### Utah Baseball Returns Home for Midweek vs. Utah Valley

The Utah baseball team returns home for a midweek game against Utah Valley on Wednesday, March 22, before hitting the road for a three-game series at 12th-ranked Stanford.

First pitch between Utah and Utah Valley is at 6:00 p.m. MT. Utah continues its season-long baseball card promotion, with Davis Delorefice featured on Wednesday. The game will be aired on ESPN 700 AM with a video stream at UtahUtes.com.

Utah's series at Stanford begins on Friday, March 24 at 6:00 p.m. PT and continues on Saturday, March 25, at 4:00 p.m. PT with game three of the series on Sunday, March 26, at 2:00 p.m. PT. All three games will be aired on the Pac-12 Networks with Roxy Bernstein and J.T. Snow calling the action.

Utah is fourth in the Pac-12 in batting average (.283). The Utes are third in the conference in doubles (34), tied for fourth in runs scored (101) and RBI (90) and fourth in on-base percentage (.377).

Utah is fifth in the league in ERA (3.20) but is ranked in the top 35 nationally in the category. The Utes are tied for first in the league with six pickoffs, and five home runs allowed is tied for the second-fewest in the conference.

Dallas Carroll leads the league in hits per game (1.71). He is third in the conference in batting average (.420) and fourth in slugging percentage (.638). On the mound, Jayson Rose is 10th in the league in strikeouts (26).

Utah Valley is 4-15 on the year. The Wolverines recently dropped three out of four to Creighton.

Stanford is coming off of a bye weekend due to finals. The Cardinal is ranked 12th in the latest D1Baseball.com poll.

### Infield

• At third base, senior Dallas Carroll ranks third in the Pac-12 in batting average (.420) and leads the league in hits per game (1.71). He is the third-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 17.3 at-bats. Carroll is fourth in the league in slugging percentage (.638) and total bases (44), tied for fifth in hits (29), tied for sixth in RBI (18), tied for seventh in doubles (7) and ninth in on-base percentage (.468). Carroll is tied for the team lead with two home runs, is second on the team in runs scored (13) and is 3-for-4 in stolen bases (tied for the team lead). He has a team-high 10 multiple-hit games and is tied for the team lead with five multiple-RBI games.

• Carroll hit .294 for the week (5-for-17) with three RBI to lead the Utes. He went 2-for-4 in game one against Washington and was 2-for-5 with a home run and a double in game three of the series.

• Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (154 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

• Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .292 with 10 RBI, 11 walks (second on the team), a stolen base (1-for-1) and a home run. He has scored 11 runs and has a .397 on-base percentage.

• Simmons went 3-for-5 last Wednesday against Nevada.

• Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.

• Simmons has 132 starts (149 games) over four seasons.

• Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .254 with nine RBI and two doubles. He has scored 11 runs and is 1-for-3 in stolen bases. Dunn has committed just one error this year.

• Dunn has had a hit in seven of his last eight games. He went 1-for-2 with two walks in game three against Washington.

• Senior Ellis Kelly and junior Kyle Hoffman have shared starts at shortstop. Hoffman has nine starts with Kelly eight.

• Kelly is hitting .200 on the season with a double and two RBI. He has not made an error in the field.

• Kelly was 2-for-3 against Nevada last Wednesday.

• Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 27 games at short over the last two seasons.

• Hoffman is hitting .258 with three doubles and two RBI. He has a .395 on-base percentage.

• Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 37 games with 18 career starts.

• Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 11 games at designated hitter with appearances in 16-of-17 games. He is hitting .256 with a double, home run and two RBI.

• Gulden has played in 79 games in his career with 42 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.

• Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 13 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally leads Utah with a .500 on-base percentage, is hitting .273, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks. He

• Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in six games with a start at DH.

**Outfield**

- Utah has started the same outfield in 16 of 17 games with sophomore Chandler Anderson in left, sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right.
- Keirse is hitting .288 on the year and has four doubles, a triple and two home runs (tied for the team lead) with 10 RBI. He leads Utah with 14 runs scored. Keirse is tied for second on the team with seven multiple-hit games and is 3-for-6 in stolen bases.
- Keirse has had a hit in seven of his last eight games, including all three games against Washington. He hit a home run in game one of the series on the first pitch of the game and went 2-for-5 in game three.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .246. His seven doubles is tied for seventh in the Pac-12 and he is tied for sixth in the league in walks (14). Rose is tied for the team lead with two home runs and is second on the team with 13 RBI and a .459 slugging percentage. He is 2-for-2 in stolen bases. His five multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead and he has reached base in all but one game. Rose is 3-for-4 with the bases loaded this year.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 165 career games with 136 career starts.
- Anderson is second on the team with a .338 batting average. He is second on the team with 22 hits and third with 12 runs scored and five doubles. Anderson has 10 RBI, a .413 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases. He is tied for second on the team with seven multiple-hit games.
- Freshman Dominic Foscalina made his first career outfield start in game three against New Mexico State. He has played in seven games total and is hitting .200 (1-for-5) with an RBI.

**Catcher**

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 15 games with 13 starts at catcher. He is hitting .268 on the year with seven RBI, is tied for the team lead with two home runs and has two doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is second in the conference. He also leads the team in HBP (five, tied for fourth in the Pac-12).
- Moeller went 2-for-4 in game two against Washington.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in six games with four starts at catcher. He is hitting .214 with four RBI and a double.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in nine games with two starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .167 with two RBI and two walks.
- Schuman went 1-for-1 with a double as a pinch hitter in game three against Washington.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 62 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 140 total games.

**Pitchers**

- Junior Jayson Rose has started five games and is 2-1 on the season. He leads Utah and is 10th in the Pac-12 with 26 strikeouts. Rose has a 4.55 ERA (27 2/3 innings pitched).
- Rose had a season-high seven strikeouts against Washington over six innings in the game-one loss.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA and is second on the team with 24 strikeouts. He is tied for seventh in the Pac-12 with 21 1/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits over six innings with five strikeouts in game two against Washington in a no-decision.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 1-3 on the year with a 3.74 ERA over five starts. He has 21 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 21 2/3 innings.
- Lapiana struck out six over 6 2/3 innings against Washington, allowing three runs (all unearned) on five hits with one walk in the loss.
- Lapiana is in his second year with the program as Utah's Sunday starter.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar emerged quickly as Utah's fourth starter. He has a 4.50 ERA, 2-2 record and 16 strikeouts over 16 innings and is second on the team with two pickoffs. He has surrendered just 10 hits and is holding hitters to a .189 batting average. Rebar has two starts and four relief appearances.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has three saves, which is tied for fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in seven games (9 2/3 innings) and has a 1.86 ERA and seven strikeouts. Drachler is 0-1 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 12 career saves over 65 career appearances on the mound.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 1.65 ERA over seven appearances (16 1/3 innings pitched) and has 10 strikeouts.
- Thomas has not allowed a run over his last three outings (nine innings). He threw 2 2/3 scoreless innings in game three against Washington and also pitched in game one of the series.
- Freshman Chase Bauerle has allowed one earned run in six outings (10 1/3 innings, four unearned runs) and has a 0.87 ERA. He has struck out 10. Bauerle recently struck out three of six batters faced in game three against New Mexico State, and also pitched 2/3 of an inning against Nevada.
- Junior Trenton Stoltz leads Utah with eight appearances (six innings pitched) and has a 4.50 ERA with five strikeouts (0-1 record).
- Sophomore Josh Tedeschi (6.23 ERA, 4 K, 4 1/3 IP) and senior Hunter Rodriguez (0.00 ERA, 3 IP, 4 K) have each pitched in three games.




