Utah Baseball Travels to No. 12 Stanford

The Utah baseball team continues in Pac-12 play this weekend, hitting the road for a three-game series at 12th-ranked Stanford.

The series begins on Friday, March 24 at 6:00 p.m. PT and continues on Saturday, March 25, at 4:00 p.m. PT with game three of the series on Sunday, March 26, at 2:00 p.m. PT. All three games will be aired on the Pac-12 Networks with Roxy Bernstein and J.T. Snow calling the action.

Utah is fourth in the Pac-12 in batting average (.282). The Utes are third in the conference in doubles (36), runs scored (108) and RBI (96).

Utah is fifth in the league in ERA (3.53). The Utes are tied for fourth in fewest runs allowed (61). The Utes lead the league with seven pickoffs and five home runs is tied for second-fewest in the conference.

Dallas Carroll leads the league in hits per game (1.71). He is third in the conference in batting average (.411) and is the third-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 18.3 at-bats. On the mound, Jayson Rose is 10th in the league in strikeouts (26).

Stanford is coming off of a bye weekend due to finals. The Cardinal is ranked 12th in the latest D1Baseball.com poll.

Infield

• At third base, senior Dallas Carroll ranks third in the Pac-12 in batting average (.411) and leads the league in hits per game (1.67). He is the third-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 18.3 at-bats. Carroll is fourth in the league in total bases (45), tied for fourth in hits (30), tied for fifth in RBI (19), sixth in slugging percentage (.616), tied for seventh in doubles (7) and eighth in on-base percentage (.464). Carroll is tied for the team lead with two home runs, is second on the team in runs scored (15) and is 3-for-4 in stolen bases (tied for the team lead). He has a team-high 10 multiple-hit games and is tied for the team lead with five multiple-RBI games.

• Carroll hit .294 last week (5-for-17) with three RBI to lead the Utes. He went 2-for-4 in game one against Washington and was 2-for-5 with a home run and a double in game three of the series.

- Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (155 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.
- Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .290 with 11 RBI, 11 walks (second on the team), a stolen base (1-for-1) and a home run. He has scored 11 runs and has a .390 on-base percentage.
- Simmons went 3-for-5 last Wednesday against Nevada.
- Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.
- Simmons has 133 starts (150 games) over four seasons.
- Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .253 with nine RBI and two doubles. He has scored 12 runs and is 1-for-4 in stolen bases. Dunn has committed just one error this year.
- Dunn has had a hit in eight of his last nine games. He went 1-for-2 with two walks in game three against Washington.
- Senior Ellis Kelly and junior Kyle Hoffman have shared starts at shortstop. Hoffman has 10 starts with Kelly eight.
- Kelly is hitting .200 on the season with a double and two RBI. He has not made an error in the field.
- Kelly was 2-for-3 against Nevada last Wednesday.
- Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 27 games at short over the last two seasons.
- Hoffman is hitting .265 with three doubles, a triple and three RBI. He has a .390 on-base percentage.
- Hoffman tripled against Utah Valley on Tuesday.
- Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 38 games with 19 career starts.
- Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 11 games at designated hitter with appearances in 16-of-17 games. He is hitting .256 with a double, home run and two RBI.
- Gulden has played in 79 games in his career with 42 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.
- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 13 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally leads Utah with a .500 on-base percentage, is hitting .273, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks. He
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in six games with a start at DH.

Outfield

- Utah has started the same outfield in 17 of 18 games with sophomore Chandler Anderson in left, sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right.
- Keirse is hitting .299 on the year and has five doubles, a triple and two home runs (tied for the team lead) with 11 RBI. He leads Utah and is tied for eighth in the conference with 16 runs scored. He is second on the team with a .468 slugging percentage and tied for second with 23 hits. Keirse is second on the team with eight multiple-hit games and is 3-for-7 in stolen bases.
- Keirse has had a hit in eight of his last nine games, including all three games against Washington. He hit a home run in game one of the series on the first pitch of the game and went 2-for-5 in game three. Keirse followed with a 2-for-4 performance against Utah Valley.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .231. His seven doubles is tied for seventh in the Pac-12 and he is tied for sixth in the league in walks (14). Rose is tied for the team lead with two home runs and is second on the team with 13 RBI. He has a .431 slugging percentage. He is 2-for-2 in stolen bases. His five multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead and he has reached base in all but two games. Rose is 3-for-4 with the bases loaded this year.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 166 career games with 137 career starts.
- Anderson is second on the team with a .333 batting average. He is tied for second on the team with 23 hits and tied for third with 12 runs scored and five doubles. Anderson has 10 RBI, a .405 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases. He is third on the team with seven multiple-hit games.
- Freshman Dominic Foscalina made his first career outfield start in game three against New Mexico State. He has played in seven games total and is hitting .200 (1-for-5) with an RBI.

Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 16 games with 14 starts at catcher. He is second on the team with a .455 slugging percentage, is hitting .273 on the year with seven RBI, is tied for the team lead with two home runs and has two doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is tied for second in the conference. He also leads the team in HBP (six, tied for the Pac-12 lead).
- Moeller went 2-for-4 in game two against Washington.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in six games with four starts at catcher. He is hitting .214 with four RBI and a double.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in 10 games with three starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .188 with four RBI and two walks.

- Schuman went 1-for-1 with a double as a pinch hitter in game three against Washington. He had two RBI against Utah Valley, including a double.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 63 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 141 total games.

Pitchers

- Junior Jayson Rose has started five games and is 2-1 on the season. He leads Utah and is 10th in the Pac-12 with 26 strikeouts. Rose has a 4.55 ERA (27 2/3 innings pitched).
- Rose had a season-high seven strikeouts against Washington over six innings in the game-one loss.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA and is second on the team with 24 strikeouts. He is tied for seventh in the Pac-12 with 31 1/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits over six innings with five strikeouts in game two against Washington in a no-decision.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 1-3 on the year with a 3.74 ERA over five starts. He has 21 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 21 2/3 innings.
- Lapiana struck out six over 6 2/3 innings against Washington, allowing three runs (all unearned) on five hits with one walk in the loss.
- Lapiana is in his second year with the program as Utah's Sunday starter.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar is Utah's fourth starter. He has a 5.57 ERA, 2-3 record, 21 strikeouts over 21 innings and is tied for the team lead (and tied for second in the Pac-12) with three pickoffs. He has surrendered just 15 hits (tied for second in the Pac-12) and is holding hitters to a .208 batting average. Rebar has three starts and four relief appearances.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has three saves, which is tied for fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in eight games (10 2/3 innings) and has a 1.69 ERA and seven strikeouts. Drachler is 0-1 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 12 career saves over 66 career appearances on the mound.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA over eight appearances (16 2/3 innings pitched) and has 10 strikeouts.
- Freshman Chase Bauerle has allowed two earned runs in seven outings (11 1/3 innings, five total runs) and has a 1.59 ERA. He has struck out 10.
- Junior Trenton Stoltz leads Utah with nine appearances (6 2/3 innings pitched) and has a 4.05 ERA with six strikeouts (0-1 record).
- Sophomore Josh Tedeschi (7.00 ERA, 4 K, 4 5 IP) and senior Hunter Rodriguez (0.00 ERA, 3 1/3 IP, 4 K) have each pitched in five games.




