THE OPENING TIP

- USF bounced back in its last time on the hardwood, notching a 14-point win over Loyola Chicago, 85-71, at Chase Center in San Francisco on Wednesday night. Spearheading the offense, Tyrone Riley IV finished with a season-high 22 points and a career-high six made three-pointers while David Fuchs returned from injury to finish with a career-high 20 points, including 10-of-14 from the free throw line. Notably, Riley IV's six triples were the most by a Don since Ndewedo Newbury shot 6-of-10 from beyond the arc in a 96-69 win at home over Portland on Jan 13, 2024.
- After shooting 52.9 percent (27-51) in the win over Loyola Chicago, San Francisco is now 26-0 under head coach Chris Gerlufsen when shooting 50 percent or over from the field. As a team, USF knocked down 13 shots from beyond-the-arc (13-27/48.1 percent), marking a new season-high in three-pointers made. The Dons also turned the ball over only four times against the Ramblers, a new season-low.
- Fuchs has been a force on the glass so far this season, coming into the contest tied for fifth in the West Coast Conference (WCC) in rebounds per game (6.7) despite missing three games due to injury. He is also tied for fifth in the conference in defensive rebounds per game (4.9). Additionally, Mookie Cook is just outside of the top ten in total rebounds, currently ranking eleventh in the WCC with 68 total boards.
- San Francisco has won its final game of nonconference play in three straight seasons, gaining momentum heading into league play. Last year, USF took down Montana, 71-67, on Dec. 21, a team that would go on to win the Big Sky Tournament and qualify for the NCAA Tournament.



CHRIS GERLUFSEN

HEAD COACH | FOURTH SEASON AT SAN FRANCISCO | FIFTH OVERALL

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS AT SAN FRANCISCO:

Chris Gerlufsen enters his fourth year as the head coach of San Francisco after being elevated from associate head coach on March 18, 2022. This past season, Gerlufen guided the Dons to an eighth straight full season of 20+ wins as the Dons finished 25-10 overall and 13-5 in conference play in 2024-25.

Last season, San Francisco finished third in the final West Coast Conference (WCC) regular season standings, earning back-to-back top-three finishes in the conference for the first time in 22 years (2001-02 and 2002-03). USF's 13 conference victories marked the most in a single season since 2013-14, when the green and gold also finished 13-5.

In postseason play, San Francisco reached the semifinal round of the WCC Tournament for the fourth consecutive season in 2024-25. The Dons earned a spot in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) for the second straight season, being awarded the No. 1 seed in the San Francisco region of the 2025 NIT. USF took care of business in the opening round, defeating Utah Valley, 79-70, on Mar. 19 before narrowly falling to Loyola Chicago, 77-76, on Mar. 23.

Three Dons earned All-WCC honors in 2024-25 as Malik Thomas and Marcus Williams were both named to the All-WCC First Team while Tyrone Riley IV was named to the All-WCC Freshman Team. Notably, Williams earned a spot on the All-WCC First Team for the second straight year after also earning First Team honors in 2023-24. Thomas was also named a Lou Henson Award Finalist by Collegelnsider. com, which is presented annually to the top mid-major player in college basketball. Academically, Robby Beasley was named to the WCC All-Academic team last season.

Through his first three seasons as head coach on the Hilltop, Gerlufsen is 68-35 (.660) overall, including a 31-19 (.620) record in conference action. Each year, Gerlufsen has improved his win total, climbing from 20 wins in year one to 23 wins in year, and most recently 25 wins in year three.

In June 2024, Jonathan Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco drafted into the NBA since 1982 as the dynamic forward was selected with the 31st pick overall in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft. With his selection, Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco to be drafted into the NBA since the trio of Quintin Dailey (Round 1, Pick 7/Chicago Bulls), Wallace Bryant (Round 2, Pick 30/Chicago Bulls) and John Hegwood (Round 9, Pick 186/San Diego Clippers) were selected in 1982. Overall, Mogbo became the 39th student-athlete from the university to be drafted into the NBA and the first under Gerlufsen. With his selection by Toronto, he is also the eighth Don all-time to be drafted in the second round. Additionally, Mogbo was the first West Coast Conference player taken off the board in the 2024 NBA Draft. It is just the second time since 2001 that a WCC school other than Gonzaga was the first to have a player selected (2023 - Brandin Podziemski/Santa Clara). Prior to the draft, Mogbo was one of 78 players invited to the 2024 NBA Draft Combine in Chicago from May 12-19.

Gerlufsen's inaugural season in 2022-23 began with a 7-1 start, a stretch highlighted by San Francisco winning the 2022 Hall of Fame Classic championship in Kansas City, MO. The Dons would finish nonconference play with a record of 11-4, which tied the most preseason win total by a first-year head coach at USF since 1980-81.

The team's 2022-23 campaign featured a 37-point win over #25 Arizona State - the largest victory over a ranked team in program history. That final margin also represents the fourth-biggest win for an unranked team over an AP Top 25 opponent in the past 31 seasons.

Gerlufsen's analytically-driven offensive system produced the 17th-most made threes per game in college basketball in 2021-22. When he was elevated to head coach in 2022-23, that number jumped to seventh in the country (out of 363 teams).

San Francisco's starting backcourt of Khalil Shabazz and Tyrell Roberts experienced significant success in 2022-23. Shabazz and Roberts were both selected as All-WCC First Team performers. Each of them improved their scoring outputs by over four points per game under Gerlufsen. Shabazz was named the Hall of Fame Classic MVP and a WCC All-Tournament team selection in his final season on the Hilltop. Roberts was selected to the Hall of Fame Classic All-Tournament team.

On March 18, 2022, Gerlufsen became the 21st head coach of the storied USF program, which has won two national championships (1955 &1956) and one National Invitational championship (1949). In 2021-22, he was an integral part of San Francisco's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1998, serving as Todd Golden's associate head coach.

During the 2021-22 season, San Francisco won 24 games - the most victories by a Dons team since the men's basketball program was reinstated from shutdown in 1985. The team's at-large NCAA Tournament berth was the program's first since the bracket was expanded to its modern format of 64+ teams.

In Gerlufsen's first year on staff, USF finished among college basketball's elite in many metric-based rankings, including a 23rd place finish in KenPom and 26th in the NCAA's NET rankings. Following a successful 2021-22 campaign, USF star guard Jamaree Bouyea became the first San Francisco Don to play in the NBA since Bill Cartwright in 1995.

Prior to Gerlufsen's arrival on the Hilltop, he spent two seasons as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii. During the 2019-20 season, he served as the acting head coach for Hawaii's first 13 games and compiled an 8-5 record (.615). His winning percentage at Hawaii currently ranks 2nd all-time in their school's Division I history. Among Gerlufsen's signature wins was an 85-75 upset victory over previously undefeated San Francisco. While at Hawaii, Gerlufsen coached All-Big West First Team guard Eddie Stansberry.

Before Hawaii, Gerlufsen spent four seasons as an assistant coach in the WCC with the University of San Diego. During his time at USD, the Toreros posted back-to-back 20+ win seasons for the first time ever. Gerlufsen's final season at San Diego saw the Toreros earn a bid to the 2019 NIT - the only NIT invitation in USD history. While coaching with the Toreros, Gerlufsen helped forward Isaiah Pineiro develop into a two-time All-WCC First Team performer.

Gerlufsen was particularly instrumental in San Diego's turnaround from an international recruiting standpoint, signing more than a half dozen foreign players during his tenure. One notable recruit, Yauhen Massalski, would play for Gerlufsen at both San Diego and San Francisco, where he blossomed into an All-WCC First Team selection on the Dons' 2021-22 NCAA Tournament team.

From 2006-15, Gerlufsen spent nine seasons on the bench at the University of Hartford. After seven years as an assistant coach, he was promoted to associate head coach for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. Gerlufsen served as the program's recruiting coordinator during that time. While at Hartford, Gerlufsen designed the team's perimeter-oriented motion offense. His system triggered six consecutive seasons with 225+ made 3's. In 2007-08, Hartford set an America East Conference record by connecting on 312 made 3's - a number which ranked 10th nationalty.

From 2001-06, Gerlufsen spent his five seasons coaching at The Citadel under Pat Dennis. On January 2, 2004, Gerlufsen served as interim head coach for one game. He began his head coaching career 1-0 with a 82-58 win over Army. Before working in the Division I ranks, Gerlufsen got his start with coaching jobs at Southwestern from 1999-2001 and Washington College (Maryland) in 1998-99.

As a player, Gerlufsen was a four-time letter winner for Randolph-Macon College, a Division III school in Virginia. While playing for the Yellow Jackets, he was named team captain for a squad that advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament twice. He graduated in 1998 with a B.A. in business and economics. Gerlufsen currently resides in San Francisco, CA with his wife lla.

2025-26 SAN FRANCISCO MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

CONTINUED SUCCESS ON THE HILLTOP:

San Francisco has won 20+ games in the last eight full seasons dating back to 2016-17. The only season in which the Dons have not reached the 20-win mark was 2020-21, when the schedule was shortened to 25 total games (without fans in attendance) due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Last year, USF won 25 games, the most wins for the program in a single-season since San Francisco went 25-6 in 1981-82.

POSTSEASON REGULARS:

Shrieve-Hawkins
San Francisco has reached a postseason tournament in three of its last four seasons, beginning with the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 1998 in March 2022. The Dons have been selected to participate in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) the past two seasons. Last year, USF earned a No. 1 seed in the San Francisco region, taking down Utah Valley (79-70) in the opening round of the tournament before narrowly falling to Loyola Chicago (77-76) in the second round. In 2024, USF dropped an overtime contest on the road at Cincinatti (73-72) in the opening round.

DON'T SLEEP ON THE DONS:

San Francisco was picked to finish third in this year's West Coast Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Poll, earning 98 total points, including one first-place vote, to finish behind Gonzaga (119 points) and Saint Mary's (109 points). Ryan Beasley and Tyrone Riley IV were named to the Men's Basketball Preseason Team. Notably, four schools had two representatives on the Preseason Team: San Francisco, Gonzaga, Saint Mary's, and Santa Clara, along with Elias Ralph of Pacific.

BACK AND HUNGRY FOR MORE:

Seven student-athletes return from last year's team: Veniamin "Ben" Abosi, Ryan Beasley, Saba Gigiberia, Ndewedo Newbury, Tyrone Riley IV, Isa Silva, and Junjie "Barry" Wang. Beasley aims to be the head of the snake for San Francisco this season, having been named the WCC Freshman of the Year in 2023-24 followed by ending last year in the starting lineup.

Jay Duncan SEASONED VETERANS:

The Dons bring in a wealth of experience through the transfer portal in the additions of Aidan Braccia (Belmont), Mookie Cook (Oregon), David Fuchs (Rhode Island), Guillermo Diaz Graham (Pitssburgh), and Vukasin Masic (Portland/Maine/Hofstra). Masic is a familiar face for USF fans, having played at Portland the past two seasons. Diaz Graham aims to be a pivotal piece for the green and gold, having averaged 5.0 rebounds in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) last season.

RILEY RISING UP:

Tyrone Riley IV returned to the Hilltop after entering the transfer portal this offseason, remaining loyal to the Dons despite a handful of offers from Power schools. Riley stayed active this summer, which included earning an invitation to USA Basketball Men's U19 National Team Training Camp. He was also invited to the 2025 Formula Zero Elite Camp as a college counselor, a camp for elite high school and college players, founded by 9-time NBA All-Star Damian Lillard.

BARRY GOES GLOBAL:

Junjie "Barry" Wang saw success on the international stage this summer, competing for Team China in the 2025 FIBA Asia Cup. For his efforts, he was named to the FIBA Asia Cup All-Star Five after China finished as the runner-up in the tournament, the country's best finish since 2015. Back in 2023, Wang represented Team China at the FIBA U-19 Basketball World Cup.

WELCOME BACK, VINNIE:

Vinnie McGhee, an Oakland native and McClymonds High School graduate, officially returned to the Hilltop on Oct. 6 as an assistant coach for the second time. McGhee spent the past two years in the NBA G League, first with the South Bay Lakers (Los Angeles Lakers) and then with the Wisconsin Herd (Milwaukee Bucks), where he continued to develop a reputation as a standout teacher and mentor for guards and perimeter players. McGhee previously spent five years with the Dons from 2019-23, helping guide USF to three 20+ win campaigns, including a 24-win season and an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2021-2022. Before his first tenure on the Hilltop, McGhee coached at Northern Colorado, where he helped lead the Bears to consecutive 20-win seasons and the 2017-18 CIT Championship. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant under Tim Floyd at UTEP in 2015-16.

San Francisco will return to Chase Center twice this season, first suiting up for the annual USF Legacy on Dec. 17 when the Dons will battle Loyola Chicago at the home of the seven-time NBA champion Golden State Warriors and Golden State Valkyries. The Dons will later host Gonzaga in their final regular season home West Coast Conference game against the Bulldogs on Feb. 18.

GRAB YOUR POPCORN:

25-12 USF will appear on national television twelve times this season, including six on CBS Sports Network (CBSSN) and four on ESPN networks. San Francisco will first appear on CBS Sports Network on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 27, when the green and gold battle Colorado in their opening game of the Acrisure Series. Both conference matchups against Gonzaga, Saint Mary's, and Santa Clara will also air on national television.

NEUTRAL SITE TESTS:

The Dons have four key neutral site matchups scheduled in their nonconference slate. First, USF will travel to Sioux Falls, S.D. to take on Minnesota at Sanford Pentagon on Saturday, Nov. 22. Less than one week later, San Francisco will return to the state of California, heading to Palm Springs for the Acrisure Classic on Thanks-26-0 7-12 59-10 giving weekend. USF is scheduled to first play Colorado on Thanksgiving morning, Thursday, Nov. 27, at Acrisure Arena. Depending on the result of the initial matchups, the green and gold will then take on Nevada or Washington on Friday, Nov. 28. Moving into December, USF treks to Tupelo, Miss. to face off against Mississippi State in a showdown at Cadence Bank Arena on Sunday, Dec. 7. 2-3

CONFERENCE REALIGNMENT:

The West Coast Conference (WCC) continues to reshape its future as universities realign throughout the country, adding Seattle U to the conference this summer on July 1. The Redhawks were previously a member of the WCC (then known as the West Coast Athletic Conference or WCAC) from 1971-1980. Recently, the WCC announced that the University of Denver will be the newest member of the conference beginning July 1, 2026, bringing the league total to eleven universities next 44-27 summer. After the conclusion of the 2025-26 academic year, Gonzaga, Oregon State, and Washington State are all scheduled to leave the WCC for the Pac-12 Conference.

Despite the loss, Christian Oliver (14 points) and Rob Lawson (11 points) finished in double figures for the Bears, with Lawson also adding a team-high eight assists.
- Following its matchup with San Francisco on Sunday afternoon, Morgan State will head south for a road game at LMU on Tuesday, Dec. 23, at 6:00 pm PT.
 - Alfred Worrell Jr., who appeared in 32 games averaging 6.5 points and 1.6 rebounds as a junior at Southern Mississippi last season, enters Sunday's contest as the leading scorer for the Bears, averaging 14.2 points per game. Alongside Worrell Jr., Lawson and Elijah Davis (Bowie State transfer) both average double figures at 13.3 points per game.
- Christian Meeks, who has started in eight of the eleven games he has appeared in for Morgan State, is the team's leading rebounder with an average of 5.0 rebounds per game and 55 total boards.

SERIES HISTORY

- Sunday will mark the third meeting all-time between San Francisco and Morgan State, with the Dons holding a 2-0 record over the Bears in the all-time series.
- Most recently, USF defeated Morgan State, 83-67, at home on the Hilltop on Nov. 22, 2021. The green and gold were also victorious in the first-ever matchup between the two programs, securing an 87-74 win at home over the Bears on Jan. 3, 2012.
