ON DECK

Utah Softball hosts California for Alumni Weekend. The centerpiece of the weekend is Saturday's contest where NFCA Hall of Famer Mona Stevens will throw out the first pitch.

UTAH NOTES

- Utah stayed at No. 15 in the latest NFCA/USA Today and ESPN/USA Softball national rankings.
- Utah was No. 11 in the NFCA/USA Today poll on 3/21. It was the highest ranking in program history.
- Utah ranks 16th nationally with a team batting average of .330. It also places 21st in scoring (6.1 runs per game) and 24th in on-base percentage (.405)
- Hannah Flippen recently surpassed the 200-hit and 100-RBI plateaus for her career. Last weekend, she set a new Utah mark for runs scored during her career, previously held by Sandy Rhea (177, 1995-98).

- Flippen currently sits third in the Pac-12 in slugging percentage (.750) and runs batted in (33), fourth in on-base percentage (.505), fifth in doubles (9), sixth in batting average (.427) and ninth in runs scored (28).

- Anissa Urtez recently surpassed 200 hits for her career and currently owns the fifth-highest batting average among Pac-12 players (.433)

- She also ranks 10th in the league in runs driven in (29). With 39 doubles, she is two shy of moving into the top-five all-time at Utah

- With 33 runs batted in, Heather Bowen ranks third in the Pac-12. Combined with Flippen, Utah is the only school with two players ranking among the top four in runs batted in.

- Delilah Pacheco has done a fantastic job in the leadoff spot, ranking fifth in the Pac-12 in walks (18). She reached base six times in 10 trips to the plate last weekend.

- Utah currently ranks 14th in the nation with a combined team ERA of 1.57. All three pitchers rank among the top 11 in the Pac-12 in ERA

- Katie Donovan is fourth in the Pac-12 with 13 wins and picked up the 50th of her career vs. Stanford. She ranks seventh in strikeouts, recently surpassing 300 K's for her career, and has also notched two saves

- Defensively, Utah leads the league in double plays turned with 16. That ranks 18th nationally comes after placing second in the nation last season.

- The Utes are one of seven Pac-12 teams ranked among the top 25 nationally in the RPI

VIRAMONTES NAMED PAC-12 PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Utah's Miranda Viramontes was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week by the conference office on Mar. 21.

Viramontes won two of three games as Utah swept No. 10 UCLA on its home field, (2-0, 0.64 ERA). She limited the Bruins to one run on nine hits in 11 innings, striking out six and walking none.

She is 8-1 with a 1.29 ERA and recently notched the 200th strikeout of her career. She also ranks third nationally in walks per seven innings.

Viramontes threw a perfect game vs. CSU Bakersfield and has a propensity for winning big contests, turning in complete game victories this season over No. 13 Tennessee and No. 10 UCLA.

In last year's NCAA Tournament, she set the tone with 6 2/3 scoreless innings against Illinois, striking out six batters then had a career-high nine strikeouts in a complete game vs. No. 9 Kentucky. She also picked up her second save of the season when she closed the door on the ninth-ranked Wildcats.

A honorable mention All Pac-12 pick in 2015, she was named to the All-Freshman Team after being named Freshman of the Week once.

LAST WEEKEND

Utah swept Stanford for the second season in a row last weekend. The Utes averaged over eight runs a contest and batted .374 for the series.

Ally Dickman batted .600 for the weekend, pacing the Utes in slugging (.800) and on-base percentage (.714). Anissa Urtez (.545) and Bridget Castro (.500) also excelled at the plate.

In the circle, Katie Donovan notched two wins with 10 strikeouts in 12 innings pitched. Miranda Viramontes saw action in a pair of contests, earning a win, striking out seven and walking none

BARRERA NAMED PAC-12 FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Utah outfielder Alyssa Barrera was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on Feb. 28 for her performances on the field at the Mary Nutter Classic.

The Chino Hills, California native led the team with four runs scored, a .438 batting average and also slugged .563. She reached base safely in her first 13 games and opened her collegiate career with an 11-game hit streak.

She is now 12th in the Pac-12 with a .390 batting average.

She currently ranks third in the Pac-12 and leads the Utes with 33 runs scored and along with teammate Ally Dickman is one of the three toughest players in the conference to strikeout.

FLIPPEN PEGGED AS SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Hannah Flippen was named as a candidate for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate softball. Thirty of the top NCAA softball student-athletes who excel both on and off the field were selected earlier this season.

For her career, Flippen owns the highest batting average of any Ute ever at .386 (Cyndee Bennett, .371, 1994-97).

Last season, the National Fastpitch Coaches Association named Flippen an All-American. The Ute second baseman was also named the 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year and tabbed as an Academic All-America First Team selection by CoSIDA.

Prior to the start of this season, Flippen was named to the USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List and also earned a spot on the US National Team.

FLIPPEN NAMED NFCA ALL-AMERICAN

Flippen, an All-American in 2014 as a freshman, was selected to the third team in 2016 and is Utah's 12th player ever to be honored. She joins Charmelle Green (1990, 91) and Sandy Rhea (1997, 98) as the other two-time honorees.

While leading the Pac-12 with a .542 batting average, a 1.034 slugging percentage and a .667 on-base percentage, she also ranked second in a number of categories including

total bases (61), walks (21), runs scored (24), hits (32) and stolen bases (7). Flippen also finished third in the conference with eight homers.

Flippen, a three-time All Pac-12 performer also became Utah Softball's fifth Player of the Year and first since joining the Pac-12. Lyndsey Trevis was the last Ute honored when she was named Mountain West Conference Player of the Year in 2001.

URTEZ, DONOVAN SELECTED ALL PAC-12

Urtez, a two-time All Pac-12 honoree, was named a Pac-12 Player of the Week during the 2016 season. She paced the conference with 16 doubles and her 65 hits were fifth – most of any player.

In Pac-12 play, she had 22 runs batted in, good for sixth overall. A Pac-12 All-Defensive Team selection last year, she led the conference this season with 131 fielding assists.

Donovan was named First Team All Pac-12 for a second-straight season as she surpassed her career high for wins with 18, third-most of any Pac-12 pitcher.

Her 2.46 ERA and 159.1 innings pitched ranked fourth in the conference while she ranked seventh in strikeouts and opponents batting average.

This marked the first season in the Pac-12 that Utah placed three players on the first team. Four Utes were named to the All-Mountain West Conference First Team during their final season in 2011.

UTAH TRIO LANDS ALL-NFCA SPOTS

The Utah softball team landed three players on the 2016 NFCA All-Pacific Region teams, the National Fastpitch Coaches Association announced Thursday morning.

Hannah Flippen was named a first team selection while Katie Donovan earned third team honors.

Utah's 10 all-region selections over the last three years set a record for the program.

Flippen became the first Ute player to earn back-to-back-to-back all-region honors since Sandy Rhea (1996-98). Rhea was also the last Utah player to earn first team honors three consecutive years.

Donovan was named all-region for the second-straight season, giving the Utes 10 two-time All-NFCA honorees in their program history.

PAC-12 TABS DICKMAN FOR FRESHMAN SQUAD

A two-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week in 2016, Ally Dickman finished second in the

conference with seven doubles, trailing only her teammate Urtez. She also accumulated 14 runs batted in, third among Ute batters.

This marked the fifth-consecutive year that Utah placed a student-athlete on the Pac-12 All-Freshmen Team.

FRONDA NAMED PAC-12 PLAYER OF WEEK

Kay Kay Fronda was Utah's first Player of the Week in 2016.

She led the Utes in a number of categories during a weekend sweep of ASU, including hits (4), batting (.667), slugging (1.500), on-base percentage (.571) and total bases (9)

UTES EARN ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Two Utah Softball student-athletes, Katie Donovan and Hannah Flippen, were named to the 2016 CoSIDA Academic All-District 8 team.

Donovan and Flippen were part of the 11-player squad selected that includes student-athletes from institutions in California, Oregon, Washington, Utah, Arizona, Nevada and Hawaii.

Utah has had two student-athletes honored as Academic All-Americans, Kathleen Thornley in 1983 and Ali Andrus-Saga in 1997. Hannah Clements was the last All-District selection for the Utes in 2012.

FOUR UTES EARN PAC-12 ALL-ACADEMIC

Hannah Flippen (3.68; Human Development & Family Studies) was Utah's first student-athlete to be named to the First Team in successive seasons.

She was joined on the 2016 Pac-12 All-Academic First Team by Katie Donovan (3.71; Honors Biology).

Bridget Castro was Utah's fourth player selected as she also earned a honorable mention nod. She is one of five Utes to be named to a Pac-12 All-Academic squad for a second time.

Utah has had 23 All-Academic selections (15 individual student-athletes) since joining the Pac-12 in 2012.

UTES EARN NFCA SCHOLAR AWARDS

Utah Softball was the only team from the Pac-12 Conference recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches of America as a 2016 Easton All-Academic Team.

Meanwhile, the Utes had eight student-athletes recognized as Easton/NFCA Division 1 Scholar Athletes, second-most of any school in the Pac-12. Among those honored were Bridget Castro, Hannah Flippen, Kay Kay Fronda, Katie Donovan, Ally Dickman and Maddie Roth.

In 16 seasons with the University of Utah softball team either as a player, assistant coach or head coach, Amy Hogue continues to build the Utes into a competitor in the best softball league in the nation, the Pac-12 Conference.

In nine seasons as the Utes' head coach, the sixth coach in program history, Hogue has a 260-229-1 (.532) record at Utah and sports a 457-314-1 (.593) overall record in 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach, which includes six seasons at the NJCAA's Salt Lake Community College.

Hogue led the Utes to a 35-22 overall record in 2016 and finished fourth in the Pac-12 Conference with a record of 13-10, its most wins since joining in 2012. The Utes also finished as the 16th-ranked team in the nation in the final NFCA Poll. This marked the third time Utah had been ranked at season's end and the first time since 2000. Utah also matched its highest final ranking (No. 16 - 1997).

The Utes reached the postseason for a 20th time, making consecutive appearances for the first time in program history. Utah also made history by winning its first two NCAA games and taking two of three against host, No. 9 Kentucky en route to the Super Regionals

Utah finished second in the league with 33 doubles while batting .307 and finishing fourth in on-base percentage (.389), runs (121) and slugging (.486). The Utes placed third in the Pac-12 with a 2.83 earned run average. They only allowed 24 homers, fewest of any team in the league, and 166 runs, good for second fewest.

Hannah Flippen was not only named Pac-12 Player of the Year, but she was also honored as a National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-American and a CoSIDA Academic All-American. Flippen also earned spots on the All Pac-12 First Team, Pac-12 All-Defensive Team was named to the USA Softball Team

Flippen was Utah Softball's fifth Player of the Year and first since joining the Pac-12. She also joined Charmelle Green (1990, 91) and Sandy Rhea (1997, 98) as the other two-time honorees.. Flippen was Utah Softball's first player to be selected for First Team Academic All-American honors.

This marked the first season in the Pac-12 that Utah placed three players on the first team. Anissa Urtez, a two-time All Pac-12 honoree, was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week during the season. She paced the conference with 16 doubles and her 65 hits were fifth -most of any player. For her efforts, she was named to the Mexican National Team after the season.

Katie Donovan was named First Team All Pac-12 and NFCA All-Pacific Region for a second-straight season as she surpassed her career high for wins with 20, third-most of any Pac-12 pitcher. Her 2.46 ERA and 159.1 innings pitched ranked fourth in the conference while she ranked seventh in strikeouts and opponents batting average.

Shelby Pacheco was named to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team for a second year in a row. She continued to be one of the most feared backstops in the Pac-12, throwing out 15 base runners, more than any other team.

A two-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week, Ally Dickman finished second in the conference with seven doubles, trailing only her teammate Urtez. She also accumulated 14 runs batted in, third among Ute batters, and was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team

Utah's NFCA 10 all-region selections over the last three years set a record for the program with Kristen Stewart honored for the second-straight season.

Bridget Castro was one of four Pac-12 All-Academic selections. Utah has had 23 All-Academic selections (15 individual student-athletes) since joining the Pac-12 in 2012 under Hogue. Utah was also the only school from the Pac-12 to be recognized as an Easton All-Academic Team as eight student-athletes were honored as NFCA/Easton Scholar Athletes.

Hogue led the Utes to a 36-19 overall record in 2015 and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. Utah had a successful Pac-12 season, earning series victories over Stanford, Oregon State and No. 22 Arizona State on the road and No. 16 Cal and No. 15 Arizona at home. The Utes also split with No. 20 Washington giving them victories in six of their eight conference match-ups.

The 2015 Pac-12 Coach of the Year, became the first Utah coach to win postseason honors since Mona Stevens was given the award in 2000 when the softball program was still a member of the Mountain West Conference. She was given the Don Reddish Award for the 2014-15 season. This award from the university of Utah athletic department is presented annually to the coach of a sport other than football, men's and women's basketball and gymnastics, who is deemed to have had the most successful season the previous year.

Flippen was named a first team NFCA selection, Kate Dickman and Donovan earned second team honors, while Stewart was tabbed a third team selection. Utah's four all-region selections were the second most in program history. Utah has had nine All-NFCA selection since joining the Pac-12 in 2012.

In 2015, Utah had six all-conference selections, a new standard for the program, and also had two players named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman squad.

In 2014, Hannah Flippen was named a NFCA All-American, the 12th in school history and the first Ute to be recognized since Jackie Wong earned in 2006. In addition to Flippen's success, Mariah Ramirez and Anissa Urtez were also named NFCA All-Region while Kate Dickman, Bridget Castro and Sammy Cordova joined them in earning All Pac-12 honors. The Utes finished 31-24 and earned Pac-12 series victories over Oregon State, Cal and Stanford.

In 2013, the Utes earned series victories against No. 15 UCLA and No. 2 Arizona State. The Utes hit .309 in league home contests during their first season at Dumke Family Softball Stadium and out-slugged their Pac-12 opponents (.508 to .467). Second baseman Jackie Sweet was named to both the Pac-12 and NFCA Pacific Region Second Teams and became the first-ever Ute to earn Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Apr. 8, 2013.

Utah put up a 26-6 non-conference record in 2012, which included a 12-game win streak and a win at No. 24 New Mexico. Generra Nielson became the first Ute softball student-athlete to ever receive weekly recognition as she was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week on Mar. 19, 2012 after throwing a no-hitter in the first game of a doubleheader against Colgate.

Six Utes were named to Pac-12 All-Conference Teams in Utah's inaugural season in the Pac-12 in 2012, including Whitney Holm, Tia Palauni, Generra Nielson, Katelyn Elliott and Kelsi Hoopiaina on the Honorable Mention squad, while Dickman received Honorable Mention status on the All-Freshmen Team. Nielson posted one of the best single-season performances on the mound in school history, leading the Pac-12 and ranking 10th in the nation with a school single-season record 294 strikeouts. At the plate, Kara Foster became Utah's all-time career home run leader under Hogue's watch as she hit 64 career round-trippers.

Before taking over the helm at Utah, Hogue built and mentored Salt Lake Community College's softball team from 1999-2004, instantly creating a successful program. She went 197-82 (.706) in her time with the Bruins. The pinnacle of her tenure with the Bruins came in 2004. SLCC was the regional champion that season and placed sixth at the NJCAA Division I National Tournament. In 2000, the Bruins' inaugural campaign, they won the Scenic West Athletic Conference title and repeated as champions again in 2003.

At SLCC, Hogue coached 36 all-region players (22 first-teamers, 14 second-team nods), and coached nine All-America standouts. In addition to the players' success, Hogue was named the SWAC Coach of the Year for her efforts in 2003. With the Bruins, Hogue coached 36 all-region players (22 first-teamers, 14 second-team nods), and coached nine All-America standouts. Utah from 1996-99 where she was involved in all facets of running the program.

Hogue got her start in coaching as Utah's graduate assistant coach from 1994-95. From there she went to Alta High School as an assistant coach from 1994-96. Hogue also coached an accelerated travel team, called The Sting. She guided her club squad to a .725 winning percentage. In her last two seasons, The Sting racked up 137 wins.

Hogue's playing career at Utah was equally as impressive. From 1991-94, Hogue helped the Utes win two conference titles, two conference tournaments and two regional titles in making two Women's College World Series appearances. She captained the 1994 squad that tallied a school-record 51 wins.

She earned second-team All-America honors as a senior. In garnering All-America accolades, she hit .455, had 101 hits, 222 at bats and 55 runs scored. All of those numbers still stand as the school's top marks for a single season. Hogue also holds season records for triples (7) and runs scored (55). She led both the 1991 and 1994 squads to the College World Series.

In addition to the team's success, Hogue was Western Athletic Conference Player of the Year, first team all-region and second team All-America in 1994. She was a three-time All-WAC player and was the team MVP in 1994.

Hogue's name appears throughout the record book at Utah. In Utah's career record book, she still ranks third in at bats (703) and stolen bases (72), fourth in hits (239), and fifth in both hitting (.340) and runs (125). Her 101 hits in a season was one of the longest-standing marks in the NCAA, and she still holds the NCAA record for at bats in a game (14).


