Postseason History: This will be Utah's 29th postseason appearance (AIAW, WNIT and NCAA) in school history and the Utes are 27-32 all-time in postseason play. This is Utah's ninth time in the WNIT and the Utes hold an 11-12 all-time record in the tournament, including a 4-0 mark when hosting. Utah Head Coach Lynne Roberts has led her teams to the postseason in each of the last six seasons including back-to-back WNIT appearances in her two seasons at Utah.

Mixing it Up: Head coach Lynne Roberts has featured three new starting lineups this season for the Utes. Daneesha Provo, Kiana Moore and Megan Jacobs have been mixed into the starting five while Paige Crozon and Emily Potter are the only Utes to start all 30 games this season.

Potter in the Paint: Junior forward Emily Potter is ranked fifth in the Pac-12 in field-goal percentage as the 6-6 Winnipeg, Manitoba native is shooting 51.7 percent from the floor. Potter leads the Pac-12 in blocked shots with 86, good for 14th in the NCAA. Potter knocked down her 1,000th career point on a free-throw in the first quarter against Northern Arizona to emerge as one of just 26 Utes to reach the milestone.

Cruzin' Crozon: Senior wing Paige Crozon is averaging 10.1 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. The team's lone senior has tallied 995 career points with time to reach the 1,000 points club. Crozon scored a season-high 25 points including five 3-pointers against Washington State (02/05) and has two double-doubles this season.

Boasting Boclair: Junior wing Tanaeya Boclair missed one game with an ankle sprain but is averaging 9.8 points and 4.2 rebounds for Utah. She knocked down a career-high 19 points against Oregon (02/17).

Buckets by Bean: Sophomore Erika Bean dishes out 5.5 assists per game, good for third in the Pac-12. Despite being the shortest starter, the 5-8 guard also has 19 blocks on the season while pulling down 4.5 rebounds per game. Bean earned her first double-double of her career with 10 points and 10 assists at No. 10 UCLA.

Magnificent Malia: Junior wing Malia Nawahine is the Utes second leading scorer with 10.5 points per game. Nawahine grabbed a career-high five steals in a 30-point win over Nevada. She is also second on the team with 57 assists on the season.

Seeing Double: Junior forward Emily Potter has tallied nine double-doubles in 29 games while also averaging in double figures with 13.9 points per game. Senior wing Paige Crozon has tallied two double-doubles on the season (Fresno State, Stanford). Sophomore guard Erika Bean earned her first double-double of her career with 10 points and 10 assists at No. 10 UCLA.

Record Watch: Junior forward Emily Potter is moving up the career blocks list in Utah's record book with 212 blocks as her 3-block performance against Nevada moved her into second. The 6-6 forward has swatted 86 shots this season including a season-high six blocks against USC and Stanford. Potter has made her way into the 1,000 points club in a 22-point performance against Northern Arizona. Senior wing Paige Crozon is on the hunt for her 1,000th career point as she's tallied 995 points.

After an impressive debut campaign in 2015-16, Utah women's basketball head coach Lynne Roberts has established the groundwork for rebuilding the Utes into a Pac-12 Conference contender and a regular postseason participant as she enters her second season at the helm.

In her first season, Roberts led the Utes to an 18-15 mark for the program's first winning season since 2012-13 and a seventh-place Pac-12 finish despite being picked 11th. Utah also earned its first postseason berth in three years, advancing to the third-round round of the WNIT.

Roberts' up-tempo style of play resulted in the Utes ranking fifth in the Pac-12 in scoring (68.7 ppg) with a 13.8 points-per-game improvement from previous year. The Utes were third in the Pac-12 in rebounding (42.4 rpg), which is the fifth-best mark in Utah history. Utah also had 140 blocked shots to rank third all-time at the U.

Three individuals took home All-Pac-12 accolades in 2015-16. Emily Potter was named to the Pac-12 All-Conference Team and earned All-Defensive Team honorable mention, while both Paige Crozon and Danielle Rodriguez took honorable mention all-conference accolades. Seven Utes earned their way on to the Pac-12 All-Academic Team.

Roberts came to Utah after nine seasons as the head coach at the University of the Pacific in Stockton, Calif., where she was a two-time conference coach of the year (2012-13 Big West

and 2014-15 West Coast Co-Coach of the Year).

She led the Tigers to postseason appearances in each of her last four seasons at U of P, a program-best streak, after taking over a team that qualified for the postseason just once in school history before her arrival. Roberts' 237-189 (.556) career record includes an 86-31 mark in four seasons at NCAA Division II Chico State from 2002-06.

She inherited a Pacific team that had won just 11 games combined the previous two seasons. Faced with a major rebuilding project, she went 51-99 her first five years before flipping the columns with an 84-45 record over the last four campaigns. The Tigers were 21-10 her final season in 2014-15 as a member of the West Coast Conference and played in the WNIT. In 2012-13, her team achieved the best record in school history by finishing 27-8 and winning the program's first Big West regular-season title. That team advanced to the third round of the WNIT. Roberts guided Pacific to the WNIT for the first time in 2011-12, when the Tigers won the program's first-ever postseason game, taking down Arizona State, 77-62.

Under Roberts' tutelage, Pacific student-athletes earned 25 All-Big West team honors, five All-Big West Freshman Team honors and the 2010 Sixth Woman of the Year award. The Tigers earned six All-WCC selections, a WCC All-Freshman pick, and the 2014 WCC Newcomer of the Year with Roberts at the helm.

Prior to Pacific, Roberts spent four seasons as the head at Chico State where she compiled an 86-31 overall record. During her final season in 2005-06, the Wildcats were 28-4 and advanced to the NCAA Division II Final Four. She was named the WBCA West Region Coach of the Year in 2004-05 and was the California Collegiate Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2004-05 and 2005-06.

Roberts began her coaching career as an assistant at her alma mater, Seattle Pacific University, from 1997-2001.

During her playing career at SPU, Roberts was named to the NCAA West Regional all-tournament team as a senior co-captain. She was second team all-conference her junior year.

The Redding, Calif., native graduated from Seattle Pacific University in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in history and added a master's degree from SPU in athletic administration 2000.

Jon M. & Karen Huntsman Basketball Facility



The new Jon M. and Karen Huntsman Basketball Facility opened this fall northeast of the Huntsman Center arena. The \$36-million project also includes a state-of-the-art Sorenson Legacy Foundation High Performance Center, which is located northwest of the arena, and encompasses 80,000-square feet of space.

JON M. AND KAREN HUNTSMAN BASKETBALL FACILITY

The three-story Huntsman Basketball Facility will include dedicated practice gymnasiums for the both men's and women's basketball teams. The gyms will include viewing balconies and on-site sports medicine facilities equipped with treatment and taping tables, stem machines, sports drink and supplement dispensers, and ice machines.

The men's and women's teams will move into new locker rooms—which will include plunge pools—film rooms, and player lounges. There will also be an expansive Hall of Fame area in the building's atrium and a shared dining room. A new and expanded equipment facility will also be part of the project.

The coaching and support staffs for both programs will have their own floor of spacious offices, meeting rooms and recruiting lounges. A large observation deck will be placed on top of the building for team and alumni functions, providing sweeping views of the Wasatch Mountain range, the University of Utah campus, and downtown Salt Lake City.

"This is a major basketball facility that will give us everything we need to be successful," said Utah athletics director Chris Hill. "It's fantastic."

SORENSEN LEGACY FOUNDATION HIGH PERFORMANCE CENTER

The state-of-the-art Sorenson Legacy Foundation High Performance Center, a two-story, 20,000-square-foot structure located northwest Jon M. Huntsman Center, opened in the summer of 2015.

The facility provides everything a student-athlete needs to achieve their peak level of performance—ranging from nutrition, strength and conditioning, sports medicine and rehabilitation, and sports psychology—all within close proximity to maximize time efficiency.

The ground floor features a 9,500-square-foot sports medicine facility and a 500-square-foot fueling station, while an expansive 10,000-square-foot strength and conditioning center resides on the top floor. Two exterior entrances are located off the southeast corner of the building, while a refurbished tunnel system connects the performance center to the existing HPER complex, the Jon M. Huntsman Center and the new Jon M. and Karen Huntsman Basketball Facility.

The new sports medicine area features 18 treatment tables—including one traction table—six taping stations, a hydrotherapy area, a functional rehabilitation space, cardio area, and three exam rooms.

Optojump, force plate, and a Delos postural proprioception system are included in the rehab area. The cardio area is highlighted by two Alter-G treadmills, which use air pressure to alleviate body weight so that athletes can start conditioning earlier after injury.

The expansive hydrotherapy area includes a plunge pool in the shape of a block U, half containing cold water and half hot water with a capacity of 20 people per side. It also houses a Hydroworks 2000 underwater treadmill equipped with cameras and television monitors, allowing athletes to watch their subsurface work.

The second-floor strength and conditioning center offers 12 working stations, providing athletes with more efficient workouts and better rest intervals. It also includes an artificial turf running surface, measuring five yards wide by 35 yards in length, where sprint and plyometric drills take place to spare athletes the wear and tear on their bodies from working on hard surfaces.

Air pressurized Kaiser Functional Trainers, which allow athletes to train with greater variance and address weaknesses, have been installed. Video evaluation systems are placed at each station.

The strength and conditioning center also includes cardio equipment, medicine balls and elastic bands to perform numerous functional exercises.

The fueling station, located adjacent to the lobby area on the ground floor, offers a variety of snacks to help athletes intake the necessary levels of carbs and proteins within the critical 30-minute window after a workout to help their bodies recover.
