### Utah Baseball Hits Road for Nevada, Washington

The Utah baseball team hits the road this week to play its first midweek game of the season against Nevada on Wednesday, March 15, and continues on to Washington to open Pac-12 play on March 17.

First pitch at Nevada is at 1:00 p.m. PT on Wednesday. Video, audio and live stats will be available.

The Washington series begins on Friday, March 17, at 7:00 p.m. PT, continuing on Saturday, March 18, at 2:00 p.m. PT. The series concludes on Sunday, March 19, at 2:00 p.m. PT. Friday and Sunday's games will be televised on the Pac-12 Network with a video stream available on Saturday.

Utah is ranked 21st in the latest RPI. The Utes are receiving votes in the latest National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association poll.

Utah is second in the conference with a .307 batting average and a .428 slugging percentage. The Utes are also second in the league in runs scored (92, tied), RBI (82, tied) and on-base percentage (.402). Utah is third in the Pac-12 in doubles (30) and hits (141).

The Utes have allowed just two home runs, which is second-fewest in the league. Utah's 44 runs allowed is the third-fewest in the league. The Utes are tied for second in the conference with four pickoffs.

Dallas Carroll leads the Pac-12 and is tied for 11th in the NCAA in batting average (.462) and is tied for 14th in the country in hits per game (1.85). Carroll is the third-toughest player in the league to strike out (one strikeout every 17.3 at-bats).

Nevada is 4-11 on the season and 2-4 in the MW. The Wolfpack went 1-2 against MW foes Fresno State and San Diego State.

The last time Utah and Washington faced each other, it was for the Pac-12 Championship with the Utes winning two of the three games. The Huskies are 9-6 and ranked 25th in the latest *Baseball America* poll. Washington recently went 2-2 against Indiana State and 3-1 vs. Sacramento State.

### Infield

• At third base, senior Dallas Carroll leads the Pac-12 and is tied for 11th in the NCAA in batting average (.462). He is tied for 14th in the country in hits per game (1.85). Carroll is the third-toughest player to strike out in the Pac-12 (one strikeout in every 17.3 at-bats), fourth in the Pac-12 in hits (24, tied), fifth in on-base percentage (.508), sixth in slugging percentage (.615) and RBI (15, tied). He has five doubles, one home run, has scored 11 runs, leads Utah

with eight multiple-hit games and is tied for the team lead with five multiple-RBI games. He is 3-for-4 in stolen bases. Carroll is hitting 9-for-18 (.500) with runners in scoring position.

• Carroll went 2-for-4 with two stolen bases in game one against New Mexico State and was 1-for-4 in game two with a two-RBI double.

• Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (150 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

• Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .300 with nine RBI, 10 walks, a stolen base (1-for-1) and a home run. He has scored 11 runs (tied for second on the team) and has a .426 on-base percentage.

• Simmons went 1-for-2 with two walks and a stolen base in game three of the series against New Mexico State.

• Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.

• Simmons has 128 starts (145 games) over four seasons.

• Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .268 with eight RBI and two doubles. He is tied for second on the team with 11 runs scored and is 1-for-2 in stolen bases. Dunn has not committed an error this year.

• Dunn has reached base in his last six games and is on a four-game hitting streak.

• Senior Ellis Kelly and junior Kyle Hoffman have shared starts at shortstop. Hoffman has seven starts and Kelly six.

• Kelly is hitting .158 on the season with a double and two RBI. He has not made an error in the field.

• Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 25 games at short over the last two seasons.

• Hoffman is hitting .320 with three doubles and two RBI. He has a .452 on-base percentage.

• Hoffman went 2-for-3 with a double and scored a run in game two against New Mexico State.

• Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 34 games with 16 career starts.

• Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started eight games at designated hitter with appearances in all 13 games. He is hitting .310 with a double, home run and two RBI. He is 2-for-5 (.400) as a pinch hitter.

• Gulden hit his first home run of the season in game one against New Mexico State.

• Gulden has played in 76 games in his career with 39 starts the infield, outfield and DH.

## 2017 Utah Baseball

- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally made a start at second in game three against NMSU. He has two starts this year (one at DH) and has played in 11 games. McNally leads Utah with a .533 on-base percentage, is hitting .300 on the year, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs.
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in five games with a start at DH.

### Outfield

- Utah started the same outfield in 12 of 13 games with sophomore Chandler Anderson in left, sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right.
- Keirse is hitting .298 on the year and has four doubles, a triple and a home run with eight RBI. He leads Utah with 12 runs scored. Keirse has six multiple-hit games and is 3-for-5 with three RBI.
- Keirse is on a four-game hitting streak. He went 2-for-4 and stole two bases in game three against New Mexico State.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .277. His six doubles is tied for sixth in the Pac-12 and he is also tied for sixth in the league in walks (12). Rose is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 with 13 RBI and he is tied for the team lead with two home runs. His five multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead and he has reached base in every game. Rose is 3-for-3 with the bases loaded this year.
- Rose hit a two-run home run in game one against New Mexico State and also drove in a run in game two of the series.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 161 career games with 132 career starts.
- Anderson is ninth in the Pac-12 with a .385 batting average. He is tied for ninth in the conference with 20 hits and is the ninth-toughest batter in the league to strike out (once in every 10.4 at-bats). Anderson is tied for second on the team with five doubles and 11 runs scored, has 10 RBI and a .450 on-base percentage. He is second on the team with seven multiple-hit games and also has three multiple-RBI games. Anderson is 2-for-4 in stolen bases.
- Anderson had a hit in two of three games against New Mexico State.
- Freshman Dominic Foscalina made his first career outfield start in game three against New Mexico State. He has played in seven games total and is hitting .200 (1-for-5) with an RBI.

### Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 12 games with 10 starts at catcher. He is hitting .281 on the year with seven RBI, is tied for the team lead with two home runs and has two doubles.
- Moeller went 2-for-3 with a home run in game one of the New Mexico State series.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in five games with three starts at catcher. He is hitting .273 with four RBI and a double.

- Senior Max Schuman has played in six games with two starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .125 with an RBI and a walk.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 62 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 137 total games.

### Pitchers

- Junior Jayson Rose has started four games and has won his last two games (vs. UTSA and NMSU). He is tied for the team lead with 19 strikeouts and has a 4.57 ERA (21 2/3 innings pitched).
- Rose struck out six over seven innings against New Mexico State, allowing one run on two hits in the win.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 3-0 with a 2.49 ERA and is tied for the team lead with 19 strikeouts. He is tied for sixth in the Pac-12 with 25 1/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen allowed one run on six hits over seven innings with five strikeouts against New Mexico State, earning his third win of the year.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 1-2 on the year with a 4.50 ERA over three starts. He has 13 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 12 innings.
- Lapiana pitched just two innings in his last outing in the loss in game three against New Mexico State and will start Utah's midweek game against Nevada.
- Lapiana is in his second year with the program as Utah's Sunday starter.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar emerged quickly as Utah's fourth starter. He has a 2.84 ERA, 2-1 record and 13 strikeouts over 12 2/3 innings and is tied for the team lead with two pickoffs. Rebar has two relief appearances and two starts.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has three saves, which is tied for fourth in the Pac-12. He is tied for the team lead with six games (nine innings) and has a 1.00 ERA and six strikeouts.
- Drachler pitched 1 2/3 innings in game one against New Mexico State, earning the save.
- Drachler has 12 career saves over 64 career appearances on the mound.
- Freshman Chase Bauerle has not allowed an earned run in five outings (9 2/3 innings, two unearned runs). He has struck out nine. Bauerle recently struck out three of six batters faced in game three against New Mexico State.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 2.19 ERA over five appearances (12 1/3 innings pitched) and has eight strikeouts.
- Thomas pitched five scoreless innings in game three against New Mexico State, allowing two hits and striking out three.
- Junior Trenton Stoltz is tied for the team lead with six appearances (4 1/3 innings pitched) and has a 4.15 ERA with three strikeouts (0-1 record).
- Sophomore Josh Tedeschi (7.36 ERA, 4 K, 3 2/3 IP) and senior Hunter Rodriguez (0.00 ERA, 2 1/3 IP, 3 K) have each made three appearances.




