent from three in a 75-59 victory over Yale on November 21. The Dons also connected on a season-high 12 three-pointers, the most in a game since knocking down 13 in an 83-80 overtime loss to Portland last season on February 2, 2023.

TWO 20-POINT SCORERS: Debora dos Santos and Jasmine Gayles surpassed the 20-point threshold at Pepperdine, marking the second time two players scored at least 20 points in the same game. Dos Santos finished the game with 24 points, while Gayles added 23. Freja Werth and dos Santos were the last to have at least 20 points in a game when the duo both had 20 against Columbia on December 28.

A CAREER NIGHT FROM DISTANCE: Jasmine Gayles shot lights out from the three-point line at Pepperdine, connecting on a career-high six of her seven attempts for 85.7 percent from distance. Gayles matched the team season high for three-pointers in a game set by Freja Werth, who also totaled six against Columbia on December 28.

BACK AT IT WITH A DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos posted her 12th double-double of the season with 24 points and 12 rebounds against Pepperdine last Thursday. Dos Santos also recorded a career-high 11 field goals, shooting 78.6 percent (11-for-14) from the field, and was perfect from the three-point line in the lone attempt.

CAMI FOUND HER GROOVE: After combining for 10 points in the previous seven conference games, she recorded eight points, the most in a game since having eight against Northern Arizona on December 9. Fulcher had an efficient shooting performance, going three-for-five from the field with two baskets coming from beyond the arc.

JASMINE IS STILL LEADING THE WAY: Serving as the team's primary offensive weapon this season, Jasmine Gayles is averaging 17.7 points per game, leading the team and ranking third in the WCC. In eight conference games, Gayles continues to lead the league, averaging 21.4 points per game.

AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos remains the lone WCC member averaging a double-double this season with 14.5 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. Dos Santos has recorded a league-high 12 doubledoubles this season while reaching double-digit points 18 times and double-digit rebounds 13 times.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for 11th in total rebounds (224), tied for 16th in rebounds per game (10.7), 24th in defensive rebounds per game (7.1), and tied for 10th in double-doubles (12).

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 14th straight game and 18th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned eight of their nine wins this season when this lineup begins a game.
