SCOUTING THE COUGARS

BYU enters the year 5-2 after Wednesday night's 74-70 loss to Boise State, giving the Cougars their first loss at home on the year. Despite losses to the roster from last year's veteran squad, head coach Mark Pope still has a heavy supply of seniors and juniors on his team, including the team leader in scoring Alex Barcello (19.6 PPG) and Purdue transfer Matt Haarms (10.2 PPG).

Barcello, who is a former teammate of Timmy Allen on the AAU circuit, has led BYU in scoring in all but one game this season (USC). The senior also leads the team with a .620 shooting clip (min. 50 FGA), including a deadly .629 clip from range, and 23 assists. Freshman Caleb Lohner paces the team on the glass, averaging 6.3 rebounds to go with his 4.7 points per game. Haarms is the only other Cougar averaging in double-figures with 10.2 points per game to go with his team-high 12 blocks. Utah Valley transfer Brandon Averette is third on the team in scoring, averaging 8.7 points and 3.6 rebounds.

As a team, BYU has done a good job of sharing the ball with six different players collecting 10-plus assists on the year. Offensively through seven games, the 71 shots from downtown is ranked third nationally through games on Dec. 9 while the 120 assists is ranked second. On the glass, the 275 rebounds is second nationally, trailing Xavier with 278.

Individually, Barcello's offensive output has him ranked third in 3-point field-goals made (22), second in field-goals made (49), first in total points (137), 10th in 3-point field-goal percentage and 14th in total minutes. Haarms' 12 blocks checks in at No. 12.

BATTLE HISTORY

Since the rivalry began in 1909 there have only been 16 games between the Runnin' Utes and Cougars that have gone into overtime with Utah holding the edge 12-4 – including a 6-1 advantage in OT games when playing at home. Of those 16 games, only one has gone into double OT and two into triple OT.

LAST TIME OUT

It was all hands on deck this past Tuesday when the Utes took on Idaho State at home with six different players registering in double-figures led by freshman Pelle Larsson's 14 points. Utah's defense forced 19 turnovers that they were able to convert for 22 points. Offensively, the team shot a blazing 50.9-percent from the floor and .500 from 3-point range (9-of-18).

UP NEXT

Utah returns home for another non-conference game on Tuesday, Dec. 15, this time against in-state foe Utah Valley led by second-year head coach Mark Madsen. The second all-time meeting between the Utes and Wolverines will air on Pac-12 Networks with tip-off set for 5 p.m. (MT).

LOOK AHEAD

The Utes, for now, will complete their non-conference slate with a game against the Vandals of Idaho on Friday, Dec. 18. That game will air on Pac-12 Networks as well, but a tip-time is yet to be determined.

MOVING ON UP

After the game vs. Idaho State, Timmy Allen now has 917 career points. He's now just 83 points shy of becoming the 40th player in Utah basketball history to record 1,000 career points and the 21st Ute to do so as a junior.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Utah's team captains were selected over the weekend and Timmy Allen, Rylan Jones and Riley Battin were chosen by their teammates.

OPENING TREND

With last Thursday's win, Utah is now 98-16 overall in its home-openers and 78-13 all-time when those home-openers have also served as the season-opener.

LATE START

This season's Dec. 3 start is the latest date for a seasonopener in the modern era (1975-Pres.). The last time Utah kicked off a season on Dec. 3 or later was against No. 7 USC at home on Dec. as well – a 90-81 contest in favor of the Trojans. Since the start of the program, the Utes have opened a season on Dec. 3 six times and have gone 5-1 overall after this season's opener against UW.

RETURN OF THE SOPHOMORES...AND JUNIORS & SENIOR

After featuring arguably one of the nation's young team last year, Utah returns a majority of its offensive production. Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, Utah tops the league with 88.5-percent of its rebounding returning while also returning 87.6-percent of its steals. Meanwhile, the Runnin' Utes check in at No. 2 in scoring (85.7%), three-point field goals (85.8%) and assists (81.8%).

Compared to the rest of the returners in the league, Timmy Allen is seventh in points (892) fifth in rebounds (373), sixth in assists (163) and eighth in steals (63). In addition, sophomore Branden Carlson is sixth amongst active returners in the Pac-12 with 43 blocks his first year as a Ute.

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR

Heading into the 2020-21 season, Utah's roster boasts six international players – which ties them with 11 other schools for the fourth-most international players on a roster. Maine leads Division I with 11 while Cal Baptist has eight. Six schools, including a pair of teams in Arizona and Washington State, are tied for third with seven.

RUNNIN' UTES LOSE LONGTIME RADIO VOICE BILL MARCROFT

The Utah Athletics family mourned the passing of longtime radio play-by-play voice Bill Marcroft. Marcroft began work on Utah's men's basketball broadcasts on KALL Radio in December of 1966 and retired from his play-by-play duties of football and men's basketball after the 2005 Fiesta Bowl win over Pittsburgh, which capped the Utes' undefeated 2004 season.

Marcroft called Utah's football games from 1968-2004. A 1952 University of Utah graduate, Marcroft called 440 Utah football games and 1,088 men's basketball games,

END OF SEASON ODDS & ENDS

- The 16-15 (.516) record is the seventh-straight season Utah has finished the year above .500 under head coach Larry Krystkowiak.
- Utah's ninth-place finish was exactly where it was predicted in the preseason poll, which is uncharacteristic of Krystkowiak coached teams.
- Utah will return 97.7% of its scoring among players that saw action in 100+ minutes in 2019-20.
- The underclassmen accounted for 89.8% of the team's scoring.
- Utah is now 83-79 all-time in league play since joining the Pac-12 in 2011-12.
- Timmy Allen now has 892 career points as a Ute, and looks to become the 40th player to join the 1,000 points club next season.
- Krystkowiak is 171-126 (.576) after wrapping up his ninth season at the helm here on The Hill.
- Krystkowiak earned his 200th career-win when the Utes defeated Minnesota 73-69 at home.

PLUMMER MAKES HISTORY

Utah junior Alfonso Plummer was unconscious in the Pac-12 Tournament opening game against Oregon State, drilling a record 11 threes for a career-high 35 points. The 11 triples ties him with Davion Buster (Lamar) and Michael Ertel (ULM) for the most 3-pointers in a game this year. Plummer is just the 25th player to drain 10-plus threes in a game since the 2010-11 season per Basketball-Reference.

TA TAKES HOME HARDWARE

Utah sophomore Timmy Allen named to the All-Pac-12 Second-Team this past season. The following day, he became the 12th Runnin' Utes player to earn USBWA All-District Team honors.

It marked the eighth-straight season Utah has had a player

earn all-conference accolades since joining the Pac-12. He's also the first sophomore to earn All-Pac-12 honors since Jakob Poeltl in 2016.

Allen is the first Ute to earn USBWA All-District honors since Kyle Kuzma in 2017 and joins Jakob Poeltl (2016), Luke Nevill (2007) and Andrew Bogut (2005) as the only sophomores at Utah to garner the award.

The 6-6 forward led the Utes in scoring and rebounding all season, averaging 17.2 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.2 steals play.

Allen produced for the Utes throughout league action, reaching double-figures in all but two games while posting 20-plus points in four games – including four double-doubles. He was critical in the team's league-opener against Oregon State, scoring 25 points with 10 rebounds while playing all 40 minutes. Allen also helped the Utes end a four-game skid at home against Washington with 13 points, nine rebounds and three assists in a come from behind win over the Huskies.

The Mesa, Ariz., native registered his sixth double-double of the year against USC at home with 21 points and 10 rebounds to help the Utes split the weekend against the LA schools. Allen nearly had a double-double in each of the final two game of the regular-season, scoring a game-high 26 points and eight rebounds at Cal before returning home with 10 points and eight rebounds against Colorado – both thrilling overtime games.

CRUNCH TIME

Utah is 57-44 (.564) all-time in overtime games and 49-35 (.583) all-time in games that were decided in the first overtime period. Head coach Larry Krystkowiak is 11-8 all-time in overtime games since taking over the helm with a 5-2 mark at home, 3-6 mark on the road and 3-0 record in neutral site games.

RESUME BUILDING

FINNISH-ING STRONG

Freshman Mikael Jantunen started to pick up his production for the Utes and played with poise at the end of the season. The Helsinki, Finland, native averaged 5.8 points, 7.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists in his last fives games while shooting .476 from the floor. In addition, he is averaging 30.6 minutes in the last five games for Utah – which is the third-highest total on the team during that stretch. Jantunen ended the year shooting an amazing 66.1-percent from the field – which leads the team.

BOMBS AWAY

Junior sharpshooter Alfonso Plummer found himself in the lineup at the end of the season for head coach Larry Krystkowiak and thrived, averaging 19.4 points with a .552 shooting clip in his final five games. His first breakout game started with 16 points off the bench against UCLA before helping lead Utah past USC with a 18 points on 5-of-8 shooting from downtown. The following week, Plummer dropped a career-high 23 points at Cal on 5-of-8 shooting from beyond the arc. He then added 21 points at home against Colorado to help Utah overcome a double-digit deficit for the OT win against CU.

Plummer's breakout performance at the end of the year culminated with the junior guard dropping a career-high 35 points on 11-of-16 shooting from 3-point range - which broke the Utah, Pac-12 and Pac-12 Tournament record for most threes in a game. The previous tournament record for most threes in a game (8) was set by Klay Thompson back in 2011 the previous Pac-12 record was 10.

CUT ABOVE THE REST

At the end of last season, then sophomore Timmy Allen and then freshman Rylan Jones put up some great numbers per Basketball-Reference and stood above the rest.

• <u>Jones</u> is 1-of-5 freshmen to average at least 9.5 points, 2.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.0 steals per game.

• <u>Allen</u> is just 1-of-8 players to average at least 17.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals this season and is the only player from a Power-5 Conference.

SWAT LAKE CITY

Freshman Branden Carlson has had two of his best games against Stanford last season, swatting away eight Cardinal shots, not once, but twice – which tied Jason Washburn for the third-most blocks in a single-game. Washburn did it against Oregon State on Feb. 4, 2012, in Utah's first season in the Pac-12.

The freshman did it first against the Cardinal at home on Feb. 26 and again 20 days later in Palo Alto. Carlson swatted away five shots in the first half before adding another three in the second frame to tie his season-high of eight blocks in the second game. The South Jordan, Utah, native has now registered 16 of his 43 total blocks (37-percent) against Stanford.

<u>Per Basketball-Reference</u>, Carlson is just 1-of-3 players this season to register eight-plus blocks in a game multiple times. He's joined by Seton Hall's Romaro Gill and FIU's Osasumwen Osaghae.


Through games on March 8, Carlson is 1-of-28 player to register eight-plus blocks in a single-game this season in Division I. According to Basketball-Reference, there's only been 49 players (including Carlson) that have recorded 15 points, 10 rebounds and eight blocks in a single-game dating back to the 2010-11 season. Of those 49, six accomplished the feat in 2019-20 with three coming from a Power-5 Conference (Onyeka Okongwu, USC; Mike Watkins, Penn State; Branden Carlson, Utah) per Basketball-Reference.



- » Larry Krystkowiak was named Utah's 15th head coach on April 4, 2011.
- » Has guided Utah to five consecutive postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 3 NIT).
- » Has won 20 or more games in five of his first seven seasons, which included winning 27 contests in the 2015-16 campaign.
- » Was the only head coach in the Pac-12 Conference to develop three-consecutive NBA First Round draft picks from 2015-17:

Delon Wright
 Jakob Poeltl
 (2015; 20th pick overall, Toronto Raptors)
 (2016; 9th pick overall, Toronto Raptors)

- Kyle Kuzma (2017; 27th pick overall, New Jersey Nets to Los Angeles Lakers).

- » Went 42-20 (.677) in two seasons at Montana (2004-06), guiding the Grizzlies to a pair of Big Sky Conference Tournament Championships and two NCAA Tournament berths.
- » Got his first opportunity as a head coach with the CBA's Idaho Stampede (2003-04), where he guided the team to a 38-14 (.731) record and a trip to the CBA Finals in his lone season with the squad.
- » Served as an assistant coach with the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks in 2006-07 before being elevated to head coach with 17 games remaining in the season. He compiled a 31-68 record in his two seasons with the Bucks.
- » Served as an assistant coach with the NBA's New Jersey Nets (2010-11) alongside head coach Avery Johnson.
- » Was selected by the Chicago Bulls in the second round (28th overall pick) of the 1986 NBA Draft. Also played in the NBA for the San Antonio Spurs, Milwaukee Bucks, Utah Jazz, Orlando Magic and Los Angeles Lakers. He averaged 8.1 points and 4.9 rebounds per game in his nine-year playing career.
- » Is the only three-time Big Sky Player of the Year (1984-86) in the league's history and was a two-time Academic All-American at Montana (1982-86). He is still Montana's all-time career leader in points (2,017) and rebounds (1,105).

NCAA Infractions

On August 6, 2019, the NCAA Committee on Infractions released its statement on violations by the University of Utah men's basketball program. The two Level II violations are related to the recruitment of prospective student-athletes and a Level III violation involved the son of the head coach.

In April 2018, the coaches engaged in the off-campus recruitment of prospects during a time period when off-campus recruiting was not permitted. The coaches also coordinated a prospect's unofficial visit to Utah with a local two-year college, which triggered an official visit and caused the institution to exceed the official visit limit for the year. Level II violations were charged for the impermissible recruiting activities. The Level III violation was the result of a prospect-aged son of a coach participating in a single summer team practice.

The coaches and institution identified and self-reported the off-campus recruiting infractions, then collaborated with the NCAA to finalize the investigation into the on-campus visit. Utah's self-imposed penalties include: a \$5,000 financial penalty; off-campus recruiting ban from July 11-15, 2018; reduction of in-person recruiting days from 130 to 113 for 2018-2019; three-week ban on unofficial visits and complimentary admissions in November 2018; reduced official visits for 2018-2019 by eight percent; additional institutional and NCAA rules education for coaching staff members; one-year ban on the recruitment of local two-year college prospects (2019-2020); letter of reprimand delivered to coaches; the responsible staff member was suspended from coaching and recruiting for one week in November 2018; and all off-campus recruiting activities must be pre-approved by compliance.

In addition to the aforementioned penalties, the NCAA applied a two-year probationary period and imposed public reprimand and censure. Utah is also required to disassociate with the former local two-year college coach for a period of one year.
