GAME NOTES & NEWS

- Finishing the regular season with double-digit conference wins for the third time in four seasons, the No. 4-seed University of San Francisco women's basketball team enters postseason play when it competes in the Credit Union 1 WCC Championship quarterfinals, facing off against No. 5-seed Pacific at 1 p.m. on Saturday, Mar. 9, at Orleans Arena.
- San Francisco enters postseason play on a three-game winning streak after posting wins over Portland, Saint Mary's, and San Diego. In the final week of the regular season, the Dons slipped past the Gaels in Moraga 78-74 in overtime on Thursday, Feb. 29, before earning a two-point 68-66 victory over the Toreros on Saturday, Mar. 2, on the Hilltop.
- Debora dos Santos led all scorers with 25 points against the Toreros, recording back-to-back 20-point performances for the second time this season. Freja Werth added 16 points and the game-winning layup with eight seconds left.
- Pacific is coming off a 72-66 win over No-8 seed San Diego in the second round of the tournament on Friday, Mar. 8. Cecilia Holmberg led the Tigers with 19 points.
- Elizabeth Elliot continues to be Pacific's top player, leading the team in scoring and rebounding at 13.8 points and 5.6 boards per game, while Anaya James ranks among the best passers in the WCC, averaging 5.9 per game, which ranks tied for first in the conference.
- San Francisco holds a 28-22 advantage in the all-time series against Pacific, with 13 wins coming since the Tigers joined the WCC before the 2013-14 season.

PLAYING CAREER

Stanford - 1989-93 Linkspring (Sweden) - 1995-96 Richmond Rage (ABL) - 1996-97 Portland Power (ABL) - 1997-98 Molly Goodenbour, a two-time national champion at Stanford who has 14 years of head coaching experience on the collegiate level, was named the ninth head coach in University of San Francisco women's basketball history on Sep. 28, 2016, and enters her eighth season at the helm of the program in 2023-24. This is Goodenbour's third coaching stint on the Hilltop, where she served as an assistant coach with the Dons during the 1994-95 and 2005-06 seasons.

In the 2022-23 season under the leadership of Goodenbour, the Dons concluded with an overall record of 19-13. Three Dons earned All-WCC Selections, while two Dons earned WCC All-Academic Honors. The Dons also participated in their third straight WNIT.

Within the first six years on the Hilltop, Goodenbour posted impressive numbers, including becoming the winningest coach in USF history through 50 games (27-23) and two seasons at 34-28 (.548). Goodenbour quickly built up her impressive resume at USF, becoming the first coach to post winning overall and conference records in her first two seasons on the job.

Building off the program's strong start to the new decade, the Dons were once again punching a postseason ticket as they battled through a grueling non-conference schedule that kept them away from the Hilltop from Thanksgiving until after New Year's Day. Following an 0-4 start to WCC play, battling through injuries and COVID-19-related pauses, the Dons went on to rattle off wins in six of their next seven games and finished with the third seed heading into the WCC Tournament. USF would go on to defeat Santa Clara in Vegas before returning home to host Air Force in the WNIT.

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Goodenbour's Dons have made consecutive WNIT appearances and won at least one game in back-to-back WCC Tournaments. Led by two-time All-WCC first-team selection Ioanna Krimili, USF's 2020-21 team led the conference in total points and points per game while being a top-four program in team plus/minus.

Goodenbour's third WCC Tournament in 2019 saw her lead the Dons to a first-round victory over Portland, marking the seventh year in a row the Dons advanced beyond their opening game.

Molly's 2017-18 squad placed three WCC All-Conference and All-Academic honorees. Anna Seilund earned First-Team All-WCC and Second-Team All-WCC recipients Michaela Rakova and Kalyn Simon.

She finished her first year on the Hilltop in 2016-17 with an 18-13 overall record, including an 11-7 mark in West Coast Conference play, suitable for a fourth-place finish, the Dons' highest since the 2002-03 season. In the process, Goodenbour became the first USF head coach since Sue Rojcewicz in 1982-83 to post a winning record in her first year at the helm and compiled the second-best record by a first-year coach in program history. In addition, USF's 11 WCC wins under Goodenbour were the most since the 1996-97 campaign.

Under Goodenbour, the Dons led the conference in free-throw percentage at 77.8%, which stands as the best single-season percentage in program history. Goodenbour's team also led the WCC in 3-point shooting (34.6%) in 2016-17. Their 217 three-pointers made were the most in program history, including a program-best 15 3s in a win over Portland on Feb. 18, 2017.

Goodenbour's squad placed four student-athletes on the WCC All-Academic team in 2016-17 and boasted a pair of All-WCC honorees in first-teamer Rachel Howard and second-team recipient Anna Seilund.

PRIOR TO SAN FRANCISCO

Goodenbour came to San Francisco from Cal State East Bay, where she was named head coach in June 2016. She has heading coaching experience at Santa Rosa Junior College, Chico State, UC Irvine and Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Before her appointment at Cal State East Bay, Goodenbour spent four seasons as the head coach at Cal State Dominguez Hills. After taking over a program that had posted a 7-48 record in the previous two seasons, Goodenbour led the Toros to a 77-34 (.694) record in her four seasons. Under her guidance, the Toros won California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Tournament Championships in 2013-14 and 2014-15 and CCAA regular season titles in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and made three consecutive NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2013-16. Her 2014-15 squad won a school-record 26 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional.

2023-24 SEASON NOTES & NEWS

PROVED THE WORLD WRONG: San Francisco was picked to finish seventh in the 2023-24 WCC Preseason Coaches Poll but ended the season in a tie for third with a 10-6 conference record. The Dons picked up double-digit conference wins for the third time in the last four seasons.

ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS: Jasmine Gayles and Debora dos Santos earned WCC All-Conference First Team honors last Tuesday, becoming the first two players to receive First Team recognition in the same season since 2004-05 when Mary Jane Krueger and Dominique Carter made the All-WCC First Team.

NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR: In her first season with the team, Freja Werth was named WCC Newcomer of the Year for her contributions to San Francisco's winning efforts this season. Werth established herself as a significant piece to the program's success, serving as the Dons' third-leading scorer at a career-high 9.7 points per game.

DEB FINISHED STRONG: In the final two regular-season games against Saint Mary's and San Diego, Debora dos Santos averaged 27.0 points, 10 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game while adding four steals and three blocks. An efficient shooter throughout the final week of conference play, dos Santos was 62.5 percent from the field while connecting on 13 of her 16 free-throw attempts.

FREJA EARNED THE WIN: Freja Werth helped guide San Francisco to a 68-66 win last Saturday, scoring 16 points and knocking down four three-pointers. In the final minute, Werth totaled five points, including the game-winning layup with eight seconds remaining.

A STRONG REBOUNDER: Freja Werth has become one of San Francisco's best rebounders, averaging 5.6 per game for second-best on the team. Werth has recorded 45 rebounds in the last seven games, including 10 against Santa Clara on February 15. In 16 WCC contests, Werth is averaging 6.3 rebounds per game, ranking seventh in the league.

LUANA KEEPS PASSING: Luana Leite continues to show her passing ability late into the campaign, accumulating 25 assists in the final three games to finish with 125 in her first Division I season. Leite, one of only eight players in the WCC to surpass 100 assists, ranks sixth in the conference in total assists and assists per game (4.3).

THE LEADING SCORER: Through 29 games this season, Jasmine Gayles has led the Dons and ranks third in the WCC in scoring this season, averaging 16.8 points per game. Gayles has posted 20 straight double-digit scoring performances while averaging 17.9 points per game during conference play.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE: In 29 regular-season games, Debora dos Santos has recorded 16 double-doubles, which leads the league. Dos Santos remains the lone player in the WCC, recording a double-double this season with 15.1 points and 10.6 rebounds per game.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Debora dos Santos continues to impress this season, ranking nationally in multiple individual categories, including rebounds per game, double-doubles, and total rebounds. Dos Santos ranks 16th in total rebounds (306), tied for 14th in rebounds per game (10.6), and tied for 17th in double-doubles (16).

SCORING OFFENSE AND TEAM REBOUNDING: As a team, San Francisco ranks fifth in the WCC in scoring offense, totaling 66.7 points per game. The Dons have become a solid rebounding team throughout the 2023-24 campaign, First ranking second in the league in rebounding, corralling 37.7 per game.

KaShanna Jones A CONSISTENT STARTING LINEUP: For the 22nd straight game and 26th overall, a starting lineup of Luana Leite, Jasmine Gayles, Cami Fulcher, Freja Werth, and Debora dos Santos took the floor to open the game. The Dons have earned 13 of their 14 wins this season when this lineup begins a game.
