FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- » Utah begins Pac-12 play on the road at Arizona. The Utes have had some success against the Wildcats of late winning four straight series against them going back to 2015.
- » Utah's offense has been hot as of late scoring double-figure runs in four of the last six games. The latest came against Niagara when they scored 10 runs against the Purple Eagles. Utah didn't have a big inning against Niagara, but kept constant pressure on scoring at least one run in six straight innings.
- » After dropping its game against Gonzaga, Utah has won five of its last seven games as it heads into Pac-12 play at Arizona.
- » Zack Moeller had a tough start to the season at the plate, but snapped out of it. Since the team beat San Diego, he is hitting .433 and has 17 RBI with three home runs. He set a career high in RBI twice during the week with six against UNLV and six against Wright State. He hit a grand slam against UNLV and then a three-run home run against Wright State.
- » Another player that has been on fire at the plate is Oliver Dunn. He's hitting .349 on the year and has scored a team-leading 17 runs. His OPS is 1.176.

FIRST PITCH

Utah begins Pac-12 play at Arizona beginning on Friday, March 15.

The Utes come in with a 6-6 record and Arizona sits at 10-6. The Wildcats' offense has been clicking up to this point as they are in the top two in 13 offensive categories in the Pac-12 rankings.

Arizona will stream all three games for the weekend.

While they're in Arizona, Utah will stick around and play Grand Canyon on Monday, March 18 at 3 p.m. Grand Canyon is 6-9 on the season.

SERIES

Overall the series is tight with Arizona having a small edge leading 69-61-12, but Utah has had the upper hand lately winning the series four seasons in a row.

Last year at Smith's Ballpark, the Utes took two out of three games winning on Friday and Saturday.

Utah and Arizona played against each other the first time in 1952.

SCHEDULE

Utah has made it through a unique stretch to start the season of playing its first 11 games against 11 different teams all on the road.

Its first home series was going to be against Niagara, but due to inclement weather, the Utes and Purple Eagles only played one game. Following that one game with Niagara and then playing Gonzaga a day later, Utah played its first 13 games against 13 different opponents.

After starting the season at Texas State, they traveled to San Diego and then East Carolina on the third weekend.

Not only did the Utah and Niagara series get canceled due to weather, but the two teams ended up traveling to BYU to play at Miller Park for their one game. With that game at a neutral site, the Utes will play 18 of its first 19 games on the road.

After traveling a lot early in the season, the Utes will finish the season in the friendly confines of Smith's Ballpark playing 10 of its final 13 games at home.

EXPERIENCE RETURNING

There were times in the 2018 season when six freshmen were on the field at once because of injuries allowing them to earn good experience. This season, Utah is returning seven starters with more experience coming off the bench.



The team has 13 upper classmen led by outfielders Chandler Anderson, Erick Migueles and infielder Oliver Dunn.

Overall, Utah has 188 games started returning on the infield and even with the loss of DaShawn Keirse Jr., the outfield returns 125 starts from a season ago.

The projected starting pitchers for the season started in 20 games during the 2018 season.

UTES OFFENSE EXPLODES

The Utes have been hot at the plate scoring double-digit runs in four of their last six games. They have scored 16 runs against UNLV, 14 against Western Carolina, 12 against Wright State and 10 against Niagara.

Over the stretch where they have won five of their last seven, they have averaged 9.57 runs per game. Before that stretch, they were only averaging 3.4 runs per game.

MOELLER RETURNS TO LINEUP

After sitting out the 2018 season with Tommy John surgery, Zack Moeller returned to the lineup as a catcher or designated hitter and is expected to be a boost not only for the offense, but also the defense behind the plate.

Since Utah beat San Diego, he is hitting .433 with 17 RBI and three home runs. Against UNLV, one of those home runs was his second career grand slam.

With that grand slam, Moeller had a career high six RBI against UNLV and then followed that up with six more RBI against Wright State.

He has currently had three hits in three straight games.

DUNN ALWAYS ON BASE

Second baseman Oliver Dunn has had a great start to the season hitting .349. He is second in the Pac-12 Conference with eight doubles and is sixth in the conference in OB% at .525.

He leads the team scoring 17 runs.

The week Utah played at UNLV and in the LeClair Classic at East Carolina, he was on base non stop. Dunn hit .500, scoring 11 runs and had nine walks. His slash for the weekend was .500/1.083/.727.

Dunn has also been a warrior on the field during his career, playing in 116 of the 118 games he's seen action in and has a career batting average of .291.

FIRST SHUTOUT OF THE SEASON

Riley Pierce, Jack Liffbrig and Jacob Dahle combined to pitch a shutout against Western Carolina in a 14-0 rout by the Utes.

Pierce got the start and earned his first win after pitching 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and only giving up four hits. Liffbrig came in first and went 3.0 innings, only giving up one hit and then Dahle closed things down in the ninth retiring the Catamounts in order with two strikeouts.

It was the first shutout since the Utes held USC scoreless in 2018.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

So far this season, 10 players have made their first appearances in a Utah uniform. Four freshmen pitchers came out of the bullpen and didn't allow a run in their first appearances.

In the field, the newcomers also made a difference as five either started or made appearances off the bench. Jayden Kiernan, Briley Knight, Chase Fernlund and Tyler Thompson have all combined to start 18 games and three of the four are hitting over .300 in the action that they've seen.

FRESHMAN PITCHERS BOOST BULLPEN

Freshmen have come up big out of the bullpen on the first three weekends.

Jack Liffbrig, Dustyn Schramm and Zac McCleve each hold an ERA under 3.00 after all have combined to appear 13 times.

Liffbrig and Jacob Dahle both came out of the bullpen to hold a shutout against Western Carolina.

Schramm earned his first career save against Nevada on Sunday, pitching two innings only allowing one hit. He also had two strikeouts. He also earned his first win against San Diego pitching 2.1 innings and giving up no runs and only three hits.

MIGUELES HAS STRONG START

Erick Migueles has been steady at the plate to start the season. He leads the team hitting .391 and is second on the team with 12 RBI.

He's had two hits in seven of the 12 games this season and came up with an RBI in eight of the 12 games this season.

Going back to last season, Migueles had had an RBI in 13 straight games up until the UNLV game this season.

SCHRAMM COMES UP BIG ON SUNDAYS

Freshman Dustyn Schramm has appeared in two of the three Sunday games this season and earned a save in the victory against Nevada and earned the win against San Diego in the second weekend.

Through those first two outings he didn't yet to allow a run in 4.1 innings pitched and has struck out four and only walked two while giving up four hits.

TOM HEATS UP AT THIRD

Rykker Tom went 3-4 against Gonzaga pushing his season average to .381. That's the second best average on the team.

He has reached base in all 11 games he's played in and has a hit in nine of the 11 games.

Tom is fourth on the team with seven RBI.

SUMMER BALL

Four Utes had success in summer leagues across the country.

Dunn helped lead Wareham Gatemen win the 2018 Cape Cod Baseball League Championship. He hit .230 in the league in 34 games with 10 RBI and scored 19 runs.

Anderson had a huge summer for the Corvallis Knights. He was named Second Team All-WCL after hitting .337 and batting in 34 RBI. Anderson led the team with 22 stolen bases and was second on the team scoring 40 runs. He stepped up in the playoffs batting .474 as the Knights won their third WCL title in a row. The outfielder hit .318 through 54 games in the regular season.

Outfielder Dominic Foscalina played in the Alaska Baseball League for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots. He hit .267 and had 20 RBI on 20 hits. He played in 24 games.

Shea Kramer also had some success playing for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League and had 15 RBI on 20 hits in 35 games.

MLB DRAFT

DaShawn Keirse, Jr. left after his junior season when he was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the fourth round.

The junior outfielder set a program record hitting .386 and having a 1.049 OPS. He had 78 hits on the season and scored 47 runs while also having 22 RBI.

In just three seasons, Keirse had a decorated career in a Utah uniform. He was a three-time All-Pac-12 member as well as a three-time Pac-12 All-Defensive Team member. After his record-setting season in 2018, he was named ABCA/Rawlings West All-Region second team. In 2016, he was a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and became the first Ute named to the Pac-12 Defensive Team.

Keirse became the 11th Utah player drafted in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft since 2008.

PRESEASON PAC-12 COACHES POLL

The Pac-12 Coaches Poll was released and Utah was voted to finish 11th in the league.

UCLA was picked to win the league just edging out Stanford with 97 points to the Cardinal 90. Defending National Champion Oregon State was picked to finish in third.

2016 PAC-12 CHAMPS

Utah baseball became the first men's program at Utah to claim a Pac-12 Championship.

In 2016, the Utes went 19-11 in conference play to claim the championship. Heading into the final series of the regular season, Utah won two out of three against the Washington Huskies to clinch the title.

600 CAREER VICTORIES

Head Coach Bill Kinneberg sits just six wins away from 600 career victories sitting at 594 after the victory over Niagara.

He has been the head coach at UTEP for a season as well as Wyoming for seven seasons. He enters his 16th season at Utah.

NEXT UP

Utah travels to No. 3 Stanford to take on the Cardinal for a three-game series beginning Friday, March 22.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.


