#### ROAD TRIP TO SAN FRANCISCO

UC San Diego women's basketball will travel to face San Francisco for the second trip to the Bay Area in as many weeks.

The Tritons (1-2) will take on the Dons (1-1) on Sunday at 2 p.m. in the first ever meeting between the programs. The game will be broadcast on ESPN+ and live statistics will be available via UCSDTritons.com.

#### **UP NEXT**

UC San Diego will begin a two-game homestand, facing Air Force on Nov. 22 and Occidental on Nov. 24. The games will be broadcast on ESPN+ with live statistics available via UCSDTritons. com.

#### LAST TIME OUT

After trailing by as many as 18, UC San Diego rallied to within

two in the fourth quarter before ultimately falling to Sacramento State, 71-60.

#### TRITON TAKEAWAYS

The Tritons currently rank second in the Big West in turnover margin (11.67), 24th nationally in the same category and second in the conference in steals (35 total, 11.7 per game). Dymonique Maxie leads the Big West with 3.3 steals per game and Makayla Rose ranks sixth with 2.7. Lev Feiman ranks 16th in the conference with 1.7 steals per game.

#### MA NEARING 1,000 CAREER MARK

Senior Sabrina Ma currently has 984 career points and is currently 16 points away from reaching the 1,000 mark. Ma recorded 396 of her points with the Tritons after spending the first two seasons at San Jose State.

UC San Diego returns seven Tritons from the 2024-25 squad that recorded the program's first 20-win season of the Division l era. Starters Gracie Gallegos and Sabrina Ma return, as well as All-Big West preseason honoree Erin Condron. Last season Ma was named Big West Newcomer of the Year and All-Big West Honorable Mention alongside Gallegos, who earned a spot

#### FRESH FACES

The Tritons added six talented newcomers to the squad during the offseason, signing two transfer scholar-athletes and four incoming true freshman for the 2025-26 season. UC San Diego added 2024-25 Big West Defensive Player of the Year, Makayla Rose (UC Riverside) for her senior season and junior guard Dymonique Maxie (Nevada). Guard Michaela Fairwell (Irmo, S.C.), guard Lev Feiman (Woodland Hills, Calif.), forward Tatum Jones (Aurora, Colo.) and guard/forward Niya Price (Lancaster, Calif.) round out the freshman class for the Tritons.

#### CONDRON NAMED TO PRESEASON COACHES' TEAM

Junior forward Erin Condron was named to the Big West Women's Basketball Preseason Coaches' Team, selected by the conference's 11 head coaches. Condron had a breakout sophomore season for the Tritons in 2024-25, averaging 8.1 points and 4.7 rebounds in 18.6 minutes per game. Condron appeared in 22 games after missing the first 14 games due to injury, recording 10 double-figure scoring efforts and one double-double.

#### TRITONS PICKED FOURTH IN PRESEASON POLL

The defending Big West champions were picked to finished fourth in the Big West Preseason Coaches' Poll, earning 77 points and two first-place votes. Hawai'i was picked to finish first with 91 points and four of the 11 first-place votes, followed closely by UC Irvine with 90 points and four first-place votes as well. UC Davis received one first-place vote and 83 points for third, while UC San Diego received the remaining two first-place votes to rank fourth.

UC Santa Barbara was picked to finish fifth with 61 points, followed by Long Beach State (57 points), UC Riverside (51), Cal Poly (34), CSUN (27), Cal State Fullerton (20), Cal State Bakersfield (14).

#### HISTORY MADE

The Tritons women's basketball team had a historical 2024-25 campaign, winning the Big West Championship as the No. 4 seed and recording the first 20-win season of the program's Division I era. UC San Diego made history as the first program to send both its men's and women's basketball teams to the NCAA Tournament in their first season of Division I eligibility.

#### WINNING IN THE CLASSROOM

The Tritons excelled in the classroom in 2024-25, with six scholar-athletes being named to the Big West Winter All-Academic Team, including current Tritons Erin Condron, Gracie Gallegos, Junaé Mahan and Rosa Smith. Additionally, 15 Tritons were named to the Big West Commissioner's Honor Roll with 10 earning Highest Honors (3.51-4.00 GPA) including Gracie Gallegos, Sabrina Ma, Nicki Polocheck, Rosa Smith and Damilola Sule.

#### UC SAN DIEGO HEADED TO THE WCC

On Sept. 3, 2025, UC San Diego accepted a formal invitation to join the West Coast Conference (WCC) beginning July 1, 2027. UC San Diego will compete in 14 of the West Coast Conference's 16 sponsored sports, including men's and women's basketball, men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, men's and women's cross country, men's water polo, baseball, softball, men's and women's tennis, men's golf and women's rowing. The university remains committed to finding a conference affiliation for its sports that will not compete in the West Coast Conference.

Beginning in 2027-28, the WCC membership will consist of: University of California San Diego, Loyola Marymount University, University of the Pacific, Pepperdine University, University of Portland, Saint Mary's College, University of San Diego, University of San Francisco, Santa Clara University, and Seattle University. UC San Diego will become the first public institution in the West Coast Conference since the departure of the University of Nevada-Reno in 1979.

#### ANDY FEE NAMED ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AT UC SAN DIEGO

On Sept. 10, 2025, UC San Diego Chancellor Pradeep K. Khosla announced the hiring of college sports veteran Andy Fee as the Tritons' new Director of Athletics. Fee will become just the fourth Director of Athletics at UC San Diego since 1966. Fee joins the Tritons after spending the 2024-25 season as Deputy AD at Seattle University. Prior to Seattle U, Fee spent two years at Washington as Deputy AD and Chief of Staff.

Before relocating to Seattle, Fee spent five years as Director of Athletics at Long Beach State from 2017 to 2022. During this time, Long Beach State's athletic programs found great success as the school advanced to the postseason in 18 of its 19 sports programs in his five-year tenure. The Beach won a pair of national championships in men's volleyball and claimed The Biq West Commissioner's Cup three times.

No stranger to conference transition, Fee will help guide the Tritons into the West Coast Conference in 2027-28. He also helped guide Washington into the Big Ten and Seattle U into the WCC in July.

#### WHY THE TRITONS?

The Triton is described as the offspring of Poseidon and Amphitrite, a demigod of the sea with a lower part of the body like that of a fish. It is known as a mighty and fierce sea warrior. Given UC San Diego's close proximity to the Pacific Ocean and its connections with the world-famous Scripps Institution of Oceanography, the Triton became our mascot in 1964.

# **HEIDI VANDERVEER • Head Coach** 14th Season

Heidi VanDerveer enters her 14th season as head coach of the UC San Diego's women's basketball program in 2025-26, after being named the sixth coach in school history on May 25, 2012. A former WNBA coach, Olympic team scout and assistant for the legendary Pat Summitt at the University of Tennessee, VanDerveer has coached the likes of Sue Bird, Candace Parker, Lisa Leslie, Diana Taurasi and several other women's basketball superstars.

During her tenure, VanDerveer has coached the Tritons to six NCAA Tournament appearances (2013, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2025), five conference championships

(2016-2020) and four conference tournament titles (2013, 2019, 2020, 2025). UC San Diego has had five All-Americans, four conference players of the year and 36 all-conference honorees.

The 2024-25 season was a historic one for UC San Diego, as the Tritons earned their first NCAA Division I Tournament berth by winning the Big West Championship in Henderson, Nev. The Tritons entered the conference tournament as the No. 4 seed and defeated No. 8 Cal Poly, No. 1 Hawai'i and No. 3 UC Davis in the finals for their first Big West crown. Sumayah Sugapong was named tournament MVP and Parker Montgomery and Gracie Gallegos earned a spot on the all-tournament team.

VanDerveer came to La Jolla following an impressive stint at Division III Occidental, where she compiled an overall record of 84-25 (.771) and led the Tigers to four straight Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC) titles during her four seasons. She also guided Occidental to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances -- including the program's first-ever NCAA berth in her first season in 2008-09. VanDerveer went 50-6 (.893) in SCIAC play, amassing the highest conference winning percentage of any coach in league history. She coached three all-conference selections in 2011-12, including SCIAC Player of the Year Makenzie Brandon, who led the league in scoring at 18.1 points per game.

VanDerveer has over two decades of experience at both the collegiate and professional levels. She began her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Tennessee under Summit in 1986 and helped guide the Lady Volunteers to the 1987 NCAA National Championship and a Final Four appearance in 1988.

She then spent six seasons as an assistant at the University of South Carolina from 1988-94, where she helped lead the Gamecocks to three NCAA Tournament appearances.

VanDerveer served as the head women's basketball coach at Eastern Washington University for three seasons from 1994-97. Her tenure was highlighted by back-to-back Big Sky Conference Tournament appearances in 1995 and 1996.

After her stint at Eastern Washington, VanDerveer spent 12 years working in the WNBA, beginning with an assistant coaching position with the Sacramento Monarchs in 1997. She was later promoted to head coach before the 1998-99 season and went on to work with the Minnesota Lynx as both an assistant (1999-2002) and head coach (2002). She was an WNBA scout from 2003-05 and served as an assistant with the Seattle Storm in 2006 and 2007.

VanDerveer moved back to the collegiate ranks as an assistant at the University of San Francisco in 2004-05 and was named the head coach of the program just four games into the season. She also served as the video coordinator for two seasons under her Hall of Fame big sister Tara VanDerveer at Stanford, and was the associate head coach at San Diego State under longtime Aztecs coach Beth Burns for one season prior to taking the job at Occidental.

In addition to her collegiate and professional experience, VanDerveer worked with USA Basketball as a scout for the 2006 World Championship team and the 2008 World Qualifying Tournament. Most recently, she served as a scout for the 2008 Olympic Team that won a Gold medal in Beijing.

VanDerveer graduated from the College of Charleston with a Bachelor's Degree in political science in 1986 and went on to earn her Master's in physical education and sports psychology from the University of Tennessee in 1988. She was a four-year letterwinner on the basketball team at Charleston and served as a team captain as a junior and a senior.
