The Basics: The University of Utah women's basketball team will play the second half of its two-game road swing with an in-state battle at Weber State on Friday, Nov. 17 with a 7 p.m. tip off. It is the 53rd meeting between the two teams.

On The Road: Utah is 12-14 on the road under the direction of head coach Lynne Roberts (0-1 in 2017-18, 6-6 in 2016-17, 6-7 in 2015-16). The Utes are 19-5 all-time against Weber State when playing in Ogden, including the last two trips north.

About the Wildcats: Weber State won its season-opener against Utah Valley, 75-57 with three double-digit scorers, including 20 points from senior Kailie Quinn. The Wildcats return eight letter winners from last season, including three starts. They also welcome two graduate transfers joining their team in Briana Gray (Bradley) and Larryn Brooks (Texas Tech). Weber State finished the 2016-17 season 13-18 overall and 6-12 in Big Sky play.

By the Numbers:

- 35: Utah has 35 wins under the direction of Lynne Roberts.
- 14: Utah will appear on the Pac-12 Networks 14 times this season.
- 9: Out of Utah's 15-person roster, nine athletes are 6-0 or taller.
- 6: Utah added six newcomers to the roster this season.
- 4: Utah has four student-athletes who hail from other countries including (Canada, Finland).
- 4: The Utes return four seniors this season in Wendy Anae, Tanaeya BoClair, Tilar Clark and Emily Potter.
- 3: Utah returns three starters this season in Emily Potter, Tanaeya BoClair and Erika Bean.
- 2: Back-to-back seasons in postseason play (WNIT in 2016, 2017).

Tyson Ewing will be on the mic giving play-by-play action during the season on ESPN 700 for all home games (no exhibition game) and away games. For games that aren't airing on TV (Pac-12 Networks), fans can catch a live stream of select games on UtahUtes.com.

Utah Sports Radio Network: ESPN 700 (KALL-AM) has been the radio home to University of Utah athletics since 1951. All of Utah's games on ESPN 700 can also be heard live on the Internet at ESPN700sports.com. Radio coverage for women's basketball games conflicting with other events airing on ESPN 700 will be announced at a later date. Managing the radio network is Utah Sports Properties, a division of CBS Collegiate Sports Properties. Utah Sports Properties (USP) is in its ninth year as the multi-media rights partner for Utah Athletics. USP brokered the most recent contract extension with ESPN 700 and Utah athletics - a five year agreement signed in May, 2012. Handling the play-by-play for the Utah women's basketball team is Tyson Ewing, who is in his second season. Ewing previously spent four years as the voice of Weber State women's basketball, and was the sports director at KWCR in 2013 during his time as a student at Weber State. He worked for the Utah Jazz Radio Network as a broadcast assistant from 2014-16 and currently serves as a statistician on the TV side.

- Roberts holds an overall record of 35-30 since stepping foot in Salt Lake City for the 2015-16 season.
- At Utah, Roberts has coached four All-Pac 12 selections and 11 all-academic honorees. She has been at the helm to see the Utes knock off a pair of Top-25 ranked opponents and earn votes in the AP and USA Today Coaches polls in back-to-back seasons.
- In 2016-17 the Utes went 16-15 overall and 5-13 in league play, making their way to the WNIT for the second straight season. Utah went 11-0 in non-conference play, but in sports there are highs and lows, with the Utes struggling during conference play to finish ninth in the Pac-12.
- The conference slate of games didn't deter the Utes with Roberts' "complacency is the devil" outlook on the game. The Utes finished the season ranked in the top-25 in the country in both blocked shots and defensive rebounds per game, thanks in large part of Pac-12 All-Defensive team and All-Pac 12 selection Emily Potter who ranked in the top-15 in blocks in NCAA Division I women's basketball, setting a new Utah single-season record at 89.
- Utah's 11-game winning streak to begin the 2016-17 season is the longest winning streak for the Utes since the 2008-09 season when Utah won 12 straight. In conference play, Utah beat USC on the road for the first time since 2013, completed a regular season sweep over Cal for the second straight year and picked up a win over Washington State and Colorado, winning three of the last four games against both teams.

Game 3: Utah at Weber State

Utes vs. The Big Sky: Utah is 205-24 all-time against the 12 members of the Big Sky Conference. Utah has played against 11 of the conference members and has a winning record against 10. The Utes and the Wildcats of Weber State have the longest history with 53 games between the two teams (Utes lead 46-6).

Last time Out: The Utes battled the Alabama Crimson Tide on Monday, Nov. 13 on the road, falling 65-60. The Utes led most of the first half, but a troubled third quarter ultimately led to the Utes demise. The Utes were led in scoring by Megan Huff with 13 points and a season-high eight rebounds with Emily Potter adding 11 points and six rebounds before fouling out.

Outrebounded: The Utes have outrebounded both of their opponents this season (83-67). Both Tori Williams and Megan Huff came away with career-highs in rebounds against Alabama (11/13) with Williams bringing down seven and Huff grabbing a team-high eight.

Bench Points: The Ute bench has scored 65 of Utah's 147 points this season (44%). They scored 45 points against Nevada (11/10), following it up with 20 points against Alabama (11/13). Tori Williams is leading the Utes off the bench with 13.0 points per game.

Shooting Deep: The Utes are ranked No. 12 in the nation and second in the Pac-12 in three-pointers made this season (12). Tori Williams leads Utah with eight threes, also ranking 12th in the country and third in the Pac-12 individually.

Perfect Play: Utes redshirt junior Megan Huff came out firing for her first two games at Utah, shooting 100-percent from the arc (4-for-4). She is one of just 19 players in the country and the only athlete in the Pac-12 to not miss a three-pointer this season.

Stat Line: Emily Potter took over sole possession of No. 17 all-time at Utah in scoring with 1,276 points. She has scored in double figures in both games this year (17 vs. Nevada, 11 at Alabama).

Threes Company: Emily Potter has led the Utes in blocks in three seasons since stepping foot on campus as a freshman. She is looking to do the same her senior season and would become just the third player in Utah history to lead the Utes in blocks for four seasons.

Dishing Dimes: Junior Erika Bean has led Utah in assists in the first two games (7 vs. Nevada, 5 at Alabama). She has had five or more assists in 25 career games at Utah.

High Shooting: Megan Huff ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (.667) through two games. Six of Utah's 10 available players are shooting 40% or better.

Two's Company: Senior Emily Potter is just the second player in Utah women's basketball history to have 1,000+ points, 800+ rebounds and 200+ blocks in a career.
