QUICK HITS

- THE CFP RANKINGS:** UTAH moves up to No. 6, OREGON drops to No. 14, and USC moves up to No. 22 in this week's CFP rankings ... UTAH leads the Pac-12 and ranks sixth nationally in weeks ranked in the College Football Playoff Poll, with 28 weeks, trailing only Alabama (35), Clemson (35), Ohio State (35), Oklahoma (33) and LSU (31).
- DIVISION RACES:** OREGON has clinched the North Division crown and will be making its third Pac-12 Football Championship Game appearance. Meanwhile, the South Division race is down to UTAH and USC. With a win over Colorado, Utah returns the Pac-12 Football Championship Game. If it stumbles and finishes in a tie with USC at 7-2, the Trojans own the tiebreaker and would head to Santa Clara for a rematch against Oregon. See page 8 of this release for Pac-12 tie-break procedures.
- FOUR OR MORE WINS:** Entering this weekend's play, the Pac-12 Conference is the only FBS conference with all its teams having four or more victories this season. Only once has the Conference had a season where all teams had won four or more games (1965).

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE & FRESHMAN Jayden Daniels, QB, ASU

Daniels threw for 408 yards and 3 TDs in ASU's 31-28 upset of sixth-ranked Oregon. In the first half, Daniels completed 12-of-14 passes for 191 yards and a TD with his two incompletions coming on the final drive of the half. In the second half, Daniels threw for 217 yards with TD passes of 26 and 81 yards, the latter coming on 3rd & 16 and ASU up 24-21 with 3:54 remaining to give ASU a 10-point advantage

OFFENSIVE LINEMAN Abe Lucas, OT, WSU

Anchored a line that helped WSU accumulate 641 yards of total offense in a 54-53 win over Oregon State. Lucas played every snap of the game, including 70 pass attempts, and did not surrender a sack. WSU also rushed for two TDs, including the game-winner with :02 seconds remaining. He graded out at 90 percent for the game and led all tackles nationally in pass blocking grade last week by PFF.

DEFENSE

Talanoa Hufanga, S, USC

Had a career-best 18 tackles in the 52-35 win over UCLA, the most in a game by a Trojan since Troy Polamalu had 20 vs. Utah in the 2001 Vegas Bowl. Hufanga had a game-best 2.0 tackles for loss, with a sack, and also broke up a pass.

DEFENSIVE LINEMAN Bradlee Anae, DE, UTAH

Finished second on the team with seven tackles, including Utah's only sack of the game in a 35-7 win at Arizona. Held Arizona to 61 yards rushing, the 10th of 11 games this season Utah has held its opponent under 100 yards rushing.

SPECIAL TEAMS Alex Kinney, P, COLO

In CU's 20-14 win over Washington, he helped the Buffs pin UW deep in their territory at key times. He had four punts for a 45.8 average, with three inside-the-15 (two inside-the-10, including one that curled out of bounds at the 1-yard line).

PAC-12 FOOTBALL NOTEBOOK

THE POLLS: Three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the AP and in the Coaches polls - UTAH (6/6), OREGON (14/13) and USC (25/25) ... Eight different Pac-12 teams have been ranked in the Top 25 at some point this season.

UTAH DEFENSE HOLDS STRONG: Utah is one of three FBS teams to rank in the top 10 in both offensive and defensive plays per yard:

- Utah is 9th in offensive ypp (6.95) and 4th in defensive ypp (4.24)
- Clemson is 4th in offensive ypp (7.49) and 2nd in defensive ypp (3.88)
- Ohio State is 8th in offensive ypp (7.04) and 1st defensive ypp (3.52)

Utah's defense continues to rank among the best in the FBS:

- 1st in rushing defense (55.9 ypg); opponents average just 2.3 yards per carry
- 2nd in first downs allowed (151)
- 3rd in total defense (243.8)
- 4th in scoring defense (10.9), yards per play (4.24) & pass efficiency defense (105.10)
- 7th in red zone defense (68.4%)
- 12th in interceptions (13)

A ROLLING UTE GATHERS NO MOSS: UTAH senior RB **Zack Moss** has rushed for 100 or more yards in seven games this season, including five of the last six with a season-high 203 at Arizona. He leads the Pac-12 in rushing (115.8 avg). Moss already owns the school career records for rushing (3,809 yards) and rushing touchdowns (37). However, it's his pass catching ability that's been gaining attention of late. Over the last five games, he's pulled in 19 receptions for 313 yards and one score. In his first 37 games as a Ute, he had 40 receptions for 304 yards ... Over the last five games, Moss is averaging 191.4 all-purpose yards per game.

2.3 MILES: Pac-12 quarterbacks combined to throw for 3,976 yards last Saturday, the equivalent of 2.3 miles. WASHINGTON STATE's **Anthony Gordon** became the third quarterback in Pac-12 history to throw for 600 yards as he went for 606 in the win against Oregon State. USC's **Kedon Slovis** set a school single-game record with 515 yards in the win over UCLA.

YOU COMPLETE ME: Through 13 weeks, four Pac-12 QBs are among the 12 FBS quarterbacks who have completed at least 68.0% of their pass attempts this season (minimum 15 passes per game/played in 75.0% of team's games). That's more than any other conference. Those four have combined to complete 1,091-of-1,531 (.713) for 13,736 yards, 117 TDs, 30 INT.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: Seven FBS quarterbacks have thrown two or fewer interceptions this season (min. 15 attempts/must play in 75.0% of team's games). Of those seven, two reside in the Pac-12 - UTAH SR QB **Tyler Huntley** (2 INT in 232 attempts) and ARIZONA STATE FR QB **Jayden Daniels** (2 INT in 291 attempts).

QUARTERBACK DEBUTS: Due to injuries, Pac-12 teams have combined to start 21 different quarterbacks this season. Not only has the Pac-12 started 21 different signal-callers, but 10 have made their first-ever FBS start in 2019.

NOT SO FRIENDLY CONFINES: The home team is just 27-22 in Pac-12 play. Only OREGON and UTAH remain undefeated at home in conference play, each with 4-0 records vs. Pac-12 foes.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL AWARD FINALISTS:

BILETNIKOFF AWARD: USC's **Michael Pittman Jr.** (95 receptions/1,222 yards/11 TDs) was announced as finalist for the Biletnikoff Award honoring the nation's top receiver.

GROZA AWARD: WASHINGTON STATE's **Blake Mazza** (18-of-19 FGs, .947, long of 51 yards, 51-of-53 PATs) was announced as finalist for the Groza Award honoring the nation's top place kicker.

OUTLAND TROPHY: OREGON's **Penei Sewell** (PFF - 96.0 run-blocking grade, 91.7 pass-blocking grade, allowed just six pressures on the QB this season on 403 pass-blocking snaps) was announced as finalist for the Outland Trophy honoring the nation's most outstanding interior lineman.

BURLSWORTH TROPHY: CALIFORNIA S/KR **Ashtyn Davis** (163 career tackles, 6 career interceptions, 1,604 kick return yards/22.9 avg) is one of their three finalists. The Trophy is awarded to the most outstanding football player in America who began his career as a walk-on.

BUTKUS AWARD: CALIFORNIA's **Evan Weaver** (164 tackles/14.9 per game) is one of six finalists for the Butkus Award honoring the nation's top linebacker.

CONFERENCE OF QUARTERBACKS: The Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award has narrowed its list to five finalists for the nation's top college quarterback. The Pac-12 is well represented on that list with OREGON QB **Justin Herbert** and UTAH QB **Tyler Huntley** ... A trio of Pac-12 quarterbacks were among the 16 semi-finalists for the Davey O'Brien National Quarterback Award - Herbert, Huntley and WASHINGTON STATE QB **Anthony Gordon**.

AROUND THE PAC-12

WASHINGTON STATE (6-5) at WASHINGTON (6-5) Fri., Nov. 29 • 1:00 pm PT • FOX • #WSUvsUW

WASHINGTON STATE: The Cougars scored a pair of TDs in the final 2:10 to come-back from 11 point deficit to defeat Oregon State, 54-53, and become bowl eligible for the a school record fifth straight season ... RSR QB **Anthony Gordon** completed 50-of-70 for 606 yards and 6 TDs. In the process, he set Pac-12 single-season records for most passing touchdowns (45) and passing yards (4,920). The 606 passing yards as the third game this season passing for more than 500 yards ... SO RB **Max Borghi** had 109 all-purpose yards, his seventh 100-yard all-purpose game this season ... Nine different receivers caught three or more passes, led by Borghi with a career-high nine (40 yards), followed by **Renard Bell** with eight (108 yards, 2 TDs) ... With 10 tackles, JR LB **Jahad Woods** upped his season total to 111, the most since Deone Bucannon made 114 in 2013 ... SO OL **Abe Lucas** has been in on 809 total snaps this season, and has committed just one penalty and allowed just one sack.

WASHINGTON: The Huskies have won six straight and nine of the last 10 Apple Cups. The only setback in that stretch was a 31-28 overtime loss at WSU in 2012 ... A win over the Cougars and the Huskies would guarantee their sixth consecutive winning season under coach Chris Petersen ... TB **Salvon Ahmed** is third in the Pac-12 in rushing, averaging 91.5 yards per game. With 915 rushing yards, he needs 85 yards to reach 1,000 and give the Huskies a 1,000-yard rusher for the fifth consecutive season ... JR TE **Hunter Bryant** was named a finalist for the John Mackey Award as the nation's top tight end. For the season, he has 46 receptions for 729 yards (15.8 avg) and 3 TDs. His 1,298 receiving yards are second all-time, trailing 2013 Mackey Award winner Austin Seferian-Jenkins (1,838).

OREGON STATE (5-6) at OREGON (9-2) Sat., Nov. 30 • 1:00 pm MT • P12N • #OSUvsUO

OREGON STATE: With a win in the Civil War, the Beavers would become bowl eligible and post their first six-win season since 2013 ... The Beavers remain first in the nation with only five turnovers committed this season ... RJR OLB **Hamilcar Rashed Jr.** owns a pair of Oregon State single-season mark with 14.0 sacks and 22.5 tackles for loss this season ... RSR QB **Jake Luton** completed 22-of-40 for a career-best 408 yards and matched his single-game best with five TD passes in the loss at WSU ... WR **Isaiah Hodgins** has 168 career receptions, seventh in OSU history ... RSR TE **Noah Tognia** had five receptions for 67 yards and 1 TD. He became the sixth Beaver tight end to reach 1,000-plus career yards receiving ... SR OL **Blake Brandel** started his 47th consecutive game - third-most in OSU history for consecutive starts.

OREGON: Won the last two meetings and 10 of the last 11 against Oregon State in the Civil War ... With his 20-of-36 performance for 304 yards and 2 TDs, SR QB **Justin Herbert** set an Oregon career record for completions with 781, passing Marcus Mariota (779), became just the second Oregon QB to reach 10,000 career passing yards with 10,036 yards, while his two TD passes give him 93 for his career, seventh on the Pac-12's career list ... JR WR **Johnny Johnson III** set a career-highs with 10 receptions, 207 yards and 2 TDs in the 31-28 loss at Arizona State ... WR **Juwan Johnson** has 19 receptions for 304 yards and four TDs in the last four games ... SR ILB **Troy Dye** posted 13 tackles at Arizona State. He moved into fifth in program history in career tackles with 376.

Notre Dame (9-2) at STANFORD (4-7) Sat., Nov. 30 • 1:00 pm PT • FOX • #NDvsSTAN

STANFORD: The Cardinal have won three of the last four meetings, and seven of the last 10, with Notre Dame. That includes a current string of five straight over the Irish at Stanford Stadium ... Over his last four games played, JR QB **Davis Mills** has completed 98-of-140 (.700) for 1,325 yards (average of 331.3 per game over that span) and 8 TDs ... Over the last two games, SO WR **Michael Wilson** has 11 receptions for a 177 yards ... FR PK **Ryan Sanborn** connected on a pair of field goal attempts, including a career-long 48-yarder ... 38 different Cardinal have now started a game this season after FR WR Elijah Higgins took the field with the Stanford offense for its first snap of the game. He is also the 18th first-time starter and eighth true freshman to start this season.

COLORADO (5-6) at UTAH (10-1) Sat., Nov. 30 • 5:30 pm MT • ABC • #CUvsUTAH

COLORADO: CU snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Huskies with a 20-14 win ... CU had five sacks; UW came into the game allowing just 13 in 10 games ... JR WR **Laviska Shenault** had seven receptions for 100 yards and 1 TD. It was his eighth 100-yard receiving game. He now has 147 receptions for 1,900 yards for his career ... TB **Alex Fontenot** posted his third 100-yard rushing game with 105 yards on 24 carries ... In his last home game, SR QB **Steven Montez** completed 17-of-28 for 223 yards and 1 TD, which gave him the most career touchdown passes (61) at Colorado. He has 9,473 passing yards, trailing only CU career record holder Sefo Liufau (9,568), and 10,473 yards of total offense, again only behind Liufau (10,509).

UTAH: The Utes have held six opponents to single-digit points this season, including four games holding an opponent without a touchdown ... In the 35-7 win over Arizona, the Utes held the Wildcats to 61 yards rushing, the 10th time this season they have held an opponent under 100 yards rushing. Only 10 FBS teams in the past 10 seasons have held opponents under 100 rushing yards in 10 or more games in a season ... Utes notched their fifth game this season with more than 500 yards of total offense (517 yards), their most since 2005 (5) ... SR RB **Zack Moss:** rushed for a season-high 203 yards on 26 carries (7.8 avg), and added four receptions for 32 yards to give him 265 all-purpose yards. Over the last five games, Moss has averaged 191.4 all-purpose yards ... SR DE **Bradlee Anae** tallied 1.0 sack, giving him 28.0 sacks for his career. The school record is 29.5 set by Hunter Dimick (2013-16) ... In the last 14 quarters at home, the Utes have not allowed a touchdown, and just six points total.

ARIZONA (4-7) at ARIZONA STATE (6-5) Sat., Nov. 30 • 8:00 pm MT • ESPN • #AZvsASU

ARIZONA: Wildcat starting linebackers accounted for 32 tackles against Utah. **Anthony Pandey** posted a career-high 11 tackles, **Tony Fields II** had 11 as well, while **Colin Schooler** added 10 tackles ... Schooler added one tackle-for-loss, giving him 43.5 for his career to tie Joe Salave'a for fifth on Arizona's career list ... FR QB **Grant Gunnell** got the Cats on the board with a 7-yard rushing touchdown with 1:50 remaining in the game. It was his first career rushing touchdown and the team's 19th this season (it had 14 the entire 2018 season).

ARIZONA STATE: In the 31-28 upset win over No. 6 Oregon, the Sun Devils put up a season-high 535 yards of offense ... FR QB **Jayden Daniels** was named the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts in the win. He completed 22-of-32 for a season-best 408 yards and 3 TDs (81, 57, 26 yards). It was his fifth game reaching the 300-mark. Only 12 times has a freshman in ASU history recorded a 300-yard game, of which Daniels now has five. And it was the third straight game with 3 TD passes. 11 of Daniels' 17 TD passes have gone for 25+ yards ... SR WR **Kyle Williams** extended his streak of consecutive games with a reception to 39 - the fourth longest streak in ASU history ... SR WR **Brandon Aiyuk** had seven receptions for 161 yards and 1 TD. He added 53 punt return yards for 213 all-purpose yards against Oregon. That's 726 all-purpose yards over the last three games. Aiyuk is third in the FBS with 163.36 all-purpose yards per game ... RJR WR **Frank Darby** has 16 catches for 287 yards (24.2 avg) with seven TDs over the last four games.

CALIFORNIA (6-5) at UCLA (4-7) Sat., Nov. 30 • 7:30 pm PT • FS1 • #CALvsUCLA

CALIFORNIA: Snapped a nine-game Big Game skid with a 24-20 comeback win at Stanford to become bowl eligible in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2008 and 2009 ... RSO QB **Chase Garbers** completed 20-of-30 for 285 yards and a TD. He was also Cal's leading rusher with 72 yards, including a 16-yard run for the winning touchdown with 1:16 remaining ... With 13 tackles, SR ILB **Evan Weaver**, a finalist for the Butkus Award as the nation's top linebacker, moved up to second on Cal's single-season list, now with 164 stops. Hardy Nickerson owns the school mark with 167 in 1985. He now boasts double digit tackles in 17 of his last 18 games.

UCLA: SO QB **Dorian Thompson-Robinson** completed 26-of-44 for 367 yards and 3 TDs, while rushing for 64 yards and another score. He had 431 yards of total offense in the 52-35 loss at USC ... RJR TE **Devin Asiasi** had five receptions for 141 yards, his first career 100-yard game ... RFR WR **Kyle Philips** had a career-high 12 receptions for a career-best 123 yards. Over the last seven games, Philips has 47 receptions for 505 yards (10.7 avg) ... RSR RB **Joshua Kelley** needs 16 rushing yards to reach 1,000 yards for the season. After rushing for 1,243 yards last season, Kelley would become the eighth Bruin all-time with 1,000 rushing yards in back-to-back season, and just the second since 1997 ... RJR RB **Demetric Felton** has 48 receptions, a school record for single-season reception by a running back.

OPEN DATE

USC (8-4): In the 52-35 win over UCLA, FR QB **Kedon Slovis** turned in his fourth 400-yard passing game of the season as he completed 37-of-47 for a USC single-game record 515 yards and 4 TDs, with no interceptions ... In the fourth quarter this season, Slovis has completed 53-of-68 (.779) for 729 yards, 8 TDs and no interceptions ... Slovis is in the national Top 12 in five NCAA stat categories: completion percentage (.718), passing TDs (28), passing efficiency (167.6), completions (23.64 per game) and passing yardage (3,242) ... Four USC receivers had over 100 receiving yards vs. UCLA - **Drake London** (8 rec/142 yards/1 TD), **Amon-Ra St. Brown** (8 rec/128 yards), **Tyler Vaughns** (6 rec/106 yards/1 TD) and **Michael Pittman Jr.** (13 rec/104 yards/2 TDs) ... Over the last three games, Pittman has collected 37 receptions for 430 yards ... Pittman has caught four or more passes in each of the last 14 games, and 16 of the last 17 games. During the last 17 games, he has a total of 117 receptions for 1,771 yards and 16 TDs.

PAC-12 FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Football Championship Game will take place Friday, December 6 and televised to a national audience on ABC. The Championship game, which will be played at Levi's® Stadium in Santa Clara, Calif., will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. If the Pac-12 champion (or any other Pac-12 team) is in the top four of the College Football Playoff ranking following the 2019 season it could find itself in either the Fiesta Bowl or Peach Bowl to participate in the CFP Semifinals. If the Pac-12 champion is not among the top four, it will take its customary position in the Rose Bowl.



TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS

The winner of each Division will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie

- Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
- Record in games played within the division.
- Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
- Record in common conference games.
- Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
- Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics following the last weekend of regular-season games.
- Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
- Record in games played within the division.
- Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
- Record in common conference games.
- Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics Following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Determination of Home Team in Pac-12 Championship

The home team in the Pac-12 Championship Game will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the home team.

Tie-breaking Procedure

- Head-to-head, if applicable.
- Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
- Record in common conference games.
- Highest ranking by SportSource Analytics following the last weekend of regular-season games.
- Coin toss.
