### Utah Baseball Begins Four-Game Home Stand vs. BYU

The Utah baseball team begins a four-game home stand on Tuesday, March 28, against BYU, with Pac-12 play continuing against Oregon Thursday, March 30.

Tuesday's game against BYU begins at 6:00 p.m. and will be aired on the Pac-12 Networks with radio at ESPN 700. Activities will be on the concourse for Youth Night and the first 500 fans in attendance will be given stick flags. Fans wearing red will receive half price tickets. Utah continues its season-long player card promotion with Dallas Carroll and Oliver Dunn player cards.

It is the first of three games Utah and BYU will play on the diamond this season, with the Utes again hosting the Cougars on Tuesday, April 18, with the final game of the series in Provo on Tuesday, May 9.

The three-game series is worth three total points towards the Deseret First Dual rivalry series, now in its 10th season. Utah has clinched the overall victory, 26-6, with wins in football, volleyball, women's basketball, gymnastics, men's and women's swimming and diving and men's and women's tennis, with just baseball remaining.

Utah (10-11) is third in the Pac-12 in batting average (.275). The Utes are fifth in the conference in doubles (38), on-base percentage (.364), slugging percentage (.382), hits (199) and home runs (11).

Utah is fifth in the league in ERA (3.44). The Utes are fourth in the league in fewest earned runs allowed (69) and fifth in fewest runs allowed (84). The Utes lead the league with seven pickoffs and five home runs is tied for the league lead.

Dallas Carroll leads the league in hits per game (1.62) and is one of just four players in the league hitting over .400 (.410). He is second in the Pac-12 in hits (34).

Tuesday starter Jacob Rebar is tied for the Pac-12 lead in fewest runs allowed (15) and is holding hitters to a .208 batting average, which is 10th in the league.

BYU is also 10-11 on the season. The Cougars recently dropped two out of three to Loyola Marymount, including being no-hit in their last game.

### Infield

- At third base, senior Dallas Carroll ranks second in the Pac-12 in batting average (.410) and leads the league in hits per game (1.62). He is the second-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 13.8 at-bats. Carroll is second in the league in hits (34), fourth in slugging percentage (.602), tied for fourth in RBI (21) and total bases (50), tied for fifth in doubles (eight) and sixth in on-base percentage (.469). Carroll leads Utah in stolen bases (4-for-5), is tied for second on the team with two home runs and is second on the team in runs scored (15). He has a team-high 11 multiple-hit games and is tied for the team lead with five multiple-RBI games.

- Carroll is on a five-game hitting streak. He hit .400 against Stanford (4-for-10). Carroll went 2-for-4 with an RBI in game two of the series and was 1-for-2 with two walks in game three.

- Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (158 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

- Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .259 with 11 RBI, 11 walks (second on the team), a stolen base (1-for-1) and a home run. He has scored 11 runs and has a .351 on-base percentage.

- Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.

- Simmons has 136 starts (153 games) over four seasons.

- Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .256 with 10 RBI and two doubles. He has scored 12 runs and is 1-for-4 in stolen bases.

- Dunn has had a hit in five of Utah's last six games. He went 2-for-4 in game one against Stanford and was 1-for-4 with an RBI in game two of the series.

- Junior Kyle Hoffman has started the last four games at shortstop (13 starts this season) and has spent most of the season sharing starts with senior Ellis Kelly (eight starts).

- Kelly is hitting .200 on the season with a double and two RBI. He has not made an error in the field.

- Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 27 games at short over the last two seasons.

- Hoffman is hitting .233 with three doubles, a triple, four RBI and 11 runs scored. He has a .353 on-base percentage.

- Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 41 games with 22 career starts.

- Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 11 games at designated hitter with appearances in 18 games. He is hitting .238 with a double, home run and two RBI and has a .347 on-base percentage.
- Gulden has played in 81 games in his career with 42 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.
- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 13 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally leads Utah with a .500 on-base percentage, is hitting .273, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks.
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in six games with a start at DH.

## Outfield

- Utah has started the same outfield in 20 of 21 games with sophomore Chandler Anderson in left, sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right.
- Keirse is hitting .300 on the year and has five doubles, a triple and two home runs (second on the team) with 12 RBI. He leads Utah and is tied for ninth in the conference with 18 runs scored. He is second on the team with 27 hits and three stolen bases (3-for-8). Keirse is second on the team with nine multiple-hit games. He has a .444 slugging percentage.
- Keirse has had a hit in six of his last seven games. He went 3-for-5 in game one against Stanford with an RBI and had a hit and scored a run in game two of the series.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .250. His eight doubles is tied for fifth in the Pac-12 and he is tied for sixth in the league in walks (15). Rose is second on the team with 13 RBI and tied for second with two home runs and 13 runs scored. He has a .434 slugging percentage. He is 2-for-2 in stolen bases. His five multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead. Rose is 3-for-4 with the bases loaded this year.
- Rose went 2-for-3 and scored two runs in game one against Stanford and was 2-for-4 with a double in game two of the series.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 169 career games with 140 career starts.
- Anderson is second on the team with a .312 batting average. He is third on the team with 24 hits and tied for second with 13 runs scored. He has five doubles. Anderson has 12 RBI, a .379 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases. He is third on the team with seven multiple-hit games.
- Freshman Dominic Foscalina started all three games against Stanford at designated hitter. He had a hit in games two and three of the series. He has played in 10 games total and is hitting .231 (3-for-13) with an RBI.

## Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 19 games with 17 starts at catcher. He leads Utah with three home runs, is second on the team with a .473 slugging percentage, is hitting .273 on the year with eight RBI and has two doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is tied for second in the conference. He also leads the team in HBP (seven, tied for second in the Pac-12).
- Moeller has had a hit in four of his last five games. He went 2-for-4 with a home run in game three against Stanford.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in six games with four starts at catcher. He is hitting .214 with four RBI and a double.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in 12 games with four starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .158 with four RBI and two walks.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 63 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 143 total games.

## Pitchers

- Freshman Jacob Rebar is Utah's fourth starter. He has a 5.57 ERA, 2-3 record, 21 strikeouts over 21 innings and is tied for the team lead (and tied for second in the Pac-12) with three pickoffs. He has surrendered just 15 hits (tied for the Pac-12 lead) and is holding hitters to a .208 batting average (10th in the league). Rebar has three starts and five relief appearances.
- Junior Jayson Rose has started six games and is 3-1 on the season. He leads Utah and is seventh in the Pac-12 with 34 strikeouts. Rose has a 3.60 ERA and is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 with 35 innings pitched.
- Rose threw a shutout against then-12th-ranked Stanford, striking out eight over 7 1/3 innings.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA and is second on the team with 26 strikeouts. He is eighth in the Pac-12 with 37 2/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen earned his first loss of the season against then-12th-ranked Stanford, allowing three runs (two earned) over 6 1/3 innings.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 1-3 on the year with a 4.10 ERA over six starts. He has 22 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 26 1/3 innings.
- Lapiana allowed three runs on 10 hits over 4 2/3 innings with a strikeout in his last start against Stanford.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has four saves, which is fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in nine games (12 1/3 innings) and has a 1.46 ERA and nine strikeouts. Drachler is 0-1 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Stanford, Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 13 career saves over 67 career appearances on the mound.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA over 10 appearances (18 innings pitched) and has 11 strikeouts.




