GAME NOTES & NEWS

- The University of San Francisco women's basketball team kicks off the final week of the regular season when it travels to take on Saint Mary's at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 29, at the University Credit Union Pavilion.
- San Francisco enters the final week of the regular season in sole possession of fourth place after earning a split at Gonzaga and Portland last week. The Dons earned a crucial road win on Saturday, Feb. 24, defeating the Pilots, 59-47, at the Chiles Center.
- In the win over Portland, three players reached double figures, led by Debora dos Santos' 15th double-double of the season with 16 points and a game-high 15 rebounds. Freja Werth (16 points) and Jasmine Gayles (15 points), also contributed offensively.
- Saint Mary's enters Thursday's contest after splitting two road games last week at LMU and San Diego. The Gaels earned a narrow 70-66 win over the Lions on Thursday, Feb. 22, before dropping a 69-52 decision to the Toreros on Saturday.
- Zeryhia Aokuso ranks first on the team in scoring, averaging 11.3 points per game. Aokuso has reached double figures in eight of the 14 WCC games, surpassing the 20-point threshold twice. Ali Bamberger also is averaging double-digit scoring this season, propelling the team with 10.2 points.
- Saint Mary's holds the upper hand all-time against San Francisco, earning wins in 48 of the 80 meetings. The Dons earned their second straight win over the Gaels earlier this season, pulling out a narrow 59-54 victory on the Hilltop on Thursday, Feb. 8.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

FIRST WIN IN PORTLAND SINCE 2021: San Francisco earned a 59-47 win at Portland last Saturday, marking the first time the Dons have won at the Chiles Center since the 2020-21 season. On February 14, 2021, the Dons defeated the Pilots 74-71, led by Amalie Langer's game-high 21 points. The green and gold shot a stellar 50 percent from the field in the win and 47.4 percent from the three-point line.

SOLID DEFENSIVE EFFORT: As a team, San Francisco held Portland to just 47 points, the second-lowest point total for an opponent this season. The Dons also accumulated 12 steals throughout the contest, the most in a game this season. Jasmine Gayles and Debora dos Santos led the green and gold with a season-high four steals apiece, while Luana Leite (three) and Paula Tirado (one) also contributed. The Dons forced the Pilots into 18 total turnovers, the second most by an opponent this season.

WON A GAME WITH THE SCORE TIED AT THE BREAK: San Francisco won a game for the first time this season when the score was tied at halftime. After the Dons jumped out to a 17-10 lead after the first guarter at Portland, the Pilots tied the game at 28 heading into halftime. The Dons pulled through and outscored the Pilots 31-19 in the second half.

HELD AN OPPONENT TO UNDER 60: For the seventh time this season, San Francisco has held an opponent to under 60 points in a game after only allowing 47 to Portland last weekend. San Francisco is 6-1 in games when an opponent scores 60 points or less, with the only loss on November 19 when it dropped a 54-48 decision to Cal State Fullerton at the Bank of Hawaii Classic.

CAME ALIVE IN THE SECOND HALF: Freja Werth totaled 16 points in the win at Portland last weekend, scoring all her points in the second half. Werth shot 58.3 percent (seven-for-12) from the field in 38 minutes of action while leading the team with two three-pointers.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE: Debora dos Santos led three San Francisco players in double figures and collected her 15th double-double of the season with 16 points and 15 rebounds, as the Dons earned a 59-47 road victory over Portland last Saturday. Dos Santos is tied for ninth in the nation in double-doubles and leads the conference with 15 on the season. She also owns this season's WCC single-game high in rebounds (18) recorded at LMU on January 4.

THE LEADING SCORER: Through 27 games this season, Jasmine Gayles has led the Dons and ranks third in the WCC in scoring this season, averaging 17.3 points per game. Gayles has posted 18 straight double-digit scoring Eighth performances while averaging 19.0 points per game during conference play.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks tied for 14th in total rebounds (286), 17th in rebounds per game (10.6), and tied for 14th in double-doubles (15).

THEY CAN DEFEND: Throughout conference play, San Francisco ranks third in scoring defense at 62.9 points per game. A strong perimeter defensive team, the Dons also rank third in opponent three-point percentage, holding teams to just 27.3 percent from distance.

SCORING OFFENSE AND TEAM REBOUNDING: As a team, San Francisco ranks k fifth in the WCC in scoring offense, totaling 66.2 points per game. The Dons e have become a solid rebounding team throughout the 2023-24 campaign, ranking second in the league in rebounding, corralling 38.0 per game. Debora dos Santos leads the team overall, averaging 10.6 per game, while Freja Werth ranks second at 5.7.

A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 20th straight game and 24th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned 11 of their 12 wins this season when this lineup begins a game.
