FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- » Utah will play its first game against BYU this season at Smith's Ballpark on Tuesday, April 2 at 6 p.m. Overall, the team's will play three times this season with two of them being at Smith's Ballpark and one of them being played at Miller Park in Provo.
- » The Utes are looking for a win after dropping their first three Pac-12 series to Arizona, Stanford and Oregon.
- » Utah has been good at the plate this season batting .276 as a team. That mark is the third best in the Pac-12. The team is also fourth in doubles with 47, led by Oliver Dunn with 13. The 13 doubles is the second most in the conference.
- » Rykker Tom is second on the team hitting .358. He has been on base in 20 of the 201 games he's played in this season and in two games he didn't have a hit, he reached base by drawing a walk. His .358 average is the 10th best in the Pac-12.
- » Zack Moeller had a tough start to the season at the plate, but snapped out of it. Since the team beat San Diego, leads the team with 22 RBI with three home runs. He set a career high in RBI twice with six against UNLV and six against Wright State.

FIRST PITCH

Utah has a midweek game against BYU in the Deseret First Duel at home in Smith's Ballpark.

It is the first meeting of three this year between Utah and BYU and only the fifth home game of the season for the Utes.

The game will be broadcasted on Pac-12 Network

SERIES

In all, Utah and BYU have played 362 times and the Utes are 116-244-2.

Utah has won or split the series the last two seasons.

SCHEDULE

Utah has made it through a unique stretch to start the season of playing its first 11 games against 11 different teams all on the road.

Its first home series was going to be against Niagara, but due to inclement weather, the Utes and Purple Eagles only played one game. Following that one game with Niagara, they then played one game against Gonzaga a day later so Utah played its first 13 games against 13 different opponents.

After starting the season at Texas State, they traveled to San Diego and then East Carolina on the third weekend.

Not only did the Utah and Niagara series get canceled due to weather, but the two teams ended up traveling to BYU to play at Miller Park for their one game. With that game at a neutral site, the Utes played 18 of its first 19 games on the road.

After traveling a lot early in the season, the Utes will finish the season in the friendly confines of Smith's Ballpark playing 10 of its final 13 games at home.

UTES OFFENSE HAS SUCCESS

Utah's offense has had some big weekends at the plate and the team is hitting .276. That is the third best mark in the Pac-12.

Against Arizona, they scored 21 runs in the first game of the series. That is the most the Utes have scored this season and first time they have scored 20-plus runs since 2017 against Utah Valley. It was the fifth time this season that Utah has scored double-digit runs.

Out of the seven wins the team has, they have scored double-digit runs in five of them.

Overall, Utah is in the top four in batting average and doubles.

MOELLER RETURNS TO LINEUP

After sitting out the 2018 season with Tommy John surgery, Zack Moeller returned to the lineup as a catcher or designated hitter and is expected to be a boost not only for the offense, but also the defense behind the plate.

Since the UNLV game, he is hitting .382 and leads the team with 22 RBI and three home runs. Against UNLV, one of those home runs was his second career grand slam.

With that grand slam, Moeller had a career high six RBI against UNLV and then followed that up with six more RBI against Wright State.

His 22 RBI ranks him 10th in the Pac-12.

100TH CAREER START

In the Sunday game against Arizona, Chandler Anderson started his 100th career game in a Ute uniform. He joins teammate Oliver Dunn as the other Ute on the team with at least 100 starts.

Anderson has started 21 games this season in left and center field and has eight RBI on the season. He's had three multi-hit games this season.

DUNN ALWAYS ON BASE

Second baseman Oliver Dunn is hitting .367 after a big weekend at the plate against Oregon. He is second in the Pac-12 with 13 doubles and is 10th in the conference in OB% at .463. He's also seventh in the conference with a .622 slugging percentage.

Dunn had a career high six RBI in Friday night's game against Arizona going 3-6 at the plate with two doubles.

He leads the team scoring 27 runs and touched 56 total bases.

Dunn currently has a hit in 13 straight games and has a hit in 20 of the 22 games played this season.

Against Oregon, Dunn hit .429 going 6-14 at the plate with a home run and triple and he scored four runs and knocked in two more runs.

Dunn has also been a warrior on the field through his career, starting in 126 of the 128 games he's seen action in.

TOM HEATS UP AT THIRD

Rykkker Tom is second on the team this season hitting .358 at the plate. He has reached base in every game this season, but once. That game came in the final game of the series against Oregon.

Tom is 11th in the Pac-12 in batting average with his .358 mark.

He's fourth on the team in total bases with 26 and has eight RBI. Tom has eight games with multiple hits this season.

KRAMER GETS THE BAT GOING

Shea Kramer is hitting .375 in Pac-12 play through the first three series. He's started in six of those game and played in eight of the nine games.

He's got four RBI and has scored one run.

BROCOFF COMES OUT OF BULLPEN IN PAC-12 PLAY

Brett Brocoff has made two appearances out of the bullpen in Pac-12 play against Stanford and Oregon and has pitched really well.

He has a 2.31 era in 11.2 innings pitched and only allowing three runs with 10 strikeouts.

Against Stanford, he pitched 6.2 innings allowing the Utes to comeback and force extra innings. Then against Oregon, Brocoff came in after one inning and pitched 5.0 innings and only allowed five hits and two earned runs. he also had a season high in strikeouts with six.

SHUTOUT

Riley Pierce, Jack Liffbrig and Jacob Dahle combined to pitch a shutout against Western Carolina in a 14-0 rout by the Utes.

Pierce got the start and earned his first win after pitching 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and only giving up four hits. Liffbrig came in first and went 3.0 innings, only giving up one hit and then Dahle closed things down in the ninth retiring the Catamounts in order with two strikeouts.

It was the first shutout since the Utes held USC scoreless in 2018.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

So far this season, 10 players have made their first appearances in a Utah uniform. Four freshmen pitchers came out of the bullpen and didn't allow a run in their first appearances.

In the field, the newcomers also made a difference as six either started or made appearances off the bench. Jayden Kiernan, Briley Knight, Chase Fernlund, Isaac Deveaux and Tyler Thompson have all combined to start 35 games.

MIGUELES LEADS THE WAY

Erick Migueles has been steady at the plate to start the season hitting over .300 the entire time. He is third on the team hitting .321 and is second on the team with 20 RBI.

He's had multiple hits in eight games and came up with an RBI in 12 games this season.

Going back to last season, Migueles had had an RBI in 13 straight games up until the UNLV game this season.

Migueles is also tied for the lead on the team with three home runs. He had a big three-run homer against Stanfrod to help force extra innings against one of the best teams in the nation.

SCHRAMM FILLS IN WHERE NEEDED

Freshman Dustyn Schramm made his first two appearances in a Utah uniform on the first two Sunday games. He earned a save in the victory against Nevada and earned the win against San Diego in the second weekend.

Through those first two outings, he didn't allow a run in 4.1 innings pitched and has struck out four and only walked two while giving up four hits.

Against Stanford, he got his first career start. After a rocky start where he gave up five runs in the first two innings, he settled in only give up one more run over the next three innings allowing the Utes to get back into the game and force extra innings.

Against Grand Canyon, the freshman came out of the bullpen and set a career high with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched.

MCCLEVE IMPRESSIVE OUT OF PEN

Zac McCleve leads the team with 13 appearances out of the bullpen and currently holds a 3.12 ERA.

He has been highly effective only allowing six earned runs in those appearances.

His longest outing of the season was against Arizona where he threw 2.2 innings and only gave up one hit while recording a career high three strikeouts.

He appeared in two of the three games at Stanford and only allowed three hits.

EXPERIENCE RETURNING

There were times in the 2018 season when six freshmen were on the field at once because of injuries allowing them to earn good experience. This season, Utah is returning seven starters with more experience coming off the bench.

The team has 13 upper classmen led by outfielders Chandler Anderson, Erick Migueles and infielder Oliver Dunn.

Overall, Utah has 188 games started returning on the infield and even with the loss of DaShawn Keirse Jr., the outfield returns 125 starts from a season ago.

The projected starting pitchers for the season started in 20 games during the 2018 season.

SUMMER BALL

Four Utes had success in summer leagues across the country.

Dunn helped lead Wareham Gatemen win the 2018 Cape Cod Baseball League Championship. He hit .230 in the league in 34 games with 10 RBI and scored 19 runs.

Anderson had a huge summer for the Corvallis Knights. He was named Second Team All-WCL after hitting .337 and batting in 34 RBI. Anderson led the team with 22 stolen bases and was second on the team scoring 40 runs. He stepped up in the playoffs batting .474 as the Knights won their third WCL title in a row. The outfielder hit .318 through 54 games in the regular season.

Outfielder Dominic Foscalina played in the Alaska Baseball League for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots. He hit .267 and had 20 RBI on 20 hits. He played in 24 games.

Shea Kramer also had some success playing for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League and had 15 RBI on 20 hits in 35 games.

MLB DRAFT

DaShawn Keirse, Jr. left after his junior season when he was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the fourth round.

The junior outfielder set a program record hitting .386 and having a 1.049 OPS. He had 78 hits on the season and scored 47 runs while also having 22 RBI.

In just three seasons, Keirse had a decorated career in a Utah uniform. He was a three-time All-Pac-12 member as well as a three-time Pac-12 All-Defensive Team member. After his record-setting season in 2018, he was named ABCA/Rawlings West All-Region second team. In 2016, he was a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and became the first Ute named to the Pac-12 Defensive Team.

Keirse became the 11th Utah player drafted in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft since 2008.

600 CAREER VICTORIES

Head Coach Bill Kinneberg sits just six wins away from 600 career victories sitting at 595 after the victory over Arizona on Friday night.

He has been the head coach at UTEP for a season as well as Wyoming for seven seasons. He enters his 16th season at Utah.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.
