### Utah Baseball Travels to No. 1 Oregon State

The Utah baseball team hits the road this weekend to face No. 1 ranked Oregon State for a three-game series beginning on Friday, April 7.

The series begins on Friday at 5:30 p.m. PT, and continues on Saturday, April 8, at 1:30 p.m. PT. Game three is Sunday, April 9, at 1:00 p.m. PT. All three games will be video streamed by OSU.

Utah (12-13, 3-6 Pac-12) is coming off its first Pac-12 series win of the season, taking two of three from Oregon.

Utah (12-13, 3-6 Pac-12) is third in the Pac-12 in batting average (.290). The Utes are third in the league in hits (251) and on-base percentage (.372), and fourth in runs scored (148), total bases (347), slugging percentage (.401) and RBI (131).

The Utes lead the league with eight pickoffs and six home runs allowed is tied for the fewest in the league.

Dallas Carroll leads the Pac-12 in batting average (.404) and is second in the league in hits per game (1.60). He is third in the Pac-12 in on-base percentage. DaShawn Keirse, Jr., ranks in the top 10 in the league in hits, runs scored and total bases.

Jayson Rose is seventh in the league in strikeouts (38).

Oregon State is ranked No. 1 in every major collegiate baseball poll. The Beavers are on a 20-game win streak (25-1, 9-0 Pac-12) and lead the NCAA with a 1.73 earned run average.

### Infield

- At third base, senior Dallas Carroll leads the Pac-12 in batting average (.404) and is second in the league in hits per game (1.60). He is third in the Pac-12 in on-base percentage (.470), fourth in hits (40) and slugging percentage (.606), tied for fourth in RBI (24) and doubles (10), fifth in total bases (60), is the sixth-toughest player in the league to strike out (one strikeout per every 9.9 at bats) and ranks 10th in runs scored (21). Carroll is tied for the team lead with two triples, has two home runs and is tied for second on the team with 12 walks. He leads Utah in stolen bases (4-for-5). He is tied for the team lead with 13 multiple-hit games and is also tied for the team lead with six multiple-RBI games. Carroll is hitting .438 (14-for-32) with runners in scoring position.

- Carroll hit .462 (6-of-13) against Oregon with two doubles, a triple and three RBI. He went 4-for-5 in game two of the series and was 2-for-4 in game three with two RBI.

- Carroll is in his fourth season starting at third base (162 starts) and also has a redshirt year under his belt. He was a 2016 All-Pac-12 player.

- Senior Hunter Simmons, who has started every game at first base, is hitting .286 with 14 RBI, 12 walks (tied for second on the team), a stolen base (1-for-1), two doubles and a home run. He has scored 15 runs and has a .363 on-base percentage.

- Simmons is on a four-game hitting streak. He drove in two runs in game two against Oregon and went 2-for-5 with an RBI in game three of the series.

- Simmons earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors on Feb. 27 after hitting .569 (9-for-16) with six RBI against Nebraska and Ohio State.

- Simmons has 140 starts (157 games) over four seasons.

- Freshman Oliver Dunn has started all but one game at second base. He is hitting .260 with 12 RBI, two doubles and a triple. He has scored 17 runs and is 2-for-6 in stolen bases.

- Dunn went 2-for-3 in game one of the series against Oregon and scored three runs in game two of the series with a stolen base and two walks.

- Junior Kyle Hoffman (13 starts) and senior Ellis Kelly (12 starts) have shared time at shortstop.

- Kelly is hitting .300 on the season with a double, triple and three RBI, scoring four runs. He has not made an error in the field.

- Kelly is on a four-game hitting streak. He went 2-for-4 with a triple, an RBI and scored two runs in game two against Oregon and had a hit and scored a run in game three of the series.

- Kelly, a JC transfer, has started 31 games at short over the last two seasons.

- Hoffman is hitting .233 with three doubles, a triple, four RBI and 11 runs scored. He has a .353 on-base percentage.

- Hoffman, in his third season at Utah, has played in 41 games with 22 career starts.

- Utility player junior Wade Gulden has started 14 games at designated hitter with appearances in 22 games. He is hitting .296 with a double, two home runs and nine RBI and has a .426 slugging percentage and .387 on-base percentage. Gulden is 2-for-2 with the bases loaded.

## 2017 Utah Baseball

- Gulden hit .455 (5-of-11) against Oregon with five RBI and a home run. His two-run home run against Oregon in game two lifted Utah to the lead in the seventh inning, and he drove in three runs in game three of the series, going 2-for-4. He is on a four-game hitting streak.
- Gulden has played in 85 games in his career with 45 starts between the infield, outfield and DH.
- Utility redshirt freshman Connor McNally has played in 14 games with two starts (one at DH, one at 2B). McNally has a .471 on-base percentage, is hitting .250, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has scored three runs with four walks.
- Redshirt freshman Jake Portaro has played in seven games with a start at DH.

### Outfield

- Sophomore DaShawn Keirse, Jr., in center and senior Josh Rose in right have started every game. Sophomore Chandler Anderson and freshman Dominic Foscalina have both started in left field.
- Keirse is hitting .333 on the year (second on the team) and is tied for eighth in the Pac-12 in hits (36). He is fifth in the league in hits per game (1.44). Keirse is eighth in the conference in total bases (54) and ninth in runs scored (22). He is tied for the team lead with three home runs and two triples and is second on the team with 16 RBI and a .500 slugging percentage. He is second on the team with three stolen bases (3-for-8). Keirse has a .387 on-base percentage. Keirse is tied for the team lead with 13 multiple-hit games.
- Keirse is on a four-game hitting streak. He hit .500 against Oregon (6-of-12) with four RBI and two walks. Keirse had multiple hits in every game against Oregon and hit a two-run home run in game three of the series.
- Keirse was All-Pac-12, a Freshman All-American and member of the Pac-12 All-Defensive team last season.
- Rose is hitting .242. His eight doubles is second on the team while his 15 RBI ranks third. He leads the Utes with 16 walks. Rose has two home runs, is 2-for-2 in stolen bases and has a .352 on-base percentage. His six multiple-RBI games is tied for the team lead.
- Rose went 2-for-4 in game two of the series against Oregon and drove in two runs in game three of the series.
- Rose was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 honoree last year. He has played in 173 career games with 144 career starts.
- Anderson is third on the team with a .304 batting average. He has 12 RBI, 14 runs scored, five doubles, 24 hits, a .378 on-base percentage and is 2-for-4 in stolen bases.
- Foscalina has started seven games (four in left field, three at DH) with 14 games total. He is hitting .292 over 14 games total with three RBI. Foscalina went 3-for-3 in game three against Oregon.

### Catcher

- Sophomore Zack Moeller has played in 23 games with 20 starts at catcher (plus one at DH). He is hitting .282 on the year and is tied for the team lead with three home runs.

Moeller has a .451 slugging percentage, a .386 on-base percentage, 11 RBI and has three doubles. Moeller has been involved in three pickoffs, which is tied for second in the conference, and has caught six runners stealing (tied for fifth in the league). He also leads the team in HBP (seven, tied for third in the Pac-12). Moeller is third on the team with eight multiple-hit games.

- Moeller has had a hit in seven of his last nine games. He went 2-for-4 and scored two runs with a double in game three of the series against Oregon.
- Moeller started part time last year at catcher.
- Freshman Alex Isola has played in seven games with five starts at catcher. He is hitting .188 with four RBI and a double.
- Junior Matt Poulin has played in two games and is 1-for-3 at the plate.
- Senior Max Schuman has played in 14 games with four starts at designated hitter. He has one relief appearance at catcher. Schuman is hitting .143 with four RBI, two doubles and two walks.
- Schuman has experience behind the plate but has started 63 games at designated hitter in his career and played in 145 total games.

### Pitchers

- Junior Jayson Rose has started seven games and is 3-2 on the season. He leads Utah and is seventh in the Pac-12 with 38 strikeouts. Rose has a 5.09 ERA and has thrown 40 2/3 innings pitched.
- Rose threw a shutout against then-12th-ranked Stanford, striking out eight over 7 1/3 innings.
- Rose, a preseason NCBWA All-American and 2016 All-Pac-12 pick, broke the Utah single-season record for strikeouts last year with 106.
- Sophomore Riley Ottesen is 4-1 (tied for sixth in the Pac-12 in wins) with a 3.15 ERA and is tied for second on the team with 31 strikeouts. He is fifth in the Pac-12 with 45 2/3 innings pitched.
- Ottesen earned the win in game two against Oregon, allowing five runs with four strikeouts and four walks over eight innings.
- Junior Josh Lapiana is 2-3 on the year with a 3.41 ERA over seven starts. He is tied for second on the team with 31 strikeouts. Lapiana has pitched 34 1/3 innings.
- Lapiana earned a win in game three against Oregon, allowing one run on six hits with a career-high nine strikeouts.
- Freshman Jacob Rebar is Utah's fourth starter. He has a 7.17 ERA, 2-4 record, 21 strikeouts over 21 1/3 innings and is tied for the team lead (and tied for second in the Pac-12) with three pickoffs. Rebar has four starts and five relief appearances.
- Senior Dylan Drachler has four saves, which is fifth in the Pac-12. He has pitched in 11 games (13 2/3 innings) and has a 3.29 ERA and 11 strikeouts. Drachler is 0-1 on the year.
- Drachler has saves against Stanford, Nebraska, Ohio State and New Mexico State.
- Drachler has 13 career saves over 69 career appearances on the mound.




