Utah Baseball Hosts Oregon for Pac-12 Home Opener

The Utah baseball team hosts its first Pac-12 games of the season against Oregon with the three-game series beginning on Thursday, March 30. All three games will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks.

Thursday's game begins at 7:00 p.m. MT with Friday's game at 5:00 p.m. MT. Game three on Saturday, April 1, is at 12:00 p.m. MT.

The team will be celebrating its 2016 Pac-12 Championship on Thursday with a raising of a championship flag. The first 500 fans in attendance will receive a Pac-12 Champs pennant flag.

Utah continues its season-long baseball card promotion with Dylan Drachler and Jayson Rose on Saturday and Kyle Hoffman on Sunday.

Utah (10-12) is third in the Pac-12 in batting average (.282). The Utes are second in the league in hits (215), third in total bases (295) and tied for fourth in doubles (39). Utah is fifth in on-base percentage (.369), RBI (110), slugging percentage (.387) and runs scored (123).

Utah is fifth in the league in ERA (3.66). The Utes are fifth in the league in fewest runs allowed (95). The Utes lead the league with eight pickoffs and five home runs is tied for the fewest in the league.

Dallas Carroll ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in batting average (.395). He is third in the league in hits (34) and hits per game (1.55). He is the second-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 14.3 at-bats.

Jayson Rose is seventh in the league in strikeouts (34).

Oregon is ranked 10th in the NCAA and second in the Pac-12 in ERA (2.66). The Ducks are 16-6 on the season and have won three of their last four, including taking two of three from Washington and a midweek win over Portland.

Infield

- At third base, senior Dallas Carroll ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in batting average (.395) and ranks third in hits (34) and hits per game (1.55). He is the second-toughest player in the league to strike out, averaging one strikeout per every 14.3 at-bats. Carroll is tied for fifth in the league in RBI (21) and doubles (50), seventh in total bases (50), eighth in on-base percentage (.465) and ninth in slugging percentage (.581). Carroll leads Utah in stolen bases (4-for-5), is tied for second on the team with two

home runs and is second on the team in runs scored (17). He has a team-high 11 multiple-hit games and is tied for the team lead with five multiple-RBI games.

- Carroll hit .400 against Stanford (4-for-10). He went 2-for-4 with an RBI in game two of the series and was 1-for-2 with two walks in game three. He scored two runs against BYU.

- Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (159 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

- Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .282 with 11 RBI, 12 walks (second on the team), a stolen base (1-for-1), a double and a home run. He has scored 13 runs and has a .374 on-base percentage.

- Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.
- Simmons has 137 starts (154 games) over four seasons.

- Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .264 with 11 RBI, two doubles and a triple. He has scored 12 runs and is 1-for-4 in stolen bases.

- Dunn has had a hit in six of Utah's last seven games. He went 2-for-4 in game one against Stanford and was 1-for-4 with an RBI in game two of the series. Dunn was 2-for-5 with an RBI against BYU, which included a triple.

- Junior Kyle Hoffman has started 13 games at shortstop, sharing starts with senior Ellis Kelly (nine starts).

- Kelly is hitting .267 on the season with a double and two RBI. He has not made an error in the field.

- Kelly went 3-for-5 on Tuesday against BYU in his last start.

- Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 28 games at short over the last two seasons.

- Hoffman is hitting .233 with three doubles, a triple, four RBI and 11 runs scored. He has a .353 on-base percentage.

- Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 41 games with 22 career starts.

- Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 11 games at designated hitter with appearances in 19 games. He is hitting .256 with a double, home run and four RBI and has a .360 on-base percentage.

- Gulden went 1-for-1 in a pinch-hit appearance against BYU, driving in two runs to bring Utah within a run.

2017 Utah Baseball

- Gulden has played in 82 games in his career with 42 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.
- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 13 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally has a .500 on-base percentage, is hitting .273, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks.
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in six games with a start at DH.

Outfield

- Utah has started the same outfield in 20 of 22 games with sophomore Chandler Anderson in left, sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right.
- Keirse is hitting .313 on the year (second on the team) and is ninth in the Pac-12 in hits (30). He has five doubles, a triple and two home runs (tied for second on the team) with 12 RBI. He leads Utah and is tied for ninth in the conference with 18 runs scored. He is second on the team with three stolen bases (3-for-8). Keirse is second on the team with 10 multiple-hit games. He has a .448 slugging percentage.
- Keirse has had a hit in seven of his last eight games. He went 3-for-5 in game one against Stanford with an RBI and had a hit and scored a run in game two of the series. Keirse was 3-for-6 on Tuesday against BYU.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .238. His eight doubles is tied for fifth in the Pac-12 and he is tied for sixth in the league in walks (16). Rose is second on the team with 13 RBI and tied for second with two home runs. He has a .413 slugging percentage, has scored 13 runs and is 2-for-2 in stolen bases. His five multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead.
- Rose went 2-for-3 and scored two runs in game one against Stanford and was 2-for-4 with a double in game two of the series.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 170 career games with 141 career starts.
- Anderson is third on the team with a .312 batting average. He is tied for third on the team with 24 hits. Anderson has scored 13 runs, has five doubles, 12 RBI, a .379 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases. He is tied for third on the team with seven multiple-hit games.
- Freshman Dominic Foscina has started the last four games, all three against Stanford at DH and starting in the outfield against BYU. He is on a three-game hitting streak. Foscina has played in 11 games total and is hitting .235 with two RBI.

Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 20 games with 17 starts at catcher (plus one at DH). He leads Utah with three home runs, is second on the team with a .475 slugging percentage, is hitting .288 on the year with 10 RBI and has two doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is tied for sec-

ond in the conference. He also leads the team in HBP (seven, tied for second in the Pac-12).

- Moeller has had a hit in five of his last six games. He went 2-for-4 with a home run in game three against Stanford. He went 2-for-4 with two RBI and a walk against BYU.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in seven games with five starts at catcher. He is hitting .188 with four RBI and a double.
- Junior Matt Poulin went 1-for-2 against BYU in his second career appearance, entering in relief at catcher.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in 12 games with four starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .158 with four RBI and two walks.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 63 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 143 total games.

Pitchers

- Junior Jayson Rose has started six games and is 3-1 on the season. He leads Utah and is seventh in the Pac-12 with 34 strikeouts. Rose has a 3.60 ERA and is tied for 10th in the Pac-12 with 35 innings pitched.
- Rose threw a shutout against then-12th-ranked Stanford, striking out eight over 7 1/3 innings.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA and is second on the team with 26 strikeouts. He is eighth in the Pac-12 with 37 2/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen earned his first loss of the season against then-12th-ranked Stanford, allowing three runs (two earned) over 6 1/3 innings.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 1-3 on the year with a 4.10 ERA over six starts. He has 22 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 26 1/3 innings.
- Lapiana allowed three runs on 10 hits over 4 2/3 innings with a strikeout in his last start against Stanford.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar is Utah's fourth starter. He has a 7.17 ERA, 2-4 record, 21 strikeouts over 21 1/3 innings and is tied for the team lead (and tied for second in the Pac-12) with three pickoffs. Rebar has four starts and five relief appearances.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has four saves, which is fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in 10 games (12 2/3 innings) and has a 3.55 ERA and nine strikeouts. Drachler is 0-1 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Stanford, Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 13 career saves over 68 career appearances on the mound.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA over 11 appearances (20 innings pitched) and has 12 strikeouts. Thomas had a strong outing against BYU, allowing one hit with a strikeout over two innings.
- Freshman Chase Bauerle has allowed two earned runs in nine outings (16 innings, nine total runs) and has a 1.12 ERA. He has struck out 14.




