SOUTH ALABAMA'S LAST GAME

ULM 69, South Alabama 49 • January 4, 2020

MONROE, La. — ULM's Michael Ertel set a school record with 11 3-pointers and the Warhawks hit 15 as a team in a 69-49 victory over the University of South Alabama men's basketball team Saturday afternoon at Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

Ertel had 28 points and eight 3s in the first half alone as the Warhawks (6-7, 2-2 Sun Belt) raced out to a 33-12 lead. The Jaguars (8-7, 1-3) used an 8-0 run to get back within 13 with 3:24 left in the first half but a triple from Josh Nicholas seconds before the buzzer sent ULM into the break up 16.

The second half began the same way as the first ended, with an 11-3 rally from the Warhawks, spurred by three triples — two from Ertel — to go up 51-27. ULM trailed by no fewer than 17 the rest of the way.

Graduate Chad Lott paced the Jaguars with 13 points, and senior Trhae Mitchell added 11 off the bench.

GAME FACTS

- Ertel hit his first trey of day 45 seconds in, and by the 6:50 mark, had eight total; he had 26 of the team's 33 points, shooting 9 for 11 overall and 8 for 10 from distance
- The Jaguars answered with eight consecutive points and a 12-4 run to trail by 13 with a minute left in the half, but a '3' from Nicholas made it a 40-26 score at halftime
- Nicholas opened the second half with another triple, and three minutes into the half the Warhawks took their biggest lead of the contest, 51-27
- USA went to work at the free-throw line, scoring seven points at the stripe in an 11-4 run to trim the deficit to 55-38, only to see Ertel answer with a 3-pointer to start a 10-2 run to effectively put the game away
- JD Williams was the only other Warhawk in double-figures with 14; Chris Efretuei grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds

THEY SAID IT

Head Coach Richie Riley

Opening statement: "We ran into a buzzsaw. We were really — and have been for awhile — struggling to score. Not only from a shot-making standpoint, but we did some of the craziest things with the ball today that I've ever seen. We're dribbling down, trying to flow into play and we lose the ball out of bounds or throw it over the backboard — we just did some crazy things. You obviously can't win like that.

Defensively, what stands out is the 15 made 3s, which is a lot, but what we talk about all the time is it's just 45 points. As a team, ULM averages 5.8 3s per game at 33%. They were hot today and he made a lot of shots. We didn't do a good enough job contesting (Ertel), especially early. We let him get too many rhythm 3s, but we didn't give up any free-throw attempts, which is an outlandish stat and we didn't do a good enough job taking away the paint. Our urgency to play has been our story all year; it's really frustrating. I don't know what to say. I told them they needed to get their head up and own it, and so do I. We played terrible, got beat and we have to go back, learn from it and go to Arlington and try to win."

On turning it around: "We have to be able to drive the basketball without losing it, we have to be able to make some wide open shots and just play better. We won at Louisiana on Thursday; we weren't great offensively, but we were good enough defensively. We missed a lot of shots, left a lot of points on the board and did the same thing today, but today it wasn't good enough because we allowed too much in the paint and they had one guy fly off and get really hot. We just didn't play very well. With a veteran team, you usually don't see guys making the mistakes that we make. So it's obviously really frustrating."

UT ARLINGTON'S LAST GAME

Little Rock 92, UT Arlington 89 • January 4, 2020

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. — Brian Warren's potential game-tying 3-pointer in the final seconds rimmed in and out, and the UT Arlington men's basketball team (5-10, 1-3 Sun Belt) dropped a 92-89 contest at Little Rock (10-5, 4-0 Sun Belt) Saturday afternoon inside the Jack Stephens Center.

UT Arlington put together its best all-around offensive game of the year as the Mavericks shot 50 percent (33-66) from the floor en route to a season-high point total, but UTA allowed a season-worst 92 points courtesy of the Trojans shooting 56 percent from the field (30-54) — the highest rate any opponent has connected from against the Mavs this year.

True freshman Sam Griffin led UTA with a season-high-tying 20 points off the bench, while Jordan Phillips added a career-best 18 in a starting role. Radshad Davis registered a season high with 17 points as well, while David Azore notched 16 and Brian Warren tallied 14 to complete the quintet of double-figure scorers for the Mays.

Trailing by eight points with three minutes remaining and by five with under a minute left, UTA mounted a resilient comeback. Davis converted a layup to make it a 91-89 contest with eight seconds left, and UTA fouled exactly who it wanted on the ensuing inbounds pass.

Little Rock's Jaizec Lottie made the first free throw but missed the second. Without a timeout, UTA pushed the ball into the frontcourt, and Warren got a good look at the top of the arc, but his final 3-point attempt hit the back of the rim, then the front of the rim, then off the backboard before eventually falling off the left side of the rim and sending to the Mavericks to an eighth loss this season by eight points or less.

"We executed offensively as well as we have all year, but we didn't get the job done on the defensive end. I'm pleased with a lot of areas, but we've got to learn from this and move on. We've got another fast turnaround hosting the preseason league favorites on Monday, so we've got to make the adjustments quickly."

Little Rock received a 30-point double-double from Kamani Johnson with 30 points and 13 rebounds, while the Sun Belt's leading scorer Markquis Nowell added 29 as the Trojans received 69 of their points from the paint or free-throw line. Ruot Monyvona recorded his league-leading seventh double-double with 11

OPENING TIP

- South Alabama's five-game losing streak to UT Arlington is its longest active against a current Sun Belt school
 The Jaguars have also lost four straight in Arlington; the program's only win on the road came in 1977.
- USA has lost 14 straight games in the state of Texas since a win at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in 2011-12.
- The last 20-point loss by South Alabama (March 7 at Coastal Carolina) was followed by a road win at Appalachian State.
- USA's free-throw percentage of .749 leads the Sun Belt and is third-best in a season in school history. It currently ranks 56th in Division I.
- The Jaguars are 7-0 when outshooting their opponent but 1-7 when being outshot, and 7-1 when winning or tying the rebounding battle and 1-6 when losing it.
- South Alabama had 12 turnovers Saturday, extending its run to five straight games with 12 turnovers or fewer.
 That streak is the program's longest since the last five games of the 2013-14 campaign. The Jags lead the conference and rank 34th in the nation with 11.8 turnovers per game.
- Josh Ajayi grabbed seven rebounds Saturday to give him 731 in his career, six away from a tie with Rory White for third in school history.
- Ajayi enters Monday's contest with 533 field goals and 365 free throws. He is one field goal from Andy Denny
 for eighth in school history, and one free throw from Ken Williams in sixth.
- Ajayi is averaging 13.0 points and 5.8 rebounds in his career against UT Arlington. He had 18 points and 10
 rebounds last year in Mobile.
- Chad Lott led the Jaguars with 13 points at ULM, his 10th double-digit scoring game of the season. He trails
 Ajayi and Fox in that category, who have hit double-figures 11 times each.
- Trhae Mitchell came off the bench Saturday to post 11 points on 4-of-8 shooting. He has alternated double-digit scoring performances in his last six outings. He is averaging 10.7 points in his last three games, all off the bench
- Mitchell scored 17 points in the only meeting between the two schools last year. He had scored 18 points total
 against the Mavericks in the three games prior.
- The last time USA gave up 15 3-pointers in a game was last season against UTA. Brian Warren had four for a
 game-high 18 points, and Jabari Narcis went 3 for 3 from distance.
- This season, the Mavericks rank third in the Sun Belt in 3-pointers per game (8.4) but ninth in 3-point percentage (.324).

MOBILE, Ala. — UT Arlington hit 15 3-pointers and Brian Warren scored 18 points in a 75-57 win over the University of South Alabama men's basketball team Thursday night at the Mitchell Center.

The Mavericks (14-15, 10-6 Sun Belt) went 15 for 26 from distance on the night, including 8 for 12 in the second half alone. Warren converted 4 of his 7 attempts, Edric Dennis was 4 for 8 and Jabari Narcis made all three shots from deep.

USA (13-15, 6-9) led for most of the first eight minutes of the contest before a 16-2 run — including 11 in a row — by UTA resulted in a 26-15 lead. The Mays led by as many as 14 in the first half and went into halftime up 11.

The Jaguars rallied to as close as five at the 12:51 mark of the second half before a 17-6 run put the Mavericks up double-digits for good.

- Juniors Josh Ajayi and Trhae Mitchell combined for all of South Alabama's first 11 points and sophomore John Pettway added a layup for a 13-10 Jaguar lead
- UT Arlington scored the next 11 points six from Dennis and after a Mitchell layup, Narcis and David Azore scored the next five points for a 26-15 advantage
- A 7-1 scoring burst stretched UTA's lead out to 14 with 4:11 left and a triple from Dennis put the Mays up 36-25 at the break
- Mitchell scored the first seven USA points of the second half, junior Herb McGee poured in the next seven and a triple from Ajayi made it a 47-42 contest with 12:51 to play
- TiAndre Jackson-Young countered with two 3s and a jumper in an 8-2 burst over 1:34 to go back up 11
- Sophomore R.J. Kelly made a layup on USA's next possession, then the Jags missed their next four shots from the floor as the Mavericks went on a 9-2 run to pull away
- Ajayi finished with 18 points and 10 rebounds for his 10th double-double of the year, and Mitchell tallied 17 points
- Dennis totaled 15 points off the bench for UTA and Narcis poured in 11

AUTOMATIC AT THE LINE

South Alabama is currently enjoying one of its best free-throw shooting seasons in its history... The team leads the Sun Belt Conference and is third all-time in the school record books at 74.9%... On three occasions, the Jaquars have converted 87.5% at the line (min. 15 FTM), something that hasn't happened since the 1980-81 team did it four times.

LOCURE JOINS RARE TERRITORY

In the Jaquars' 98-72 victory over Spring Hill on Nov. 19. Tyreke Locure became the first USA freshman to record 20 points, five assists and no more than one turnover since Calodeis Canion on Jan. 4, 1984... Locure shot 3 for 7 from 3-point territory and 9 for 12 from the free-throw line for 20 points and dished out five assists in his first career start... The last Jaguar of any class to have 20 and five with one turnover was Augustine Rubit in 2013-14.

SELLOUT!

South Alabama's game on Nov. 12 against No. 22 Auburn set a new Mitchell Center attendance record with 10,068... It broke the previous record of 10,041 against Ole Miss on Dec. 16, 2006.

NATIONAL PUBLICATIONS TAB JAGUARS AS SUN BELT FAVORITES

Three national publications picked South Alabama to win the Sun Belt Conference and honored several Jaguars with major awards... Lindy's, Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook and Street & Smith's all have the Jaquars as their preseason favorite and named seniors Josh Ajayi and Trhae Mitchell to their all-conference teams... Mitchell is Lindy's Player of the Year and Most Versatile, and senior Don Coleman is a secondteam selection as well as the Newcomer of the Year and Top NBA Prospect... Coleman was Blue Ribbon's pick for Newcomer of the Year as well.

MITCHELL NAMED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE YEAR, THREE TABBED TO PRESEASON TEAM

Trhae Mitchell, Don Coleman and Josh Ajayi were voted to the Sun Belt preseason team released in November, with Mitchell being named the Preseason Player of the Year... Mitchell is the first Jaguar to earn player-of-the-year honors since Augustine Rubit in 2013... Mitchell and Ajayi were first-team selections, while Coleman is a third-team pick.

JAGUARS PICKED FIRST IN PRESEASON POLL

In a poll of the league's coaches, South Alabama received 138 points and eight first-place votes to earn the top spot in the preseason poll... It is the first time the Jags have earned the preseason No. 1 ranking since at least 2004... UT Arlington was second with 124 points and two first-place votes, and Georgia Southern and Texas State had 121 points and 110 points, respectively, with a first-place vote apiece.

AJAYI VOTED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Josh Ajayi was voted the first Sun Belt Player of the Week this season after averaging 21.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in South Alabama's 2-0 start... He set a new career high with 30 points vs. Southern Miss, with 20 coming after halftime... Ajayi shot 10 for 14 from the floor and 8 for 9 from the foul line against the Golden Eagles, and made two of his four 3-point attempts... He also grabbed a team-high seven rebounds and dished out three assists... In the opener against Pikeville, he recorded his 20th career double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds, and became the ninth Jaguar to have a 13-13 game in a season opener in school history... Ajayi went 5 for 6 from the field and blocked three shots.

AJAYI, MITCHELL NAMED TO 2018-19 ALL-SUN BELT TEAM

Josh Ajayi (2nd) and Trhae Mitchell (3rd) were both voted to the all-Sun Belt team prior to the start of the tournament... It is the first allconference honor for either player and marks the first time since 2009 that the Jaguars have had two honorees.

BLOCK PARTY

Trhae Mitchell leads the Sun Belt and is 36th in the nation with 2.2 blocks per game... He ranked second in the Sun Belt and 31st in the nation in blocks with 2.1 per game last season... His total of 71 was the second most by a junior in school history and fifth most by any Jaguar... He blocked 8 shots vs. Arkansas State in the first round of the Sun Belt Tournament, which was tied for third in school history and one shy of the

record... Mitchell eclipsed that with a record-tying nine blocks in the 2019-20 season opener vs. Pikeville that also set a new Mitchell Center record.

TAKING A I FAF

South Alabama's game against Troy on Feb. 29 will be the program's second ever on that date... The only other game on Leap Day was a Feb. 29, 2004 home win vs. North Texas (80-63).

WAITING IN THE WINGS

The Jaguars have two players that transferred into the program over the summer that will be sitting out the 2019-20 campaign: **Sam Iorio** and **Deaundrae Ballard...** Both are juniors and will have two seasons of eligibility remaining... Iorio was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie team in 2016-17 after ranking in the top 10 in points per game (8th, 14.9 ppg), field-goal percentage (7th, 47.7%), blocks (T-7th, 25) and steals (T-9th)... He averaged 13.5 ppg as a sophomore, and ranked 10th in the conference in 3-pointers (62)... Ballard appeared in 59 games in two seasons at Florida with one start... He was a top-100 recruit out of Southwest Atlanta Christian Academy.

REUNITED (AND IT FEELS SO GOOD)

Sam Iorio and A.C. Kelly were high school teammates at Parkland High School in Allentown, Pa. . . . Iorio, a junior, played his first two seasons at American before transferring to South Alabama prior to this season . . . Kelly is a freshman that spent last season at Scotland Campus Sports prep school.

BYCK IN TIMIEUDW

After having to sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules, seniors **Don Coleman** and **Andre Fox**, and junior **Josh Ayeni** are returning to action in 2019-20... Coleman led California in scoring with 14.2 ppg as a junior, and was second in assists (57) and steals (42)... Fox scored over 1,000 points in three seasons at High Point, and was a Second Team All-Big South honoree in 2017-18... Ayeni made 40 starts and averaged 6.1 points in two seasons at St. Bonaventure.

HOME OPENING SUCCESS

In the 51 years of the program, the Jaguars have a history of successful home openers... USA sports a 44-8 record in its home opening contests and has won 28 in a row... The last loss was 81-75 to Southern Miss in 1991... The streak was extended this season with an 82-51 win over Pikeville... Spring Hill is the most frequent victim during the streak, losing three times... The Jaguars have defeated Abilene Christian, Alabama State, Alcorn State and Prairie View A&M twice each in season lid-lifters.

ACCURACY IS THE KEY TO SUCCESS

Since the start of the 2007-08 season, South Alabama is 168-35 (.828) when compiling a higher shooting percentage than its opponent — 97-26 (.789) vs. SBC schools — but 29-161 (.153) — 17-100 (.145) vs. Sun Belt teams — when being outshot... This season, South Alabama is 7-0 with a higher percentage and 1-7 with a lower one.

THAT 70s SHOW

When scoring 70 or more since the start of the 2007-08 season, the Jaguars are 144-58 (.713), but 55-138 (.285) when scoring 69 or fewer.

AT HOME IN THE MITCHELL CENTER

Since the facility opened in 1999, the Jaguars have established a winning tradition on their home floor, the Mitchell Center... In 20 seasons, South Alabama has a 208-98 (.680) record and has 12 seasons of 10 or more wins... The 200th win in arena history came on Feb. 2, 2019 with an 81-75 victory over Troy... In 2007-08 the Jags posted a 17-1 slate in front of their home fans (17-0 in the regular season), the second-most home wins in school history (19. 1973-74).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

Last season, South Alabama put together two six-game streaks that had not been accomplished by the program in almost 30 years... Starting Dec. 8 against Tulane, the Jaguars recorded 79 points or more and posted a positive assist/turnover ratio in six straight outings, neither of which had been done since the end of the 1990-91 campaign... The team averaged 81.8 points and had 114 assists compared to 79 turnovers during that stretch... The Jags also shot 50 percent or better in five straight games in that span, which also had not been done since 1990-91.

SEEING DOUBLE

South Alabama had 20 double-double performances last season, led by **Josh Ajayi** (10) and **Trhae Mitchell** (9) who combined for 19 of them... Ajayi ranked second in the league and Mitchell was third, and they combined for the most by a pair of teammates in the Sun Belt... Ajayi's total was the most by a Jaguar player since Augustine Rubit had 12 in 2013-14... **Herb McGee** recorded his first career double-double at Appalachian State with 12 points and 10 boards... Mitchell and Ajayi had a double-double in the same game three times in 2018-19, and Mitchell and McGee each had one at App State.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

Last season against Alabama A&M, **Trhae Mitchell** came up one assist shy of the program's first triple-double since 1989... Mitchell finished the night with 11 points, a career-high 13 rebounds and 9 assists... He also added four blocks and four steals apiece... **Josh Ajayi** was two assists shy of a triple-double on Jan. 3 against Appalachian State, with 15 points, 12 rebounds and 8 assists... Mitchell had a close call in the first round of the Sun Belt Tournament, posting 13 points, 13 rebounds and eight blocks... USA Hall of Famer **Junie Lewis** has South Alabama's only two triple-doubles, coming just over a week agart in February

Richie Riley Head Coach Eastern Kentucky, 2005 2nd Season

It took just one season for Richie Riley to turn the fortunes of the South Alabama men's basketball program around as he led the Jaguars to its best record in five years and has them poised to become a force in the Sun Belt Conference.

The gains in year one were modest, but important. The Jags increased their win total by three to 17, which was their most since 2012-13, set a new school record for 3-pointers with 285, and had two players — Josh Ajayi and Trhae Mitchell — named all-Sun Belt for the first time since 2009.

Ajayi and Mitchell paced a group of five players in double digits, a first for the program since 1996-97, led by Ajayi's career-best 16.4 points per game. Ajayi, who led the Sun Belt in field-goal percentage and ranked in the league's top in both scoring and rebounding, was voted to the second team, while Mitchell, the school's second-ever player — and first since 1988-89 — to record 200 rebounds and 100 assists in the same season.

The offense, which posted a scoring average of 72.9, USA's highest since 2007-08, was firing on all cylinders in December during a span that saw South Alabama go 6-2. Starting Dec. 8, the Jaguars recorded 79 points or more and posted a positive assist/turnover ratio in six straight outings, neither of which had been done since the end of the 1990-91 campaign. In addition, the Jags also shot 50 percent or better in five straight games during that span, which also had not been done since 1990-91.

A recruiting strategy based heavily on the transfer market brought in highly-regarded players from California. Florida and South Carolina, and all-conference honorees from American. High Point and Howard.

Riley was announced on March 8, 2018 as the 10th head coach in the history of the program after helping Nicholls to its first regular-season Southland Conference championship since 1998.

Riley was the head coach the previous two seasons at Nicholls, compiling a 35-28 overall record and a 22-14 mark in the Southland Conference. In his last season, he led the Colonels to the regular-season co-championship with a 15-3 record in league play and an overall mark of 21-11; it was the program's first winning season since the 2008-09 campaign.

Nicholls led the conference in scoring with an average of 82.5 points per game, and was among the top three in the league in eight other statistical categories including second in field-goal percentage (47.2%), 3-point field goals per game (8.1), steals per game (9.6) and scoring margin (+7.2 ppg). Not only was the team among the top five in the country in total steals, steals per game and turnovers forced, it ranked among the top 25 nationally in scoring average and top 50 in field-goal percentage as well.

Under his guidance, Roddy Peters became the Colonels' first first-team all-league selection since 2013 this season, with two other student-athletes earning all-Southland recognition during Riley's two years at the helm of the program.

Peters, who was also the league's newcomer of the year, joined fellow all-Southland honoree Tevon Saddler in the top six in the conference in scoring, with 19.7 and 15.8 points per game, respectively. Peters was second in scoring and sixth with 4.2 assists per contest, while Saddler, a second-team selection, was sixth in points and ninth with 6.6 rebounds per game.

The Colonels' tenacity on defense led to three players listed in the conference's top 11 in steals, including all-defensive team member Jahvaughn Powell, who led the SLC in steals per game (2.3), and Kevin Johnson, who ranked third (1.9).

The season before, the team went 7-11 in league play and 14-17 overall, but led the Southland in both blocks (6.1) and 3-pointers (9.0) per game. The Colonels were fourth in steals per game (7.5), but Powell was second individually (2.0), and Johnathan Bell ranked third (1.9).

Powell paced the SLC in assists per game (5.0) and Liam Thomas was the statistical champion in blocks (4.2)

Prior to taking over at Nicholls, he was an assistant for two seasons at Clemson. In his first season on the staff, he helped the Tigers to eight Atlantic Coast Conference wins — with one coming at NCAA Sweet 16 participant North Carolina State — as well as a pair of victories over NCAA Tournament teams from the SEC, including a top-25 Arkansas squad. The following year Clemson won 10 ACC games for only the fifth time in program history, while his efforts in recruiting helped the Tigers sign both ESPN 4-star top-100 prospect Ty Hudson and the No. 2 national junior-college prospect. Legend Robertin.

As an assistant at Alabama-Birmingham from 2012-14, Riley played a key role in the Blazers signing a top-25 recruiting class that would provide the core of a team that advanced to the third round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament; the group included three individuals who would go on to earn all-Conference USA honors as well as the league's 6th Man-of-the-Year Award. His time at UAB was highlighted by a 63-59 victory over No. 16 North Carolina during the 2013-14 season.

Riley's efforts with the Blazers led to his selection to attend the prestigious Villa 7 Conference for rising

In his lone season at Eastern Kentucky in 2011-12, he was part of a staff that led the Colonels to a 16-16 record. But his efforts in recruiting for the program played a part in signing a class that would help EKU advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2015; the group included Corey Walden, who would go on to twice be chosen the Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Year and the 2014 OVC Tournament Most Valuable Player in addition to being voted first-team all-league in '15.

Riley's first experience at the NCAA Division I level came at Coastal Carolina, where he was an assistant on Cliff Ellis' staff from 2009-11. In his two years with the program, the Chanticleers posted a 56-13 mark overall and 31-5 record in the Big South Conference, winning a pair of regular-season titles, advancing to the conference tournament championship game twice and making an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament each season.

After beginning his coaching career as an assistant at Georgetown (Ky.) from 2003-05, Riley also served as an assistant at Hawai'i-Pacific during the 2005-06 campaign before a three-season stint at Pikeville (Ky.) from 2006-09. While at PC he received the honor of 'Top NAIA Assistant' from RecruitingRumors.com.

A 2005 Eastern Kentucky graduate with a degree in special education and human behavior, Riley and his wife Jess have two sons, Reese and Rock.
