Utah Baseball Hosts California

The Utah baseball team returns home this week for a three-game series against California beginning on Thursday, April 13 and continuing through Saturday, April 15. All three games will be held at 11:30 a.m. MT.

A video and audio stream will be provided for all three games.

Schedule magnets will be given away during all three games. Utah continues its season-long player card promotion featuring Alex Isola on Thursday, Spencer Kevin Johnson on Friday and Ellis Kelly on Saturday. Interlocking U car decals will also be given out on Saturday.

Utah (12-16, 3-9) has been through the gauntlet in Pac-12 play, with all four of Utah's league series (Washington, Stanford, Oregon and Oregon State) coming against ranked opponents. The Utes are coming off a series against No. 1 Oregon State, dropping two of the three games in the final inning.

Utah (12-16, 3-9 Pac-12) is fourth in the Pac-12 in batting average (.276). The Utes are also fourth in the league in hits (272). Utah is fifth in the Pac-12 in runs scored (157) and is tied for fifth with 139 RBI.

The Utes are fifth in the league with a 3.84 ERA, with a 3.61 ERA in Pac-12 games. Utah is fifth in the conference in fewest runs allowed (127). The Utes have allowed the fewest home runs in the conference (eight) and lead the league in pickoffs (eight).

Dallas Carroll ranks in the top five in the league in multiple categories, including batting average (fifth/.381 BA), hits per game (fourth/1.54) and slugging percentage (fifth/.593). DaShawn Keirse Jr., is fifth in the league in hits per game (1.46). He is on a seven-game hitting streak.

Jayson Rose is seventh in the league in strikeouts (46) while Josh Lapiana is tied for ninth in strikeouts (36). Riley Ottesen is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 in innings pitched (52 2/3).

California is 15-14 overall and 7-5 in the Pac-12. The Bears have won six-straight Pac-12 games with sweeps against Washington State and Arizona State, but were also swept by UCLA and dropped two of three to Oregon.

Infield

- At third base, senior Dallas Carroll ranks in the top five in the league in multiple categories. He is fifth in batter average (.381), fourth in hits per game (1.54) and is the fourth-toughest player in the league to strike out (one strikeout per every 10.3 at bats). Carroll is fifth in the conference in slugging percentage (.593) and hits (43), tied for fifth in the league in doubles (11), total bases (67), RBI (26) and is sixth in the conference in on-base percentage (.455). He is tied for the team lead with three home runs and two triples and is third on the team with 14 walks. Carroll leads Utah in stolen bases (5-for-6). He is tied for the team lead with seven multiple RBI games and is second on the team with 14 multiple hit games.

- Carroll had three hits and two RBI in game two against Oregon State, including the go-ahead home run in the 16th inning of the game.

- Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (165 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

- Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .271 and is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 (second on the team) with 19 walks. He has 14 RBI, a .380 on-base percentage, a stolen base (1-for-1), two doubles and a home run. Simmons has scored 16 runs.

- Simmons walked seven times over the three game series against Oregon State, including five times in game two of the series.

- Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.

- Simmons has 143 starts (160 games) over four seasons.

- Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .233 with 12 RBI, two doubles and a triple. He has scored 18 runs and is 2-for-6 in stolen bases.

- Junior Kyle Hoffman (13 starts) and senior Ellis Kelly (15 starts) have shared time at shortstop.

- Kelly is hitting .283 on the season with two doubles, a triple and three RBI, scoring six runs. He has not made an error in the field.

- Kelly has had a hit in seven of his last nine games. He went 2-for-4 with a double in game one of the series against Oregon State.

- Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 34 games at short over the last two seasons.

2017 Utah Baseball

- Hoffman is hitting .233 with three doubles, a triple, four RBI and 11 runs scored. He has a .353 on-base percentage.
- Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 42 games with 22 career starts.
- Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 17 games at designated hitter with appearances in 25 games. He is hitting .250 with a double, two home runs and 10 RBI.
- Gulden has played in 88 games in his career with 48 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.
- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 15 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally has a .471 on-base percentage, is hitting .250, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks.
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in seven games with a start at DH.

Outfield

- Sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in left have started every game. Sophomore Chandler Anderson and freshman Dominic Foscalina have both started in left field.
- Keirse is hitting .333 on the year (second on the team) and is tied for fifth in the Pac-12 in hits per game (1.46). He is tied for sixth in the league in hits (41), eighth in total bases (60) and tied for ninth in the Pac-12 in runs scored (23). Keirse is tied for the team lead with three home runs and two triples, is second on the team with 19 RBI, a .488 slugging percentage, a .390 on-base percentage and three stolen bases (3-for-8). Keirse leads the team with 15 multiple-hit games.
- Keirse is on a seven-game hitting streak. He hit .333 against Oregon State (5-for-15) with three RBI. Keirse had two hits in each of the first two games of the series and had Utah's only hit and RBI of game three of the series.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .248. He is tied for sixth in the league in walks (20) and has a .369 on-base percentage. Rose is second on the team with eight walks while his 17 RBI ranks third. He has two home runs, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has a .386 slugging percentage. His seven multiple RBI games is tied for the team lead.
- Rose hit .300 (3-for-10) with two RBI against Oregon State. He drove in two runs in game one of the series and had two hits with two walks in game two.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 176 career games with 147 career starts.
- Anderson is third on the team with a .293 batting average. He has 12 RBI, 14 runs scored, five doubles, 24 hits, a .366 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases.
- Foscalina has started nine games (six in left field, three at DH) with 16 games total. He is hitting .286 with three RBI.
- Foscalina went 3-for-4 in game one against Oregon State.

Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 26 games with 23 starts at catcher (plus one at DH). He is hitting .250 on the year and is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Moeller has a .405 slugging percentage, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored and has four doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is tied for second in the conference, and has caught seven runners stealing (tied for second in the league). He also leads the team in HBP (seven, tied for fifth in the Pac-12). Moeller is tied for third on the team with eight multiple hit games.
- Moeller had a double in game one against Oregon State.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in eight games with five starts at catcher. He is hitting .188 with four RBI and a double.
- Junior Matt Poulin has played in two games and is 1-for-3 at the plate.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in 15 games with four starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .136 with four RBI, two doubles and two walks.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 63 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 146 total games.

Pitchers

- Junior Jayson Rose leads Utah and is seventh in the Pac-12 with 46 strikeouts. Rose is 3-2 on the year with a 4.72 ERA and has thrown 47 2/3 innings (eighth in the Pac-12).
- Rose allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits and tied his season high with eight strikeouts over seven innings vs. Oregon State in a no-decision.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 4-1 with a 3.25 ERA and 33 strikeouts. He is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 with 52 2/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen was strong over seven innings against Oregon State, allowing three runs on seven hits in a no decision.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 2-4 on the year with a 4.02 ERA. He is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 (second on the team) with 36 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 40 1/3 innings.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar is Utah's fourth starter. He has a 7.17 ERA, 2-4 record, 21 strikeouts over 21 1/3 innings and is tied for the team lead (and tied for second in the Pac-12) with three pickoffs. Rebar has four starts and five relief appearances.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has four saves, which is tied for fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in 12 games (15 1/3 innings) and has a 3.52 ERA and 12 strikeouts. Drachler is 0-2 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Stanford, Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 13 career saves over 70 career appearances on the mound.
- Junior Tanner Thomas is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA over 12 appearances and leads the relievers with 24 innings pitched. He has 17 strikeouts.




