The Basics: The University of Utah women's basketball team is set to host the Incarnate Word Cardinals on Friday, Nov. 24 at 3:30 p.m. The game will take place in the Jon M. Huntsman Center and will be streamed on UtahUtes.com.

Home Sweet Home: The Utes are 491-102 all-time in the Jon M. Huntsman Center, holding a winning home record for three straight seasons and in five of the last six seasons. The Utes are 2-0 in Salt Lake City this season.

About the Cardinals: Incarnate Word enters the game against the Utes 1-3 this season. They started with a loss at Oklahoma State (86-35) that would turn into a three game losing streak to begin the season before defeating Mary Hardin-Baylor, 76-58 on Nov. 20. The Cardinals are led by sophomore guard Imani Robinson who is averaging 11.3 points and 4.0 rebounds. UIW plays out of the Southland Conference, finishing seventh in last year's standings.

By the Numbers:

- 37: Utah has 37 wins under the direction of Lynne Roberts.
- 14: Utah will appear on the Pac-12 Networks 14 times this season.
- 9: Out of Utah's 15-person roster, nine athletes are 6-0 or taller.
- 6: Utah added six newcomers to the roster this season.
- 4: Utah has four student-athletes who hail from other countries including (Canada, Finland).
- 4: The Utes return four seniors this season in Wendy Anae, Tanaeya BoClair, Tilar Clark and Emily Potter.
- 3: Utah returns three starters this season in Emily Potter, Tanaeya BoClair and Erika Bean.
- 2: Back-to-back seasons in postseason play (WNIT in 2016, 2017).

Game Promotion: Utah's game against Incarnate Word is its annual Give Thanks Day. At every time out, Utah Athletics will be giving away floor seats to the following games: St. Mary's (Dec. 2, 2:30 p.m.), Arizona (Dec. 29, 6 p.m.), Oregon State (Jan. 26, 6 p.m.), Colorado (Feb. 1, 7 p.m.) and Washington State (Feb. 16, 7 p.m.). Fans that bring a canned food item can also get into the women's and men's games for free.

Post-game Services: Head coach Lynne Roberts and selected student-athletes will be available for post-game interviews with the media after each game. Full box scores will be provided and can be emailed or faxed upon request.

Radio/Video: Fans wishing to tune-in for the 2017-18 season has several options to do so. Tyson Ewing will be on the mic giving play-by-play action during the season on ESPN 700 for all home games (no exhibition game) and away games. For games that aren't airing on TV (Pac-12 Networks), fans can catch a live stream of select games on UtahUtes.com.

Utah Sports Radio Network: ESPN 700 (KALL-AM) has been the radio home to University of Utah athletics since 1951. All of Utah's games on ESPN 700 can also be heard live on the Internet at ESPN700sports.com. Radio coverage for women's basketball games conflicting with other events airing on ESPN 700 will be announced at a later date. Managing the radio network is Utah Sports Properties, a division of CBS Collegiate Sports Properties. Utah Sports Properties (USP) is in its ninth year as the multi-media rights partner for Utah Athletics. USP brokered the most recent contract extension with ESPN 700 and Utah athletics – a five year agreement signed in May, 2012. Handling the play-by-play for the Utah women's basketball team is Tyson Ewing, who is in his second season. Ewing previously spent four years as the voice of Weber State women's basketball, and was the sports director at KWCR in 2013 during his time as a student at Weber State. He worked for the Utah Jazz Radio Network as a broadcast assistant from 2014-16 and currently serves as a statistician on the TV side.

LYNNE ROBERTS

15 seasons as a head coach // six consecutive seasons taking her teams to the postseason // 29 all-conference selections under her direction // 37 wins at Utah // two consecutive seasons receiving votes in the Top 25 Polls

- Roberts holds an overall record of 37-31 since stepping foot in Salt Lake City for the 2015-16 season.
- At Utah, Roberts has coached four All-Pac 12 selections and 11 all-academic honorees. She has been at the helm to see the Utes knock off a pair of Top-25 ranked opponents and earn votes in the AP and USA Today Coaches polls in back-to-back seasons.
- In 2016-17 the Utes went 16-15 overall and 5-13 in league play, making their way to the WNIT for the second straight season. Utah went 11-0 in non-conference play, but in sports there are highs and lows, with the Utes struggling during conference play to finish ninth in the Pac-12.
- The conference slate of games didn't deter the Utes with Roberts' "complacency is the devil" outlook on the game. The Utes finished the season ranked in the top-25 in the country in both blocked shots and defensive rebounds per game, thanks in large part of Pac-12 All-Defensive team and All-Pac 12 selection Emily Potter who ranked in the top-15 in blocks in NCAA Division I women's basketball, setting a new Utah single-season record at 89.
- Utah's 11-game winning streak to begin the 2016-17 season is the longest winning streak for the Utes since the 2008-09 season when Utah won 12 straight. In conference play, Utah beat USC on the road for the first time since 2013, completed a regular season sweep over Cal for the second straight year and picked up a win over Washington State and Colorado, winning three of the last four games against both teams.

Game 5: Utah vs. Incarnate Word

Utes vs. The Southland: Utah is 4-1 all-time against the current members of the Southland Conference. Utah has only played against five of the 13 conference members. The last time Utah played against a team from the Southland Conference was in 2015 when they defeated Lamar, 71-67.

Last time Out: Utah took down the Purdue Boilermakers at home on Monday, Nov. 20, coming away with an 81-68 victory. It was Utah's second Power Five opponent of the non-conference season. The Utes were led by redshirt junior Megan Huff who scored a career-high 23 points, adding a career-high nine rebounds. Tori Williams (15), Daneesha Provo (13) and Emily Potter (10) also contributed double digit scoring with Erika Bean leading the team in assists with seven.

Consecutive Starts: Senior Emily Potter has started in every game since stepping foot on campus as a Ute. Potter has started in 99 games, missing the 2014-15 season with an injury.

20 or Bust: Megan Huff scored 20-or-more points in back-to-back games (20 vs. Weber State, 11/17 - 23 vs. Purdue, 11/20). Her career-high in points at Hawai'i was 18. Emily Potter is the only other player since Lynne Roberts took over that has scored 20-plus points in back-to-back games.

In the Books: With her six rebounds against Purdue (11/20), Emily Potter has moved into the top-10 all-time at Utah in career rebounds (836). She ranks No. 9 in total rebounds, No. 8 in offensive rebounds (256) and No. 6 in defensive rebounds (580). Her 836 career rebounds also ranks in the top-50 all-time in the Pac-12 Conference.

Off the Bench: Senior Tanaeya BoClair started the first two games of the season, but has come off the bench to be key for the Utes in the last two games. While starting, she was shooting 29-percent from the floor and only averaging 5.5 points. Coming off the bench, she is shooting 57-percent from the field and averaging 10.5 points.

Free Points: The Utes haven't been shy about getting to the free throw line this season, and they have made it count. Utah was 20-for-23 from the line against Purdue (11/20) with five players shooting perfect. Utah is ranked first in the Pac-12 and No. 11 in the NCAA in free throw percentage (81.7).

Score, Score, Score: The Utes may have began their season with a defensive bootcamp, but head coach Lynne Roberts stressed that she still expected a high powered offense. Utah only averaged 64.5 points per game last season, but this season has had 80-plus points in three of its four games, averaging 78.2. The Utes rank fourth in the Pac-12 in scoring offense through four games.

Take Care: Utah averaged a little over 16 turnovers in the first two games, but have taken care of the ball in the last two, only averaging 8.5 against Weber State (11/17) and Purdue (11/20). Utah ranks 32nd in the country in turnovers per game (12.5).

Newcomer News: Freshman Tori Williams hasn't been playing like a true freshman. She only has three turnovers through four games with 14 assists and is averaging 10.8 points per game. She is third in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (4.67), also ranking No. 24 nationally.

On the Line: Daneesha Provo is one of just four players in the Pac-12 that hasn't missed a free throw this season. She is a perfect 11-for-11. She only shot 56-percent from the free throw line last season, but with her 100-percent average this season, she is tied for first in the nation (43 players tied).

Outrebounded: The Utes have outrebounded all four of its opponents this season (168-118). Utah ranks third in the Pac-12 through four games in total rebounds (168) and second in rebounding margin (+12.5).

Stat Line: Emily Potter has taken over sole possession of No. 17 all-time at Utah in scoring with 1,290 points. She has scored in double figures in two games this year (17 vs. Nevada, 11 at Alabama).

Among the Best: Emily Potter enters the season ranked seventh all-time in the Pac-12 in career blocks (219) and is seventh in the nation among active career leaders.
