GAME #11 - UTAH STATE

GAME STORYLINES

- ▶ Saturday's match-up is the 19th meeting between the teams with Utah State holding a 12-6 advantage.
- ▶ The Aggies have won the last seven meetings in the series, five by 20+ points.
- ▶ USU has won three straight in the series in Logan. UH's last road win over the Aggies was in 2010 (45-7). USU holds a 6-2 advantage in games played in Logan.
- ▶ The Aggies have won all six contests in the series as Mountain West members. Prior to that, the schools were in the Western Athletic Conference and UH won five of the seven contests.
- ▶ Fifteen of the 18 all-time meetings have been decided by double-digits, including USU's last three wins in Logan. The three games decided by single digits were all held in Honolulu (1927, 2011, and 2022).
- ▶ The teams have played in Logan in late October or November six times with the Aggies winning four of the six match-ups (UH won in 2006 & '10).
- ▶ In UH's Division I era (since 1974), the Rainbow Warriors have played 14 games in weather below 50 degrees at kickoff. UH is 3-11 in those games with wins over Wyoming in 2021 (44°), Nevada in 2019 (39°), and Utah State in 2006 (46°).
- ▶ UH is 2-14 on the road under head coach Timmy Chang, including 1-3 this season.
- ▶ UH (4-6, 2-3 MW) saw its two-game win streak come to an end last week after a 29-27 loss to UNLV in Honolulu. **Brayden Schager** threw for 282 yards and three touchdowns and rushed for a team-high 42 yards while **Tariq Jones** led the defense with a career-high 10 tackles.
- ▶ USU (2-7, 1-3) is coming off a 49-28 loss at Washington State last week in Pullman, Wash. The Aggies generated 395 yards of total offense while **Spencer Petras** passed for 208 yards and two touchdowns and **Herschel Turner** rushed for 85 yards.
- ▶ UH ranks No. 1 in the Mountain West in scoring defense (22.7 ppg) and total defense (346.2 ypg) and No. 3 in passing yards allowed (210.0 ypg).
- ▶ USU features the No. 2 passing attack in the Mountain West and No. 14 nationally at 290.6 yards per game. The Aggies also rank No. 3 in the MW and No. 18 nationally in total offense, averaging 451.0 yards per game.

MEDIA INFORMATION

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NEW HOME STADIUM

UH began playing its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex in 2021. The stadium increased its capacity to 15,194 last season after holding 9,000 in 2021-22. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

Hawai'i's men's team nickname is the "Rainbow Warriors" while the women's teams are referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

LAST WEEK vs. UNLV
UNLV 29, UH 27 — Nov. 9, 2024
Ching Complex; Honolulu, O'ahu

- ▶ UNLV retained possession of the Island Showdown Trophy with its second straight win over UH.
- ▶ The loss was UH's first to UNLV in the last four match-ups in Honolulu and just the second in the last nine meetings in the 50th state.
- ▶ UNLV set UH opponent highs in total offense (465), total plays (76), rushing yards (290) and rushing attempts (48).
- ▶ The last time two opposing players rushed for 100+ yards against UH was Tyler Nevens (152) and Kairee Robinson (111) of San José St on Dec. 5, 2020.
- ▶ UH tied a season low with 14 pass completions (also versus Nevada).
- ▶ The 29 points allowed by UH was the most at home this season (previously 28 vs. Boise State).
- ▶ UH committed a turnover on its opening drive for the first time this year when Brayden Schager was intercepted on the second offensive play of the game.
- ▶ UH had its first punt blocked since last season (vs. San Diego State) when Ricky White III blocked Lucas Borrow's attempt into the end-zone for a UNLV safety.

SERIES vs. UTAH STATE

- ▶ Utah State holds an 12-6 advantage in the all-time series.
- ▶ The Aggies have won the last seven meetings in the series, including five by 20+ points.
- ▶ USU has won three straight in Logan. UH's last road win over the Aggies was in 2010 (45-7). USU holds a 6-2 advantage in games played in Logan.
- ▶ The Aggies have won all six contests as Mountain West members. Prior to that while the schools were part of the Western Athletic Conference, UH won five of the seven contests.
- ▶ Fifteen of the 18 all-time meetings have been decided by double-digits, including USU's last three wins in Logan.

LAST MEETING vs.
UTAH STATE

USU 41, UH 34 — Nov. 12, 2022
Ching Complex; Honolulu, O'ahu

- ▶ Utah State won for the seventh straight time in the series.
- ▶ The Aggies led 24-10 at the half and 41-24 late in the fourth quarter before UH scored 10 straight in pull within one score.
- ▶ Hawai'i had more yards of total offense (541 to 374) however committed four turnovers (3-INT,

1-FUM) to USU's zero.

- ▶ UH set season-highs in points scored (34), total offense (541), passing yards (306), rushing yards (235), tackles-for-loss (8) and sacks (4).
- ▶ **Brayden Schager** threw for a then-career high 306 yards passing on 46 attempts.
- ▶ **Logan Taylor** finished with 13 tackles for his fourth straight game with double-digit stops.

TEAM NOTES

- ▶ Three of UH's six losses this season were decided by three points or less — UCLA (16-13) San Diego State (27-24), and UNLV (29-27).
- ▶ Under head coach Timmy Chang, UH is 0-14 when scoring 17 points or fewer compared to 12-10 when scoring more than 17 points.
- ▶ UH enjoyed its largest margin of victory in 3+ seasons at Ching Complex and its largest under Timmy Chang with its 29-point win over Northern Iowa, Sept. 21.
- ▶ The 21-point win over Nevada was the largest at home over a Mountain West opponent since moving into the Ching Complex in 2021.
- ▶ UH's 13-point fourth-quarter comeback against Fresno State was its largest since erasing a 14-point deficit against Fresno State at home on Oct. 2, 2021.
- ▶ UH has won its last 22 games against FCS teams dating back to 2001 including wins over Delaware State and Northern Iowa this season. The average winning margin victory during the streak is 25.8 points per game.
- ▶ UH had its most penalties and fewest penalties on the road this season, committing a season-high 14 penalties for 122 yards in a loss to Sam Houston (the most by a Hawai'i team since 2004) and had a season-low four penalties for 30 yards at Washington State.

HAWAI'I IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

- ▶ Hawai'i is playing its 13th season in the Mountain West in 2024.
- ▶ UH is 33-68 (.327) all-time in the MW — 19-33 (.365) at home and 14-35 (.286) on the road.
- ▶ Hawai'i has appeared in one Mountain West Championship game during the 2019 season.

ROAD SHOW

- ▶ It's no secret that UH has had its struggles on the road, given its 16-58 record since 2012.
- ▶ Under head coach Timmy Chang, UH is 2-14 on the road (0-6 in 2022, 1-5 in '23, 1-3 in '24).
- ▶ Chang's first road victory snapped a 10-game road losing streak dating back to 2021 as UH defeated Nevada 27-14, Nov. 4, 2023. Almost one year to that day, Hawai'i rallied to defeat Fresno State, 21-20, Nov. 2, 2024 for Chang's second road win.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ UH's five road games this season is its fewest since 2007 (not counting 2020 COVID season).
- ▶ UH will total nearly 30,040 air miles with its

- Over the last decade, UH played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021.
- The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- The 2024 season marks UH's fourth home season at the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex, which has a seating capacity of 15,194.
- UH is scheduled to move into the new Aloha Stadium in 2028. The old Aloha Stadium served as Hawai'i's home stadium from 1975-2020.
- UH has a 14-12 (.538) all-time record in Ching Complex. Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season of 2021; finished 3-4 in 2022; were 4-3 last season; and are 3-3 this season.
- Under head coach Timmy Chang, UH is 10-10 at home, including 5-6 in conference games.

NATIONAL TELEVISION

- UH made five national television appearances this season with an 0-5 record.
- UH's game against UCLA game marked the program's first appearance on network TV since 2012 (at USC on FOX) and first home game on network TV since 2005 (vs. Fresno State on ABC). It was UH's ninth all-time appearance on network TV.
- Hawai'i has dropped its last 15 games on national television and 18 of its last 19 dating back to the start of the 2021 season.

TROPHY GAMES

- UH played one of its four rivalry trophy games in 2024, falling to UNLV last week for the **Island Showdown Trophy**.
- UH played all four of its rivalry trophy games in 2023, marking the first time in program history the team played all four in the same season.
- UH currently has possession of one rivalry trophy, the **Kuter Trophy** by virtue of a 27-13 win over Air Force last season in Honolulu.

SCHEDULE NOTES

- UH is playing a 12-game slate for the first time since 2017 (not counting 2020 COVID season).
- Five opponents played in bowl games last season — UCLA, Boise State, Fresno State, UNLV, and Utah State.
- The Warriors will play the Mountain West's last three champions — Boise State (2023), Fresno State (2022), and Utah State (2021).

GAME 11 - UTAH STATE

OFFENSE NOTES

- Twenty-eight of UH's 36 sacks allowed on the year have occurred in the last six contests. Hawai'i ranks No. 130 nationally, surrendering 3.60 sacks per game.
- The 36 points scored against Northern Iowa is the most UH has scored under Timmy Chang, exceeding the 35 points scored in the season opener versus Delaware State.
- UH's 528 yards of total offense against UNI was its second-most under Chang, only exceeded by its 541 yards versus Utah State in 2022.
- Hawai'i rushed for 242 yards against Nevada which was the most in three seasons under Chang, exceeding the previous high of 235 yards against Utah State in 2022.

SCHAGER-BOMB

- UH's deep pass plays have been nicknamed "Schager Bombs" for QB **Brayden Schager**, who in his four seasons in Manoa, has 16 50+ yard pass plays, including five this season.
- Schager's five 50-yard passes is tied for fifth nationally. He had two 50-yard throws against UNLV last week, which were the two longest pass plays of the season — 74 yards to **Dekel Crowdus** and 62 yards to **Nick Cenacle**.
- Schager also completed a 49-yard touchdown to **Jonah Panoke** last week against UNLV.
- Over his career, Schager has 22 passes of over 40+ yards and 38 passes of over 30+ yards.

TEXAS GUNSLINGER

- QB **Brayden Schager** is in his third season as the team's starting signal caller having made a school-record 32 consecutive QB starts dating back to 2022.
- He made his 36th career start last week against UNLV which moved him past Colt Brennan for sole possession of No. 2 all-time among QBs in school history. The UH record is 50 starts by **Timmy Chang**.
- Schager ranks No. 3 all-time in program history in passing attempts (1,417) and completions (840), No. 4 in passing yards (8,972) and total offense (9,300), No. 5 in passing TDs (60), and touchdowns responsible for (68).
- Has thrown a TD in 30 of the last 32 games.
- Rushed for four TDs against Nevada, which tied a school-record for most rushing TDs by a quarterback with Glenn Freitas and Ivin Jasper.
- Has a 13-23 career record (.361) as a starting QB which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State in 2021.
- Schager is the Mountain West's active career leader in several categories.

TOP TARGETS

- Brayden Schager's top two targets this season are WR **Pofele Ashlock** and WR **Nick Cenacle**.
- Ashlock leads the team in receptions (51) while Cenacle is the team-leader in receiving yards (556). Both share the team lead with five receiving touchdowns.
- Ashlock missed the first game of his career at Washington State (head) after playing in 19 straight contests dating back to last year. He has caught a pass in all 22 games of his career.
- Cenacle has caught fire in recent weeks including a career-best performance at Fresno State in which he posted personal highs in receptions (12), receiving yards (113) and touchdowns (2).
- Ashlock logged 8+ catches during a four-game span, becoming the first UH player to do that since Greg Salas in 2010.

MR. VERSATILITY

- RB/WR **Tylan Hines** has emerged as UH's top playmaker this season, having played four different positions this season. In recent weeks, Hines returned to his natural running back position while also lining up at receiver.
- The Mt. Pleasant, Texas native led the team with five catches for 42 yards against Washington State and scored a receiving TD for the third straight week.
- Tallied a season-high 66 rushing yards and had three catches for 21 yards in UH's road win at Fresno State.
- Ranks No. 10 nationally in combined return yards (403) as the team's starting punt and kick returner. Named one of 15 players on the Jet Award Midseason Watch List which honors the nation's top kick returner.
- Leads the team with 753 all-purpose yards on the year — 281 kickoff return, 177 receiving, 122 punt return, and 173 rushing.

DEFENSE NOTES

- UH has allowed an average of 18.0 points in six home games as opposed to 30.0 points in four road contests.
- In UH's road win at Fresno State, UH allowed 19 rushing yards, the fewest since holding South Alabama to 18 on Dec. 1, 2012. Hawai'i held the Bulldogs to minus-16 yards in the second half.
- In addition, the Warrior defense held Fresno State to 176 yards of offense, the fewest given up by a UH team since Sept. 22, 2018 vs. Duquesne (166 yards). The defense held the Bulldogs to just 67 yards in the second half.
- The seven points allowed against Northern Iowa was the least UH has given up in a game since a 21-7 win at UNLV in 2019 and the 199 yards of total offense allowed was the least since 2018 when UH held Duquesne to 166 yards.

BIG D

- New defensive coordinator **Dennis Thurman** has a reputation of coaching an attacking, physical-style of defense during his three decades of coaching in both college and the NFL.

- In his most recent stint as DC, Thurman guided a Jackson State squad that ranked in the FCS Top 10 in a dozen defensive categories as the Tigers enjoyed unprecedented success with a combined 23-3 record in back-to-back seasons.
- UH ranks No. 1 in the MW in scoring defense (22.7) and total defense (346.2); No. 3 in passing defense (210.0) and rushing defense (136.2); and No. 4 in sacks per game (2.50).
- In the PFF ratings, UH's defense ranks No. 2 in the Mountain West in overall defense (87.6). In addition, UH is No. 1 in coverage (90.1) and No. 2 in tackling (70.9) and run defense (84.2).

STONE ISLAND

- Cornerback **Cam Stone** is rated among the top cornerbacks in the country according to PFF. Among cornerbacks Stone ranks No. 2 overall in defense grade (87.8) and No. 4 in coverage grade (89.1) among players who have played a minimum of 50% of the team's snaps.
- On the year, the Angleton, Texas native has six pass breakups and one interception. He also has 32 total tackles (24 solo), including 3.0 for loss and one forced fumble.
- His blocked PAT in the second quarter against Fresno State proved to be the difference in UH's 21-20 road victory.
- According to PFF, Stone's receivers has been targeted 36 times this season and he has allowed 21 receptions. After allowing a 55-yard reception to Sam Houston, the longest pass play he's surrendered since was 18 yards.

AGENT ZERO

- DL **Elijah Robinson**, who wears jersey #0, has become a force on the UH defensive line this season, leading the unit in tackles, tackles-for-loss, and sacks.
- The Wilmington, N.C., native ranks second on the team with 43 tackles (32 solo) and has a team-high 10.5 tackles-for-loss. He also shares the team lead with five sacks.
- In the team's last two games against Fresno State and UNLV, Robinson has 13 tackles (0 solo), including 4.5 for loss, and 3.5 sacks.
- Recorded a career-high 11 tackles (10 solo), including three for loss at San Diego State.

ROTATING 'BACKERS

- The linebacker corps has been the leaders of the defense this season with five players rotating among the two positions.
- Sophomore **Jamih Otis**, who has made four starts this season, leads the team with 47 tackles along with five tackles-for-loss and two sacks. In the season-opener against Delaware State, led the team with 11 tackles and was the Mountain West's Defensive Player of the Week.
- The unit has three of the team's four interceptions this season, one each by **Jalen Smith** and **Logan Taylor**, both occurring against UCLA, and **Nalu Emerson** against Nevada.

- Taylor, who returned to the lineup this season after suffering a season-ending injury in the third game of last season, is third on the team

- ▶ Emerson, one of the team's oldest players, has made three starts this season while senior **Noah Kema** made his first start of the season and eighth of his career at Sam Houston.

MANUMA MAGIC

- ▶ Safety **Peter Manuma** has been a staple in the UH secondary since his true freshman season of 2022.
- ▶ Had a streak of 26 consecutive starts snapped when he missed two games (Washington State and Nevada) due to injury. Returned to his starting spot against Fresno State.
- ▶ Ranks fourth on the team with 35 tackles (26 solo) with one pass breakup and one forced fumble.
- ▶ Last season, led the team with 87 total tackles (60 solo) including 5.5 for loss along with a team-leading three interceptions while earning honorable mention all-Mountain West honors.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- ▶ UH leads the Mountain West and ranks No. 25 nationally in net punting (41.48 avg.).
- ▶ In a season-opening win over Delaware State, UH returned a punt for a touchdown for the first time in 12 years when **Tylan Hines** scored on a 44-yard return late in the first quarter.
- ▶ KO specialist **Ben Falck** has 14 touchbacks in 47 kickoffs and has helped UH rank No. 1 in the Mountain West and No. 6 nationally in kickoff return defense (14.28).
- ▶ Snapper **Hunter Higham** recorded UH's first two-point conversion of the season, catching a pass from **Landon Sims** against Northern Iowa.

YOUTUBE SENSATION

- ▶ UH's starting placekicker **Kansei Matsuzawa** learned how to kick by watching YouTube videos in his native Japan.
- ▶ A transfer from Hocking College in Ohio, Matsuzawa booted his first two career kicks at the FBS level in UH's loss to UCLA.
- ▶ The Tokyo, Japan native is 10-for-13 (76.9%) in field goal attempts this season and a perfect 26-for-26 on PATs.
- ▶ Kicked the game-winning PAT against Fresno State with 15 seconds remaining.
- ▶ Nailed a career-long 41-yard field goal against UNLV. Also hit a 33-yarder in the third quarter, converting multiple field goals for the fourth time this year.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE

- ▶ Australian **Lucas Borrow**, a transfer from Ball State, is the team's starting punter.
- ▶ The Newcastle, NSW, Australia native averages 46.08 yards on 39 punts this season, which ranks No. 8 nationally and No. 1 in the Mountain West.
- ▶ Has 11 punts of 50+ yards and 11 inside the 20.

- ▶ Has three punts of 60+ yards, including a career-long 70-yarder against Boise State, which was the longest by a Rainbow Warrior since Rigo Sanchez' 73-yard punt versus Air Force in 2015.
- ▶ Twice named Ray Guy Award's weekly Ray's 8 following the Boise State and Sam Houston games. Averaged 52.5 yards per punt in four punts against Sam Houston and 48.8 yards on four punts versus Boise State.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

THE STATE'S TEAM

- ▶ As the only Division I university in the state of Hawai'i, UH's teams prides itself as representing the entire state which is evident in the football team's use of the island chain on the left side of its helmet.
- ▶ UH began using the island chain decal on its helmet during the 2018 season. Days before its season-opener at Colorado State and while already headquartered in Fort Collins, a tropical storm headed toward the Hawaiian Islands. In a symbolic gesture to the people of Hawai'i, the team donned the decal for the game and has worn it since.
- ▶ The island chain look actually dates back to former record-setting quarterback Colt Brennan in 2007 when, for his love of the 50th state, he dyed the Hawaiian Islands in his hair prior to the start of the season.

WE ARE THE "BRADDAHOOD"

- ▶ Following the 2021 season, the "Braddahood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy. Braddahood is Pidgin English for Brotherhood.
- ▶ WR **Jonah Panoke** was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach **Timmy Chang**, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

THE LEADERS OF THE "BRADDAHOOD"

- ▶ UH's captains this season are DL **Ezra Evaimalo**, DB **Peter Manuma**, WR **Jonah Panoke** and LB **Logan Taylor**.

SPANNING THE GLOBE

- ▶ UH's roster featured players from six countries—United States (109), American Samoa (5), Australia (2), Canada (1), Japan (1), and Samoa (1), which is tied for the third-most in FBS.
- ▶ 53 of the 118-man roster hails from the state of Hawai'i while California (17), Texas (9), Nevada (8) and combine to make up more than a quarter of the roster.
- ▶ UH also has players from 19 states, encompassing five time zones.

'BOWS IN THE PROS

- ▶ Two former Warriors are currently on active NFL 53-man rosters — eight-year veteran P **Rigoberto Sanchez** of the Indianapolis Colts and sixth-year LB **Jahlani Tavai** of the New England Patriots.

**TIMMY CHANG***Head Coach; 3rd Season**Overall Record: 12-24**MW Record: 7-14*

Former record setting quarterback Timmy Chang is the sixth former Rainbow Warrior to head the program, joining Tom Kaulukukui (1946-50), June Jones (1999-2007), and Nick Rolovich (2016-19).

Chang was hired as UH's 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022. He completed his first season with a 3-10 record which included career win No. 1 against Duquesne.

Chang spent the previous five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, under coach Jay Norvell. He helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia and also spent two seasons at Jackson State in Mississippi from 2014-15.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons assisting with the quarterbacks.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his collegiate career, Chang played professionally in the NFL, CFL, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from pro football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

COACHES NOTES

- ▶ **Timmy Chang** is one of three Polynesian head coaches in FBS (Kalani Sitake-BYU and Ken Niumatalolo-San Jose State) and one of 17 head coaches who are coaching their alma maters.
- ▶ Chang who is tied with Colorado State's Jay Norvell as the second-longest tenured coach in the Mountain West behind Air Force's Troy Calhoun.
- ▶ In addition to Chang (2000-04), three other former Warriors are on the full-time coaching staff: LB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), OL coach **Derek Faavi** (2001-05), and DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14). UH is one of seven schools in the FBS to have four or more alumni on staff along with Air Force (7), Utah (5), Fresno State (4), Georgia Southern (4), Oregon State (4), and Iowa (4).
- ▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang has previous coaching ties with only **Thomas Sheffield** at Nevada. In addition, **Matt Chon** (Chief of Staff), **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel) and **Cade Socha** (Analyst) also were on the same staff at Nevada.
- ▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.
- ▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).
- ▶ DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson**, a Maui native, spent the 2021 and '22 seasons as a graduate assistant and quality control coach, respectively, before briefly taking a full-time job at The Citadel in the spring. He returned to UH in summer 2023.
- ▶ The coaching staff went through a make-over during the offseason with the addition of five new full-time assistant coaches — DC/CB coach **Dennis Thurman**, QB coach **Dan Morrison**, OL coach **Derek Faavi**, DT coach **Jeff Reinebold**, and SAF coach **Nick Locher**. The five new staff members have a combined 140 years of coaching experience led by Morrison (43), Reinebold (41), and Thurman (34).
- ▶ Morrison and Reinebold are making returns trips to Manoa. Morrison was on the UH staff from 1999-2007 while Reinebold is in his third stop after stints in 2005-07 and '22.
- ▶ Thurman was part of the Colorado staff in 2023. Prior to that, he was defensive coordinator at Jackson State from 2020-22, where he guided a Top 10 defense in FCS. The former Dallas Cowboy spent more than half of his coaching career in the NFL where he was a part of four organizations - including two as defensive coordinator (NY Jets and Buffalo Bills).
- ▶ Faavi, a former UH lineman, has 16 years of experience, including the last two seasons as an analyst at USC.
- ▶ Locher was a graduate assistant for the Rainbow Warriors last season.

He was invited as a guest of honor of First Lady Jill Biden at the State of the Union Address in Washington D.C. The Pupunu family also helped house more than 30 individuals displaced from the fires.

► QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in his hometown of Highland Park, Texas for special-needs youth. This year marked the game's seventh anniversary. As a 10-year-old, Schager had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.

► LB **Logan Taylor** recently became a campus missionary at UH and occasionally preaches Sunday services at his church Grace Bible Honolulu.

► OL **Luke Felix-Fualalo** played rugby in his native country of Australia before picking up American football in high school. Named after Luke Skywalker, he is a student of an ancient Samurai swordsman. His cousin Colm Wouffe-Felix won New Zealand's Strongest Man competition. His mother (Denise) played professional netball and father (Daniel) played rugby for Tonga. A recent espn.com article named him college football's Most Interesting Man,

► RB **Landon Sims** dons the same jersey number (#30) as his famous UH football father, Travis, who was a member of the 1992 Holiday Bowl championship squad. Days before the season-opener, Landon was awarded a scholarship in a surprise reveal by Travis at a team meeting.

► DB Eli **Matagi Thompson** was named after his uncle Eli Thompson who was committed to UH but passed away his senior year of HS. Fire knife dances for his father's luau company "Tihati Productions."

► LB **Logan Taylor** and DL **Elijah Robinson** are part of only 34 players nation-wide in their seventh year of collegiate football.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** has three children while LB **Logan Taylor** has two with another on the way.

► P **Lucas Borrow** played high level Australian Rules Football until the age of 17 before joining Prokick Australia to train for American football.

► PK **Kansel Matsuzawa**, a native of Japan, learned how to kick by watching YouTube videos and learned to speak English by listening to his junior college teammates.

► WR **Spencer Curtis**, one of the oldest players on the team (25), graduated from HS in 2017; played at Weber State, Oregon and Nevada before coming to UH. Also did a two-year LDS mission following his freshman year at Weber.

► DB **Elijah Palmer** was raised by his grandparents. WR **Carlito Capanang Jr.** is the youngest of 12 children. WR **Josiah Fetui** is of royal bloodline. His fifth great grandma was a princess in American Samoa. DL **Jordon Crawford** is the youngest of nine siblings. His father Sydney played football for Rutgers. DB **Brandon Shah** can play the piano by ear. LB **Jamih Otis** is a barber.

► Among Hawai'i high schools, there are 12 players from Saint Louis School followed by Punahou School (6), Kamehameha Schools-Kapalama and Campbell HS (5).

THE RUN-AND-SHOOT

► The most productive offensive scheme in program history is the **Run-and-Shoot**, which Hawai'i used for 16 seasons since 1999.

► UH ran the offense for 13 consecutive seasons under coaches June Jones (1999-2007) and Greg McMackin (2008-11) until Nick Rolovich brought it back for the 2018 & '19 seasons.

► UH finished in the Top 10 nationally in passing in 13 of 16 seasons and led the country in 2002, '06 & '10. UH also led the nation in scoring in 2006 and '07.

► UH is the only school to feature three 1,000-yard receivers in the same season twice – 2018 (JoJo Ward, Jared Smart, Cedric Byrd II) and 2007 (Ryan Grice-Mullen, Davone Bess, Jason Rivers).

- UH took over in the second half of its season opener, scoring 21 unanswered points to secure a win in its first-ever meeting with Delaware State.
- Senior quarterback Brayden Schager accounted for four touchdowns - two through the air and two on the ground.
- Tylan Hines sparked the Warriors with a 44-yard punt return for a touchdown late in the first quarter and led UH with 99 all-purpose yards.
- The punt return touchdown was UH's first in 12 years. The last punt return for a TD was Scott Harding's 69-yard return vs. UNLV on Nov. 12, 2012.
- UH's 35 points were the most scored in 27 games under Timmy Chang. The 21-point margin of victory was also the largest by UH under Chang.
- UH won its first season opener since 2020 after dropping its previous three.
- UH has now won its last 21 games against FCS teams dating back to 2001 with an average win margin of 25.7 points per game.
- The team's combined for 20 punts. Ball State transfer Lucas Borrow made his debut for UH and averaged 44.0 yards on eight punts.
- Seven Rainbow Warriors made their first career starts for the program including Kentucky transfer Dekel Crowdus who scored on a 29-yard catch, as well as sophomore linebacker Jamih Otis who finished with a team-high 11 tackles and 2.5 TFLs.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ SDSU won a back-and-forth affair in the conference opener for both teams.
- ▶ The Aztecs have won five straight overall in the series and 11 of the last 13.
- ▶ It was another close meeting between the teams as six of the last seven meetings have been decided by seven points or less.
- ▶ UH fell to 1-13 on the road and 0-4 following bye weeks under Timmy Chang.
- ▶ Brayden Schager made his 27th straight start at quarterback dating back to 2022, setting the longest such streak in school history, surpassing Bryant Moniz (26, 2009-11).
- ▶ Schager, who hit 11 different targets during the game, tossed three touchdown passes and has seven combined in the last two games.
- ▶ UH ran a season-high 73 plays while tying its season high with 44 pass attempts.
- ▶ UH finished with 10 tackles-for-loss, one shy of a season high. Elijah Robinson led the way with a career-high 3.0 TFLs among his career-high 11 overall tackles.
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors limited SDSU to just 2.9 yards per carry, the lowest average by a UH opponent this year.
- ▶ Pofele Ashlock scored a receiving touchdown in his fourth straight game following his 6-yard catch in the third quarter. It's the longest such streak since Calvin Turner, Jr., during the 2020 season.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ The Warriors gave No. 17 Boise State a battle through three quarters, but the Broncos ultimately pulled away with 15 fourth-quarter points.
- ▶ The Broncos notched their 10th straight win over Hawai'i, matching BYU's win streak against UH.
- ▶ The Broncos have won 16 of the last 17 match-ups since 2001 — all as conference foes. UH's last win over Boise State came in 2007.
- ▶ Heisman hopeful Ashton Jeanty finished with 217 yards on 31 carries with one rushing touchdown and one receiving touchdown.
- ▶ UH held Boise State to its lowest scoring output this season The Broncos came into the game leading the nation in scoring at 50.6 points per game.
- ▶ UH scored a season-low seven points. The previous low was 13 points at Sam Houston and vs. UCLA.
- ▶ Boise State racked up eight sacks, the most since Louisiana State had nine against the Warriors in the 2018 Hawai'i Bowl.
- ▶ With 264 yards passing, UH quarterback Brayden Schager moved past Cole McDonald for fourth on the all-time passing list with 8,097 career yards.
- ▶ Tylan Hines started for the first this time this season and for the second straight week found the end zone with a 27-yard reception for UH's lone score of the night.

GAME NOTES

- ▶ UH lost in its first-ever visit to Pullman, while the Cougars defeated UH for the first time in the last three meetings.
- ▶ UH has lost its last six versus Pac-12 teams and its last 13 in Pac-12 road games.
- ▶ UH allowed a season-high 42 points to the Cougars while also suffering its largest margin of defeat this year. It marked just the second time in seven games this year that UH gave up more than 30 points.
- ▶ UH tied its season-high for turnovers with three. After losing just one fumble through the first six games, UH lost two fumbles versus the Cougars.

- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors led from wire-to-wire in defeating the Wolf Pack for the fifth time in the last six meetings, including the last three meetings in Honolulu.
- ▶ Brayden Schager ran for a career-high 120 yards and four touchdowns — tying the program record for rushing scores by a quarterback as UH earned their first conference win of the season while snapping a three-game losing streak.
- ▶ The UH offense churned out 242 rushing yards, breaking the 200-yard mark for the first time since Nov. 12, 2022 against Utah State.
- ▶ UH, which also got a career-high 82 yards rushing from Landon Sims, had entered the game with a total of three rushing touchdowns this season and had averaged 83.9 rushing yards per game.
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors pitched a first-half shutout for the second time this season and forced two Nevada turnovers (one interception, one fumble recovery).
- ▶ UH's 21-point win over the Wolf Pack was the largest at home over a Mountain West opponent since moving into the Ching Complex in 2021.
- ▶ UH went 6-of-6 in the red zone with four touchdowns. The Warriors entered the evening having scored 12 touchdowns on 22 red-zone drives.
- ▶ Making his second start of the season, senior linebacker Nalu Emerson finished with six tackles, a sack, an interception and one pass breakup.

GAME NOTES

- Wide receiver Nick Cenacle caught a touchdown pass with 15 seconds left to help push the Rainbow Warriors over the Bulldogs in the 56th meeting between the teams.
- Cenacle caught 12 passes for 113 yards and was on the receiving end of both of Brayden Schager's fourth-quarter touchdown passes as the Warriors erased a 13-point deficit in the final period.
- Schager led a game-winning drive in the final minute of regulation for the third time in his career.
- The UH defense provided fuel for the rally by forcing Fresno State punts on seven consecutive possessions while holding the Bulldogs to 176 yards of total offense, just 67 coming in the second half.
