The Basics: The University of Utah women's basketball team will host UT-Arlington on Monday, Nov. 27 for its third consecutive home game. The game is set for a 6 p.m. tip.

Home Sweet Home: The Utes are 492-102 all-time in the Jon M. Huntsman Center, holding a winning home record for three straight seasons and in five of the last six seasons. The Utes are 3-0 in Salt Lake City this season.

About the Mavericks: The UT-Arlington Mavericks enter the game against the Utes as one of 42 teams in the country that are still undefeated (5-0). The Mavericks and the Utes share similar non-conference schedules with UTA already picking up wins over Incarnate Word (61-48) and Oral Roberts (70-46). They are led by senior Crystal Allen, who is averaging 170 points and 3.8 rebounds per game. The Mavericks are under the direction of Krista Gerlich who is in her sixth season at UTA after leading them to a 22-9 record and a second place finish in the Sun Belt Conference in 2016-17, earning a spot in the WNIT.

By the Numbers:

- 38: Utah has 38 wins under the direction of Lynne Roberts.
- 14: Utah will appear on the Pac-12 Networks 14 times this season.
- 9: Out of Utah's 15-person roster, nine athletes are 6-0 or taller.
- 6: Utah added six newcomers to the roster this season.
- 4: Utah has four student-athletes who hail from other countries including (Canada, Finland).
- 4: The Utes return four seniors this season in Wendy Anae, Tanaeya BoClair, Tilar Clark and Emily Potter.
- 3: Utah returns three starters this season in Emily Potter, Tanaeya BoClair and Erika Bean.
- 2: Back-to-back seasons in postseason play (WNIT in 2016, 2017).

Radio coverage for women's basketball games conflicting with other events airing on ESPN 700 will be announced at a later date. Managing the radio network is Utah Sports Properties, a division of CBS Collegiate Sports Properties. Utah Sports Properties (USP) is in its ninth year as the multi-media rights partner for Utah Athletics. USP brokered the most recent contract extension with ESPN 700 and Utah athletics – a five year agreement signed in May, 2012. Handling the play-by-play for the Utah women's basketball team is Tyson Ewing, who is in his second season. Ewing previously spent four years as the voice of Weber State women's basketball, and was the sports director at KWCR in 2013 during his time as a student at Weber State. He worked for the Utah Jazz Radio Network as a broadcast assistant from 2014-16 and currently serves as a statistician on the TV side.

- Roberts holds an overall record of 38-31 since stepping foot in Salt Lake City for the 2015-16 season.
- At Utah, Roberts has coached four All-Pac 12 selections and 11 all-academic honorees. She has been at the helm to see the Utes knock off a pair of Top-25 ranked opponents and earn votes in the AP and USA Today Coaches polls in back-to-back seasons.
- In 2016-17 the Utes went 16-15 overall and 5-13 in league play, making their way to the WNIT for the second straight season. Utah went 11-0 in non-conference play, but in sports there are highs and lows, with the Utes struggling during conference play to finish ninth in the Pac-12.
- The conference slate of games didn't deter the Utes with Roberts' "complacency is the devil" outlook on the game. The Utes finished the season ranked in the top-25 in the country in both blocked shots and defensive rebounds per game, thanks in large part of Pac-12 All-Defensive team and All-Pac 12 selection Emily Potter who ranked in the top-15 in blocks in NCAA Division I women's basketball, setting a new Utah single-season record at 89.
- Utah's 11-game winning streak to begin the 2016-17 season is the longest winning streak for the Utes since the 2008-09 season when Utah won 12 straight. In conference play, Utah beat USC on the road for the first time since 2013, completed a regular season sweep over Cal for the second straight year and picked up a win over Washington State and Colorado, winning three of the last four games against both teams.

Game 6: Utah vs. UT-Arlington

Utes vs. The Sun Belt: Utah is 3-1 all-time against the current members of the Sun Belt Conference, having only played against Texas State and South Alabama. The last time Utah played against a team from the Sun Belt Conference was in 2011 when they fell to South Alabama, 61-53 in the UTSA Thanksgiving Classic. The last time Utah defeated a team from the SBC was in 1991 when they came away with a 69-64 overtime win at Texas State.

Last time Out: Utah put up a convincing win over Incarnate Word on Friday, Nov. 24, beating them 90-31. Emily Potter scored 21 points to lead the Utes, adding seven rebounds and a season-high four blocks. Daneesha Provo added a career-high 19 points (7-for-9) with Kiana Moore pouring in a season-best 14 points. The Utes defense was stingy with the Cardinal only shooting 18-percent from the floor in the game with 15 turnovers.

100 Straight: Senior Emily Potter has started in every game since stepping foot on campus as a Ute. Potter has started in her 100th consecutive game against Incarnate Word (11/24).

Low Points: Utah held Incarnate Word to just 31 points (11/24). It was the 63rd time in program history that the Utes have held an opponent to below 40 points and the first time since Utah held Houston Baptist to 33 points in a 71-33 win in 2012. The school record for low points by an opponent was 22 points (San Diego State) in 2003.

To the 90s: The Utes scored 90 points against Incarnate Word (11/24), the fifth time since Lynne Roberts took over the program that the Utes have score 90-or-more points. Utah has scored 90-plus points in 72 games in program history.

One of Three: Utah is one of just three schools in the Pac-12 (Oregon State, Arizona State) to have two players ranked in the top-10 in the league in assist/turnover ratio. The Utes hold the top two spots with Tori Williams (5.33) ranking first and Erika Bean (4.83) in second. The Utes are the only team in the Pac-12 to have two players ranked in the top-25 in the same statistic with Williams at the No. 9 spot and Bean coming in at No. 15.

Deep Shots: Daneesha Provo ranks No. 3 in the Pac-12 and 12th in the NCAA in three-point field goal percentage after the game against Incarnate Word (11/24). Provo scored a career-high five threes (5-for-6), ending up with a career-high 19 points after going 7-for-9 from the floor.

Moore Points: Sophomore Kiana Moore scored a season-best 14 points against Incarnate Word (11/24). She hit a career-high six field goals, shooting 66-percent from the floor. She ranks second on the team in field goal percentage this season (60-percent, 9-for-15).

Swat Stats: Utah racked up a season-high 10 blocks against Incarnate Word (11/24), led by senior Emily Potter with four. The Jon M. Huntsman Center record for blocks in a game was 13 vs. Montana State in 1993.

Stat Line: Emily Potter has taken over sole possession of No. 16 all-time at Utah in scoring with 1,311 points after her 21 points against Incarnate Word (11/24). It was the 16th time in her career that she has scored 20-plus points and the 77th time she has scored in double figures.

Score, Score, Score: The Utes may have began their season with a defensive bootcamp, but head coach Lynne Roberts stressed that she still expected a high powered offense. Utah only averaged 64.5 points per game last season, but this season has had 80-plus points in four of its five games, averaging 80.6. The Utes rank third in the Pac-12 in scoring offense and in the top-40 in the nation.

Among the Best: Emily Potter came away with a season-best four blocks against Incarnate Word (11/24), moving her to No. 5 all-time in Pac-12 history with 223 career blocks.

In the Books: Emily Potter has moved into the top-10 all-time at Utah in career rebounds (843). She ranks No. 9 in total rebounds, No. 8 in offensive rebounds (257) and No. 6 in defensive rebounds (586). Her 843 career rebounds also ranks in the top-50 all-time in the Pac-12 Conference.

Off the Bench: Senior Tanaeya BoClair started the first two games of the season, but has come off the bench to be key for the Utes in the last three games. While starting, she was shooting 29-percent from the floor and only averaging 5.5 points. Coming off the bench, she is shooting 62-percent from the field and averaging 8.5 points.

Take Care: Utah averaged a little over 16 turnovers in the first two games, but have taken care of the ball in the last three. In the last three games, Utah has only averaged 10.0. The Utes rank second in the Pac-12 and No. 21 in the NCAA in turnovers per game.

Newcomer News: Freshman Tori Williams hasn't been playing like a true freshman. She only has three turnovers through five games with 16 assists and is averaging 10.2 points per game. She is first in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (5.33), also ranking No. 9 nationally.

On the Line: Daneesha Provo is one of just two players in the Pac-12 and 11 in the country that hasn't missed a free throw this season. She is a perfect 11-for-11. She only shot 56-percent from the free throw line last season.

Outrebounded: The Utes have outrebounded all five of its opponents this season (218-142). Utah ranks fourth in the Pac-12 through five games in total rebounds (218) and also ranks first in rebounding margin (+15.2, ranks No. 16 in the NCAA).

Free Points: The Utes haven't been shy about getting to the free throw line this season, and they have made it count. Utah was 20-for-23 from the line against Purdue (11/20) with five players shooting perfect. Utah is ranked second in the Pac-12 and No. 20 in the NCAA in free throw percentage (78.7).

Five-for-Five: The Utes had five players score in double-digits against Weber State (11/17). The last time Utah had five players score 10-or-more points was against Utah Valley on Nov. 19, 2016.

Beating Your Best: Junior guard Erika Bean scored just three three-pointers in 2016-17. She has hit four this season already, including a career-high three at Weber State (11/17). She scored a career-high 15 points against the Wildcats.

First Timer: Tori Williams finished the game against Nevada (11/10) 6-for-9 from the arc (6-for-6 in the fourth). Williams's 18 points is the most a Utah true freshman has scored in a game since former Ute Malia Nawahine scored 19 at Oregon on Feb. 8, 2014.

Utes Ink Four: Utah signed four future student-athletes to National Letters of Intent on Wednesday, Nov. 8 with all four towering over 6-2 or taller.

Threes Company: Emily Potter has led the Utes in blocks in three seasons since stepping foot on campus as a freshman. She is looking to do the same her senior season and would become just the third player in Utah history to lead the Utes in blocks for four seasons.
