- Coming off a third-round win over LMU on Saturday, the University of San Francisco women's basketball team takes on No. 4-seed Oregon State at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday, Mar. 9, in the quarterfinals of the Credit Union 1 West Coast Conference Championship at Orleans Arena.
- San Francisco won its first conference tournament game since 2022, when it defeated LMU 75-66. Freja Werth led all scorers with 24 points while shooting 50 percent (six-for-12) from the field and knocked down 11 of her 12 free-throw attempts.
- Emma Trawally Porta and Angeliki Ziaka scored 13 points apiece, while Trawally Porta nearly recorded a double-double with a game-high nine rebounds.
- Oregon State enters the quarterfinal round winners of three of its last four contests, including a 73-46 win at Pepperdine on Saturday, Mar. 1 in the regular season finale.
- Kelsey Rees leads the team in scoring and rebounding, averaging 13.3 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Rees has posted double-digit points in 21 games this season, averaging 16.0 points per game in the last four games.
- The Beavers have numerous scoring threats, as five players average at least 8.0 points per game. AJ Marotte, the other double-figure scorer for the program, averages 11.4 points per game.
- San Francisco and Oregon State have faced off 11 times in program history, with the Beavers holding the commanding 8-4 edge.
