GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team returns to the Hilltop to kick off a three-game homestand starting with a matchup against Saint Mary's at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 8, at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center.
- San Francisco enters Thursday's matchup against Saint Mary's in a tie for third place in the WCC standings after splitting two road games last week. The Dons dismantled Pepperdine on Thursday, Feb. 1, in a 78-54 decision at Firestone Fieldhouse before falling at San Diego, 77-66, on Saturday, Feb. 3.
- Jasmine Gayles and Debora dos Santos produced back-to-back 20-point performances last week at Pepperdine and San Diego, marking the first time since 2015 that the Dons had consecutive games with two 20-point scorers.
- Saint Mary's enters Thursday's contest in seventh place in the WCC standings after dropping a 68-35 decision at home to Portland last Saturday, Feb. 3.
- Zeryhia Aokuso ranks first on the team in scoring, averaging 11.0 points per game. Aokuso has reached double figures in five of the eight WCC games while surpassing the 20-point threshold twice. Ali Bamberger also is averaging double-digit scoring this season, propelling the team with 10.2 points per game while leading the team in rebounding, averaging 4.7 per game and blocks with 17.
- Saint Mary's holds the upper hand all-time against San Francisco, earning wins in 48 of the 79 meetings. The two programs split the season series in 2022-23, as both teams earned wins on the road.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

TWO 20-POINT SCORERS X2: Jasmine Gayles and Debora dos Santos produced back-to-back 20-point performances last week at Pepperdine and San Diego, marking the first time since 2015 that the Dons had consecutive games with two 20-point scorers. Zhane Dikes and Taylor Proctor totaled 24 and 23 points in a win at San Jose State on December 6, 2015, followed by Rachel Howard and Proctor scoring 26 and 20 points at Long Beach State on December 8, 2015.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: After averaging a double-double with 22.0 points and 11.5 rebounds per game, Debora dos Santos was named Credit Union 1 WCC Player of the Week. Dos Santos shot 56.7 percent from the field and added three steals and one block throughout the week. Overall, this marks the third weekly WCC honor by a Don this season, as Jasmine Gayles was previously selected twice on November 13 and January 15.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE: After recording two double-doubles last week at Pepperdine and San Diego, Debora dos Santos has increased her season total to 13. Dos Santos ranks first in the WCC and tied for ninth nationally in double-doubles. Dos Santos remains the lone WCC member averaging a double-double this season with 14.7 points and 10.7 rebounds per game while reaching double-digit points 19 times and double-digit rebounds 14 times.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for 11th in total rebounds (235), 15th in rebounds per game (10.7), 25th in defensive rebounds per game (7.0), and tied for ninth in double-doubles (13).

A PROVEN SCORER: Jasmine Gayles has reached double figures in 19 of the 22 games this season. After scoring 23 points at San Diego last Saturday, she surpassed her previous best of 18 games with double-digit points set during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.

JASMINE IS STILL LEADING THE WAY: Serving as the team's primary offensive weapon this season, Jasmine Gayles is averaging 17.9 points per game, leading the team and ranking second in the WCC. In nine conference games, Gayles continues to lead the league, averaging 21.4 points per game.

DISTRIBUTING THE ROCK: Luana Leite showed off her passing abilities last week, totaling nine assists in two games. In nine league games, Leite ranks fifth in total assists (39) and assists per game (4.3) while leading the team overall in assists with 87.

STRONG REBOUNDING TEAM: As a team, San Francisco continue to be a dominant rebounding team, leading the conference in rebounds per game (38.0) and defensive rebounds per game (25.7), and rank fourth in offensive First rebounds per game (12.2). The Dons have four players that have accumulated at least 75 rebounds this season: Debora dos Santos (235), Freja Werth (118), Jasmine Gayles (97), and Luana Leite (77).

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 15th straight game and 19th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned eight of their nine wins this season when this lineup begins a game.

TURNOVERS ARE DOWN: In the last three games, San Francisco has kept turnovers to a minimum, with only 12 against Gonzaga and Pepperdine, while accumulating a season-low 11 at San Diego. In the last three games, the Dons are averaging 11.6 turnovers per game, 4.2 less than their season average of 15.8 per game.

POINTS APLENTY IN WCC PLAY: San Francisco has three of the highest point totals in a game during WCC play. The Dons scored 83 points against Pepperdine on January 11 (seventh most), 81 at Pacific on January 13 (10th most), and 78 at Pepperdine (14th most). Gonzaga has recorded the most, having six of the highest point totals in the top 15.
