### NOTABLES

• **LAST TEST BEFORE LEAGUE PLAY:** Texas hosts its final contest of the 2018 calendar year before starting Big 12 Conference play on Jan. 2 at K-State.

• **UTA CONNECTION:** UTA first-year head coach Chris Ogden was a four-year letterwinner (2000-03) and captain of the 2003 Final Four team at Texas.

• **WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?:** In UT's seven victories this season, the Longhorns have averaged 81.1 ppg on 45.7% FG shooting (36.6% 3FG) and have a +4.7 rebound margin. In UT's four losses, the Horns have averaged 61.2 ppg on 36.9% FG shooting (23.5% 3FG) and have a -7.0 rebound margin.

• **HAYES ON A STREAK:** Freshman F Jaxson Hayes is shooting a team-best 74.6-percent (47-63) on the year and owns a current streak of 16 consecutive field goals made. He went 6-6 vs. Purdue, 4-4 vs. Grand Canyon and 6-6 vs. Providence (after missing his final attempt vs. VCU).

## UTA SERIES INFO

- Friday's game marks the 13th meeting between Texas and UTA.
- Each of the previous 12 contests have been held at the Frank Erwin Center.
- UT holds an 11-1 lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 116-66 Texas win on Nov. 28, 1989 in Austin.
- The Longhorns won the first 11 meetings in the series, before UTA posted a 72-61 victory in Austin on Nov. 29, 2016.

## FORMER PLAYER RETURNS AS VISITING COACH

- First-year UTA head coach **Chris Ogden** was a four-year letterwinner (2000-03) at Texas.
- He served as captain for the 2003 Final Four team.
- Ogden also spent 12 seasons on the coaching staff with the Longhorns, including eight as an assistant coach (2007-15).

## HORNS AT HOME

- UT is in its 42nd season of play at the Frank Erwin Center. The Longhorns have registered an all-time record of 505-126 (.800) in the building.
- **Texas is 233-43 (.844) at the Erwin Center in the last 17 seasons (dating to the start of the 2002-03 season).**
- UT is 42-17 at home during the Shaka Smart era (5-3 this year).
- The Horns have recorded three consecutive home wins against AP Top 20 opponents (defeated No. 16 TCU, No. 8 Texas Tech and No. 12 Oklahoma last year).

## PROVIDENCE GAME NOTES

- The all-time series is tied at 3-3 following Providence's win.
- **Matt Coleman III** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the fifth time this year (11 games) and 21st time in his career (45 games).
- **Jase Febres** set a career high in minutes played (34), previous: 30 vs. TCU on Jan. 10, 2018.
- **Royce Hamm Jr.** tied his career high in minutes played (14), also set at Texas Tech on Jan. 31, 2018.
- **Jaxson Hayes** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the seventh time this year (11 games). He converted ALL of his field goal attempts (6-6) for the third straight contest.

- **Elijah Mitrou-Long** set UT career highs in steals (4) and minutes played (30).
- **Dylan Osetkowski** posted a double-double (12 points, 10 rebounds) for the fourth time this year (11 games) and seventh time in his UT career (45 games). He reached double figures in scoring for the seventh time this season and 32nd time in his UT career. Osetkowski reached double digits for the fifth time this year and 10th time in his UT career.
- **Courtney Ramey** reached double figures in scoring (10 points) for the second straight game and fourth time this year (11 games).
- **Kerwin Roach II** did not play (stomach illness).

## 20-WIN MARK

- **Texas has reached the 20-win mark 16 times in the last 19 seasons.**
- UT has reached the 20-win plateau a total of 31 times in its previous 112 seasons of basketball.
- Texas had a school-record streak of 13 consecutive 20-win seasons from 1999-2000 through 2011-12.

## A CONSISTENT DANCER

- Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 18 of the last 20 seasons. UT is one of 8 schools to appear in at least 18 of the last 20 NCAA tourneys.
- Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 26 of the last 30 seasons. UT is one of 6 schools to appear in at least 26 of the last 30 NCAA tourneys.
- UT has made a total of 34 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (35-37 record).

## YEAR 4 OF THE SHAKA SMART ERA

- **Shaka Smart** was introduced as the 24th head basketball coach at The University of Texas on April 3, 2015.
- The 41-year-old Smart spent six seasons (2009-15) at Virginia Commonwealth University, leading the Rams to an overall record of 163-56 (.744) and five NCAA Tournament appearances including the 2011 Final Four.
- Smart has posted a 57-54 (.514) mark in four seasons in Austin. He has led the Longhorns to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2016 and 2018) in his first three years.

- **In 10 seasons overall as a collegiate head coach, Smart has compiled a 220-110 (.667) record.** Seven of his first nine teams have advanced to NCAA Tournament play.

#### PRESEASON ALL-BIG 12 HONORS

- Senior G **Kerwin Roach II** and sophomore F **Jericho Sims** were named to the preseason All-Big 12 Conference Honorable Mention team.

#### WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE??

- Offensive production and rebounding have been the primary difference-makers in UT's wins and losses this year.
- In UT's seven victories, the Longhorns have averaged 81.1 points per contest while hitting 45.7-percent (197-431) from the field, including a 36.6-percent mark (74-202) from 3-point range.
- Texas has registered a +4.7 rebound margin (39.3-34.6) in its seven wins.
- During UT's four losses, the Longhorns have averaged 61.2 points per contest while hitting 36.9-percent (89-241) from the field, including a 23.5-percent mark (24-102) from 3-point range.
- Texas has recorded a -7.0 rebound margin (33.8-40.8) in its four defeats.

#### SHARE & PROTECT THE ROCK

- **Texas has recorded a 157-to-135 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.16) in its first 11 games.** The Longhorns have committed just 12.3 turnovers per contest this season.
- In the season opener vs. Eastern Illinois (Nov. 6), the Longhorns had 20 assists on their 26 field goals made.
- In the home win vs. ULM (Nov. 12), Texas committed just 9 turnovers.
- UT posted an 18-to-7 assist-to-turnover ratio in the victory vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- The Longhorns had 17 assists on 23 field goals made in the home win against No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).
- Texas registered a season-high 22 assists on 37 field goals made in the victory vs. Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).

#### FORCING TURNOVERS

- UT has forced an average of 15.0 turnovers per game in the first 11 contests.
- The Longhorns own a +2.7 turnover margin (12.3-15.0) this season.

#### BENCH PRODUCTION

- The Texas bench has outscored the opponent's bench in nine of UT's first 11 contests this year.
- The Longhorns have registered a **+10.8** (26.4-15.6) margin in bench scoring through the first 11 games.

#### LONG-RANGE SUCCESS

- In the home win against Grand Canyon (Dec. 15), the Longhorns hit 16-of-30 (.533) from 3-point range. The 16 threes marked a tie for the second-most threes made in a game in school history. It is the most threes made by Texas since UT hit 16 vs. New Mexico State on Nov. 23, 2007.
- UT hit 10-of-17 (.588) from 3-point range in the first half against Grand Canyon. The 10 threes made marked a tie for the fourth-most threes made in a half in school history. It is the most threes made in a half by Texas since UT hit 11 at Kansas (first half) on March 3, 2007.

#### SENIOR LEADERSHIP

- For the first time since the 2015-16 season (Coach Smart's first year at UT) when Texas had 5 seniors in its playing rotation, the Longhorns will feature an experienced, returning senior as a major piece in their lineup. **In fact, Texas will lean on a pair of seniors: G Kerwin Roach II and F Dylan Osetkowski.**
- Both Roach II and Osetkowski are on pace to earn their degrees (Roach in Physical Culture & Sports, Osetkowski in American Studies) in May 2019.
- Roach has played in 106 career games (70 starts) during his four years in Austin.
- Osetkowski is in his fifth year of collegiate basketball. He spent his first two years at Tulane (65 career games) before transferring to UT prior to the 2016-17 season. After sitting out that year due to NCAA transfer rules, he has played and started all 45 games during his two seasons with the Longhorns.

## ROACH'S RESUME

**Kerwin Roach II** is in his fourth season in the backcourt rotation and has played in 106 career games (70 starts). Roach has topped the 20-point mark eight times and reached double figures in scoring 53 times in his career. He has two career double-doubles and has reached double figures in rebounds three times.

- **He leads the team in scoring (14.3 ppg), assists (39, 4.3 apg) and minutes (31.6 mpg) and ranks second in rebounding (5.1 rpg) and third in steals (14).**
- Roach has reached double figures in scoring in seven of his first nine contests.
- He tallied 15 points (6-8 FG, 2-3 threes) and 5 assists against 1 turnover in 22 minutes against Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).
- Roach recorded 10 points (2-4 threes, 4-4 FT), 4 rebounds, 5 assists against just 1 turnover and tied a career high with 2 blocks in 30 minutes against No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).
- He tallied 15 points, 4 boards, 3 assists without a turnover and 3 steals in 26 minutes vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- Roach registered a team-high 13 points, 6 assists against just 2 turnovers, 4 boards and 2 steals in 38 minutes vs. ULM (Nov. 12).
- In his season debut vs. Arkansas (Nov. 9), he posted a double-double with a team-high 18 points and 11 rebounds in 39 minutes. He tied his career high in rebounds (set twice previously) and recorded his first double-double since he had 15 points and 11 boards vs. Vanderbilt on Jan. 30, 2016 (in his freshman season).

## ROACH ENJOYS VEGAS

- **Kerwin Roach II** averaged 23.5 points, 6.0 assists, 3.5 steals and 4.0 rebounds in 33.5 minutes per game during UT's two contests at the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational.
- He converted 16-29 (.552) FG, including 6-12 (.500) from 3-point range, and posted a 12-to-5 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Roach earned a spot on the 7-person All-Tournament Team.
- In the win vs. No. 7/6 North Carolina (Nov. 22), he registered a career-high 32 points (career-best 12-15 FG, 3-3 threes, 5-7 FT), 7 assists, 6 rebounds and 4 steals in 34 minutes.
- **Per Stats by Stats, in the past 20 years, the only other major conference player to reach those numbers in points-assists-rebounds and steals is LSU's Ben Simmons (Dec. 2, 2015).**
- Roach followed with a team-high 15 points, 5 assists and 3 steals in 33 minutes vs. No. 11/11 Michigan State (Nov. 23).

## ROACH JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

- With his 3-pointer at the 4:19 mark of the second half vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16), **Kerwin Roach II became the 37th player in UT program history to join the 1,000-point club.**
- He enters Friday's contest with 1,088 points scored in 106 career games (10.3 ppg).

## ROACH PLAYS 'STOPPER'

- **Kerwin Roach II** has proven to be one of the top perimeter defenders in the Big 12 Conference during his career.
- Last year, he held Duke's Grayson Allen to 12 points (4-11 FG, 2-7 threes) in 25 minutes (Nov. 24, 2017).
- Roach had primary responsibility on Alabama's Collin Sexton (entered the game leading the SEC at 21.4 ppg) and limited Sexton to 8 points (4-12 FG) in 32 minutes during UT's road win on Dec. 22, 2017.
- He held Texas Tech's Keenan Evans to 11 points (3-8 FG, 0-5 threes) and 4 turnovers in 36 minutes during UT's home win on Jan. 17, 2018.

## OSETKOWSKI IN SENIOR YEAR

**Dylan Osetkowski** (pronounced: oh-set-COW-skee) is in his second season at UT in the frontcourt rotation and fifth year of college basketball. He has played and started in all 45 career games in his two seasons at Texas. Osetkowski has recorded seven double-doubles and reached double figures in scoring 32 times and in rebounds 10 times. He has topped the 20-point mark five times.

- **Through the first 11 games this season, Osetkowski leads the team in rebounding (8.5 rpg) and double-doubles (4), ranks second in scoring (10.6 ppg) and steals (15) and third in minutes (28.5 mpg).**
- He has reached double figures in scoring in seven games and recorded double digits in rebounds in five contests.
- Osetkowski tallied 12 points (5-7 FT) and a game-high 10 rebounds in 31 minutes against Providence (Dec. 21).
- He registered 10 points (4-7 FG, 2-3 threes) and a game-high 7 boards (4 offensive) in 21 minutes vs. Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).
- Osetkowski posted a career-high 17 rebounds (previous high: 14 vs. New Hampshire on Nov. 14, 2017) to go along with 9 points and 2 blocks in 36 minutes vs. Radford (Nov. 30).
- He tallied 13 points (5-11 FG) and tied a career high with 4 steals in 29 minutes vs. No. 11/11 Michigan State (Nov. 23).
- Osetkowski recorded 14 points (4-8 FG, 4-6 FT) and 5 rebounds in 33 minutes vs. No. 7/6 North Carolina (Nov. 22).
- He registered 15 points (7-14 FG), 11 rebounds (6 offensive), 3 steals and 2 blocks in 26 minutes vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- Osetkowski tallied 12 points (4-8 FG, 3-3 FT) and 10 boards in 29 minutes vs. ULM (Nov. 12).
- He recorded a double-double (11 points, 13 rebounds) and added 3 steals in 39 minutes against Arkansas (Nov. 9). Six of his 13 rebounds came on the offensive glass.

## COLEMAN III AT THE POINT

Sophomore G **Matt Coleman III** returns for his second year as the starting point guard. **This marks the first time since the 2015-16 season that Coach Smart has the luxury of a returning point guard** (Isaiah Taylor in 2015-16). Coleman has played and started all 45 games in his two years at UT. He has reached double figures in scoring 21 times and topped the 20-point mark five times.

- **Through the first 11 games this year, he is tied for third on the team in scoring (10.5 ppg), second in minutes (30.9 mpg), third in assists (33, 3.0 apg) and fourth in steals (9).**
- Coleman has reached double figures in scoring in five contests and has posted a 33-to-23 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.43).
- He registered 13 points and 4 rebounds in 34 minutes vs. Providence (Dec. 21).
- **Coleman tallied a season-high 22 points (7-11 FG, 3-5 threes, 5-6 FT) in 31 minutes in the home win vs. No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).**
- He recorded 13 points (5-6 FT) in 32 minutes vs. No. 11/11 Michigan State (Nov. 23).
- Coleman registered 16 points (2-3 threes) and 5 assists in 32 minutes vs. No. 7/6 North Carolina (Nov. 22).
- He tallied a team-high 13 points (5-9 FG) and 7 assists against 2 turnovers in 31 minutes against Eastern Illinois (Nov. 6).

## FEBRES FINDING HIS ROLE

Sophomore G **Jase Febres** (pronounced: JAYCE FEB-rus) has played in 42 games (28 starts) in his first two seasons. He started 17 of the last 20 contests to end his freshman year. Febres has reached double figures in scoring six times.

- Through the first 11 games this season, Febres ranks sixth on the team in scoring (6.6 ppg) while hitting 35.2-percent (19-54) from three-point range in 21.3 mpg.
- He posted a season-high 16 points (6-13 FG, 4-10 threes) and 5 rebounds (3 offensive) in 20 minutes against Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).
- Febres had a career-high 6 rebounds (all in the first half) in the home win against No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).
- He registered 12 points (4-5 threes) in 18 minutes vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).

## MITROU-LONG SHAKES OFF THE RUST

Junior G **Elijah Mitrou-Long** (pronounced: MEE-true) is playing a key role in the UT backcourt rotation after sitting out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

- **Through the first 11 games this year, Mitrou-Long leads the team in steals (17) and ranks fourth in assists (29, 2.6 apg), fifth in scoring (7.6 ppg) and sixth in rebounding (3.4 rpg).**
- He has posted a 29-to-15 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.93) in 22.1 mpg and has reached double figures in scoring three times.
- He registered a UT career-high 4 steals to go along with 9 points and 4 assists in a season-best 30 minutes against Providence (Dec. 21).
- Mitrou-Long tallied a UT career-high 16 points (6-8 FG, 3-3 threes), 4 rebounds, 4 assists without a turnover and 2 steals in a season-high 28 minutes vs. Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).

- He recorded 10 points (3-6 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-2 FT), 5 rebounds and 3 assists in 24 minutes vs. No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).
- Mitrou-Long registered season highs in rebounds (7) and steals (3) and tied his season high with 6 assists against just 1 turnover in 23 minutes vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- He tallied 10 points (5-6 FT) in 24 minutes against Arkansas (Nov. 9).
- Mitrou-Long earned the start in the season opener vs. Eastern Illinois (Nov. 6) and posted 9 points (4-8 FG), a team-high 6 rebounds, 6 assists and a team-best 3 steals in 24 minutes.
- He spent his freshman and sophomore seasons (2015-16 and 2016-17) at Mount St. Mary's. He played in 66 career games (58 starts) for the Mountaineers and converted 37-percent from three-point range over his two-year career.
- Mitrou-Long earned First-Team All-Northeast Conference honors as a sophomore (2016-17) while averaging 15.0 ppg, 5.2 rpg, 4.4 apg and 1.6 spg in 34.4 mpg.

## SIMS LOOKS TO MAKE SOPHOMORE LEAP

Sophomore F **Jericho Sims** returns for his second year in the UT frontcourt. Sims has played in 45 games (22 starts) in his two seasons at Texas. He has reached double figures in scoring seven times and in rebounds once.

- Through the first 11 games this year, he is fourth on the team in rebounding (4.5 rpg), second in blocks (8) and seventh in scoring (6.4 ppg) while averaging 19.5 mpg.
- Sims posted a team-high 14 points (7-9 FG), 6 rebounds and 1 block in 24 minutes vs. VCU (Dec. 5). He set a career high in FG made.
- He tallied a season-high 16 points (6-9 FG), 8 rebounds and 1 block in 26 minutes vs. Radford (Nov. 30). His 16 points were one shy of his career high (17 vs. West Virginia on March 3, 2018).
- Sims registered 14 points (4-7 FG, 6-10 FT), 5 boards and 2 blocks in 36 minutes against Arkansas (Nov. 9). His 6 FT made marked a career high (previous: 5 vs. West Virginia on March 3, 2018).

## HAMM JR. ADDING STRENGTH

Sophomore F **Royce Hamm Jr.** played in 17 games as a freshman. He added 15 pounds of muscle in the offseason and is attempting to play a more consistent role as an energy guy who adds physicality to the rotation, both defensively and attacking the glass.

- After missing the first three games this year due to a right knee injury, Hamm Jr. saw his first action vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16) and registered 3 points and 2 boards in 3 minutes.
- He recorded a career-high 7 points (2-3 FG, 3-4 FT) and tied his career high with 5 rebounds in 7 minutes vs. Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).
- Hamm posted 4 points, 4 boards and 1 block while tying his career high in minutes (14) against Providence (Dec. 21).

## AJ1 CONTINUES TO MAKE IMPROVEMENT

Junior G **Andrew Jones** was diagnosed with leukemia in early January 2018. He underwent successful treatment in the spring and summer at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, then enrolled in fall classes and re-joined the team earlier this fall. Here's a timeline of Andrew's battle and continuing recovery:

- May 2017: Went through NBA Pre-Draft Combine following his freshman season but decided to withdraw his name from the draft pool and return to UT for his sophomore season.
- Dec. 5, 2017: Suffered a fracture in his right wrist during the final minutes of the win at VCU and missed the next four games.
- Dec. 29, 2017 and Jan. 1, 2018: Returns to the court but only plays limited minutes (9 vs. Kansas, 11 at Iowa State).
- Jan. 9, 2018 (night): Shaka Smart informs the Texas team that Jones has been diagnosed with leukemia.
- Jan. 10, 2018: Andrew's family (through UT) publicly announces Jones' diagnosis.
- Jan. 19, 2018: Moved to The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston.
- Feb. 24, 2018: Released from MD Anderson Cancer Center and began receiving treatments on an outpatient basis.
- June 7, 2018: Jones is approved to enroll in web-based coursework for first session of summer school at UT. Allowed to move into a dorm room and uses the room during the times he is on campus over the summer.
- Aug. 24, 2018: Finishes latest round of treatment at MD Anderson Cancer Center and heads to Austin to move back into the dorm.
- Aug. 29, 2018: Began fall classes at UT and allowed to participate in basketball-related activities.
- **Nov. 6, 2018:** Entered the Eastern Illinois game at the 11:40 mark of the second half. Saw 9 minutes of playing time and recorded 1 point (1-2 FT), 1 board, 1 assist and 1 steal in his first game action since Jan. 1, 2018 at Iowa State.
- **Dec. 11, 2018:** Returned to MD Anderson to begin next round of pre-scheduled treatment (expected return to UT in early January).

## JONES ON THE COURT

**Andrew Jones** has played in 45 career games (31 starts) in his first three years in Austin. He has reached double figures in scoring 29 times.

- Jones played in 10 games (8 starts) as a sophomore (2017-18). He averaged 13.5 ppg in 22.6 mpg while converting 52.2-percent (47-90) from the floor, including 46.3-percent (19-41) from three-point range.
- As a freshman in 2016-17, he tied for the team lead in assists (117, 3.5 apg) and ranked second in steals (41), third in scoring (11.4 ppg), fourth in minutes (27.9 mpg) and tied for fourth in rebounding (3.9 rpg).

## FOUNDATIONAL FRESHMAN CLASS

The Longhorns feature a five-man freshman class that ranked as the No. 8 recruiting class in the country by ESPN and 247Sports. This comes on the heels of the five-man class in 2017 that ranked as the No. 5 class in the nation by Rivals.

- **Brock Cunningham** averaged 14.8 ppg, 10.8 rpg and 3.8 apg as a senior at Westlake HS (Austin, Texas). He led Westlake to a 36-4 record and a trip to the Class 6A state semifinals as a senior.
- **Jaxson Hayes** was ranked the No. 89 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN. He averaged 12 points, seven rebounds and four

blocks per game while leading Moeller HS (Cincinnati, Ohio) to a 27-3 record and the Division I state title. Hayes set the school single-season record for most blocks (123) and registered 9 blocks in a pair of contests as a senior.

- **Kamaka Hepa** was ranked the No. 47 prospect in the nation by Rivals. He averaged 16.5 ppg, 10.4 rpg and 6.2 bpg as a senior while helping Jefferson advance to the 6A state championship game. Hepa earned Gatorade State Player of the Year honors in Oregon following his senior year. He led Jefferson to the 6A state title as a junior. Hepa was a two-time Gatorade State Player of the Year in Alaska, leading Barrow HS to back-to-back 3A state titles as a freshman and sophomore.
- **Gerald Liddell** was ranked the No. 41 overall prospect in the nation by 247Sports and No. 47 by ESPN. He averaged 16.5 ppg, 8.7 rpg and 1.5 bpg as a senior while leading Steele to a 32-3 mark.
- **Courtney Ramey** was ranked the No. 34 overall prospect in the nation by 247Sports. The all-time leader at Webster Groves HS in points (1,838) and assists (521), he averaged 21.8 ppg, 6.7 rpg and 6.6 apg as a senior while leading his team to a 22-9 mark and the school's second straight Class 5 state title.

## HAYES MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Freshman F **Jaxson Hayes leads the team in blocks (27, 2.45 bpg) and is third on the squad in rebounding (4.8 rpg) and tied for third in scoring (10.5 ppg) while averaging 20.6 mpg.** He has converted **74.6-percent** (47-63) from the floor on the season and has reached double figures in scoring in seven of UT's first 11 games.
- **In the last three games, Hayes is a perfect 16-for-16 from the field.**
- He recorded 13 points (6-6 FG) and 2 blocks in 21 minutes against Providence (Dec. 21).
- Hayes posted 14 points (6-6 FG, 2-2 FT) and 3 blocks in 26 minutes in the home win vs. No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).
- **He earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (Nov. 26)** honors for his play in the two games at the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational. He averaged 13.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 3.0 bpg and 1.5 spg in 26.0 mpg while converting 9-11 (.818) FG and 8-10 (.800) FT.
- Hayes joined teammate Kerwin Roach II on the 7-person All-Tournament Team at the Las Vegas Invitational.
- He tallied 11 points (4-6 FG, 3-4 FT), 3 blocks and a season-high 3 steals in 27 minutes against No. 11/11 Michigan State (Nov. 23).
- Hayes registered a season-high 15 points (5-5 FG, 5-6 FT), 9 rebounds and 3 blocks in 25 minutes vs. No. 7/6 North Carolina (Nov. 22).
- **He earned Phillips 66 Big 12 co-Newcomer of the Week (Nov. 19)** honors for his play in the two home wins against ULM and The Citadel. Hayes averaged 11.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 2.0 bpg in 21.0 mpg while converting 69.2-percent (9-13) field goals in the two contests.
- Hayes posted 12 points (4-5 FG), 7 rebounds (4 offensive) and 1 block in 16 minutes vs. The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- He tallied 11 points (5-8 FG), 5 boards and 3 blocks in 26 minutes against ULM (Nov. 12).
- In his collegiate debut, Hayes registered 12 points (5-9 FG), 4 rebounds and 2 blocks in 20 minutes vs. Eastern Illinois (Nov. 6).

## RAMEY PROVIDES SPARK

- **Courtney Ramey** ranks second on the team in assists (34, 3.1 apg) and eighth in scoring (6.1 ppg) while averaging 18.3 mpg.
- Ramey has reached double figures in scoring in four contests.
- He recorded 10 points, 3 boards and 3 assists in 22 minutes against Providence (Dec. 21).
- **Ramey posted 10 points (4-6 FG, 2-4 threes) and a career-high 8 assists while adding 4 boards and 2 steals in 19 minutes vs. Grand Canyon (Dec. 15).**
- He recorded a season-high 13 points (3-7 threes) in 21 minutes against The Citadel (Nov. 16).
- Ramey registered 10 points (4-6 FG, 2-3 threes), 3 boards and 2 assists without a turnover in 16 minutes vs. Arkansas (Nov. 9). His floater with 47 seconds remaining in OT proved to be the game-winner.

## HEPA WINS GOLD FOR TEAM USA

- Prior to enrolling in classes this summer, freshman F **Kamaka Hepa** earned a spot on 12-person USA U18 National Team.
- Hepa and Team USA won a gold medal at the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship, held June 10-16 at St. Catharines, Canada.
- During the six-game tourney, Hepa averaged 3.3 ppg and 5.0 rpg in just 9.8 mpg.
- Through the first 11 games this year, he is averaging 2.0 ppg and 1.6 rpg in 10.5 mpg.
- Hepa had 5 points, 3 rebounds and 2 assists without a turnover in a season-high 23 minutes vs. No. nr/24 Purdue (Dec. 9).

## BUZZER BEATERS UNDER SMART

- The Longhorns have won four contests during the **Shaka Smart** era on game-winning field goals in the final 2.0 seconds.
- **Javan Felix** hit a jumper as time expired to beat No. 3/3 North Carolina 84-82 in Austin on Dec. 12, 2015.
- **Isaiah Taylor** went coast-to-coast and hit a running floater high off the glass with 1.1 seconds left for the 75-73 victory at Stanford on Dec. 19, 2015.
- **Andrew Jones** hit a 3-pointer from 25 feet with 1.8 seconds left to lift Texas to an 84-83 home win against Oklahoma on Jan. 23, 2017.
- **Kerwin Roach II** made a driving lay-up with 1.2 seconds left to beat Oklahoma State 65-64 on Feb. 24, 2018.

## UT INKS 3 DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

**Will Baker** (Austin, Texas), **Kai Jones** (Nassau, Bahamas) and **Donovan Williams** (Houston, Texas) signed National Letters of Intent to play basketball next season at The University of Texas on Nov. 14. The trio will join the Longhorns for the 2019-20 season. The three-man class is currently No. 10 nationally in the Rivals team rankings and No. 11 in the 247Sports composite.

- **Baker** (6-11, 250), a center from Westlake HS who plays under Robert Lucero, is ranked as the No. 15 prospect in the nation by Rivals, No. 20 by 247Sports composite and No. 26 by ESPN. He averaged 19.4 ppg and 8.6 rpg while leading Westlake to a 36-4 mark and a trip to the Class 6A state semifinals in his junior year.

- **Jones** (6-10, 200), a forward from Brewster Academy (Wolfeboro, N.H.) who plays under coach Jason Smith, is ranked as the No. 45 prospect in the nation by ESPN and No. 53 by 247Sports composite. Originally from Nassau, Bahamas, he came to the United States prior to his junior year and attended Orlando Christian Prep (Orlando, Fla.) last season. He helped Orlando Christian Prep to a 21-9 mark and the Class 3A state title as a junior.
- **Williams** (6-5, 175), a guard from Fort Bend Elkins HS (Houston, Texas) who plays under Albert Thomas, is ranked as the No. 50 prospect nationally by 247Sports and No. 51 by Rivals. He averaged 13.2 ppg while leading Elkins to a 29-12 mark and a trip to the Class 5A state quarterfinals as a junior.

## IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Friday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 936 consecutive games.**
- In fact, UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,064 of 1,071 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

## NEW ARENA ANNOUNCEMENT

- The University of Texas and a group led by the Oak View Group (OVG) will build a world-class arena on campus that will be the home to Texas Men's and Women's Basketball games, graduations, concerts and other events, the University announced Dec. 20.
- The arena is expected to open in 2021.
- The innovative 35-year agreement between UT and ArenaCo - which includes OVG, Live Nation, C3 Presents and Matthew McConaughey - will provide a public benefit for UT and the City of Austin. The \$338 million venue will be constructed on land fully owned by UT without using any university or public money.
- The arena will be located on a current parking lot south of Mike A. Myers Stadium.
- The 10,000-seat arena will provide an intimate, state-of-the-art men's and women's basketball fan experience and feature student seating surrounding the court. The new arena is designed to expand to 15,000 seats to provide a world-class venue for touring concerts and shows.
- **Shaka Smart statement:** "What a great day for the future of Texas Basketball! Everyone in our program is extremely excited to see things move forward with today's announcement. I want to thank President Fennes and Chris Del Conte for their leadership and vision on this project. We all want to give our players a true home court advantage for every home game. For our students and fans, this new arena will create a completely new and improved game day experience. This is a major step forward for our program."



## OFF THE COURT WITH THE HORNS

- **Matt Coleman III's** father, Clifford Coleman, played basketball at Newport News Apprentice School (NCAA Division III) and is currently the head coach at Bryant and Stratton Junior College (Virginia Beach, Va.).
- **Brock Cunningham's** dad, Ed Cunningham, played was an offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989.
- **Jackson Hayes** was born in Norman, Okla. (May 23, 2000) and moved with his family to Cincinnati when he was 3 years old. His father, Jonathan, is the tight ends coach for the Cincinnati Bengals. Jonathan was an All-American tight end at the University of Iowa (1982-85) who went on to play 12 seasons in the NFL with the Kansas City Chiefs (1985-93) and Pittsburgh Steelers (1994-96). He was an assistant coach on Oklahoma's football's 2000 National Championship team. Jackson's mom, Kristi (Kinne), played basketball at Drake University (1991-95) and earned honorable mention Kodak All-America accolades and Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year honors as a senior (1994-95). She recorded 3,406 career points during her four seasons at Jefferson-Scranton High School (Jefferson, Iowa). She previously served as an assistant women's basketball coach at Oklahoma, Iowa and Southern Illinois-Carbondale.
- **Kamaka Hepa** was born and raised in Barrow, Alaska. Barrow is the northern-most point in the U.S. and is only accessible by plane. His ethnicity is a combination of Hawaiian, Filipino, Inupiat (Eskimo) and Caucasian. Hepa is looking to become the first Inupiat to play in the NBA.
- **Andrew Jones'** sister, Alexis Jones, played basketball at Baylor (2014-17) and was selected as the No. 12 overall pick of the 2017 WNBA Draft by the Minnesota Lynx.
- **Elijah Mitrou-Long** is the third-youngest of 10 children in his family. His older brother, Nazareth Mitrou-Long, played at Iowa State University (2012-17) and begins the 2018-19 season with the Utah Jazz. Elijah wears jersey No. 55 to honor his uncle, Tinos Mitrou.
- **Dylan Osetkowski's** brother, Cory Osetkowski, played basketball at Columbia University (2011-15) and set the school record for most career games played (114). Cory also pitched for the Columbia baseball team as a freshman in 2012.
- **Kerwin Roach II** won back-to-back 5A state championships in the triple jump for North Shore HS as a junior (2014) and senior (2015). Roach also set a Nike Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays meet record with a jump of 50-8.00 (15.44 meters) in April 2015 on the UT campus. His father, Kerwin Sr., played basketball at Texas Southern University. Kerwin's younger brother, Kieston Roach, is a redshirt freshman cornerback on the Texas State football team.
- **Jericho Sims** is the youngest of six children (all boys) in his family. His brother Jason played basketball at the University of Northern Iowa (1993-96). His brother Ty played basketball at Kansas State University (1997-99). His brother Dominique played football at the University of Minnesota (2000-04). His brother Isaiah currently plays basketball at Rainy River Community College in International Falls, Minn.
