### OPENING TIPS

• Utah State faces former Western Athletic Conference-foe UT Arlington (1-4) on Saturday, Nov. 27, inside the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. The Aggies are 1-3 all-time against the Mavericks, including a 1-1 mark in Logan. The teams last played during the 2012-13 season, the final season for USU in the WAC.

• Utah State is riding a four-game winning streak, shooting close to 50 percent from the floor (.498) and better than 40 percent from behind the 3-point line (.402) over that stretch.

• Senior forward **Justin Bean** was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for the second consecutive week after leading the Aggies to the title of the Myrtle Beach Invitational. Bean was named the tournament MVP after averaging 24.7 points and 14.3 rebounds per game in victories over Penn, New Mexico State and Oklahoma.

• Junior guard **Rylan Jones** joined Bean on the Myrtle Beach all-tournament team after averaging 15.3 points, 4.7 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game. **Jones** is currently fourth in the MW with 5.2 assists per game.

• **Bean's** 19 rebounds against Oklahoma marked the fourth-most by any player in the NCAA in a single game this season.

• **Bean** is currently second in the nation in total double-doubles (4) and rebounds per game (13.8) and fifth in the nation in scoring (24.0 ppg).

• **Bean** has totaled 30 double-doubles in his career and needs one more to move into a tie for fifth all-time in USU history, matching **Bob Lauriski** (1971-73) with 31 career double-doubles.

• **Bean** is the first player in the NCAA since 2007-08 to record 120 points and 69 rebounds over the first five games of the season. (Michael Beasley - Kansas State)

• Utah State's starting frontcourt of **Bean** and senior forward **Brandon Horvath** have scored in double figures in each of the Aggies' games this season. USU's starting frontcourt has outscored its counterparts in each contest this season.

• **Bean** is the only player in the MW averaging a double-double this season (24.0/13.8) and leads the league in field goal percentage, shooting 66.2 percent (45-of-68) from the floor. **Horvath** leads the MW from behind the 3-point line, connecting on 56.5 percent (13-of-23) from long range.

## SOLID SCORING

• Utah State has scored as many or more points in the second half than each of its opponents this season.

• The Aggies have scored more points in the paint than their opponents in all but one game this season.

## BIG SHOOTERS

• Utah State's frontcourt combo of seniors **Justin Bean** and **Brandon Horvath** are shooting a combined 59.2 percent (71-of-120) from the floor and 57.9 percent (22-of-38) from behind the arc.

• Individually, Bean is shooting a MW-best 66.2 percent (45-of-68) from the floor and 60.0 percent (9-of-15) from behind the 3-point line.

• Horvath is shooting 50.0 percent (26-of-52) from the floor and a MW-best 56.5 percent (13-of-23) from behind the 3-point line.

## MILLENNIAL SCORERS

• Utah State entered the 2021-22 season with three players in pursuit of 1,000 points in their respective careers. **Horvath** passed the mark in the season opener, scoring a team-best 19 points to increase his career total to 1,005.

• **Bean** (973 points) only needs 27 more points to hit 1,000, while senior guard **Brock Miller** (889 points) is also closing in on 1,000.

## STARTING SCORERS

Utah State's offense has been paced by its starters this season as the starting 5 have accounted for 85.4 percent of the points this season.

## CHANGING OF THE GUARD

• Utah State head men's basketball coach **Ryan Odom** began his tenure at the helm in Logan, being announced as the 20th head coach in USU men's basketball history on April 5, 2021.

• **Odom** is the only coach in NCAA men's basketball history to lead a No. 16-seed to a victory over the top seed in the NCAA Tournament.

## UTAH STATE GLASS EATERS

• Utah State has pulled down as many or more rebounds than its opponents in 44 consecutive games, dating back to the 2019-20 season.

• The Aggies last lost the battle of the boards on Feb. 1, 2020, in an 80-68 loss at San Diego state.

• Utah State is a perfect 4-0 when winning the battle of the boards this season and 4-0 when recording more defensive rebounds than the opposition.

## MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

• Utah State leads the MW in assists per game, averaging 18.4 per contest.

• Individually, senior forward **Justin Bean** leads the league in rebounds per game (13.8) and field goal percentage (.662). **Bean** is second in the league in scoring (24.0) and minutes per game (38.2). Senior forward **Brandon Horvath** leads the league in 3-point field goal percentage (.565).

• Utah State is a perfect 3-0 this season when recording a better field goal percentage than its opponent this season.

## WINNING TRADITION

• Utah State finished the 2020-21 season with a record of 20-9, marking the third-straight year with 20 or more wins and the first time the Aggies have won 20 games or more in three-consecutive seasons since 2010-13.

• Since the year 2000, only 17 teams have recorded 16 seasons with 20 or more wins and 11 NCAA Tournament bids (Utah State, Kentucky, Florida, North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Kansas, Texas, Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin, Arizona, Xavier, Creighton, Butler, BYU and Gonzaga).

• Utah State has players from seven different countries, including the United States, Australia, Bahrain, The Netherlands, Poland, Ukraine and England.

• **Zee Hamoda** is the first NCAA Division I men's basketball player from the country of Bahrain.

## ABOUT STEVEN ASHWORTH

- Ashworth originally signed with Utah State in 2017.

- Served a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Indianapolis, Indiana. Earned the nickname "Boots" on his mission after playing some pick-up basketball in his snow boots.

- Led Lone Peak High School to back-to-back Utah 6A state title games, capturing the state championship as a senior.

- Named the Utah 6A MVP and to the GEICO National all-tournament team as a senior. Scored 29 points in the GEICO High School National Quarterfinals against Mount Verde, all in the second half while being guarded by current NBA player RJ Barrett (Knicks).

- Played alongside current NBA guard **Frank Jackson** at Lone Peak HS during his freshman and sophomore seasons.

## ABOUT BRANDON HORVATH

- Appeared in 113 games at UMBC, including 54 starts over the course of four years. Totaled 986 career points.

- Led the Retrievers in rebounding last season with 8.7 per game and finished second on the team with 13.1 points per game.

- Named first-team all-America East Conference as a senior, along with earning second-team all-District 1 by the NABC.

## ABOUT RJ EYTLEROCK

- Appeared in 73 games with 64 starts in three years at UMBC.

- Led the Retrievers in scoring and assists last season, turning in 14.3 points and 2.5 assists per game.

- Named to the America East all-rookie team as a freshman after appearing in 31 games with 24 starts, recording 5.1 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game

## ABOUT CADE POTTER

- Served a mission for The Church of the Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Bogota, Colombia, and New York, returning in March, 2021.

- Played in the first five games during his senior year at Orange Lutheran, averaging 10.8 points, 3.6 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.0 steals per game before graduating early.

## ABOUT MAX SHULGA

- Member of both the U20 and U18 Ukrainian National team.

- Scored in double figures in all but two games during the 2019 U18 European Championships and finished the tournament averaging 13.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

- Was the best shooter at the 2019 U18 Championships, connecting on 61.9 percent from the floor, including 65.2 percent from inside the 3-point line and 52.9 percent from beyond the arc.

- **Shulga** is fluent in four different languages, including English, Russian, Spanish and Ukrainian.



## ABOUT SZYMON ZAPALA

- Member of the Polish National team at the 2019 U18 European Championships, averaging 7.5 points, 5.1 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game as his team finished second.

## ABOUT CONNER GILLIS

- One year removed from college basketball after enrolling as a student at East Carolina last year.

- Prepped at Gaston Christian High School, averaging 12.0 points, 2.8 assists and 2.0 rebounds per game.

## ABOUT CONNOR ODOM

- Member of the Flagler College scout team last season after originally signing with the University of Maryland out of high school.

- Oldest of two children of USU head coach **Ryan Odom**.

## HEAD COACH RYAN ODOM

**Hampden-Sydney, 1996**  
**First Year (130-82, Seven Seasons)**

Ryan Odom was named the head men's basketball coach at Utah State on April 5, 2021. In all, Odom is 126-81 (.609) in seven years as a head coach and has 25 years of collegiate coaching experience.

Odom comes to Utah State after spending the past five years as the head coach at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), leading the Retrievers to a 97-60 (.573) record, including a 50-29 mark in the America East Conference. In the 2018 NCAA Tournament, UMBC became the first-ever 16-seed to win a first round game as it posted a 74-54 win against top overall seed Virginia.

In his five years at UMBC, Odom coached three of the top four win-producing teams in school history and set a program record by winning 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons, including a school-record 25 victories during the 2017-18 campaign.

In 2020-21, Odom led UMBC to a 14-6 record, including a 10-4 league mark. Following the year, he was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 1 Co-Coach of the Year. Odom also earned America East Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading the Retrievers to a share of the regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the America East Playoffs.

The 2018-19 Retrievers advanced to the championship game of the America East Tournament after posting a 21-13 record, including an 11-5 conference mark, for its third-straight 20-win season.

In his second year at UMBC, Odom and the Retrievers posted a 25-11 record, including a 12-4 league mark, to finish second in the America East and set a school record for wins. UMBC also won an America East Conference title at prohibitive favorite Vermont and followed that up by engineering the first victory by a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament history. UMBC overwhelmed the tournament's top overall seed, Virginia, 74-54, in Charlotte, N.C., earning an ESPY nomination for the "Best Moment" of the year. Following the season, Odom earned the 2018 Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top mid-major coach.

After taking over a program that finished 7-25 in 2015-16, Odom led UMBC to its first winning season since 2007-08 with a 21-13 record, as the Retrievers advanced to the semifinals of the 2017 CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). UMBC finished the 2016-17 campaign as the nation's third-most improved team, with a +13.0 mark, behind only Minnesota and UCLA. Odom's team posted three wins in the CIT and became the first America East team to win three games in a postseason tournament.

At the end of the season, Odom earned the 2017 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I.

Before serving as the head coach at UMBC, Odom was the head men's basketball coach at Lenoir-Rhyne (N.C.) University for one year (2016). The Bears (21-10) advanced to the NCAA Division II Regional Finals for the first time in school history and won 20 games in a season for the first time in eight years. Lenoir-Rhyne improved by 10.5 games from the previous campaign, led the nation in 3-point field goals made per game (12.4), and finished ninth in the country in scoring at 90.1 points per game.

Odom was also an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15), including serving as the interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped the 49ers earn a bid to the postseason NIT.

Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokies' team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.

Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).

Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament. In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

Ryan is the son of Dave Odom, who retired in 2008 as the head coach at South Carolina. The elder Odom earned SEC Coach of the Year honors while at South Carolina in 2004 and ACC Coach of the Year honors in 1991, 1994 and 1995, while at Wake Forest.

Odom and his wife, Lucia, have two sons - Connor and Owen.
