FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

» Utah will go for its fifth straight win over in-state foe BYU. The Utes and Cougars both played a week ago and Utah came out on top in a thriller that was tied headed to the bottom of the eighth. Rykker Tom hit a two-run triple to put the Utes up 8-6 and eventually proved to be the game-winning hit.

» Oliver Dunn leads the team hitting .355 this season with 63 total bases. He is in the top 11 of the Pac-12 offensive rankings in seven categories. He has a 1.033 OPS and a .444 on-base percentage as well as a .589 slugging percentage. Dunn leads the team in runs scored with 29 and third on the team in RBI with 14. He has a hit in 18 straight games.

» Rykker Tom is second on the team hitting .340. He has been on base in 22 of the 25 games he's played in this season and in two games he didn't have a hit, he reached base by drawing a walk.

» Zack Moeller had a tough start to the season at the plate, but snapped out of it and leads the team with 24 RBI. He set a career high in RBI twice with six against UNLV and six against Wright State.

» The Utes are going for their fifth win in a row over BYU on Tuesday, April 9.

FIRST PITCH

Utah heads south to Provo, Utah to take on BYU for the second week in a row as a midweek opponent.

First pitch will be at 6 p.m. and be broadcasted on BYU TV.

BYU is 22-8 on the season and Utah is 8-18 after their weekend series.

SERIES

The Utes and Cougars have played each other 363 times and Utah is 117-244-2.

Utah has won four games in a row with the game last Tuesday as well as the last three games played during the 2018 season.

Utah and BYU will play once more this season at Smith's Ballpark on Tuesday, May 14.

SCHEDULE

Utah has made it through a unique stretch to start the season of playing its first 11 games against 11 different teams all on the road.

Its first home series was going to be against Niagara, but due to inclement weather, the Utes and Purple Eagles only played one game. Following that one game with Niagara, they then played one game against Gonzaga a day later so Utah played its first 13 games against 13 different opponents.

After starting the season at Texas State, they traveled to San Diego and then East Carolina on the third weekend.

Not only did the Utah and Niagara series get canceled due to weather, but the two teams ended up traveling to BYU to play at Miller Park for their one game. With that game at a neutral site, the Utes played 18 of its first 19 games on the road.

After traveling a lot early in the season, the Utes will finish the season in the friendly confines of Smith's Ballpark playing 10 of its final 13 games at home.

MOELLER RETURNS TO LINEUP

After sitting out the 2018 season with Tommy John surgery, Zack Moeller returned to the lineup as a catcher or designated hitter and has been a big boost for not only for the offense, but also the defense behind the plate.

Since the UNLV game, he is hitting .343 and leads the team with 24 RBI and three home runs. Against UNLV, one of those home runs was his second career grand slam.

With that grand slam, Moeller had a career high six RBI against UNLV and then followed that up with six more RBI against Wright State.

Against BYU, he batted second in the order for the first time this season and gave the Utes their first lead of the game with a double to score Dunn.

DUNN ALWAYS ON BASE

Second baseman Oliver Dunn leads the team hitting .355. Dunn is in the top 11 of the Pac-12 rankings in seven different categories. Those categories are batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, doubles and triples.

Dunn had a career high six RBI in the Friday game against Arizona going 3-6 at the plate with two doubles.

He leads the team scoring 29 runs scoring two more against BYU and has touched 63 total bases.

Dunn currently has a hit in 18 straight games and has a hit in 24 of the 26 games played this season.

Against Oregon, Dunn hit .429 going 6-14 at the plate with a home run and triple and he scored four runs and knocked in two more runs.

Dunn has also been a warrior on the field through his career, starting in 129 of the 131 games he's seen action in.

TOM HEATS UP AT THIRD

Rykker Tom is second on the team this season hitting .340 at the plate. He has reached base in 23 of the 25 games he's played this season.

He's fourth on the team in total bases with 38 and has 10 RBI. Tom has nine games with multiple hits this season.

With the game tied in the eighth inning against BYU, Tom hit his first triple of the season to knock in two RBI to give Utah the lead back and eventually allowing them to get the win.

KRAMER GETS THE BAT GOING

Shea Kramer is hitting .385 in Pac-12 play through the first four series. He's started in seven of those game and played in nine overall.

He's got five RBI and has scored one run.

Kramer continued that hot streak against BYU coming up with two RBI against the Cougars and also had one RBI against Oregon State.

100TH CAREER START

In the Sunday game against Arizona, Chandler Anderson started his 100th career game in a Ute uniform. He joins teammate Oliver Dunn as the other Ute on the team with at least 100 starts.

Anderson has started 25 games this season in left and center field and has 10 RBI on the season. He's had three multi-hit games this season.

BROCOFF MOVES BACK INTO STARTING ROTATION

Brett Brocoff has made two appearances out of the bullpen in Pac-12 play against Stanford and Oregon and has pitched really well.

He has a 2.31 era in 11.2 innings pitched and only allowing three runs with 10 strikeouts.

Against Stanford, he pitched 6.2 innings allowing the Utes to comeback and force extra innings. Then against Oregon, Brocoff came in after one inning and pitched 5.0 innings and only allowed five hits and two earned runs. he also had a season high in strikeouts with six.

In the Oregon State series, he was moved back into the weekend starting rotation. He pitched 6.1 innings against the Beavers only giving up one run on five hits. He also tied his season high with six strikeouts.

Brocoff has pitched at least six innings in four of his seven appearances on the mound. He's second on the team with 25 strikeouts and is third on the team pitching 35.1 innings pitched so far this season.

SHUTOUT

Riley Pierce, Jack Liffbrig and Jacob Dahle combined to pitch a shutout against Western Carolina in a 14-0 rout by the Utes.

Pierce got the start and earned his first win after pitching 5.0 innings with five strikeouts and only giving up four hits. Liffbrig came in first and went 3.0 innings, only giving up one hit and then Dahle closed things down in the ninth retiring the Catamounts in order with two strikeouts.

It was the first shutout since the Utes held USC scoreless in 2018.

NEWCOMERS SEE ACTION

So far this season, 10 players have made their first appearances in a Utah uniform. Four freshmen pitchers came out of the bullpen and didn't allow a run in their first appearances.

In the field, the newcomers also made a difference as six either started or made appearances off the bench. Jayden Kiernan, Briley Knight, Chase Fernlund, Isaac Deveaux and Tyler Thompson have all combined to start 35 games.

MIGUELES LEADS THE WAY

Erick Migueles has been steady at the plate to start the season hitting over .300 the entire time. He is third on the team hitting .306 and is second on the team with 21 RBI.

He's had multiple hits in nine games and came up with an RBI in 13 games this season.

Going back to last season, Migueles had had an RBI in 13 straight games up until the UNLV game this season.

Migueles is also tied for the lead on the team with three home runs. He had a big three-run homer against Stanford to help force extra innings against one of the best teams in the nation.

SCHRAMM FILLS IN WHERE NEEDED

Freshman Dustyn Schramm made his first two appearances in a Utah uniform on the first two Sunday games. He earned a save in the victory against Nevada and earned the win against San Diego in the second weekend.

Through those first two outings, he didn't allow a run in 4.1 innings pitched and has struck out four and only walked two while giving up four hits.

Along with coming out of the bullpen, Schramm has gotten two starts on the mound against Stanford and BYU.

Against Stanford, he got his first career start and after a rocky start where he gave up five runs in the first two innings, he settled in only give up one more run over the next three innings allowing the Utes to get back into the game and force extra innings.

Against Grand Canyon, the freshman came out of the bullpen and set a career high with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched.

MCCLEVE IMPRESSIVE OUT OF PEN

Zac McCleve leads the team with 15 appearances out of the bullpen and currently holds a 3.22 ERA.

He has been highly effective only allowing eight earned runs in those appearances.

His longest outing of the season came against Oregon State, where he threw 4.0 innings. He had three strikeouts, but also gave up two runs.

EXPERIENCE RETURNING

There were times in the 2018 season when six freshmen were on the field at once because of injuries allowing them to earn good experience. This season, Utah is returning seven starters with more experience coming off the bench.

The team has 13 upper classmen led by outfielders Chandler Anderson, Erick Migueles and infielder Oliver Dunn.

Overall, Utah has 188 games started returning on the infield and even with the loss of DaShawn Keirse Jr., the outfield returns 125 starts from a season ago.

The projected starting pitchers for the season started in 20 games during the 2018 season.

SUMMER BALL

Four Utes had success in summer leagues across the country.

Dunn helped lead Wareham Gatemen win the 2018 Cape Cod Baseball League Championship. He hit .230 in the league in 34 games with 10 RBI and scored 19 runs.

Anderson had a huge summer for the Corvallis Knights. He was named Second Team All-WCL after hitting .337 and batting in 34 RBI. Anderson led the team with 22 stolen bases and was second on the team scoring 40 runs. He stepped up in the playoffs batting .474 as the Knights won their third WCL title in a row. The outfielder hit .318 through 54 games in the regular season.

Outfielder Dominic Foscalina played in the Alaska Baseball League for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots. He hit .267 and had 20 RBI on 20 hits. He played in 24 games.

Shea Kramer also had some success playing for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League and had 15 RBI on 20 hits in 35 games.

MLB DRAFT

DaShawn Keirse Jr. left after his junior season when he was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the fourth round.

The junior outfielder set a program record hitting .386 and having a 1.049 OPS. He had 78 hits on the season and scored 47 runs while also having 22 RBI.

In just three seasons, Keirse Jr. had a decorated career in a Utah uniform. He was a three-time All-Pac-12 member as well as a three-time Pac-12 All-Defensive Team member. After his record-setting season in 2018, he was named ABCA/Rawlings West All-Region second team. In 2016, he was a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and became the first Ute named to the Pac-12 Defensive Team.

600 CAREER VICTORIES

Head Coach Bill Kinneberg sits just six wins away from 600 career victories sitting at 596 after the victory over BYU during its first midweek matchup.

NEXT UP

Utah will begin a seven-game homestand with USC beginning on Thursday, April 11 at Smith's Ballpark.

The first game will be at 6 p.m. and the last two games will begin at 11:30 a.m. All three games will be broadcasted on Pac-12 Network.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.

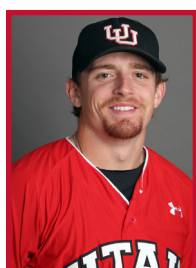

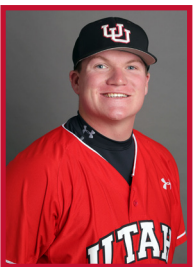
