### OPENING TIPS

• Utah State opens the Myrtle Beach Invitational on Thursday, Nov. 18, facing Penn (X) at Noon (MT). The game marks the first meeting between the two schools in USU history.

• Over the last three years, Utah State is 18-7 in tournament play, including appearances in the NCAA Tournament, Mountain West Tournament and three MTEs. The Aggies captured the championship of the 2019 Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic.

• Senior forward **Justin Bean** was named the Mountain West Player of the Week after averaging a double-double in the Aggies' opening contests last week. **Bean** scored 16 points and pulled down 13 rebounds in the season opener against UC Davis before scoring a career-high 30 points and logging 13 rebounds against Richmond.

• **Bean** recorded his 28th-career double-double against Richmond and now ranks eighth in school history in career double-doubles. **Bean** needs one more double-double to move into a tie for seventh with **Jimmy Moore** (1973-75).

• **Bean** is on pace to become just the third Aggie in school history to finish his career with more than 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. Currently, Bean has totaled 899 points and 715 career rebounds. (Bean recorded 356 rebounds as a sophomore in 2019-20)

• Coming into the Myrtle Beach Invitational, **Bean** is the top individual scorer (23.0 ppg) and rebounder (13.0 rpg) in the entire tournament field.

• Utah State's starting frontcourt of **Bean** and **Horvath** have scored in double figures in each of the Aggies' two games this season. USU's starting frontcourt has outscored its counterparts in each contest this season.

• Utah State finished last season 20-9, marking the third-straight year with 20 or more wins and the first time the Aggies have won 20 games or more in three-consecutive seasons since 2010-13.

• Since the year 2000, only 17 teams have recorded 16 seasons with 20 or more wins and 11 NCAA Tournament bids (Utah State, Kentucky, Florida, North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Kansas, Texas, Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin, Arizona, Xavier, Creighton, Butler, BYU and Gonzaga).

## SOLID SCORING

• Utah State has scored as many or more points in the second half than each of its opponents this season.

• The Aggies scored 40 points in the paint against Richmond in its last game out, nearly doubling the Spiders' 22 points in the paint.

## BIG NUMBERS & 3'S

• Utah State's frontcourt combo of seniors **Justin Bean** and **Brandon Horvath** are shooting a combined 56.9 percent (29-of-51) from the floor and 52.6 percent (10-of-19) from behind the arc over the first two games.

• Both Horvath and Bean hit career highs from behind the 3-point line against Richmond, knocking down four and three triples, respectively.

## MILLENNIAL SCORERS

• Utah State entered the 2021-22 season with three players in pursuit of 1,000 points in their respective careers. **Horvath** passed the mark in the season opener, scoring a team-best 19 points to increase his career total to 1,005. **Bean** (899 points) and senior guard **Brock Miller** (853 points) are also closing in on 1,000.

## CHANGING OF THE GUARD

• Utah State head men's basketball coach **Ryan Odom** began his tenure at the helm in Logan, being announced as the 20th head coach in USU men's basketball history on April 5, 2021.

• **Odom** is the only coach in NCAA men's basketball history to lead a No. 16-seed to a victory over the top seed in the NCAA Tournament.

## UTAH STATE GLASS EATERS

• Utah State outrebounded every opponent last season, carrying a rebounding margin of +10.3.

• Utah State has only lost the rebounding battle in nine games over the last three years.

• Utah State's streak of 40-plus rebounds in each of the last three years is the longest since the 1975-76 to 1977-78 seasons.

## MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

• Utah State led the Mountain West in rebounding (40.5), rebounds allowed (30.4), defensive rebounds (27.9), offensive rebounds (10.1), blocks (4.97), assists (15.97) and attendance (1,383).

• In league games, Utah State led the Mountain West in scoring defense (60.6), scoring margin (14.7), field goal percentage defense (.383), rebounding (41.3), rebounds allowed (30.0), offensive rebounds (12.8), defensive

rebounds (28.5), rebounding margin (11.3), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30), blocks (5.16), assists (17.79) and attendance (1,517).

## BRAVO FOR BEAN

• **Bean** finished the year scoring in double figures in each of the last 10 games and in 12 of the last 13.

• **Bean** also recorded at least one steal in each of the final 10 games of the 2020-21 season.

• **Bean** has led the Aggies in steals in each of the last two seasons, finishing the 2020-21 campaign with a team-best 38 thefts.

• **Bean** is the only returning player in the Mountain West to average 11+ points, 7.5+ rebounds, 1.5+ assists and 1.0+ steals per game from a season ago.

## ATTABOY ASHWORTH

• Sophomore guard **Steven Ashworth** totaled 76 assists last year to rank seventh in a single season among freshman in USU history.

• **Ashworth's** assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0 (76 assists/38 turnovers) ranks second all-time among freshmen in USU history.

## LOCKED DOWN D

• Utah State's defense has held opponents to less than 40-percent shooting from the floor each of the last three years, marking the longest such streak since the 1960-61 to 1962-63 seasons.

• Utah State only allowed 62.3 points per game during the 2020-21 season, marking the fewest points allowed by the Aggies since the 2008-09 season when the Aggies allowed 62.0 points per game.

## OPPORTUNISTIC AGGIES

• Utah State pulled down double-digit offensive rebounds in all but four games last season and led the MW with 12.8 offensive rebounds per game in league play. The Aggies scored 341 second-chance points last season, making up more than 15 percent of their total points.

• Utah State had close to a 2-to-1 advantage in second-chance points as the Aggies totaled 341 to their opponent's 196.

## ASK SHERWIN-WILLIAMS

Utah State scored 928 points in the paint last season, outscoring all but four opponents from inside. The 928 points represented almost 45 percent of the Aggies' total points.

## AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Aggies finished the year ranked second in the nation in rebounding margin (10.3), seventh in total rebounds per game (40.69), ninth

in total blocks (145) and 10th in field goal percentage defense (.390).

## BEST IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

• Utah State ranked first in the Mountain West in assists per game (16.2), blocks per game (5.0), defensive rebounds per game (28.14), field goal percentage defense (.390), fouls per game (15.0), rebound margin (10.3), total assists (469), total blocks (145), total rebounds (1,180) and total rebounds per game (40.69).

• Utah State was also atop the MW in league play in scoring defense (60.6), scoring margin (14.7), field goal percentage defense (.383), rebounds per game (41.3), rebounds allowed (30.0), offensive rebounds (12.8), defense rebounds (28.5), rebound margin (11.3), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30), blocks (5.16) and assists (17.79).

• Utah State's 15 victories in Mountain West play were the most of any team in the league last season and matched the most wins in MW play in Utah State history.

## SHORT SCORING

• Utah State was undefeated last season (16-0) when its starting backcourt outscored the opponent's starting guard line.

• Utah State was also a perfect 18-0 when shooting better from behind the arc than its opponent.

## ACTIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLE LEADERS

**Bean** is the current active leader in the Mountain West with 28 career double-doubles.

## ABOUT STEVEN ASHWORTH

- **Ashworth** originally signed with Utah State in 2017.

- Served a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Indianapolis, Indiana. Earned the nickname "Boots" on his mission after playing some pick-up basketball in his snow boots.

- Led Lone Peak High School to back-to-back Utah 6A state title games, capturing the state championship as a senior.

- Named the Utah 6A MVP and to the GEICO National all-tournament team as a senior. Scored 29 points in the GEICO High School National Quarterfinals against Mount Verde, all in the second half while being guarded by current NBA player RJ Barrett (Knicks).

- Played alongside current NBA guard **Frank Jackson** at Lone Peak HS during his freshman and sophomore seasons.

- Has appeared in 31 games as an Aggie, entering the year averaging 6.1 points, 2.6 assists and 1.9 rebounds per game.

## ABOUT BRANDON HORVATH

- Appeared in 113 games at UMBC, including 54 starts over the course of four years. Totaled 986 career points.

- Led the Retrievers in rebounding last season with 8.7 per game and finished second on the team with 13.1 points per game.

- Named first-team all-America East Conference as a senior, along with earning second-team all-District 1 by the NABC.

## ABOUT RJ EYTLEROCK

- Appeared in 73 games with 64 starts in three years at UMBC.

- Led the Retrievers in scoring and assists last season, turning in 14.3 points and 2.5 assists per game.

- Named to the America East all-rookie team as a freshman after appearing in 31 games with 24 starts, recording 5.1 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game

## ABOUT CADE POTTER

- Served a mission for The Church of the Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Bogota, Colombia, and New York, returning in March, 2021.

- Played in the first five games during his senior year at Orange Lutheran, averaging 10.8 points, 3.6 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.0 steals per game before graduating early.

## ABOUT MAX SHULGA

- Member of both the U20 and U18 Ukrainian National team.

- Scored in double figures in all but two games during the 2019 U18 European Championships and finished the tournament averaging 13.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

- Was the best shooter at the 2019 U18 Championships, connecting on 61.9 percent from the floor, including 65.2 percent from inside the 3-point line and 52.9 percent from beyond the arc.

- **Shulga** is fluent in four different languages, including English, Russian, Spanish and Ukrainian.

- Appeared in 23 games a season ago, averaging 1.6 points and 1.8 rebounds per game in 6.8 minutes per game.



## ABOUT SZYMON ZAPALA

• Member of the Polish National team at the 2019 U18 European Championships, averaging 7.5 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game as his team finished second.

• Appeared in 13 games for the Aggies a season ago, averaging 1.1 points and 1.2 rebounds in 3.8 minutes per game. Recorded 16 total rebounds last year, including 12 on the offensive glass.

## ABOUT CONNER GILLIS

• One year removed from college basketball after enrolling as a student at East Carolina last year.

• Prepped at Gaston Christian High School, averaging 12.0 points, 2.8 assists and 2.0 rebounds per game.

## ABOUT CONNOR ODOM

• Member of the Flagler College scout team last season after originally signing with the University of Maryland out of high school.

• Oldest of two children of USU head coach **Ryan Odom**.

## ABOUT RYLAN JONES

## HEAD COACH RYAN ODOM

**Hampden-Sydney, 1996**  
**First Year (127-82, Seven Seasons)**

Ryan Odom was named the head men's basketball coach at Utah State on April 5, 2021. In all, Odom is 126-81 (.609) in seven years as a head coach and has 25 years of collegiate coaching experience.

Odom comes to Utah State after spending the past five years as the head coach at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), leading the Retrievers to a 97-60 (.573) record, including a 50-29 mark in the America East Conference. In the 2018 NCAA Tournament, UMBC became the first-ever 16-seed to win a first round game as it posted a 74-54 win against top overall seed Virginia.

In his five years at UMBC, Odom coached three of the top four win-producing teams in school history and set a program record by winning 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons, including a school-record 25 victories during the 2017-18 campaign.

In 2020-21, Odom led UMBC to a 14-6 record, including a 10-4 league mark. Following the year, he was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 1 Co-Coach of the Year. Odom also earned America East Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading the Retrievers to a share of the regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the America East Playoffs.

The 2018-19 Retrievers advanced to the championship game of the America East Tournament after posting a 21-13 record, including an 11-5 conference mark, for its third-straight 20-win season.

In his second year at UMBC, Odom and the Retrievers posted a 25-11 record, including a 12-4 league mark, to finish second in the America East and set a school record for wins. UMBC also won an America East Conference title at prohibitive favorite Vermont and followed that up by engineering the first victory by a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament history. UMBC overwhelmed the tournament's top overall seed, Virginia, 74-54, in Charlotte, N.C., earning an ESPY nomination for the "Best Moment" of the year. Following the season, Odom earned the 2018 Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top mid-major coach.

After taking over a program that finished 7-25 in 2015-16, Odom led UMBC to its first winning season since 2007-08 with a 21-13 record, as the Retrievers advanced to the semifinals of the 2017 CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). UMBC finished the 2016-17 campaign as the nation's third-most improved team, with a +13.0 mark, behind only Minnesota and UCLA. Odom's team posted three wins in the CIT and became the first America East team to win three games in a postseason tournament.

At the end of the season, Odom earned the 2017 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I.

Before serving as the head coach at UMBC, Odom was the head men's basketball coach at Lenoir-Rhyne (N.C.) University for one year (2016). The Bears (21-10) advanced to the NCAA Division II Regional Finals for the first time in school history and won 20 games in a season for the first time in eight years. Lenoir-Rhyne improved by 10.5 games from the previous campaign, led the nation in 3-point field goals made per game (12.4), and finished ninth in the country in scoring at 90.1 points per game.

Odom was also an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15), including serving as the interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped the 49ers earn a bid to the postseason NIT.

Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokies' team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.

Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).

Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament. In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

Ryan is the son of Dave Odom, who retired in 2008 as the head coach at South Carolina. The elder Odom earned SEC Coach of the Year honors while at South Carolina in 2004 and ACC Coach of the Year honors in 1991, 1994 and 1995, while at Wake Forest.

Odom and his wife, Lucia, have two sons - Connor and Owen.
