About the Mean Green

North Texas looks to build off of the 13-7 record posted in 2020-21. Head Coach Jalie Mitchell might have her most talented roster. UNT features the Preseason Conference USA POY in junior Quincy Noble. Mitchell also added six new faces with three transfers and three freshmen. The Mean Green have posted back-to-back 90 point offensive efforts to get to 2-0. Not to mention in the C-USA Preseason Coaches Poll, North Texas was voted to finish third, the highest projection under Mitchell.

About the Mavs

UT Arlington comes to Denton with some momentum off of its three-game homestand. The Lady just recently upset Houston on Wednesday night in overtime, 69-66. They feature three tough players in Chastain Claire, Starr Jacobs, and Terryn Milton. They gobble up most of the minutes and for good reason. Milton comes off of career-high 26-point performance and she didn't sit a second of the game. Jacobs came up with a gritty 14 points in the victory over Houston. The Lady Mays were picked third in the Sun Belt Preseason Coaches Poll.

History Between The Squads

North Texas won the last meeting against UT-Arlington in the 2020 South Padre Island Classic, 74-56. With a victory Saturday, the Mean Green will tie up the all-time series.

Scouting UTA

- Jacobs and Milton are the only Lady Mavs averaging double figures in scoring.

-They are winners of their last two, overcoming 15-point deficit against

Houston at halftime.

- They are averaging 17 free throws per contest making 71% of those opportunities.

- The Lady Mavs average only 2.7

3-pointers per game.

- In the Houston game, they dished out a season-high in assists with 19.

- Katie Ferrell and Milton became the all-time leaders in assists by a duo in the same recruiting class at UTA.

Last Time Out

- Jazion Jackson was the only Mean Green to register double figures for the third straight contest.
- Madison Townley joined Jackson reaching double figures with 11.
- Jackson tied a career-high with eight rebounds.
- As a team, North Texas had four players pull down seven rebounds each.
- UNT held Missouri State to 31.4% from the floor, and 13.6% from deep, respectively.
- North Texas held Missouri State to its lowest team total since December 19, 2020.
- Aly Gamez, Jackson, Lampkin, Noble and Townley all started.

Season Tabs

 UNT's 93 points broke a school record for most points scored in a season opener.

- North Texas knocked down 14 from 3-point range against How-

ard, which broke a school record for most made in a game.

- Mean Green posted back-toback 90 points games for the first time since 1999 (SMU/Columbia), when Jalie Mitchell was a sophomore. (USAO/Howard)

- UNT reached 2-0 for the first time since 2018-19, winning both

games by 35+ points.

- The Mean Green have seven players averaging at least seven points per contest.

- UNT is averaging 79 points per

game.

- On the season, North Texas is shooting 37.1% from 3-point range.

- Jalie Mitchell is 15 wins away from 100 career victories at North

Texas.

Around The Country

 The Mean Green are one of the top rebounding teams in the country they check in at No. 11.

- UNT gets to the free throw line as much as anybody. They come into Saturday's matchup ninth in the NCAA in attempts.

Noble Notables

- Her 25-point performance against Howard is the second-most points by a C-USA player this season.

- She made five from downtown, which ties for the most by a C-USA player this year.

- Noble is seven for seven from the free throw line this year.

- She is averaging 14.7 PPG, shooting 43.8% from 3-point range.

Noble Held in High Regard

Quincy Noble became the second Mean Green to ever receive C-USA First Team honors, as Terriell Bradley did in 2017-18 and 2018-19.

In the history of the program, there have been seven Mean Green to be named first team all-conference to amass 10 total awards:

1986: Clara Campbell (Southland) 1999: Jalie Mitchell (Big West) 2001: Jalie Mitchell (Sun Belt) 2002: Jalie Mitchell and Shannan Stephenson (Sun Belt) 2003: Kim Blanton (Sun Belt) 2009: Amber Jackson (Sun Belt) 2018: Terriell Bradley (C-USA) 2019: Térriell Bradley (C-USA) 2021: Quincy Noble (C-USA) Noble was ranked in the top 10 within C-USA in several categories including 3-point percentage (2nd, 38.3), 3-pointers per game (3rd, 2.7), points per game (5th, 17.8), free throw percentage (5th, 78.0) and field goal percentage (10th, 42.6) a season ago.

New Transfers

 Gamez joined the Mean Green as a graduate transfer following four seasons with the Fresno State Bulldogs.

 She earned Mountain West All-Freshman Team selection in 2018 and was a four-year

starter.

- The guard was fourth on the team in scoring at 9.8 points per game in 2020-21 and knocked down 51-percent of her shots, including 41-percent on 3-pointers.

 The MacArthur High graduate led her team to a district championship and was a two-time first team all-district selection.

- Jaylen Mallard played two seasons for the South Alabama Jaguars and earned 22 starts in 2020-21 with averages of 8.8 points and 6.5 rebounds.

- The Little Rock, Arkansas, native scored a career-high 18

points versus Appalachian State and pulled down a career-best 13 rebounds against Troy. The forward scored in double figures in each of her last four contests.

- Dixon joins the UNT outfit from Louisiana Tech as a graduate transfer.

- An all-around player, Dixon averaged 9.8 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 1.5 steals for the Lady Techsters in 2020-21.

 The Mansfield Summit graduate registered three double-doubles. scored in double figures a dozen times, and had five games of 10 or more rebounds last season.

- UNT and LA Tech split last season's series as Dixon recorded 29 points, 10 rebounds, five assists and three steals in the two meetings. Throughout her four years in Ruston, she compiled 895 points, 394 rebounds and 334 assists.
- As a senior at Summit High School, Dixon was named the District 10-5A Offensive Player of the Year, TABC All-Region and TGCA All-State while leading the team to a 26-8 record.

Freshmen File

- All of North Texas' true freshmen are from the great state of Texas.
- Mcgruder hails from Grand Praire, Texas. She will be playing guard for the Mean Green.

- She was rated No. 32 by Premiere Basketball Player in the '21 class.

-Canyon, Texas native Chloe Callahan saw her first action in the exhibition game against TWU. In the class of 2021, she was rated No. 42 by Premier Basketball Player.

- The Red Oak product, Anivah Johnson stands as tall a six feet and two inches. She will be playing forward for the Mean Green.

- The lefty was named to the All-Ellis County 2019-2020 Girls Basketball First Team.

- All three were ramked in the top 45 in their respective recruiting class.

UNT Joining the American

The University of North Texas was accepted as a new member of the American Athletic Conference and will begin competition at a date determined by league officials.

Also set to join The American as soon as 2023 are Charlotte. Florida Atlantic, Rice, UAB and UTSA. The new invites join existing members East Carolina, Memphis, Navy (football only), SMU, Temple, Tulane, Tulsa, USF, and Wichita State.

UNT has competed as a member of Conference USA since 2013. North Texas was a member of the Sun Belt Conference beginning in 2001.

Staff Additions

 Ciara Carl comes from San Diego State where she was an assistant coach for the Aztec women's basketball team the past eight seasons.

 Carl directed the Aztecs' scouting efforts, worked with the team's guards and recruited. Since Carl began serving on SDSU's coaching staff, the Aztecs have garnered at least one Mountain West honoree each season.

- This past season the Aztecs earned the eighth seed in the Mountain West Tournament and tied for fifth in the league in 2019-
- Carl assisted in the signing of back-to-back top-75 recruiting classes in 2017 and 2018. Prior to that, SDSU did not have a nationally ranked recruiting class since 2010-11.
- Matt Holt Holt comes to Denton from Milwaukee where he was the Director of Strength and Conditioning since 2017. He worked with six olympic sports.

Mitchell in Coaches Circle

Head Coach Jalie Mitchell was selected to last year's Conference USA Coaches Circle. Joining Mitchell: Cara Consuegra (Charlotte), Tina Langley (Rice), Joye Lee-McNelis (Southern Miss) and Kevin Baker (UTEP). The Circle consists of C-USA coaches who earned votes for the league's Coach of the Year award.

Best-Ever Mark in C-USA

The 52-51 win over Marshall Feb. 26, 2021 handed North Texas their ninth league win and set a program-best for Conference USA victories to surpass the previous high of eight, set during the 2016-17 season during head coach Jalie Mitchell's second season. The Mean Green added another conference victory with the win at Rice March 6 to increase the total to 10.

Regardless of conference affiliation, the most league wins ever is 12, when UNT went 12-3 while in the Sun Belt during Mitchell's senior season in 2001-02 under head coach Tina Slinker.



Seventh Year (North Texas '02)

Jalie Mitchell has vastly improved Mean Green women's basketball since her return to Denton in 2015 when she was chosen to lead her alma mater. The team has improved upon the program's previous record nearly every year under Mitchell while setting several school records and program firsts

North Texas is coming off a record-breaking season in 2020-21 that included the best conference start in program history (5-0), the highest Conference USA win total ever (10), the greatest winning percentage in 15 seasons (65.0), the top scoring average in 19 years (69.3) and a double-digit league win tally for the sixth time in 38 years. She also was able to help Quincy Noble recieve First Team C-USA honors. Noble is the second to ever do so at UNT.

The 2019-20 season may have been cut short, but North Texas women's basketball was still able to put up some impressive numbers and execute notable performances. The Mean Green consistently ranked in top 25 nationally in total rebounds, rebounds per game and offensive rebounds per game and had the only duo (Anisha George and Charlene Shepherd) in the nation to collect at least 23 rebounds in a single contest.

The 114 points scored against Texas A&M-Texarkana were the highest total recorded by a Conference USA team and 13th most points scored in Division I, while the 46 field goals were fifth best in DI and the 63 rebounds were 11th. The team put up 2,033 total points for the ninth-best performance in program history and concluded the season ranking second in C-USA in offensive rebounds (14.3), third in steals (8.7) and fourth in scoring defense (62.7). George was selected Second Team All-Conference by leading C-USA in field goal accuracy and was fifth in the nation at shooting over 64 percent.

North Texas women's basketball made history in 2018-19 during Mitchell's fourth season with several program firsts, including the program's only nonconference postseason win in a 56-42 victory over UTRGV during the opening round of the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Mean Green had advanced past the conference tournament in three seasons previously, 1985-86, 2000-01, and 2001-02, but had never pulled out a win until the defeat of UTRGV March 20.

Under Mitchell's guidance, Terriell Bradley is the only Mean Green player to receive C-USA First Team honors (2017-18 and 2018-19) after finishing last season with averages of 15.8 points, 4.1 rebounds and 1.8 assists. Bradley finished her career as the fifth-leading scorer in program history with 1,467 points and is number one in the charts in free throws with 417 and fifth in 3-pointers with 138.

George was also recognized by the league as an All-Defensive Team selection after pulling an average of 6.9 rebounds per contest and tallying 29 blocks on the season.

In 2017-18, Mitchell led North Texas to its most wins in 12 years and best finish in a conference tournament in 16 years.

The Mean Green owned one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to an average of just 56.2 points per game, the 15th-best mark in the country and the greatest in program history. They finished with a 17-14 record to achieve their first winning season in 12 years. In the Conference USA Tournament, UNT reached the semifinals for the first time since Mitchell's senior season in Denton in 2001-02.

The Mean Green defeated Charlotte twice, a program they had never beaten previously, and in the C-USA quarterfinals they defeated Louisiana Tech for the first time in school history.

In her third season, Mitchell guided Bradley to an all-conference first-team honor, the program's first in nine years and just its third in 15 seasons. In addition, freshman Lauren Holmes was named to the conference's all-freshman team.

North Texas posted a program-best 3.33 gradepoint average, and recruited two NJCAA All-Americans, one more than it had recruited in its 41-year history.

In 2016-17, the Mean Green improved on their overall record by a game. They won eight Conference USA games, the most since they joined the conference in 2013-14, and defeated UTEP in El Paso for the first time in program history. UNT reached the quarterfinals of the C-USA Tournament for the first time.

In May of 2015, Mitchell became the Mean Green's eighth head coach and took what she described as her "dream job."

Mitchell took over a program that won five games the previous season. For her first career win as a head coach, the Mean Green beat the No. 17 ranked Oklahoma Sooners in Oklahoma.

It was the first time a Mean Green team had defeated a ranked opponent.

North Texas had a noticeable increase in offense in her first season as the Mean Green improved their field goal percentage by 7.23% — the largest improvement in the country. It was also the sixth-highest shooting percentage in North Texas history.

Mitchell had two stints as an assistant coach at UNT, including one-year under current Texas head coach Karen Aston. She was instrumental in the recruiting of eventual top-10 WNBA draft pick

In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015, their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. Mitchell spent two seasons at North Texas with Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC-Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

Mitchell played at North Texas from 1998-2002 and was a four-time all-conference selection and the 2002 Sun Belt Player of the Year after averaging 19.4 points per game. She is the program's leading scorer with 1,764 points and her number 44 was retired on her senior night.

She is part of the winningest senior class in North Texas history, putting together a 77-39 record, including 42-4 at home. The Mean Green made back-to-back appearances to the WNIT in 2001 and 2002.

In 2007, Mitchell was inducted into the North Texas Athletic Hall of Fame along with teammate Rosalyn Reades.

In addition to the North Texas Athletics Hall of Fame, Mitchell was inducted into the Duncanville ISD Athletic Hall of Honor in October of 2015.







Ciara Carl

Assoc. Head Coach

First Year (Point Loma Nazarene '05)

Carl comes to Denton from San Diego State where she was an assistant coach for the Aztec women's basketball team the past eight seasons. Carl directed the

Aztecs' scouting efforts, worked with the team's guards and recruited. Since Carl began serving on SDSU's coaching staff, the Aztecs have garnered at least one Mountain West honoree each season.

This past season the Aztecs earned the eighth seed in the Mountain West Tournament and tied for fifth in the league in 2019-20. In 2018-19, the team won 14 games and advanced to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Carl assisted in the signing of back-to-back top-75 recruiting classes in 2017 and 2018. Prior to that, SDSU did not have a nationally ranked recruiting class since 2010-11.

Carl helped McKynzie Fort (2014-18) climb the scoring charts to become the Aztecs' third-leading scorer (1,708 points) in program history. Fort was a four-time all-Mountain West honoree and was named to the conference's all-defensive team twice. Carl was also instrumental in the development of Geena Gomez, who finished her career with a three-point field-goal percentage of .361 (115-319), the third best in school history.

During her one season at Metro State, Carl helped coach the Roadrunners to 21 victories and a spot in the NCAA Division II tournament, where they advanced to the second round. Under her tutelage, five Metro State players garnered All-Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference accolades, including Kristin Valencia, who was named the league's defensive player of the year. As a team, the Roadrunners led the RMAC in scoring defense (51.2 ppg) and limited opponents to a league-worst .350 field-goal percentage.

Carl also witnessed success during her tenure at Cal Poly Pomona from 2010-12, as the Broncos compiled a two-year mark of 47-14 (.770) and made a pair of NCAA DII tournament appearances, including a berth in the Elite Eight in 2011. During that season, Carl assisted in the development of senior guard Reyana Colson, who earned All-America honors after capturing the California Collegiate Athletic Association's Most Valuable Player award.

In 2019 Carl launched Unchained, a non-profit aimed to serve and inspire young people through love and passion while helping them visualize and realize the futures they desire. The organization uses basketball as a tool to teach leadership and character lessons while providing real life examples of people who have triumphed over challenging circumstances they faced as a young person.

As a collegian, Carl starred at point guard for Point Loma Nazarene, helping the Sea Lions compile an 83-27 overall record in her final three seasons. During that stretch, PLNU made three consecutive trips to the NAIA tournament, capped by a Final Four appearance in 2005. She still holds the school's career record with 647 assists and ranks second with 277 steals.

Carl received her undergraduate degree in exercise science from PLNU in 2005 and earned her Master of Science degree from California University (Pa.) in 2006 with an emphasis in performance enhancement and injury prevention. She later completed an internship at North Carolina State, working with the Wolfpack's strength and conditioning program.

A native of Los Angeles, Carl was raised in Cary, N.C., before graduating from Saint Mary's School in 2000. In addition to earning all-state honors in basketball as a senior, Carl also lettered in volleyball and golf during her prep career.



Durmon Jennings

Assistant Coach

Second Year (Indianapolis '13)

Jennings came to Denton in 2020 following three seasons as the women's basketball associate head coach at Eastern New Mexico. Spearheaded by his

player development and recruiting, Jennings helped guide the Greyhounds to the second most wins in program history with an overall record of 22-9. ENMU advanced to the NCAA Division II South Central Region Championship Tournament for the third time ever and also posted a victory over No. 1 ranked and defending national champions Lubbock Christian during the regular season.

The Hounds compiled a 19-11 record during the 2018-19 season to secure a spot in the South Central Regional. ENMU went 14-6 in Lone Star Conference play to finish tied for third in the league while also setting the best home record in program history with a 12-1 mark inside Greyhound Arena.

Jennings joined ENMU's women's basketball program prior to the start of the 2017-18 campaign as the team compiled a record of 16-12 and a 12-8 mark in the LSC to finish in a tie for fourth in conference play.

Jennings previously served as the graduate assistant coach of the ENMU men's basketball program during the 2015-16 season and the fall semester of the 2016-17 season before becoming the volunteer assistant coach in January 2017.

Before coming to Eastern, Jennings served as a boys varsity and junior varsity coach at Durango High School in Las Vegas, Nevada, for two seasons. Jennings also served as a 17U coach for the Elite Youth Basketball League in the summer of 2015 and as a 15U coach for the Under Armour Association during the summer of 2014.

In 2013, Jennings served as an intern for the NBA Summer League as well as served as an intern for the Athletic Administration at the University of Nevada at Las Vegas (UNLV) for one year. Before moving to Las Vegas, the Indianapolis native coached back home as a high school girls basketball and track and field coach at Warren Central High School from 2011 to 2013. Jennings got his start in coaching at Manual High School in Indianapolis where he coached the varsity girls' basketball team during the 2010-11 season.

Jennings earned his bachelor's degree in Sports Management at the University of Indianapolis in 2013 after he transferred from Geneva College where he played on the men's basketball team during the 2007-08 season. Jennings earned his master's degree in Sports Administration from Eastern New Mexico University in 2016.





Kelby Jones

Assistant Coach

Second Year (North Texas '16)

Jones returned to Denton in 2020 after spending the past four seasons as a member of the Texas women's basketball staff, most recently serving as the program's

basketball analyst coordinator. His responsibilities focused on assisting with basketball philosophy development, game preparation and scouting, skill development and special-situation offensive study.

Before working with the Longhorns, Jones spent four years as Director of Managerial Operations as an undergraduate at UNT, beginning in 2012. He was the team's head manager and was promoted to the program's interim basketball operations director his senior year. Jones was responsible for film exchange, team travel, practice schedules, the scout team, equipment and assisted with on-campus recruiting. In 2015, he was nominated for the "Hardest Working Employee" award at the University of North Texas.

During the past four seasons as a member of the Texas staff, the Longhorns compiled a record of 95-37 (.720) for an average of 24 wins per season and earned three NCAA Tournament appearances, including a pair of NCAA Sweet 16 showings. Texas ranked within the top-25 nationally in rebounding margin in each of his four years, including three top-six national rankings in that category. Jones' contributions to Texas recruiting efforts resulted in two top-three national classes, according to espnW Hoop Gurlz and six McDonald's All-Americans.

In 2018-19, Jones served as the program's video coordinator where he oversaw video exchange and the breakdown of opponent and individual video scouting, along with on-campus recruiting and other duties. In his first two seasons, Jones was the program's graduate assistant. In that role, he managed the team's day-to-day equipment needs, coordinated scheduling for managers and practice players, assisted with game and opponent scouting, and was heavily involved in on-campus recruiting.

Jones earned his master's degree in physical education-teacher education from the University of Texas in May 2018. A native of Pottsboro, Texas, and a 2012 graduate of Pottsboro High School, Jones earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from UNT in May 2016.



Brinee' Dancer

Director of Ops

Third Year (Southern Polytechnic St., 15)

Dancer came to Denton in August 2019 after two years at Tennessee State as the director of operations for women's basketball where she handled all

operational functions for the program.

Before TSU, Dancer served as a graduate assistant coach on the women's basketball staff at Mississippi Valley State where she coordinated travel, assisted with the budget, conducted video sessions and monitored study hall. She also helped with the development of All-SWAC First Team selection Ashley Beals.

Dancer worked with Lady Eagles Sports in Dallas for a year as the coordinator where she served as an advisor, organized travel and monitored the team. Dancer also spent time with the Summer Basketball Organization in Fort Worth as a DFW Elite Basketball Grassroots assistant coach.

Dancer was a member of the women's basketball team at Johnson C. Smith for two seasons before graduating from Southern Polytechnic State with a bachelor of science in business administration. She earned a master's degree in sports administration from Mississippi Valley State in August 2018.

First Year (Carroll '11)

Matt Holt joins North Texas as an Assistant Strength and Conditioning Coach to work with Mean Green women's basketball.

Holt comes to Denton from Milwaukee Athletics where he was the Director of Strength and Conditioning since 2017. He worked with men's basketball, volleyball, women's soccer, men's soccer, tennis and cross country.

Holt joined Milwaukee Athletics in 2014 as an Assistant Strength and Conditioning Coach. Prior to that, he was at Marquette University as an intern from 2013-2014. Holt also served as an intern with Milwaukee Athletics from 2011-2013, during which time he completed his master's degree in Kinesiology.

Holt has additional experience working as an intern for the Milwaukee Bucks and as a Strength and Conditioning Assistant with Carroll University Baseball. Additionally, Holt was the Head Wrestling Coach at Waukesha West High School and an assistant at New Berlin West/Eisenhower High Schools.
