## THE OPENING TIP

Bouncing back from a tough double-overtime loss at LMU on Thursday, San Francisco got back on track with a dominant 80-60 victory at Pepperdine on Saturday night. USF held Pepperdine to just 30.5 percent shooting from the field and 14.3 percent shooting from three, both season lows for a Dons opponent this season.

Making his first start in over a month, Junjie Wang was on fire against the Waves, scoring a career-high 27 points on 10-of-14 shooting from the floor and 7-of-9 shooting from three in a career-best 34 minutes. Wang's seven made threes were the most by a Don since Khalil Shabazz hit as many threes on Mar. 4, 2023 in USF's 93-87 double-overtime win against Santa Clara in the WCC Championship Quarterfinal, and the most threes by a Don in regulation since Dec. 4, 2021, when Jamaree Bouyea made eight threes in USF's 83-62 win over UNLV.

David Fuchs (14 points, 12 rebounds) and Tyrone Riley IV (19 points, season-high 11 rebounds) both tallied double-doubles against Pepperdine, marking the first time that two Dons logged double-doubles in the same game since Feb. 1, 2024, when Jonathan Mogbo (21 points, 10 rebounds) and Marcus Williams (19 points, 10 assists) achieved the feat against San Diego.

Continuing to dominate the glass, San Francisco has corralled a season-high-tying 49 rebounds in back-to-back games, now leading the WCC in rebounding in conference play, averaging 42.7 boards per game. Individually, Fuchs ranks second in the league in rebounding (9.2/game) in WCC action, while Veniamin Abosi has grabbed a career-high nine rebounds in three of the last four games, ranking 11th in the conference in rebounding in conference contests (6.7 per game). Nationally, USF ranks 66th in rebounding this season, averaging 39.1 rebounds per game overall.

A golden opportunity awaits the Dons as Tuesday night brings the second Quad 1 opportunity for San Francisco this season, with Saint Mary's currently sitting at No. 30 in the NCAA's NET Rankings. USF's lone Quad 1 contest so far this season came on Dec. 13, 2025 at Saint Louis, when the Dons fell in a tight game, 85-75, in Missouri.

# CHRIS GERLUFSEN

HEAD COACH | FOURTH SEASON AT SAN FRANCISCO | FIFTH OVERALL

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS AT SAN FRANCISCO:

Chris Gerlufsen enters his fourth year as the head coach of San Francisco after being elevated from associate head coach on March 18, 2022. This past season, Gerlufsen guided the Dons to an eighth straight full season of 20+ wins as the Dons finished 25-10 overall and 13-5 in conference play in 2024-25.

Last season, San Francisco finished third in the final West Coast Conference (WCC) regular season standings, earning back-to-back top-three finishes in the conference for the first time in 22 years (2001-02 and 2002-03). USF's 13 conference victories marked the most in a single season since 2013-14, when the green and gold also finished 13-5.

In postseason play, San Francisco reached the semifinal round of the WCC Tournament for the fourth consecutive season in 2024-25. The Dons earned a spot in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) for the second straight season, being awarded the No. 1 seed in the San Francisco region of the 2025 NIT. USF took care of business in the opening round, defeating Utah Valley, 79-70, on Mar. 19 before narrowly falling to Loyola Chicago, 77-76, on Mar. 23.

Three Dons earned All-WCC honors in 2024-25 as Malik Thomas and Marcus Williams were both named to the All-WCC First Team while Tyrone Riley IV was named to the All-WCC Freshman Team. Notably, Williams earned a spot on the All-WCC First Team for the second straight year after also earning First Team honors in 2023-24. Thomas was also named a Lou Henson Award Finalist by CollegeInsider.com, which is presented annually to the top mid-major player in college basketball. Academically, Robby Beasley was named to the WCC All-Academic team last season.

Through his first three seasons as head coach on the Hilltop, Gerlufsen is 68-35 (.660) overall, including a 31-19 (.620) record in conference action. Each year, Gerlufsen has improved his win total, climbing from 20 wins in year one to 23 wins in year, and most recently 25 wins in year three.

In June 2024, Jonathan Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco drafted into the NBA since 1982 as the dynamic forward was selected with the 31st pick overall in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft. With his selection, Mogbo became the first student-athlete from San Francisco to be drafted into the NBA since the trio of Quintin Dailey (Round 1, Pick 7/Chicago Bulls), Wallace Bryant (Round 2, Pick 30/Chicago Bulls) and John Hegwood (Round 9, Pick 186/San Diego Clippers) were selected in 1982. Overall, Mogbo became the 39th student-athlete from the university to be drafted into the NBA and the first under Gerlufsen. With his selection by Toronto, he is also the eighth Don all-time to be drafted in the second round. Additionally, Mogbo was the first West Coast Conference player taken off the board in the 2024 NBA Draft. It is just the second time since 2001 that a WCC school other than Gonzaga was the first to have a player selected (2023 - Brandin Podziemski/Santa Clara). Prior to the draft, Mogbo was one of 78 players invited to the 2024 NBA Draft Combine in Chicago from May 12-19.

Gerlufsen's inaugural season in 2022-23 began with a 7-1 start, a stretch highlighted by San Francisco winning the 2022 Hall of Fame Classic championship in Kansas City, MO. The Dons would finish nonconference play with a record of 11-4, which tied the most pre-season win total by a first-year head coach at USF since 1980-81.

The team's 2022-23 campaign featured a 37-point win over #25 Arizona State - the largest victory over a ranked team in program history. That final margin also represents the fourth-biggest win for an unranked team over an AP Top 25 opponent in the past 31 seasons.

Gerlufsen's analytically-driven offensive system produced the 17th-most made threes per game in college basketball in 2021-22. When he was elevated to head coach in 2022-23, that number jumped to seventh in the country (out of 363 teams).

San Francisco's starting backcourt of Khalil Shabazz and Tyrell Roberts experienced significant success in 2022-23. Shabazz and Roberts were both selected as All-WCC First Team performers. Each of them improved their scoring outputs by over four points per game under Gerlufsen. Shabazz was named the Hall of Fame Classic MVP and a WCC All-Tournament team selection in his final season on the Hilltop. Roberts was selected to the Hall of Fame Classic All-Tournament team.

On March 18, 2022, Gerlufsen became the 21st head coach of the storied USF program, which has won two national championships (1955 & 1956) and one National Invitational championship (1949). In 2021-22, he was an integral part of San Francisco's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1998, serving as Todd Golden's associate head coach.

During the 2021-22 season, San Francisco won 24 games - the most victories by a Dons team since the men's basketball program was reinstated from shutdown in 1985. The team's at-large NCAA Tournament berth was the program's first since the bracket was expanded to its modern format of 64+ teams.

In Gerlufsen's first year on staff, USF finished among college basketball's elite in many metric-based rankings, including a 23rd place finish in KenPom and 26th in the NCAA's NET rankings. Following a successful 2021-22 campaign, USF star guard Jamaree Bouyea became the first San Francisco Don to play in the NBA since Bill Cartwright in 1995.

Prior to Gerlufsen's arrival on the Hilltop, he spent two seasons as the top assistant to head coach Eran Ganot at Hawaii. During the 2019-20 season, he served as the acting head coach for Hawaii's first 13 games and compiled an 8-5 record (.615). His winning percentage at Hawaii currently ranks 2nd all-time in their school's Division I history. Among Gerlufsen's signature wins was an 85-75 upset victory over previously undefeated San Francisco. While at Hawaii, Gerlufsen coached All-Big West First Team guard Eddie Stansberry.

Before Hawaii, Gerlufsen spent four seasons as an assistant coach in the WCC with the University of San Diego. During his time at USD, the Toreros posted back-to-back 20+ win seasons for the first time ever. Gerlufsen's final season at San Diego saw the Toreros earn a bid to the 2019 NIT - the only NIT invitation in USD history. While coaching with the Toreros, Gerlufsen helped forward Isaiah Pineiro develop into a two-time All-WCC First Team performer.

Gerlufsen was particularly instrumental in San Diego's turnaround from an international recruiting standpoint, signing more than a half dozen foreign players during his tenure. One notable recruit, Yauhen Massalski, would play for Gerlufsen at both San Diego and San Francisco, where he blossomed into an All-WCC First Team selection on the Dons' 2021-22 NCAA Tournament team.

From 2006-15, Gerlufsen spent nine seasons on the bench at the University of Hartford. After seven years as an assistant coach, he was promoted to associate head coach for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. Gerlufsen served as the program's recruiting coordinator during that time. While at Hartford, Gerlufsen designed the team's perimeter-oriented motion offense. His system triggered six consecutive seasons with 22+ made 3's. In 2007-08, Hartford set an America East Conference record by connecting on 312 made 3's - a number which ranked 10th nationally.

From 2001-06, Gerlufsen spent his five seasons coaching at The Citadel under Pat Dennis. On January 2, 2004, Gerlufsen served as interim head coach for one game. He began his head coaching career 1-0 with a 82-58 win over Army. Before working in the Division I ranks, Gerlufsen got his start with coaching jobs at Southwestern from 1999-2001 and Washington College (Maryland) in 1998-99.

As a player, Gerlufsen was a four-time letter winner for Randolph-Macon College, a Division III school in Virginia. While playing for the Yellow Jackets, he was named team captain for a squad that advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament twice. He graduated in 1998 with a B.A. in business and economics. Gerlufsen currently resides in San Francisco, CA with his wife Ila.

### SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Saint Mary's (SMC) has been perfect to begin conference play, winning each of its first five WCC games, as the Gaels are hungry to notch a 10-0 start to league action for a fourth consecutive season.
- Last time out, SMC was tested as they eked out an 88-82 victory over Washington State on Saturday afternoon in their second-closest home game this season. The top three scorers for the Gaels each finished with 20-plus points in the win over the Cougars: sophomore Joshua Dent (26), junior Paulius Murauskas (24), and sophomore Mikey Lewis (20). Notably, Saint Mary's shot a perfect 20-for-20 from the free throw line in the win, marking the eighth time this season that a team has shot 100 percent from the line in one game (min. 15 free throw attempts) across Division I.
- In his second year in Moraga, Murauskas has established himself as one of the nation's best scorers as he leads the WCC in scoring at 19.6 points per game overall this season, good for 46th nationally. Within conference play, Murauskas is the league's only player averaging at least 20.0 points per game (22.0).
- As a unit, Saint Mary's has been one of the best defensive teams in the country this season, holding its opponents to just 64.9 points per game, the 16th-fewest across D-I teams.
- In his 25th season as head coach of the Gaels, Randy Bennett is the fifth-longest tenured active head coach in Division I this season, as he looks to lead Saint Mary's to a fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and a fourth straight WCC regular season championship.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Tuesday night's primetime matchup on the Hilltop will mark the 194th all-time meeting between San Francisco and Saint Mary's, with the Dons holding a 102-91 lead in the all-time series. Last season, USF ended SMC's perfect 10-0 start to WCC play, handing the Gaels their first loss of conference action in a 65-64 thriller on Feb. 6, 2025 at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. It also ended the Gaels' 15-game road win streak while giving the green and gold its first victory over SMC in over six years.
