GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team continues its final road trip of the season when it takes on Portland at 5 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 24, at Chiles Center.
- San Francisco enters Saturday's contest after falling at #16/15 Gonzaga, 74-48, last Thursday, Feb. 22. Cami Fulcher led the Dons in scoring for the second time in three games, posting 14 points on 75 percent (six-for-eight) shooting. Jasmine Gayles helped propel the team with 13 points on five-of-11 shooting.
- Portland dropped two consecutive games for the second time this season after falling at Pacific and Santa Clara last week. The Pilots came up short against the Tigers in Stockton, 80-74, on Thursday, Feb. 15, before falling flat in a 66-58 loss to the Broncos in the South Bay on Saturday, Feb. 17.
- Offensively, Emme Shearer and Maisie Burnham lead the team, averaging 12.0 and 11.6 points per game, respectively.
- Shearer, the team's leading scorer, is also a staple on the defensive end, guiding the Pilots with 64 steals.
- Lucy Cochrane, ranking second in the nation in blocks, has totaled 82 through 27 games.
- Portland holds a narrow 40-38 advantage over San Francisco throughout the history of the two programs.

Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalya Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

A HARD TIME AT THE KENNEL: San Francisco dropped a hard-fought battle Thursday evening at the McCarthy Athletic Center, 74-48. The Dons tied their second-lowest point total in a game this season, matching the 48 points scored against Cal State Fullerton on November 19 in Hawaii.

CAMI HITTING HER STRIDE AT THE RIGHT TIME: For the first time in her career, Cami Fulcher reached double figures for the third consecutive game after leading the Dons with 14 points at Gonzaga last Thursday. In the last three games, Fulcher is averaging 13 points per game on 54.2 percent shooting.

A THREE-POINT THREAT: Cami Fulcher leads the team in three-point percentage, shooting at a 39.7 percent clip. In the last six games, Fulcher is averaging 42.9 percent from the three-point line on 1.5 makes per game.

THE LEADING SCORER: Through 26 games this season, Jasmine Gayles has led the Dons and ranks third in the WCC in scoring this season, averaging 17.4 points per game. Gayles has posted 17 straight double-digit scoring performances while averaging 19.3 points per game during conference play.

100 ASSISTS AND COUNTING: After recording four assists at Gonzaga, Luana Leite has totaled 100 in her first season with the team. Leite, the fourth Don to reach 100 or more assists in a single season since 2017-18, became the sixth player in the WCC this season to reach 100 assists. Overall, Leite ranks sixth in the WCC in total assists (100) and seventh in assists per game (3.8).

BLOCKS AND STEALS: Debora dos Santos has been an impact player on defense this season, leading the team in blocks (26) and steals (37). Dos Santos has recorded a block or a steal in a game in nine of the last 10 contests. During that span, dos Santos has recorded nine blocks and 16 steals, the most by any player on the team.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES: In 26 games, dos Santos is averaging 14.1 points and 10.4 rebounds per game, remaining the only player in the WCC averaging a double-double. Dos Santos also leads the team and the WCC in double-doubles with 14.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks 16th in total rebounds (271), tied for 20th in rebounds per game (10.4), and tied for 16th in double-doubles (14).

MARINA GOT HER SHOT: Marina Hernandez played in a career-high 24 minutes for San Francisco last Thursday at Gonzaga. Giving a spark off the bench, she reached career highs in field goals (two), rebounds (four), and blocks (two).

A STRONG REBOUNDER: Freja Werth has become one of San Francisco's best rebounders, averaging 5.7 per game for second-best on the team. Werth has recorded 41 rebounds in the last five games, including 10 against Santa Clara last week. In 12 WCC contests, Werth is averaging 6.5 rebounds per game, ranking seventh best in the league.

SCORING OFFENSE AND TEAM REBOUNDING: As a team, San Francisco ranks fifth in the WCC in scoring offense, totaling 66.5 points per game. The Dons have become a solid rebounding team throughout the 2023-24 campaign, ranking second in the WCC with 37.8 rebounds per game.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 19th straight game and 23rd overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned 10 of their 11 wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

SCOUTING THE PILOTS

TWO STRAIGHT LOSSES: Portland dropped two consecutive games for the second time this season after falling at Pacific and Santa Clara last week. The only other time this season the Pilots have lost at least two consecutive games was when they lost three straight to California Baptist (Nov. 22), Northern Arizona (Nov. 24), and Rhode Island (Nov. 25).

Portland has only dropped two straight conference games twice in the last three seasons, with the last coming in 2021-22.

TWO LEAD THE TEAM OFFENSIVELY: Offensively, Emme Shearer and Maisie Burnham lead the team, averaging 12.0 and 11.6 points per game, respectively. Burnham, the Pilots' primary offensive weapon, has reached double figures in 11 of the 13 conference games while posting 17 twice in wins over San Diego and Saint Mary's.

DICKIE REVENGE GAME: In her first game against her former team, Kennedy Dickie led Portland in the 67-60 win on the Hilltop earlier this season, scoring 17 points and grabbing 13 rebounds. In two seasons with the Dons, Dickie averaged 9.4 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. Last season, Dickie led the Dons in rebounding, averaging 7.8 per game.

A PRESENCE INSIDE: Lucy Cochrane, ranking second in the nation in blocks, has totaled 82 through 27 games. The 6-6 forward, averaging just over three blocks per game, has recorded five or more blocks in five games, including a season-high eight at California Baptist.

A FRESHMAN STAR: Dyani Ananiev, who ranks fourth on the team in scoring at 9.0 per game, ranks first on the team in three-point percentage, shooting at a 38.8 percent clip. The first-year guard has totaled more than two three-pointers in a game 13 times, including knocking down six of her eight attempts in a win over Seattle U on November 14.

DEFENSE IS THEIR SPECIALTY: Portland ranks among the best teams in Division I defensively, placing 12th nationally in steals, averaging 11.5 per game, tied for 11th in blocks, averaging 5.6 and 16th in turnovers forced per game at 20.8.

THEY GET TO THE LINE: Portland ranks 56th in Division I in free throws per game at 19.41. Along with getting to the line, the Pilots rank 83rd in free throws made per game with 13.3.

SERIES HISTORY: Portland holds a narrow 40-38 advantage over San Francisco throughout the history of the two programs. The Pilots pulled out the victory last time out, earning a narrow 67-60 win over the Dons on Saturday, Jan. 6, at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center.
