UTA HAS PLAYED THE NATION'S 3RD-HARDEST (2019-20) AND 7TH-HARDEST (2018-19) NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULES THE LAST TWO SEASONS

PRIMARY UTA STORYLINES

UTA played five games in 10 days to open the 2020-21 season; only one Division-I team in the nation played more games in the first 10 days of the year than the Mavs, and that was San Francisco with six (the Dons do not have a game scheduled from Dec. 5-30).

Making things even more challenging for UTA was that four of those five games came against opponents which won 20 games a season ago and/or finished in the top 100 of the NET:

Oklahoma State: 64 NET || Arkansas: 20 Wins & 43 NET
Louisiana Tech: 22 Wins & 87 NET || Tulsa: 21 Wins & 78 NET

This is UTA's first 1-4 start to a season since the 2001-02 campaign.

TWEETABLES

1) UTA ranks 15th in the nation in total steals with 45; Shahada Wells is 28th in the country with 11 thefts, despite having no steals against Tulsa in limited minutes.

2) Despite suffering a 79-64 loss at Tulsa last Friday – a game the Mavs trailed by only a 40-37 margin at halftime – UTA had 12 different scorers, and all 14 players who dressed appeared in the contest.

3) That marked the second-straight loss by double digits for UTA (at Arkansas, 72-60). It's the just the second time in the Chris Ogden era that the Mavs have lost consecutive games by 10+ points (five-straight from Nov. 20-Dec. 4 in 2018).

4) The contest will count as a normal game for UTA; however, it will serve as an exhibition contest for the Division-III Cowboys.

• Last time HSU and UTA met was in the 2010-11 season with the Mavs claiming an 88-71 win; UTA has won each of the last six matchups and 15 of 18 (HSU won three-straight from 1986-88) dating back to 1978.

• HSU enters as winners of two in a row over Sul Ross State and McMurry. The Cowboys other victory came via a 81-70 margin in the season opener at Howard Payne – UTA's final non-conference opponent.

• The Cowboys have five players averaging between 11 and 13 points per game, with Steven Quinn and Kyle Brennon pacing the quintet at 13.2. Neal Chambliss is averaging a double-double through the first five games at 11.3 points and 10 rebounds.

• HSU has forced each of its first five opponents into at least 15 turnovers.

PRESEASON SUN BELT SELECTION

David Azore has been named to the 2020-21 Sun Belt Conference Preseason Second Team, as voted on by the league's head coaches. Azore – UTA's leading returning scorer at 14 points per game – was selected to the Sun Belt Second Team last year, in addition to earning a spot on the NABC All-District Second Team.

The Houston native also led the Mavericks in steals (33) and free-throws made (119) last season, while tying for the team lead in assists (3.7 per game) and ranking 3rd in rebounding (4.8 per contest). Those 119 connections from the charity stripe by Azore represented 29 percent of UTA's total free throws made during the season (409).

SCHEDULE ALTERATIONS

Like every team's non-conference schedule, UTA's was drastically impacted and looks significantly different now than it did in late spring. The non-league docket features seven contests – three at home, one at a neutral site and three on the road. Each of those games were drivable and regionally located. In early December, UTA and Oral Roberts mutually agreed to delay the start of their home-and-home series by one season to 2021-22 (were scheduled to play at ORU on Dec. 19).

UTA played five games in 10 days to open the season, including two Power-5 teams (vs. Oklahoma State, @ Arkansas) and three opponents which won at least 20 games a season ago (@ Louisiana Tech, @ Arkansas, @ Tulsa).

UTA's 18-game Sun Belt schedule will begin on Jan. 1 at Little Rock. The league switched to a divisional conference schedule in 2020-21 to help mitigate the travel impacts associated with COVID-19.

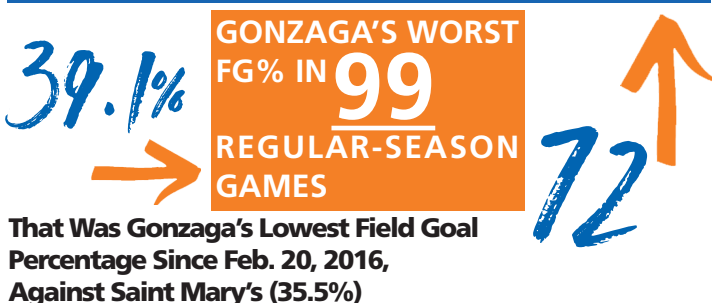
Despite all the scheduling issues, UTA still impressively played four of its five Division-I non-league games against teams which finished in the top-100 of the NET last season (Arkansas: 43; Oklahoma State: 64; Tulsa: 78; Louisiana Tech: 87).

HARD-LUCK LOSSES / LAST YEAR'S SCHEDULE BREAKDOWN

After playing the nation's 7th-hardest non-conference strength of schedule in 2018-19, UTA played the 3rd-most difficult non-league slate in 2019-20. Through that extremely-challenging slate and the Sun Belt schedule, the Mavericks remained extremely competitive despite finishing 14-18 overall and 10-10 in the Sun Belt. Among those notable accomplishments:

- **Six Losses By One Possession – Three Points Or Less**
- **Three Losses By One Point – Tied For The Most In Single-Season Program History**
 - o Also occurred in 1974-75, 1977-78, 1982-83 and 1987-88.
 - o All three setbacks came at the buzzer or in the final 4 seconds as the opponent hit a game-winning shot: Furman (58-57; floater with 3.8 seconds left), Louisiana (66-65; 3-pointer at the buzzer) and Coastal Carolina (63-62; jumper at the buzzer).
- **13 Of The 18 Losses Were By Eight Points Or Less**
 - o One of those was to then-#8 Gonzaga, 72-66, as UTA led for 16 minutes and locked down on the Bulldogs.

Gonzaga's fewest points in a home non-conference game since Dec. 10, 2016 (61 vs. Akron as part of a 61-43 win).

NET CHANGES

Prior to this season, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee announced that the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) will be changed to increase accuracy and simplify it by reducing a five-component metric to just two. The remaining factors include the Team Value Index (TVI), which is a result-based feature that rewards teams for beating quality opponents, particularly away from home, as well as an adjusted net efficiency rating. The adjusted efficiency is a team's net efficiency, adjusted for strength of opponent and location (home/away/neutral) across all games played. For example, a given efficiency value (net points per 100 possessions) against stronger opposition rates higher than the same efficiency against lesser opponents and having a certain efficiency on the road rates higher than the same efficiency at home. No longer will the NET use winning percentage, adjusted winning percentage and scoring margin.

LOCKED IN ON DEFENSE

The Mavs have produced two of the best single seasons on the defensive side of the ball in program history under Chris Ogden's guidance.

4TH UTA held opponents to 68.4 points per game in 2019-20 – the 4th-fewest in program history; that came on the heels of a 69.8 point-per-game average in 2018-19 – the 8th-best in program history.

In terms of opponent field-goal percentage, UTA limited foes to only 41.2 percent last year – tied for the 5th-lowest in program history; in 2018-19, the Mavs held opponents to 42.3 percent – the 7th-best in program history.

AZORE CLOSING IN ON HISTORY

David Azore entered the season with 718 career points – well on pace to become only the 26th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone (**currently: 778**).

Only three players in program history have scored more than 1,500 career points: Willie Brand (1,907 from 1987-91), Kevin Hervey (1,783 from 2014-18) and Erick Neal (1,557 from 2014-18). **Among those three players, only one has scored more points through his first two years than Azore:**

Brand: 979 Points

Neal: 622 Points

Azore: 718 Points

Hervey: 510 Points

UTA finished in the top-40 in the nation in four key statistical categories last season: assist-to-turnover ratio (16th, 1.3), defensive 3-point percentage (20th, 29.6), fewest turnovers per game (29th, 11.2) and assists per game (35th, 14.9).

DECADE OF SUCCESS

UTA's first season of basketball took place in 1959-60, and since that opening year the Mavs have improved significantly in each of their six decades. Below are the average amount of wins each decade:

Despite ending last year with just 14 victories, UTA still finished with an average of 19 wins per season in the 2010s – by far the highest in program history. UTA has posted seven 20-win seasons in its 60-year history, but five of those have come since 2007-08:

BLACK HISTORY MONTH SHIRTS



UTA donned these warmup shooting shirts for Black History Month this past February.



With a concept created by Video Coordinator Matthew McGann, each player and staff member chose who he wanted featured on the front of his own shirt and the Kobe Bryant quote on the back of each. Each player and staff member then had to give a presentation – spaced out throughout the month – to the team about why he chose that person and why that person was symbolic to him and African American history.

FREE-THROW EMPHASIS

In 2019-20, UTA connected at a 74.8 percent clip from the free-throw line – the 4th-best percentage in single-season program history. In 2018-19, the Mavs went 74.1 percent from the charity stripe – the 6th-best percentage in single-season program history. Those are two of only six seasons of 74+ percent from the free-throw line in the 61-year history of the program.

CIVIL RIGHTS EMPHASIS

Since taking over the program, Chris Ogden has placed an emphasis on discovering and exploring the city in which the Mavs are playing, many times ensuring it's an educational experience related to civil rights.

Among numerous trips last year, UTA visited Lorraine Motel – the site of Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassination – and **Little Rock Central – the high school of the Little Rock Nine who bravely paved the way for desegregation in public schools. The Mavs – who had 100% voter registration among those eligible for this past election – also practiced at Little Rock Central.**

RE-TWEETS

1) UTA and Georgia Southern are the only two Sun Belt Conference teams to have posted six-straight years of double-figure league victories.

2) The Mavs went 9-9 in SBC action in their first year in the conference in 2013-14, and since then have posted at least 10 Sun Belt wins in every season.

3) Despite finishing last year with a 14-18 record, UTA still posted the 2nd-highest NET Ranking (formerly the RPI) in the Sun Belt at #129 – behind only Texas State at #120.

4) UTA owns the 2nd-most wins against Sun Belt opponents (78) since joining the league in 2013-14 (Georgia State: 90; Louisiana: 78).

5) UTA finished in 7th place in the Sun Belt regular-season standings last year with a 10-10 record – the first time since joining the league in 2013-14 that it did not finish in the top-5 of the conference (was the only team in the league to have accomplished that feat).

6) The Mavs have a pair of current 15-game winning streaks: Houston Baptist (1980-2014) and Texas Wesleyan (1984-2009).

7) Over the last 12 years, UTA has finished with a positive scoring margin 10 times; in the first 48 years of the program, that occurred just eight times.



Famed WWE personality The Undertaker (Mark Calaway) played basketball at Texas Wesleyan University, about 20 minutes down I-30 from UTA in Fort Worth. **Current UTA associate head coach Greg Young was an assistant coach at TWU during Calaway's time with the Rams in the mid-80s.**

HOME SUCCESS

- Since 2015-16, UTA has compiled an impressive 57-19 record in College Park Center.
- 13-2 in 2015-16, 14-1 in 2016-17, 13-2 in 2017-18, 9-5 in 2018-19, 8-8 in 2019-20 and 0-1 so far in 2020-21. **Included in that stretch was a 21-game regular-season winning streak.**
- The 14 victories in 2016-17 equaled a program record, set in 2007-08, for most home wins. The only loss was a four-point setback to Cal State Bakersfield in the NIT Quarterfinals.

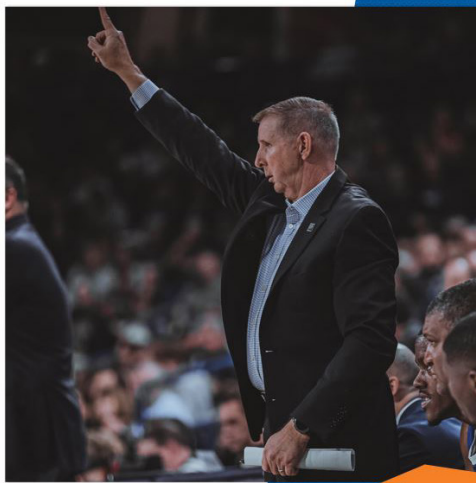

ABOUT THE CPC

The Mavericks have called the beautiful College Park Center home since the 7,000 all chair-back seat multi-purpose arena opened on Feb. 1, 2012. The \$78 million project broke ground on March 5, 2010, and opened less than two years later. The arena is part of a 20-acre section of campus known as the College Park District, which includes a residence hall, student apartments, a 4.62 acre park, restaurants and three parking garages. The arena features 4,055 lower bowl seats, in addition to a 2,800-square-foot hospitality suite. A distinctive feature is a center hung 4-sided Daktronics LED scoreboard with an additional end zone LED display, ribbon displays and scorer's table. The lower concourse contains sports medicine facilities, two full-sized practice courts, a 2,500-sq-ft weight room, a press center, an academic support study center and coaches' office suites. In addition to Mavericks basketball and volleyball events, the facility hosts a variety of concerts, speaking engagements and other events. The WNBA's Dallas Wings also call College Park Center home during their season.



Longtime associate head coach Greg Young was named the top assistant coach in the Sun Belt Conference this summer, as unveiled by Stadium's Jeff Goodman.

Young, who is in his 12th season with UTA, was voted as the top assistant coach in the league by his peers as Goodman polled at least 20 coaches in the conference.

Since joining UTA in 2009-10, Young has helped guide the Mavs to a 207-152 record (.577) and advanced to the postseason four times: 2012 NIT, 2013 CIT, 2016 CIT and 2017 NIT.

He has been a member of two regular-season championship teams – 2012 Southland Conference and 2017 Sun Belt – in addition to reaching the Western Athletic Conference Tournament Final in 2013 and the Sun Belt Tournament Final in both 2018 and 2019.

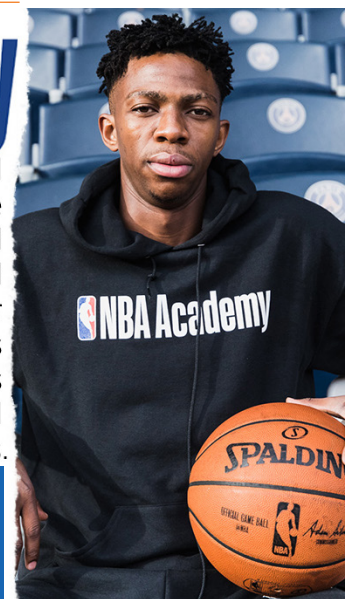
GLOBAL PRESENCE

The UTA roster this year is represented by seven different countries, five different continents and three different states: Nigeria and Congo (Africa), Canada and Dominican Republic (North America), Brazil (South America), France (Europe) and Australia; Texas, Utah and Florida. **The seven different countries represented on one roster are tied for the 2nd-most in the nation (Maine, 8).** While he lists his hometown as Mesquite, Texas, Akobundu-Ehiogu was born in Nigeria and lived there until he was 13.



NBA Academies, a network of elite basketball training centers around the world, include educational development for top male and female prospects from outside the U.S. and mark the NBA's signature elite player development initiative. The initiative exposes elite prospects to NBA-level coaching, facilities and competition and provides a global framework for them to maximize their success.

Patrick Mwamba (NBA Academy Africa) is one of currently 35 academy products worldwide playing Division-I basketball (or whom have signed to play); seven currently playing professionally.



T.J. FORD APPEARANCE



Former National Player of the Year T.J. Ford attended UTA's 2019-20 season opener. Ford was teammates with Chris Ogden at Texas for the two years he was with the Longhorns in 2001-02 and 2002-03. Ford and Ogden helped lead Texas to the Final Four in 2003 for the first time since 1947.

MAVERICKS IN THE PROS

On Dec. 12, 2019, former UTA standout Kevin Hervey signed a two-way contract with the Oklahoma City Thunder. **UTA's all-time leading rebounder (921) and 2nd-leading scorer (1,783), Hervey became the first Maverick to play in an NBA game on Dec. 26 versus the Memphis Grizzlies.**

He played in 10 games with OKC last season, including three in the NBA Bubble in Orlando; he scored an NBA career-best eight points against the Phoenix Suns on Aug. 10. Following the season, Hervey signed a professional deal with Lokomotiv Kuban in Russia's top tier.



An Arlington native, Hervey was drafted by the Thunder with the 57th pick in the 2nd Round in 2018. He was the 4th all-time UTA player selected in the draft and the first since the NBA reduced the number of rounds to just two in 1989. Paul Renfro became UTA's first-ever draft pick when he was taken in the 9th round (181st overall) by the Utah Jazz in 1980. Two Mavericks were selected in 1982 – both by the Dallas Mavericks. Ralph McPherson was selected in the 9th round (188th) and Albert Culton picked in the 10th round (209th).

Chris Ogden was named the eighth head coach in program history on Apr. 6, 2018.

In his first season leading UTA in 2018-19, the Mavs went 17-16 and Ogden guided a team predicted to finish 2nd-to-last in the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Poll to a 2nd-place finish in the regular-season standings (12-6) and a berth in the Sun Belt Tournament Championship Game for the second-straight year.

That nine-spot improvement from preseason to final regular-season finish was tied for the best in the nation along with Siena, which was picked 11th in the MAAC (Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference) and finished in a four-way tie for 2nd.

In 2019-20, UTA played the 3rd-hardest non-conference schedule in the nation; 13 of its losses during the year were by eight points or less.

During his 15 years on the basketball staffs at Texas, Tennessee and Texas Tech, Ogden helped compile a 346-173 record for a .667 winning percentage. In 10 seasons as a full-time assistant coach he went 215-130 and registered a total of 32 victories over Associated Press top 25 ranked teams. He helped lead three programs to 11 total NCAA Tournament appearances, including three regional finals.

Ogden recruited many of the Texas Tech players who would go on to finish as National Finalists in 2018-19.

Ogden is a co-founder of Nine Banded Whiskey, named after the nine-banded armadillo, the official state small mammal of Texas. Nine Banded is the official bourbon partner of the Los Angeles Rams, and has been featured on HBO's 'Ballers.'

Ogden has coached seven players who have gone onto have their name called in the NBA Draft, six of which were selected in the first round (Thompson, No. 4 by Cleveland in 2011; Jordan Hamilton, No. 26 by Dallas in 2011; Joseph, No. 29 by San Antonio in 2011; Avery Bradley, No. 19 by Boston in 2010; Damion James, No. 24 by Atlanta in 2010; and Turner, No. 11 by Indiana in 2015).

Ogden played for Texas from 2000-03 and was a member of four NCAA Tournament teams. UT reached the 2003 NCAA Final Four with Ogden serving as a senior captain. He finished his Longhorns' career with 97 team victories, more than any other player in program history at the time.

Following his collegiate playing career, Ogden joined the Texas basketball staff as a student assistant coach for the 2003-04 season while he completed his undergraduate degree.

Ogden played four years of varsity basketball at Seminole High School. He was crowned the state of Texas "Mr. Basketball" following his senior season in 1998-99. That year, he averaged 17.3 points, 10.6 rebounds and 8.5 assists per game while leading SHS to a 36-4 record and a runner-up finish in the Class 3A state tournament.

A First Team All-American at Tyler Junior College last year, Wells scored 13 of his 21 in the 2nd half to match the output of heralded Cade Cunningham – the 2020 Naismith High School Player of the Year. Wells added six rebounds and a game-high five steals as well in an impressive debut.

After being held scoreless in the 1st half, redshirt junior David Azore – UTA's leading returning scorer from a season ago – poured in a game-best 14 points over the closing 20 minutes. Sophomore Nicolas Elame picked up where he left off last year with another formidable performance of 12 points to go along with a team-best eight rebounds and a team-best five assists.

UTA couldn't maintain a torrid offensive start at Tulsa as the Mavericks suffered a 79-64 setback to the Golden Hurricane.

UTA made nine of its first 11 field-goal attempts (82 percent) and held a 32-25 lead following 13 minutes of action, but after that the Mavs were out-scored 54-32 and connected on just 14-43 attempts (33 percent).

Sam Griffin paced UTA with 13 points, while David Azore finished as the Mavs only other double-figure scorer with 11. UTA – which closed the game on a 10-0 run over the final three minutes – did have 12 different players score.

UTA's leading scorer Shahada Wells played just 10 minutes and scored only three points. The junior transfer guard had led (or tied) the Mavs in scoring in each of the first four games of the year, and came in averaging 17.8 points per contest.

The Mavs were playing their fifth game – four of which were away from home – in 10 days to open the season.

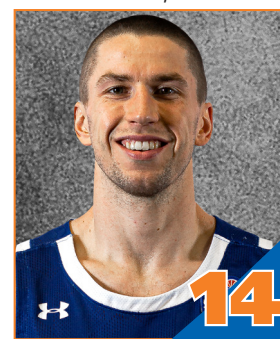
