The Basics: The University of Utah women's basketball team makes its return to the Huntsman Center on Monday, Nov. 20 after two weeks on the road, taking on the Purdue Boilermakers at 7 p.m. It is just the second time in school history the two teams have met.

Home Sweet Home: The Utes are 490-102 all-time in the Jon M. Huntsman Center, holding a winning home record for three straight seasons and in five of the last six seasons. The Utes are 1-0 in Salt Lake City this season.

About the Boilermakers: Purdue will play one more game (vs. Lamar on Nov. 18) before heading to Salt Lake City on Monday. The Boilermakers are 2-0 this season, beating Central Michigan (79-69) and Miami Ohio (75-66). They returned three starters to the court this season, including sophomore guard Dominique Oden who averaged 10.8 points per game in 2016-17. They currently have four players averaging in double figures, led by Andreona Keys (15.5 ppg).

By the Numbers:

- 36: Utah has 36 wins under the direction of Lynne Roberts.
- 14: Utah will appear on the Pac-12 Networks 14 times this season.
- 9: Out of Utah's 15-person roster, nine athletes are 6-0 or taller.
- 6: Utah added six newcomers to the roster this season.
- 4: Utah has four student-athletes who hail from other countries including (Canada, Finland).
- 4: The Utes return four seniors this season in Wendy Anae, Tanaeya BoClair, Tilar Clark and Emily Potter.
- 3: Utah returns three starters this season in Emily Potter, Tanaeya BoClair and Erika Bean.
- 2: Back-to-back seasons in postseason play (WNIT in 2016, 2017).

Game Promotion: Utah's game against Purdue is "Star Wars Night." Mini light sabers and Utah women's basketball Star Wars posters will be given out at the door with a chance to win tickets to opening night for "The Last Jedi."

Post-game Services: Head coach Lynne Roberts and selected student-athletes will be available for post-game interviews with the media after each game. Full box scores will be provided and can be emailed or faxed upon request.

Tyson Ewing will be on the mic giving play-by-play action during the season on ESPN 700 for all home games (no exhibition game) and away games. For games that aren't airing on TV (Pac-12 Networks), fans can catch a live stream of select games on UtahUtes.com.

Utah Sports Radio Network: ESPN 700 (KALL-AM) has been the radio home to University of Utah athletics since 1951. All of Utah's games on ESPN 700 can also be heard live on the Internet at ESPN700sports.com. Radio coverage for women's basketball games conflicting with other events airing on ESPN 700 will be announced at a later date. Managing the radio network is Utah Sports Properties, a division of CBS Collegiate Sports Properties. Utah Sports Properties (USP) is in its ninth year as the multi-media rights partner for Utah Athletics. USP brokered the most recent contract extension with ESPN 700 and Utah athletics – a five year agreement signed in May, 2012. Handling the play-by-play for the Utah women's basketball team is Tyson Ewing, who is in his second season. Ewing previously spent four years as the voice of Weber State women's basketball, and was the sports director at KWCR in 2013 during his time as a student at Weber State. He worked for the Utah Jazz Radio Network as a broadcast assistant from 2014-16 and currently serves as a statistician on the TV side.

- Roberts holds an overall record of 36-31 since stepping foot in Salt Lake City for the 2015-16 season.
- At Utah, Roberts has coached four All-Pac 12 selections and 11 all-academic honorees. She has been at the helm to see the Utes knock off a pair of Top-25 ranked opponents and earn votes in the AP and USA Today Coaches polls in back-to-back seasons.
- In 2016-17 the Utes went 16-15 overall and 5-13 in league play, making their way to the WNIT for the second straight season. Utah went 11-0 in non-conference play, but in sports there are highs and lows, with the Utes struggling during conference play to finish ninth in the Pac-12.
- The conference slate of games didn't deter the Utes with Roberts' "complacency is the devil" outlook on the game. The Utes finished the season ranked in the top-25 in the country in both blocked shots and defensive rebounds per game, thanks in large part of Pac-12 All-Defensive team and All-Pac 12 selection Emily Potter who ranked in the top-15 in blocks in NCAA Division I women's basketball, setting a new Utah single-season record at 89.
- Utah's 11-game winning streak to begin the 2016-17 season is the longest winning streak for the Utes since the 2008-09 season when Utah won 12 straight. In conference play, Utah beat USC on the road for the first time since 2013, completed a regular season sweep over Cal for the second straight year and picked up a win over Washington State and Colorado, winning three of the last four games against both teams.

Game 4: Utah vs. Purdue

Utes vs. The Big Ten: Utah is 13-14 all-time against the current members of the Big Ten Conference. The last time the Utes played a team against the Big Ten was against Nebraska in 2014, losing 66-43 on the road. The last time Utah defeated a Big Ten foe was against Michigan in 2012 (59-40) at home.

Last time Out: Utah put up a dominating performance against Weber State on Friday, Nov. 17, winning 85-58. The Utes had five players in double-figures, led by redshirt junior Megan Huff with 20 points. Erika Bean scored a career-high 15 points with Tilar Clark pitching in 10. Off the bench, Daneesha Provo and Tanaeya BoClair both scored in double-digits, scoring 13 and 12 points, respectively.

Beating Your Best: Junior guard Erika Bean scored just three three-pointers in 2016-17. She has hit four this season already, including a career-high three at Weber State (11/17). She scored a career-high 15 points against the Wildcats.

Careful Stats: Freshman Tori Williams had a career-high four assists at Weber State (11/17), finishing the game with zero turnovers. She only has two turnovers through three games with 10 assists. She is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (5.00), also ranking No. 34 nationally.

On the Line: Daneesha Provo is one of just six players in the Pac-12 that hasn't missed a free throw this season. She is a perfect 8-for-8, including her career-high 6-for-6 against Weber State (11/17). She only shot 56-percent from the free throw line last season, but with her 100-percent average this season, she is tied for first in the nation.

Five-for-Five: The Utes had five players score in double-digits against Weber State (11/17). The last time Utah had five players score 10-or-more points was against Utah Valley on Nov. 19, 2016.

20 or Bust: Megan Huff scored a career-high 20 points against Weber State (11/17). It is the first 20-point game of her collegiate basketball career. Her career-high in points at Hawai'i was 18.

Outrebounded: The Utes have outrebounded all three of its opponents this season (129-92). Utah ranks third in the Pac-12 through three games in total rebounds (129) and rebounding margin (+12.3).

Bench Points: The Ute bench has scored 99 of Utah's 232 points this season (43%). Daneesha Provo is leading the Utes off the bench with 11.3 points per game, ranking second on the team.

Shooting Deep: The Utes are ranked No. 13 in the nation and second in the Pac-12 in three-pointers made this season (30). Tori Williams leads Utah with eight threes, also ranking third in the Pac-12.

Almost Perfect: Utes redshirt junior Megan Huff came out firing for her first two games at Utah, shooting 100-percent from the arc (4-for-4). She missed her first three-pointer of the year against Weber State (11/17), still shooting 3-for-4

from deep. She ranks No. 4 in the nation and No. 2 in the Pac-12 in three-point percentage (.875).

Stat Line: Emily Potter has taken over sole possession of No. 17 all-time at Utah in scoring with 1,280 points. She has scored in double figures in two games this year (17 vs. Nevada, 11 at Alabama).

High Shooting: Megan Huff ranks fourth in the Pac-12 and No. 27 in the nation in field goal percentage (.708) through three games. Six of Utah's 10 available players are shooting 40% or better.
