HEAD COACH



KYLE KEPLER

Head Coach - 17th Year

Kyle Kepler is in his 17th year as the head coach of the Utah women's cross country and track & field programs. Kepler's organization and attention to detail have allowed him to develop a solid foundation and create a competitive program that has steadily improved each year.

Kepler has coached seven athletes to All-America honors at Utah. Amanda Mergaert was a five-time All-American, with her career culminating in first-team honors in 2013 in the indoor mile and the outdoor 1,500 to go with her cross country honors in 2012. Grayson Murphy was also a five-time All-American, including two first-team All-America honors in the 3,000 steeplechase, two second-team All-America honors in the indoor 5,000 and a 2017 cross country All-America distinction. Langley Iverson (2011, indoor high jump), Brianna LeRoy (2012, outdoor high jump), and Rosalie Waller (2014, outdoor 800) have also earned All-America honors at Utah under Kepler.

Most recently, Sarah Feeny earned All-America honors in the indoor mile. She was a first-team honoree finishing eighth overall at the 2019 NCAA Indoor Championships. It was the first All-American honor for Feeny and the third consecutive indoor All-American for the Utes. Poppy Tank was the latest distance runner under Kepler to earn All-America distinction with Tank garnering All-American honors in cross country and in the outdoor 10k – both were first time honors for the Plymouth, Devon, England native. Tank closed out her collegiate career holding the program record in the 10k (32:50.57, outdoors), second in the 5k (15:45.07, outdoors) and third in the 3k



(9:16.22, indoors).

Under Kepler, the Utes have had 58 athletes post 103 NCAA Outdoor preliminary qualifying marks, and sent 11 athletes to the NCAA Outdoor Championships. Mergaert (2011-13, 1,500) and Chelsea Shapard (2007-09, 400 hurdles) were both three-time NCAA attendees. Mergaert finished third in the 1,500 at NCAA's as a senior in 2013. She was the 2011 USTFCCA Mountain Region Women's Track Athlete of the Year. Kepler increased Utah's NCAA Outdoor Regional Championships attendees from five in 2006 to 10 in 2013. Tank, who qualified for both the 5k and 10k at the NCAA Outdoor Championships in 2021, became just the second Ute to keep in both distance races at the championships besides Jill Molen (1982).



The Utes have also sent three athletes to the NCAA Indoor Championships under Kepler, including Murphy twice in the 5,000 (2017-18). Mergaert (2012, mile) and Rebekah Winterton (2014, 5,000) have both won Mountain Pacific Sports Federation indoor track championships. Utah has set 18 outdoor and 15 indoor school records since 2006.

In cross country, Utah qualified for the NCAA Championships as a team for the first time in program history in 2015 and repeated the feat in 2016 and 2019. Kepler and the Utes earned their highest finish

of 16th at the NCAA Championships in 2019, improving four spots from 2016's finish and placed 26th in 2015. Utah made its national presence known at the Joe Piane Invite this past season, going head-to-head with some of the nation's best teams and came out victorious in a tight race against top-ranked Colorado. Following that inspiring performance, the Utes vaulted up and into the national rankings and came in with their highest ranking in program history at No. 6. At the conference championship, the women of Utah had a huge day recording their highest finish of third since joining the Pac-12 in 2011. Hosting the regional championships in 2019, Utah earned an at-large bid, securing fifth against arguably the toughest region in the nation. The Utes finished third in the region in 2015, their highest regional finish under Kepler.

He's also had athletes qualify individually for the NCAA cross country championship seven times. Murphy's eighth-place finish at the 2017 championships is the best finish for a Utah runner. Mergaert was a three-time cross country NCAA qualifier in addition to Tank's berth in 2021. The Utes have had 13 runners combine for 20 all-region honors while seven runners have earned 10 All-Pac-12 accolades.

During Utah's six years in the Mountain West Conference under Kepler, Utah student-athletes won nine outdoor conference titles and two indoor titles. Shapard was a three-time 400 hurdles

outdoor champion. Utah earned 23 outdoor and 20 indoor All-MWC honors.

Kepler's influence on his student-athletes is not just visible on the track, but also in the classroom. His cross country teams have earned USTFCCCA All-Academic Team honors 12 years while his track teams have earned honors eight times. His athletes have combined for 67 individual honors from the USTFCCCA between track and cross country. Lauren Endersen was a two-time CoSIDA Academic All-American in 2008 and 2009, while Waller earned honors in 2014.

Kepler is in his 23rd year coaching at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to coming to Utah, Kepler served as Northern Iowa's head men's and women's cross country coach and assistant track and field coach for two seasons. He was on staff at UNI for a total of seven years, serving as an assistant cross country coach for five years prior to being named head coach in 2003. Kepler was named the Missouri Valley Conference Men's Cross Country Coach of the Year in 2003 after leading the Panthers to a MVC title. The Panthers won 12 MVC titles among cross country and indoor and outdoor track during his tenure with the Panthers. He coached nine All-Americans at UNI, and 15 athletes qualified for the NCAA Championships between track and cross country.

At UNI, he served as the meet manager for the 2003 NCAA Cross Country Championships and Pre-Nationals meet. Kepler was also named the meet director of the annual A. D. Dickinson Relays, one of the largest high school indoor meets in the nation.

Kepler competed at Northern Iowa, taking part in both cross country and track and field for the Panthers and serving as a team captain during the 1997-98 school year. As an athlete, Kepler was a member of five MVC championship teams. He earned all-conference honors nine times during his collegiate career, was a two-time all-region cross country selection and a six-time Academic All-MVC honoree.

Kepler holds both master's and bachelor's degrees from Northern Iowa. He earned his master's degree in physical education in 2004 and graduated with a bachelor's in secondary education (geography) in 1998.

Kepler is married to Hannah Vickery and they have two daughters, five-year old Cora and two-year old Arielle.





ASSISTANT COACH



KELSEY QUINN Assistant Track and Cross Country Coach - 3rd Year

Quinn enters her third year with the Utah cross country and track & field teams after being hired in September of 2019.

In her first season with the Utes, Quinn worked primarily with those competing in cross country and distance group. The Utes

saw great success on the courses her first year during the cross country season with Utah claiming the Joe Plane Invitational and earning its highest ranking ever in program history at No. 6. The Women of Utah went to make their third NCAA Championships appearance and had the best finish in program history at 16th – four spots higher than the previous high.

Her second season was very much peculiar with the Pac-12 moving its season to the spring of 2021 due to COVID-19, but saw a mix of young and veterans set new PRs throughout the year. The shortened season culminated with Poppy Tank qualifying for the NCAA Regionals before earning All-America honors at the NCAA Cross Country Championships. Tank also garnered her second-straight First-Team All-Pac-12 honor after placing sixth for the second-straight year at the conference championships. Out on the track, Utah saw the outdoor 10k program record get broken twice. Bella Williams (33:17.07) was the first to break the 10k record on April 2 at the Hayward Premiere before Tank smashed her fellow countrywoman's mark by nearly 25 seconds with a time of 32:50.57 at the West Coast Relays.

Quinn comes to Salt Lake City after spending the past year as the assistant coach of the cross country/track & field teams at the University of Portland. The Marion, Iowa native assisted in leading the Portland men's cross country team to a third place finish at the 2018 NCAA Cross Country Championships, while seeing the women's cross country team record their best ever finish at the meet placing 12th. Between the two programs, Quinn coached five cross country All-Americans in 2018, which was a school record.

Also instrumental for the track and field team, Quinn helped coach Portland's Taryn Rawlings to a fourth place finish in the

mile at the NCAA Indoor Championships and a ninth place finish in the 1500M at the NCAA Outdoor Championships. The Pilots also set four new school records this past year under the guidance of Quinn.

Quinn also brings Pac-12 experience to Utah after serving as the Director of Operations for the Washington track & field/cross country teams. During her one-year stint in Seattle, Quinn was tasked with directing five indoor track and field meets that accommodated over 1,500 student-athletes from 40+ teams at each meet.

From the fall of 2015 through the spring of 2017, Quinn was the head coach at Warner Pacific College in Portland, Ore. Quinn was responsible for all aspects of the NAIA program. Her obligations included recruiting, budgeting, implementing workout programs, and travel. Quinn's first full-time coaching position came at Grand View University in Des Moines, Iowa.

Before beginning her coaching career, Quinn was a member of the track and field team at the University of Iowa where she qualified for the NCAA West Preliminary Championships in the 400M hurdles and as a member of the 4x400M relay team. The sprinter and hurdler made her way into the top-10 lists at Iowa at the time for performances in both events.

Along with her cross country and track & field experience, Quinn held intern positions at both University of Iowa and Iowa State's strength and conditioning departments. Quinn designed and implemented conditioning workouts and learned sport-specific lifting techniques.

Quinn graduated with a bachelor's degree in Interdepartmental Studies from the University of Iowa where she was a two-time Big Ten All-Academic selection. She then went on to complete a master's degree in Kinesiology at Iowa State.

She is married to Riley Quinn and recently had a daughter, Willow. Husband Riley is also a volunteer coach with the Utah cross country and track & field team.



VOLUNTEER COACH



GRAYSON MURPHY Volunteer Cross Country and Track Coach - 1st Year

Five-time All-American Grayson Murphy begins her second season with the Utes as a volunteer coach with the cross country and track & field program.

Arguably, one of Utah's most decorated athlete in program history, Murphy has also seen

success on the pro circuit. She most recently defended her USATF Mountain Racing Championship crown in August (2021) after breaking the course record by nearly nine minutes at the Skibowl Ski Resort. Back in 2019, Murphy captured her first USATF Mountain Racing Championship title and earned a spot on Team USA at the World Mountain Running Championships. She then turned around and captured the World Mountain Running Championship title two months later in Argentina.

In just two years, Murphy left her mark on the Utah program in the record books and still holds the school record in the outdoor 3000m steeplechase (9:48.57) and indoor 5k (15:44.45). She is also third in the outdoor 5k (15:58.29), third in the outdoor 10k (33:17.85) and sixth in the indoor 3k (9:29.71).

Murphy also racked up the awards during her time at the U, garnering back-to-back first-team All-America honors in the outdoor 3000m steeplechase (2017 & 2018), consecutive second-team All-America honors in the indoor 5000m (2017 & 2018) and All-America honors in cross country (2017). Additionally, she earned all-region honors in cross country back-to-back season (2016 & 2017) and was a two-time All-Pac-12 honoree in cross country – including first-team honors in 2017.

A standout in the classroom, Murphy was also a two-time USTFCCCA All-Academic honoree in cross country (2016 & 2017) and a 2017 USTFCCCA All-Academic recipient in track.

Murphy started her career at Santa Clara, where she competed her first two collegiate seasons. Her 6k time of 20:46 is still second-best in program history for the Broncos in cross country. Meanwhile, she's still the program leader in the outdoor 1500m (4:27.67) and 3000m steeplechase (10:23.22) while her outdoor 3000m (9:59.20) and 5000m (16:26.70) are still second-fastest in Santa Clara history.

Murphy graduated summa cum laude from Utah with a degree in civil engineering in 2018.

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS



MICHAEL TAMAYO Director of Operations - 3rd Year

Michael Tamayo is in his third year after joining the Utah staff in the fall of 2019 as the Director of Operations.

Tamayo joins the University of Utah from Charlotte, N.C., where he competed at UNC Charlotte (2011-2016) as a member of the Track and Field program. Post

collegiately, Tamayo was a volunteer coach at UNC Charlotte, as well as co-managing the top local running specialty store in the city.

Competing at UNC Charlotte, Tamayo was the school-record holder in the 600m, 800m, 100m and the 1500m events, which two records still stand today. In 2017, Tamayo competed in the 1000m semifinals of the USA Championships, after finishing his collegiate career at the first round of the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the 800 meters. Tamayo's career-best time of 1:48.94 in the 800m event, still stands as the school's all-time record at UNC Charlotte.

Michael is one of three children belonging to David and Sheliah Tamayo, who currently reside in central North Carolina. His sister, Claire, is a proud middle-school social studies teacher, and his brother, David, currently attends UNC Charlotte seeking his bachelor's degree.
