#### TIPPING OFF

Loyola Chicago is set for NIT round two action against San Francisco. Tip-off between the Ramblers and Dons is slated for 6 p.m. CT. Loyola looks to even the season series against USF with a win and advance in the tournament.

Sunday's game can be watched on ESPN2 with Chris Sylvester (PXP) and Jerod Haase (Analyst). The game can also be listened to Rambler Sports Network with Scott Sudikoff (PXP) and Christian Thomas (Analyst).

#### RAMBLINGS

- The Ramblers won their first NIT game since 1962 after downing San Jose State in the opening round, 73-70.
- Des Watson poured in 24 points on 8-15 from the field and 6-6 at the line. It marked his sixth 20-point performance of the year.
- Miles Rubin added 14 points for the Ramblers, while Francis Nwaakorrie neared a double-double with eight points and nine rebounds.
- Loyola won its first ever A-10 Tournament game, beating Saint Louis in the quarterfinals, 72-64.
- Watson dropped a career-high 25 points against the Billikens. He went 7-14 from the field and 8-9 at the line.
- Jayden Dawson (12) and Sheldon Edwards Jr. (10) added double-figure performances, while Kymany Houinsou grabbed 10 boards for the second straight game.
- The Ramblers dominated the boards against VCU in the semifinals, out rebounding the Rams, 48-38.
- Loyola grabbed a season-high 22 offensive rebounds, led by Rubin who had five. Rubin, Houinsou, and Jalen DeLoach totaled eight rebounds each.
- For the second straight season, Rubin broke the single-season block record. He tallied one block against the Rams, marking his 77th of the year. Last year, he broke the 40-year-old record with 76 blocks.
- Edwards Jr. also broke a single-season record. His 86th three-pointer of the season set the new mark. He did it in a 22-point, 10 rebound double-double on senior day vs. Davidson. Edwards Jr. has 101 made this season after hitting two against SJSU.
- Dawson and Rubin earned All-Atlantic 10 honors. Dawson was tabbed to the second team, while Rubin collected All-Defensive honors for the second straight season.
- Rubin moved up in national rankings. He sits eighth in total blocks (79), ninth in block percentage (11.8),

### SCOUTING SAN FRANCISCO

The Dons enter the second round of the NIT at 25-9 overall. With a 13-5 conference record, USF took third in the West Coast Conference and fell in the semifinals to Gonzaga, 85-76. The Dons have the second-best three-point field goal percentage defense in the country, holding opponents to just 28.1 percent from the arc.

USF is led by Malik Thomas who ranks 26th in total points (640) and 30th in points per game (19.4) in the country. He's scored at least 10 points in all but three games this year and has 16 games with at least 20. He dropped a season-best 35 points against the Ramblers earlier this season. Thomas was a All-WCC First Team selection.

Chris Gerlufsen is in his third season at the helm with a 76-39 record with the Dons.

### LAST TIME OUT

Des Watson poured in 24 points, helping the Ramblers to a first-round NIT win Wednesday night. Loyola Chicago outlasted a late San Jose State rally to win, 73-70. Watson went 8-15 from the field and 6-6 at the free throw line to fuel his sixth 20-point outing of the season.

San Jose State drained the first three of the game to take control early, jumping ahead 8-2. The laed never got above six, as the Ramblers battled back. Des Watson scored five straight to get within one, while Jayden Dawson's three at the 14:29 mark gave Loyola its first lead of the night, 12-11. SJSU would find one more lead of the half before Sheldon Edwards Jr. hit his 100th three of the season to keep the Ramblers in control.

Loyola's lead diminished with a with SJSU chipping away. Jose Uduje connected on a big three to tie the game 24-all with 7:35 on the clock. Three minutes later, the Spartans regained a lead on a 6-0 run. Four were from Uduje whose layup off a Rambler turnover swung the momentum. Jermaine Washington hit a three just under the four-minute mark to put SJSU up by four, but Francis Nwaokorie scored back-to-back threes to lead Loyola on a 13-2 run to close the half with a lead, 42-35.

Loyola's lead went up to 10 right out of the break on a Dawson three. The lead climbed to 14 with seven straight Rambler points. Watson put up five of them, including a fast break three for the 54-40 edge with

16:03 to play. The Rambler lead stayed north of 10 over the next several minutes. Miles Rubin would put away a dunk for Loyola's largest lead at the 9:17 mark, 67-52.

After Rubin's dunk, the Spartans sparked their comeback. Donovan Yap Jr.'s steal and layup led SJSU on an 18-4 run to get back within one of the Ramblers, 71-70. Watson tallied all of Loyola's points in the final seven minutes, including two clutch free throws with 42 seconds on the clock. The Ramblers held on to win, 73-70.

### ALL-ATLANTIC 10

Jayden Dawson and Miles Rubin collected All-Atlantic 10 honors Tuesday afternoon, the league announced. Dawson was tabbed to the Second Team, while Rubin was named All-Defensive for the second consecutive season.

Dawson leads the Ramblers in scoring, averaging 13.5 points per game. He has racked up 19 games with at least 10 points scored and a team-leading five 20-point outings. The junior guard is shooting 42.1 percent from the field and 38.8 percent from three-point range with 71 makes on the year. Dawson adds 3.0 rebounds, 1.9 assists 1.0 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game.

In the season opener, Dawson dropped his first 20 piece of the year. He then recorded four more 20+ point games in conference play, including three straight games to earn A-10 Player of the Week honors. The Omaha native scored 24 at Richmond, a career-high 26 vs. Saint Louis, and another 24 at Davidson. Dawson made at least five threes in each game.

For the second straight year, Rubin earned All-Defensive honors. Rubin leads the Ramblers in both rebounds per game (5.2) and blocks per game (2.4). In the NCAA, Rubin ranks eighth in total blocks (74) and 11th in blocks per game (2.4). His 12.3 block percentage also ranks eighth in the Nation.

Rubin has three double-doubles and four games with 10+ rebounds this season. He grabbed a career-best 13 rebounds at Princeton helping Loyola to the win. He's tallied at least three blocks in 15 games this year, including a season-high five vs. San Francisco. Rubin needs three more blocks to break the single-season record of 76 that he set last year. He also ranks third in the program's record book with 150 career-blocks.

### IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Miles Rubin is climbing the record book in career blocks. The sophomore center has 155 career blocks, ranking third in program history. He has 79 and counting this season, which broke the single-season record he set last year.

Sheldon Edwards Jr. has 101 made three-pointers this season and broke the single-season record against Davidson on March 5. He finished 7-12 from the arc and claimed the record with his 86th made three of the season, which was his third of the game.

Edwards Jr. and Des Watson both eclipsed 1,000 career points this season. Edwards Jr. notched the milestone against VCU on his first three-pointer of the game that fell in the second half. Watson surpassed the mark at Saint Joseph's on his final bucket of the game.

### RECORD SETTING RAMBLERS

Loyola drained 18 three-pointers at Richmond in an 87-80 overtime win. The 18 made threes is second on the program's single-season game record list. It is the most threes made against an A-10 opponent.

The win against St. Bonaventure, 77-53, was the largest win against a conference opponent since joining the A-10. It was also the fewest points Loyola allowed in an A-10 game.

Loyola held UMass to 26.6 percent from the field, which is the best field goal percentage defense vs. an Atlantic 10 opponent since joining the league.

Loyola tallied a season-low five turnovers vs. Rhode Island, which ties the fewest turnovers committed during Valentine's tenure.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Miles Rubin, Sheldon Edwards Jr., and Kymany Houinsou have double-doubles in the Maroon & Gold. Rubin has four career, while Edwards Jr. and Houinsou have one each.

Rubin's first double-double of the season came in a hard fought win at Princeton back in November. He tallied 11 points and 13 rebounds. Rubin finished 5-of-9 from the field and added four blocks. His second of the year came vs. Eastern Michigan with 10 points and 10 boards. Rubin was 5-of-7 from the field. Against Saint Louis, Rubin tallied 10 points and 11 boards.

Edwards Jr. notched his fifth 20-point outing of the year with 22 points vs. Davidson. He added 10 rebounds. The 22 points tied his season-best, while the 10 boards was a new high on the year.

Houinsou tallied one in the regular season finale against UMass. He recorded new career-highs in rebounds (10) and assists (10).



NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Over the last two seasons, Loyola has posted a 31-3 record in Gentile Arena. The win over Davidson on March 5 gave the Ramblers a 16-1 record to wrap the home season. Its the most wins on their home court since the 1965-66 season.

At home this season, the Ramblers held a +12.7 scoring margin, averaging 77.8 points per game. Loyola shot nearly 49 percent from the field and averaged 19.4 assists per game. Defensively, the Ramblers held an edge on the glass (+2.3) and averaged 7.2 steals and 4.7 blocks per game.

Des Watson was the top scorer on the home court, averaging 13.7 points per game. Jayden Dawson added 12.3 ppg, while Sheldon Edwards Jr. averaged 12.1. All three shot over 35 percent from three with over 30 makes each.

# DREW VALENTINE

**HEAD COACH | 4TH SEASON**  
RECORD AT LOYOLA - 81-50 (4 SEASONS)  
CAREER RECORD - SAME



Drew Valentine enters his fourth season as head coach of Loyola men's basketball in the 2024-25 season and eighth overall year with the Ramblers, having spent the four seasons prior as an assistant coach.

During his tenure as head coach, the Ramblers have a Missouri Valley Conference Tournament Championship, a NCAA Tournament appearance, an Atlantic 10 Regular Season Title, and a NIT First Round appearance.

In 2023-24, Valentine piloted the Ramblers to one of the NCAA's best turnarounds with the fourth highest win improvement from the 2022-23 season. Loyola increased its win total by 12 wins, going from 10-21 to 22-10 against Division I opponents. Loyola finished with a 23-10 overall record and 15-3 finish in the A-10 in 2023-24. The Ramblers took home a share of the league's regular season title, ultimately earning an NIT bid.

Valentine was named an Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Collegiate Co-Coach of the Year, while guiding Des Watson, Braden Norris, and Miles Rubin to All-Conference honors. Watson was tabbed to the A-10 Second Team, Norris to the A-10 Third and All-Academic Teams, and Rubin to the A-10 All-Rookie and All-Defensive Teams. Watson also earned NACB All-District Second Team accolades.

Rubin made a statement in his freshman campaign, breaking a 40-year-old single-season block record after finishing the season with 76. He ranked first in the country in block percentage (14.1 percent). Rubin was the driving force behind Valentine's squad that also set the single-season team block record at 166 that stood for over 40 years.

Valentine also saw four of his 2023-24 graduates sign professional deals, highlighted by Philip Alston who inked a contract with the Milwaukee Bucks in August 2024. Norris, Dame Adelekun, and Patrick Mwamba all signed overseas.

The Lansing, Mich. native made his head coaching debut in the 2021-22 season and was the youngest coach in NCAA Division I hoops at the age of 30. Valentine made quite a splash in his first season as Loyola's head coach setting a program record for wins by a first-year Rambler skipper (25), while also becoming the only first-year coach in program history to lead Loyola to a NCAA Tournament appearance.

One of only three first-year head coaches to steer his club to 25 or more wins in 2021-22, Valentine also became the youngest head coach since Todd Bozeman in 1993 to lead his team to a national ranking. Loyola earned a No. 22 ranking in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll in mid-January.

Valentine put his twist on the Rambler program in 2021-22 and once again Loyola ranked among the nation's top offensive and defensive teams in the nation, while also establishing a single-season school record by knocking down 293 three-point field goals. Under Valentine's tutelage, five Ramblers collected All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades, including guard Lucas Williamson, who was tabbed MVC Defensive Player of the Year for the second straight season, and also garnered first team all-league recognition.

In four years as an assistant coach on Porter Moser's staff at Loyola, Valentine played a pivotal role in the program's ascension to national prominence, helping the Ramblers to a 99-36 (.733) overall record, a 56-16 (.778) ledger in MVC action, and a NCAA Final Four appearance in 2018 and Sweet 16 in 2021.

Krutwig became Loyola's first AP Third Team All-America selection since 1985, and in 2018, Custer was tabbed Third Team Academic All-America.

During his four seasons on the Loyola staff as an assistant, Loyola ranked in the top six in the nation in scoring defense three times and helped lead Loyola to five consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins, including a school-record 32 victories in 2017-18 during a magical run to the NCAA Final Four. Loyola is 6-3 in NCAA Tournament games since Valentine joined the Ramblers' staff in 2017-18.

In 2020-21, Valentine's influence was evident as Loyola posted a 26-5 overall record as well as a program-record 16 conference victories, while capturing the MVC regular season and tournament championships. Earning the No. 8 seed in the NCAA Tournament, the Ramblers reached the Sweet 16, picking up wins over the Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament champion, Georgia Tech, as well as the top seed in the Midwest Region, Big Ten Tournament champion, Illinois.

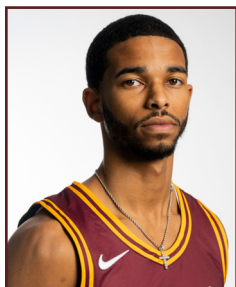
