### FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- » The Utes stay on the road for the second weekend of Pac-12 play as they travel to No. 3 Stanford to begin a three-game series on Friday, March 22.
- » Utah enters the series sitting 7-9 overall and 1-2 in the Pac-12 after dropping the opening conference series at Arizona.
- » The Utes bats have been hot lately as they scored 28 runs in the three-game series against Arizona. A big part of that was in the first game they plated a season-high 21 runs.
- » Rykker Tom has been surging at the plate leading the team with a .375 batting average. He has been on base in every game this season and has a hit in 13 of the 15 games he's seen action in. The two games he didn't have a hit, he reached base by drawing a walk.
- » Zack Moeller had a tough start to the season at the plate, but snapped out of it. Since the team beat San Diego, he is hitting .413 and has a team-leading 21 RBI with three home runs. He set a career high in RBI twice with six against UNLV and six against Wright State.

**FIRST PITCH**

The Utes stay on the road in Pac-12 play as they travel to No. 3 Stanford for a weekend series. The Cardinal are off to a very strong start this season going 12-3 up to this point and most recently taking three out of four games against the Texas Longhorns.

This is Stanford's first Pac-12 series of the season.

The first game will be Friday, March 22 at 7 p.m. MT.

**SERIES**

Utah is 6-19 overall against Stanford. They won their last series against the Cardinal in 2016, the year they won the Pac-12 Championship.

**SCHEDULE**

Utah has made it through a unique stretch to start the season of playing its first 11 games against 11 different teams all on the road.

Its first home series was going to be against Niagara, but due to inclement weather, the Utes and Purple Eagles only played one game. Following that one game with Niagara, they then played one game against Gonzaga a day later so Utah played its first 13 games against 13 different opponents.

After starting the season at Texas State, they traveled to San Diego and then East Carolina on the third weekend.

Not only did the Utah and Niagara series get canceled due to weather, but the two teams ended up traveling to BYU to play at Miller Park for their one game. With that game at a neutral site, the Utes will play 18 of its first 19 games on the road.

After traveling a lot early in the season, the Utes will finish the season in the friendly confines of Smith's Ballpark playing 10 of its final 13 games at home.

**UTES OFFENSE HAS SUCCESS**

Utah's offense had a big weekend against Arizona posting 28 runs with 21 of those coming on Friday night.

The 21 runs are the most the Utes have scored this season and first time they have scored 20-plus runs since 2017 against Utah Valley. It was the fifth time this season that the Utes have scored double-digit runs.

Utah is hitting .288 as a team this year, which is the third best mark in the Pac-12. Overall, Utah is in the top four in batting average, one base percentage, hits and doubles.

**MOELLER RETURNS TO LINEUP**

After sitting out the 2018 season with Tommy John surgery, Zack Moeller returned to the lineup as a catcher or



designated hitter and is expected to be a boost not only for the offense, but also the defense behind the plate.

Since Utah beat San Diego, he is hitting .413 with 21 RBI and three home runs. Against UNLV, one of those home runs was his second career grand slam.

With that grand slam, Moeller had a career high six RBI against UNLV and then followed that up with six more RBI against Wright State.

His 21 RBI has him fifth in the Pac-12 in RBI.

#### 100TH CAREER START

In the Sunday game against Arizona, Chandler Anderson started his 100th career game in a Ute uniform. He joins teammate Oliver Dunn as the other Ute on the team with at least 100 starts.

Anderson has started 15 games this season in left field and has eight RBI on the season. He's had three multi-hit games this season.

#### DUNN ALWAYS ON BASE

Second baseman Oliver Dunn has had a great start to the season hitting .371. He is tied for first in the Pac-12 with 12 doubles and is eighth in the conference in OB% at .494.

He leads the team scoring 20 runs and had a big weekend knocking in run against Arizona. He had a career high six RBI in Friday night's game going 3-6 at the plate with two doubles.

Dunn has also been a warrior on the field through his career, starting in 120 of the 122 games he's seen action in.

#### TOM HEATS UP AT THIRD

Rykker Tom leads the team this season hitting .375 at the plate. He has reached base in all 15 games with hits in 13 of those 15 games.

He's fourth on the team in total bases with 22 and has eight RBI.

#### EXPERIENCE RETURNING

There were times in the 2018 season when six freshmen were on the field at once because of injuries allowing them to earn good experience. This season, Utah is returning seven starters with more experience coming off the bench.

The team has 13 upper classmen led by outfielders Chandler Anderson, Erick Migueles and infielder Oliver Dunn.

Overall, Utah has 188 games started returning on the infield and even with the loss of DaShawn Keirse Jr., the outfield returns 125 starts from a season ago.

The projected starting pitchers for the season started in 20 games during the 2018 season.

#### SHUTOUT

Riley Pierce, Jack Liffbrig and Jacob Dahle combined to pitch a shutout against Western Carolina in a 14-0 rout by the Utes.

Pierce got the start and earned his first win after pitching 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and only giving up four hits. Liffbrig came in first and went 3.0 innings, only giving up one hit and then Dahle closed things down in the ninth retiring the Catamounts in order with two strikeouts.

It was the first shutout since the Utes held USC scoreless in 2018.

#### NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

So far this season, 10 players have made their first appearances in a Utah uniform. Four freshmen pitchers came out of the bullpen and didn't allow a run in their first appearances.

In the field, the newcomers also made a difference as six either started or made appearances off the bench. Jayden Kiernan, Briley Knight, Chase Fernlund, Isaac Deveaux and Tyler Thompson have all combined to start 28 games.

#### MIGUELES HAS STRONG START

Erick Migueles has been steady at the plate to start the season. He is third on the team hitting .355 and is second on the team with 15 RBI.

He's had multiple hits in eight games and came up with an RBI in nine games this season.

Going back to last season, Migueles had had an RBI in 13 straight games up until the UNLV game this season.

#### SCHRAMM COMES UP BIG ON SUNDAYS

Freshman Dustyn Schramm has appeared in two of the four Sunday games this season and earned a save in the victory against Nevada and earned the win against San Diego in the second weekend.

Through those first two outings, he didn't allow a run in 4.1 innings pitched and has struck out four and only walked two while giving up four hits.

His last appearance was on a Monday and he was equally as impressive. He posted career highs pitching 4.2 innings and struck out six against Grand Canyon.

**MCCLEVE IMPRESSIVE OUT OF PEN**

Zac McCleve has made nine appearances out of the bullpen and currently holds a 1.64 ERA.

He has been used the most out of the pen for the Utes and has been highly effective only allowing two earned runs in those appearances.

His longest outing of the season was this past weekend against Arizona where he threw 2.2 innings and only gave up one hit while recording a career high three strikeouts.

**SUMMER BALL**

Four Utes had success in summer leagues across the country.

Dunn helped lead Wareham Gatemen win the 2018 Cape Cod Baseball League Championship. He hit .230 in the league in 34 games with 10 RBI and scored 19 runs.

Anderson had a huge summer for the Corvallis Knights. He was named Second Team All-WCL after hitting .337 and batting in 34 RBI. Anderson led the team with 22 stolen bases and was second on the team scoring 40 runs. He stepped up in the playoffs batting .474 as the Knights won their third WCL title in a row. The outfielder hit .318 through 54 games in the regular season.

Outfielder Dominic Foscalina played in the Alaska Baseball League for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots. He hit .267 and had 20 RBI on 20 hits. He played in 24 games.

Shea Kramer also had some success playing for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League and had 15 RBI on 20 hits in 35 games.

**MLB DRAFT**

DaShawn Keirse, Jr. left after his junior season when he was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the fourth round.

The junior outfielder set a program record hitting .386 and having a 1.049 OPS. He had 78 hits on the season and scored 47 runs while also having 22 RBI.

In just three seasons, Keirse had a decorated career in a Utah uniform. He was a three-time All-Pac-12 member as well as a three-time Pac-12 All-Defensive Team member. After his record-setting season in 2018, he was named ABCA/Rawlings West All-Region second team. In 2016, he was a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and became the first Ute named to the Pac-12 Defensive Team.

Keirse became the 11th Utah player drafted in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft since 2008.

**PRESEASON PAC-12 COACHES POLL**

The Pac-12 Coaches Poll was released and Utah was voted to finish 11th in the league.

UCLA was picked to win the league just edging out Stanford with 97 points to the Cardinal 90. Defending National Champion Oregon State was picked to finish in third.

**2016 PAC-12 CHAMPS**

Utah baseball became the first men's program at Utah to claim a Pac-12 Championship.

In 2016, the Utes went 19-11 in conference play to claim the championship. Heading into the final series of the regular season, Utah won two out of three against the Washington Huskies to clinch the title.

**600 CAREER VICTORIES**

Head Coach Bill Kinneberg sits just six wins away from 600 career victories sitting at 595 after the victory over Arizona on Friday night.

He has been the head coach at UTEP for a season as well as Wyoming for seven seasons. He enters his 16th season at Utah.

**NEXT UP**

Utah will host its first Pac-12 series at home in Smith's Ballpark against Oregon.

First pitch is scheduled for 6 p.m. on Friday, March 29.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.


