- The Lady Mavs welcome four starters back this season in the likes of Terryrn Milton, Katie Ferrell, Shyia Smith, and Claire Chastain. Camryn Hawkins and Emma Halverson are key returning letterwinners while Starr Jacobs and De'Sha Benjamin look to made an immediate impact as transfers.
- UTA is 24-24 all-time in season openers including a 14-4 record at home. UTA has won five straight season openers with their last loss coming at the hands of the Bears on Nov. 13, 2015.

- Baylor opened the season on Tuesday evening with a 77-70 win over Sun Belt foe Texas State in Waco.

- Baylor has won seven straight over UTA dating back to 1988.

- Reigning Wade Trophy recipient Nalyssa Smith returns in 2021-22 and was named to the Wade Watch list.

- Smith became the third Bear to bring home the Wade Trophy last season, joining Brittney Griner (2012, 2013) and Odyssej Sims (2014).

- Smith – the AP Preseason All-American and Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year – is also on the preseason watch list for the Katrina McClain Award, presented to the nation's top power forward. She won the award last season after averaging a team-best 18.0 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.

- Smith was joined by teammates Queen Egbo and Jordan Lewis on the Wooden Award's Preseason Top 50 Watch List. Smith and Egbo were also named to the 2022 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Women's Watch List.

- Egbo, a Preseason All-Big 12 honoree, averaged career-bests in points (11.1), rebounds (8.6) and blocks per game (1.9). She moved to ninth all-time on Baylor's career list for blocks with 56 as a junior, bringing her total to 120 in three seasons.

- The Big 12's Preseason Newcomer of the Year, Lewis is a graduate transfer from Alabama, where she left as the program's fifth all-time leader in assists with 510 and ninth all-time with 1,581 points. The sixth-year senior guard put up career numbers for the Crimson Tide last season, averaging career-bests with 17.0 points and 4.2 assists per game. She is a former teammate of UTA transfer De'Sha Benjamin.

ASSIST QUEENS

Seniors Katie Ferrell and Terryn Milton continue to make their mark in the record book as they both entered the Top 10 in career assists this past season.

Ferrell moved into third all-time in career assists after dishing out three in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament loss to App State, passing Paige Smith-Wojciak.

As the 2021-22 season begins, Ferrell inches closer to second as she is only 40 behind Terra Wallace, a mark she can hit in the early half of the season.

Ferrell will have an outside chance to become the all-time leader in assists as she is 192 behind all-time leader Krystal Buchanan.

Milton, on the other hand, has a chance to make some serious movement as she enters the 2021-22 season ninth all-time in assists, only 28 behind Cierra Johnson for eighth and 45 behind Gale Haynes for seventh.

Milton is only 79 assists away from moving as high as fourth all-time.

OPENING CREDITS

Thursday's opener against Baylor will mark the sixth straight contest where UTA has opened the season at home. The Lady Mavs have won five straight season openers and seven straight home openers.

UTA's last loss in a season opener came against No. 5 Baylor on Nov. 13, 2015, where they fell 62-20 in Waco.

The last time the Lady Mavs dropped a home opener came on Nov. 14, 2013, where they fell to Incarnate Word by the score of 52-48.

UTA is 24-24 all-time in season openers with a 14-4 record at home. The Lady Mavs are 36-12 all-time in home openers. It is the third time UTA will open the season with Baylor as they hold a 1-1 mark including a 68-65 win on Nov. 27, 1984.

TERRYN NAMED TO PRESEASON 2ND TEAM



Senior Terryn Milton was named to the 2021-22 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference Team as voted on by the conference's head coaches.

Milton becomes the 13th Lady Mav to earn SBC Preseason honors. It is the third straight season a player from UTA has earned preseason conference honors.

If the Lady Mavs want to achieve the ultimate goal of winning a conference title, Milton will be an integral piece as the senior from Owasso, Okla. comes off a season where she appeared in 15 of 16 games and averaged 9.6 points, 3.8 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 1.3 steals throughout the season. Those marks were even more impressive in conference play as Milton upped her totals to 10.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.3 assists, and 1.4 steals.

NOTES

Milton was fourth in the conference last season in assist/turnover ratio (1.9) in league games and fifth in assists (4.3). She was a significant part of the Lady Mavs defense that held opponents to just 51.0 points, 34.9 percent shooting from the field, and 25.2 percent from long distance, which was all No. 1 in the Sun Belt.

Milton scored in double figures nine times in 2020-21, including a career-high 24 points on 10 of 13 shooting in a win over ULM on January 8. She also dished out five or more assists seven times last season, including a season-high eight assists against Arkansas State on January 29.

LADY MAVS PICKED THIRD

The UT Arlington women's basketball team was selected to finish third by the league's coaches.

Last season, the Sun Belt was divided into divisions for the first time due to the effects of COVID-19 as UTA was selected to win the Western Division. However, the conference will return to its traditional standings this season.

It is the third time in the last four seasons that UTA has been selected to finish third in the conference. The last time the Lady Mavs were chosen to finish third in the conference was 2019-20, where UTA won a share of the regular-season title.

Defending Sun Belt Champion Troy was selected to repeat as Sun Belt Champions. The Trojans have won three of the last five SBC Tournament Championships and earned 11 of the 12 first-place votes (142). The remaining vote went to SBC runner up, and west division champions Louisiana (124). The Lady Mavs were selected third. (101) followed by Texas Stats (95) and Little Rock (92).

HOME SWEET HOME

The UTA women have called the College Park Center home since February 1, 2012 when they defeated UTSA in their first contest in their new home arena, 51-40. Since then, the Lady Mavs have compiled a home record of 80-51 including five seasons with 10 or more wins.



Since the 2016-17 season, the Lady Mavs have been remarkable at home as they have put together an impressive 56-13 record including a 37-6 record in Sun Belt play as they have not lost more than two games inside their home arena.

CLAIRE RETURNS

After only playing in three games last season and opting out due to COVID-19 concerns, senior Claire Chastain returns to the floor for her final season and looks to make an impact on a talented squad.



Chastain is a two-time Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference selection, earning third team honors in 2020-21 and second team honors in 2019-20.

During her sophomore campaign in 2019-20, Chastain was second on the team in points with 10.9 per game to go with .400 shooting from the field and .325 from behind the arc. She was eighth in the Sun Belt in 3-point field goals made per contest at 1.52 and upped her point total to 11.1 points in conference play. She led the team in scoring 20 times that season.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Second year head coach Shereka Wright is excited for the prospect of two transfers who look to make an immediate impact on the team beginning on Thursday.

Dallas native Starr Jacobs signed with UTA this past year after an incredible season with Temple College as she was named an WBCA All-American.

In her two seasons with the Leopards, Jacobs played in and started 42 games. As a redshirt freshman she averaged 18.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists, while shooting 56.1 percent from the floor.

As a redshirt sophomore in 2020-21, the 6-foot-2 forward ranked 2nd in the nation in points per game (23.6), 17th in rebounds per game (10.6), and 11th in total steals (69). She picked up NTJAC All-Conference and NJCAA Region V All-Region Team honors.

Additionally, the Lady Mavs add Alabama transfer De'Sha Benjamin to the mix.

In her three seasons with the Crimson Tide, Benjamin played in 63 games, making 10 starts. She averaged 6.1 points and 3.1 rebounds and shot 40 percent from the field and 37.2 percent from long range. Benjamin scored in double figures for Bama on 19 occasions.

UTA also adds seven freshmen to the mix who will vie for playing time among an upperclassmen led group.

CAM FROM DEEP

Senior Camryn Hawkins comes off a breakout season in which she made a huge impact on the team, making 18 appearances to go with 10 starts.

Hawkins was especially good from deep as she finished 30 of 83 from behind the arc, good for a 3PT percentage of .372, which was the 15th best in school history.

Hawkins was sixth in the SBC in 3PT percentage as well as 3PT field goals made per game at 1.7.

The Lady Mavs held their opponents under 40% shooting in 16 games last season and held opponents under 30% from behind the arc in 12 games. They also held their opponents under 60 points in 13 games.

EHLBECK NAMED THIRTY UNDER 30 HONOREE

Assistant Coach Sean Ehlbeck was named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced today (March 17) the WBCA Thirty Under 30 presented by Morgan Stanley Global Sports & Entertainment.

The WBCA Thirty Under 30 program was created to recognize 30 up-and-coming women's basketball coaches age 30 and under at all levels of the game. Each honoree has exemplified their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others, professional manner, and attitude and professional association involvement.

FORMER LADY MAV JOINS COACHING STAFF

Shereka Wright announced the hiring of 2020-21 team captain Jordynn Hernandez as a women's basketball graduate assistant coach.

A transfer from Collin College, Hernandez sat out the entire 2019-20 season due to injury and played in 13 games, making 12 starts, in 2020-21 before a knee injury ended her season. Last season for the Lady Mavs, Hernandez averaged 8.0 points, 2.7 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.9 steals, while shooting 80.6 percent from the charity stripe.

Hernandez was selected to participate in the 2021 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) "So You Want To Be A Coach" program. During the WBCA's one-day online workshop, she was able to learn about the administrative side of coaching, recruiting, how to get hired, skill development, the importance of knowing the rules, and how to balance work and life.

BULKING UP THE SCHEDULE

UT Arlington built up a tough non-conference schedule in 2020-21 as 10team docket includes three teams who made the NCAA Tournament last season, two teams who competed in the WNIT, and eight total teams who had a winning record in 2020-21.

Former WNBA player and Power 5 Associate Head Coach Shereka Wright was named UTA's 10th head women's basketball coach on Sept. 4, 2020 by Director of Athletics Jim Baker.

In her rookie campaign as a head coach, Wright led the Lady Mavs through an interesting season that saw multiple stoppages due to COVID, COVID opt-outs, injuries and games postponed/canceled. Wright and the Lady Mavericks finished the season with a 13-7 overall record and 11-4 record in Sun Belt Conference play.

Wright secured her first career win in the 2020-21 season opener against Texas A&M-Commerce at College Park Center on Nov. 25. UTA went on to earn the West Division's No. 2 seed in the SBC Tourney, falling to App State in Quarterfinals.

Despite the challenges that were thrown their way in 2020-21, Wright and the Lady Mavs led the Sun Belt in scoring defense (54.0 ppg), field goal percentage defense (34.8%) and three-point percentage defense (26.7%) and ranked top-3 in scoring margin (2nd; +7.0), three-point percentage (3rd; 32.3%), assists (2nd; 14.9 apg) and assist/turnover ratio (2nd; 0.9).

In the national rankings, the 2020-21 edition of the Lady Mavs ranked in the Top-50 nationally in multiple categories, including scoring defense (10th), field-goal percentage (12th) and three-point percentage defense (20th).

Wright – a Texas High School Hall of Fame member and former longtime assistant coach at Texas Tech – brings her impressive resume to the Lady Mavericks after spending two seasons (2018-20) with Vanderbilt, five years at Alabama (2013-18) and seven campaigns in Lubbock (2006-13).

A native of Copperas Cove just west of Fort Hood, Wright was the 2000 National Player of the Year her senior season at Copperas Cove High School after averaging 25 points and 10 rebounds per game.

Known nationally as a strong recruiter, Wright – who served as Vanderbilt's recruiting coordinator – helped bring a pair of ESPNW top 100 players to the Commodores' Class of 2019, including Koi Love, who became the first player in school history to earn back-to-back SEC Freshman of the Week honors.

Prior to Vandy, Wright was a critical part of Alabama's resurgence and helped the Crimson Tide to consecutive 20-win seasons, which included the quarterfinals of the 2018 WNIT. Under Wright's tutelage, Alabama forward Ashley Williams finished her career ranked 9th in school history in scoring (1,450) and 5th in rebounding (859).

Additionally, under Wright's direction, SEC All-Freshman selection Ashley Knight set the Alabama single-season record and led the league in blocks with 90, becoming the first player in program history to finish as the SEC's leader in blocks.

Wright also was instrumental in constructing a signing class that ranked in the top 25 nationally, featuring both the Alabama and Mississippi high school players of the year.

Wright began her coaching career at Texas Tech and was responsible for the perimeter players, recruiting, scouting, academics and equipment. She helped the Lady Raiders advance to the postseason five times, and posted 20+ win seasons each of the last three years – including advancing to the NCAA Tournament twice.

Wright was selected as the 13th overall pick in the 2004 WNBA Draft by the Detroit Shock after a stellar career at Purdue. She was traded to the Phoenix Mercury on draft night, and spent two seasons with them until an injury brought her professional playing career to an end in 2006.

A prolific player, Wright remains to this day the only three-time All-American in Purdue women's basketball history. She was just the third Boilermaker in program history to be named All-Big Ten First Team on three occasions, and was a finalist for National Player of the Year as both a junior and senior. As a freshman in 2001, Wright was named to the NCAA Final Four All-Tournament Team.

Wright amassed 2,251 points (2nd in Purdue history) and 793 rebounds (7th) over the course of her career, to go with 177 blocked shots (10th), 291 assists (17th) and 129 steals. Her 350 offensive rebounds are the most in school history. Wright made and attempted more free throws than any player in Big Ten history, going 776 for 1,071 from the line.

Throughout her four-year career, Purdue appeared in four NCAA tournaments, advancing to the National Championship Final in 2001, the Elite Eight in 2003 and the Sweet Sixteen in 2004. Purdue won two Big Ten regular-season titles (2001, 2002) and a pair of Big Ten Tournament crowns (2003, 2004) with Wright being named Most Outstanding Player both times.

Wright, who graduated from Purdue in 2004 with a degree in health and fitness, was inducted into the Purdue Athletics Hall of Fame earlier this year.

As a high school player, Wright set Copperas Cove records with 3,269 points, 1,148 rebounds and 220 blocks. At the time of her graduation, she was just the 36th player in the country and only the 4th Texan to record 3,000 points in a high school career.
