A-State leads 16-15

- ▶ Arkansas State and UT Arlington meet for the second time this season on Saturday, with the Red Wolves looking to avenge a close 90-87 loss in January in Jonesboro. Saturday's meeting will mark their final regular-season bout as conference mates, with UTA moving to the WAC in July.
- ▶ UTA has owned the series of late, winning the last nine in a row entering Saturday.

THE OPENING TIP

- ▶ Arkansas State is looking to enter postseason play on a winning note, taking on UT Arlington in the final regular season contest. Tip inside the College Park Center is set for 2 p.m. Saturday. The game will be broadcasted live on ESPN+ and can be heard on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network flagship station KNEA 95.3/96.9 The Ticket/970 AM. The 2021-22 campaign marks the 31st season in the Sun Belt Conference for Arkansas State.
- ▶ The 2021-22 campaign marks the program's 48th season, with the Red Wolves amassing a 768-600 all-time record (.561) dating back to the inaugural 1974-75 season. A-State is the active winningest program among current Sun Belt Conference members.

ABOUT THE LADY MAVERICKS

- ▶ UT Arlington enters Saturday's contest at 17-6 overall (11-3 SBC) after defeating Little Rock 63-54 on Friday morning. The Lady Mavericks allowed the Trojans just two free throws, while UTA had four players score in double figures.
- ▶ **Starr Jacobs** leads the conference in scoring (20.0) while also pacing the Lady Mavs in rebounding (6.0). She shoots a league-best 54.7 percent from the field and is also second in the conference with 2.2 steals per ballgame. **Claire Chastain** is one of the league's top foul shooters, holding a 78.0 percent clip, while **Terryn Milton** and **Katie Ferrell** rank first and second in the conference in assist/turnover ratio at 2.5 and 2.3, respectively.
- ▶ Collectively, UTA leads the conference in assist/turnover ratio (1.11) and 3-point field-goal defense (26.6 percent), the latter which ranks 22nd in the nation entering Friday. The Lady Mavericks have coughed up just 310 turnovers in 23 games - the least in the league and 14th lowest total nationally.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Arkansas State held a halftime edge on Thursday at Texas State, but could not overcome a second-half surge by the Bobcats, falling 84-75 at Strahan Arena. A-State shot the ball well at a 57.1 percent clip (31-60) but only made nine trips to the free-throw line and only converting on four of those attempts.
- ▶ **Jireh Washington** tied for the game high with 25 points off the bench, while **Maily Wilkerson** factored in 12 points.

AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD . . .

- ▶ Improve Arkansas State's record at 12-15 and surpass 2019-20's win total while matching 2018-19's total.
- ▶ Move A-State to 5-9 in Sun Belt Conference play and surpass last season's conference win total.
- ▶ End a three-game losing streak.
- ▶ Give A-State a win to end the regular season for the first time since 2019 (75-73 at Louisiana)
- ▶ Halt a nine-game losing skid in the series against UT Arlington
- ▶ Be better than a loss.

TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE

- ▶ A pair of Arkansas State guards joined the illustrious 1,000-Point Club recently as **Morgan Wallace** and **Jireh Washington** achieved the feat during A-State's Alabama road swing in late January.
- ▶ Wallace was the first to move into the club and is just the eighth player in program history with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds in a career. She sits 21st in career scoring (1,080), passing Zenia Hayes (1986-90) on Saturday against Little Rock.
- ▶ Meanwhile, Washington is the team's active scoring leader with 1,115 points after a 25-point outburst at Texas State on Thursday, ranking 18th all-time in scoring. The Memphian became the 26th player in school history to achieve the feat, which means there will be another page added into the 2022-23 A-State Women's Basketball Reference Guide to account for these two new additions.
- ▶ With two 1,000-Point Scorers on the team, it is just the SIXTH time an A-State team had 2 or more 1,000-point scorers on the same team (1986-87; 1991-92; 1992-93; 2005-06; 2015-16).

THE IRON LADY

- ▶ Former British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher is the Iron Lady, but so is Arkansas State's **Morgan Wallace**, who is the ultimate stat stuffer for the Red Wolves. On Jan. 27 against UT Arlington, she became the first A-State player with a triple double since Rudy Sims in 2006.
- ▶ Wallace has played at least 35 minutes 16 times this year, including three games with 40 minutes.

ON THIS DAY - FEBRUARY 26

- ▶ Since the 1991-92 season (first season in SBC), Arkansas State has played eight times on February 26, owning a 5-3 mark.
- ▶ A-State last played on this date in last season, falling 60-40 to Saturday's opponent, UT Arlington, in Jonesboro.
- ▶ **1863:** Abraham Lincoln signs the National Currency Act, establishing a single national U.S. currency.
- ▶ **1935:** Babe Ruth is released by the Yankees and he signs with the Boston Braves.
- ▶ **1983:** Michael Jackson's "Thriller" album goes #1 and stays #1 for 37 weeks.
- ▶ **HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO:** the late Johnny Cash (1932), Marshall Faulk (1973)

TRINITEE'S TRANSFORMATION

- ▶ Forward **Trinitee Jackson** has been one of the most improved players in the Sun Belt Conference over the past two seasons in multiple areas, including upping her minutes played per game from 6.8 in 2019-20 to 15.4 a season ago. Because of that, Jackson went from averaging just 3.0 points and 2.9 rebounds to becoming a key impact performer who averaged 7.9 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting 48.0 percent from the floor.
- ▶ That has continued into this season, where she is averaging the most minutes of her career (21.5), and as a result, becoming a force in the post in the Sun Belt Conference. Jackson leads the Sun Belt with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game (18th in NCAA), while ranking fourth in total rebounds (209) and third in rebounds per game (8.7). When she's not scoring or attacking the glass, she's getting to the foul line, attempting 119 free throws entering Saturday, which is second-most in the conference.
- ▶ Jackson owns 10 career double-doubles, but eight of them have come this season, which is third-most in the league.
- ▶ On 1/29 versus Texas State, she posted one of the best lines to date with 18 points and 21 rebounds - tied for the second most in school history in a single game. Jackson is one of just 12 players in Division I to score 15 or more points and record 21 or more rebounds, but the **ONLY** one to do so in under 30 minutes.

"IT MUST BE NICE TO HAVE WASHINGTON ON YOUR SIDE"

- ▶ It's definitely nice to have an All-Sun Belt Conference performer like **Jireh Washington**. Despite missing the last 11 games of last season, she still earned a preseason Second Team nod.
- ▶ Washington has started to return to form after recovering from a season-ending injury last year. The junior missed the first three games of the year but has started to show why she was a preseason all-league honoree. The Memphis native has scored in double figures in eight of the last 10 games, and in 11 of her last 15 outings. She has scored 25 or more in four of those games after pouring in 25 on Thursday off the bench at Texas State.
- ▶ Over the last 16 games, Washington has been playing in a completely different gear, averaging 14.9 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.8 assists while shooting 48.6 percent from the field and 36.4 percent from deep. In the six games prior, she averaged just 8.3 points and 1.3 boards.
- ▶ But she's not only scoring, she's proven to be just as capable a facilitator and is now eighth all-time in program history in career assists (305), passing Jasmine Taylor (2007-11) Thursday night at Texas State.

"THE ZOOM WHERE IT HAPPENS"

- ▶ Aaron Burr wanted to be in the "Room Where It Happens," but it's also a big deal to be in the ZOOM where it happens... Arkansas State women's basketball began weekly Zoom media conferences at the beginning of league play.
- ▶ In multiple previous Zooms, Interim Head Coach **Destinee Rogers** has called out individual players who need to step up their game.
- ▶ On Jan. 3, Rogers called out both **Keya Patton** and **Trinitee Jackson** by name, and both responded well, with Patton scoring 30 points and earning Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week honors while Jackson notched a double-double with 16 points and 10 boards.
- ▶ On Jan. 10, Rogers said that **Jireh Washington** and **Morgan Wallace** needed to step up. And step up they did, to the tune of 25 points and a double-double of 16 points and 10 rebounds, respectively, against Appalachian State on Thursday.
- ▶ On Jan. 18, Rogers challenged freshman guards **Jade Upshaw** and **Lauryn Pendleton** to step up their game against South Alabama and Troy. Pendleton answered the call against the Trojans, dropping a game-high and career-best 21 points.

PATTON POWER

- ▶ Arkansas State newcomer **Keya Patton** provided an instant impact in the lineup before succumbing to a season-ending injury during pregame warmups on Thursday at South Alabama.
- ▶ The Indianapolis, Ind., native dropped 30 points in the first half (!) against ULM on Jan. 8 and was rightly being named the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week on Jan. 11.
- ▶ The Auburn transfer led A-State in scoring (14.3) prior to her injury, while ranking second in the conference in field-goal percentage (51.4%).
- ▶ Patton scored 10 or more points in 12 of her 15 games played this season, with her 30-point performance versus App the first by an A-State player since Dec. 20, 2016 (Jada Ford vs. Northern Kentucky).

ROGERS TAKES OVER AS INTERIM HEAD COACH

- ▶ **Destinee Rogers** has stepped in as the program's interim head coach for the remainder of the regular season after the sudden resignation by now-former head coach Matt Daniel on Monday night. Rogers was tapped as interim on Dec. 14 prior to A-State's 81-47 wallop of MVSU.
- ▶ The win over the Delta Devils wasn't just her first career win as a collegiate head coach, however. Rogers made Arkansas State Athletics history as the first African-American woman to not only lead an A-State program but also to win a game in that capacity.
- ▶ Rogers has been on staff at A-State since 2019-20, being promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to last year.

ANOTHER TRIP AROUND THE SUN

- ▶ Arkansas State is in its 31st season of Sun Belt Conference play and looks to continue its success against league foes, owning a 240-136 (.638) all-time mark against current conference members. A-State joined the league prior to the 1991-92 season, owning a 268-220 (.549) all-time mark in league play entering Saturday.

HISTORY MADE

- ▶ After taking over as interim head coach prior to A-State's contest on Dec. 14 against Mississippi Valley State, **Destinee Rogers** made history with the 81-47 victory.
- ▶ Rogers' win marked the first win in Arkansas State athletics history by an African-American woman. That milestone drew attention from other coaches on the national stage, with South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley sending a video message to Rogers as well as a piece of her championship net ([Rogers got the net](#)). Hall-of-Famer Sherri Coale also reached out to Rogers to provide encouragement and insight.

RED WOLVES FEBRUARY

- ▶ Arkansas State has fared well in the month of February, traditionally, owning 19 records of .500 or better in the second and shortest month of the calendar year.
- ▶ Since the 1991-92 season (first season in the Sun Belt), A-State is 131-100 (.567) in February, including an unblemished 8-0 mark in 2015-16. Lately, however, the Red Wolves have faced some stiff competition in the latter part of the season, owning just one record of .500 or better in the month over the last five seasons dating back to 2016-17.

"I WANNA GO FAST!"

- ▶ Just like racing legend Ricky Bobby, Arkansas State wants to go fast. They have played a fast brand of basketball early on this season, and it's showing both on the scoreboard and in the advanced metrics.
- ▶ According to HerHoopStats.com, the Red Wolves rank 15th nationally (out of 356 teams) in possessions per 40 minutes ("Pace"), averaging 76.0 possessions per 40 minutes against Division I foes. A-State's 75.6 points per game against D1 opposition is also inside the top 20 in HHS's rankings (18th as of Feb. 25).
- ▶ In conference play, A-State is even faster, if that was thought to be impossible... The Red Wolves are second in the league in scoring in conference games only (75.7) and are fourth in pace (75.0 possessions/40 min.) as of Friday. A-State also leads the league with 100.6 points per 100 possessions in conference play.

ALL GAS, NO BRAKES

- ▶ Speaking of scoring, Arkansas State has picked up the pace scoring-wise over the last several games. While scoring just 65 on Jan. 20 at South Alabama and Feb. 5 versus Texas State, A-State has scored 70-plus in 11 of its last 15 games.
- ▶ The Red Wolves scored 80-plus in three straight conference games for the first time since January-February, 2000 (4 in a row versus New Orleans, South Alabama, Louisiana, & Little Rock), and enter Saturday second in the Sun Belt in points per game in conference play (75.6).

GRAB THE WINDEX!

- ▶ Arkansas State has two of the top rebounders in the Sun Belt Conference this season in **Trinitee Jackson** and **Morgan Wallace**.
- ▶ Jackson has done a nice job cleaning up the glass, sitting second on the team and ranking fourth in the Sun Belt with 209 boards. She is tops in the conference on the offensive glass, ranking 18th in Division I with 4.0 offensive boards per game (93 total). Wallace leads the squad with 211 rebounds, but is also moving up the career charts in A-State history, ranking seventh all-time in career boards (791). Wallace is just the ninth player in school history with 700 or more rebounds and the eighth with 700 boards AND 1,000 points. **MORE ON PAGE 9.**

"YOUNG, SCRAPPY & HUNGRY"

- ▶ Arkansas State has one of the top freshmen in the country in rookie **Lauryn Pendleton**. The Little Rock native was included in Howard Megdal's list of the freshmen who might be the next big names in women's college basketball on [FiveThirtyEight.com](#).

THREE'S A CROWD, FOUR'S A PARTY

- ▶ Arkansas State has had three or more players record double-digit scoring in 24 of 26 games this season, including a run of 21 in a row that ended on Feb. 5 at Louisiana.
- ▶ Dating back to the the 2012-13 season, A-State is 111-69 (.617) when three or more players score 10 or more points.
- ▶ In its win over Appalachian State on Jan. 13, all five starters scored 10 or more points for the first time since **Feb. 7, 2019, versus South Alabama**. All five starters achieved the feat again on Thursday night against UT Arlington.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- ▶ Arkansas State is among the nation's best at getting the free-throw line this season, ranking inside the top 30 nationally with 524 free-throw attempts (30th) and 375 made free throws (29th), ranking third in the Sun Belt in both.
- ▶ Individually, **Trinitee Jackson** and **Morgan Wallace** rank near the top in the Sun Belt in free-throw attempts and makes, respectively. Jackson has attempted 119 foul shots, which is second in the conference while Wallace has made 91 of her 111 attempts, the former which leads the conference and the latter ranking fourth in the league.
- ▶ Wallace is also climbing up the career charts in free throws made, entering Saturday ranked fifth all-time at A-State in the area with 360 makes at the charity stripe, passing Julie Hagood (1997-00) with eight makes on Feb. 12 at Little Rock. She ranks inside the top 50 among active Division I players in both free throw attempts (38th - 505) and makes (44th - 360). She also needs just six attempts to tie Shay Scott (2008-11) for fifth (513).

TAKE IT TO THE BANK!

- ▶ Arkansas State is in its 35th season inside First National Bank Arena, formerly the Convocation Center (aka "The Convo"), owning a 338-123 (.735) ledger.
- ▶ A-State has posted four straight seasons above .500 at "The Bank," and just two sub-.500 marks in 34 seasons. The Red Wolves are 8-5 this season in the friendly confines. With the 2021-22 home slate complete, A-State has clinched a winning record in the building for the fifth year in a row.

"A LITTLE HELP FROM MY FRIENDS"

- ▶ Arkansas State played incredibly unselfish basketball in its season-opening win over Central Baptist College, handing out 18 assists to 26 made field goals for a ~nice~ 69.2 assist percentage. A-State then recorded a 61.5 percent assist percentage (24 assists/39 field goals) versus McNeese on 11/15.
- ▶ In its win over McNeese on 11/15, A-State handed out 24 assists. A-State has posted back-to-back 20-assist outings, delivering 20 assists on 28 field goals against MVSU on Dec. 15 for a season-best rate of 71.4 percent before handing out a season-high 27 on 40 made buckets versus Hendrix on Dec. 19 (67.5 percent).
- ▶ Most recently, the Scarlet and Black delivered 22 assists on 32 field goals at ULM on Monday for a solid 68.8 percent.
- ▶ Arkansas State has handed out 15 or more assists in 12 games this season, surpassing last season's total (6).

TAKE IT AWAY

- ▶ Last season, A-State forced 16 or more turnovers in 12 games, including 20 or more in five games. The Red Wolves forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games.
- ▶ A-State got off to a strong start this season, having forced 15 or more takeaways in 16 outings, including 20 or more five times. In its win over Ozarks (11/23), the Red Wolves forced 31 turnovers - the most by an A-State team since Nov. 12, 2010 (32 vs Texas A&M-Corpus Christi).
- ▶ Going back to the start of the 2019-20 season, Arkansas State has forced double-digit turnovers in all but four games including 19 games with 20 or more.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

- ▶ ... find out what it means to me ...
- ▶ Arkansas State junior guard **Jireh Washington** received some preseason hype from the Sun Belt Conference coaches, being tabbed a preseason Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference member.
- ▶ The Memphis native received Third Team honors after a strong 2019-20 season and was on track to another award-winning season before her year was cut short to injury after 11 games.

RED WOLVES PICKED 10TH IN PRESEASON

- ▶ In the preseason coaches poll, however, the Red Wolves did not receive as much hype, being picked to finish 10th in the Sun Belt Conference.
- ▶ The league moved back to a 1-12 standings format after being in a divisional-only schedule in 2020-21 due to COVID-19. Teams will play a similar schedule this season, facing "division" foes twice and cross-divisional opponents once.

COVID CANCELLATIONS

- ▶ With the rise of the Omicron variant, COVID-19 is rearing its highly-contagious head yet again, and Arkansas State has had to wait longer than expected to open up its home league slate. Back-to-back home outings versus Georgia State (Jan. 1) and Louisiana (Jan. 6) were canceled due to COVID-19 concerns with those programs.
- ▶ The Sun Belt policy states games that cannot be played due to COVID-19 will be canceled and considered a no-contest and will not be rescheduled. The minimum threshold required to compete is seven (7) student-athletes (scholarship or non-scholarship), plus one full-time coach. If a team meets that minimum threshold, they are required to play. Teams may choose to play with less than the minimum threshold.
- ▶ Seeding in the Sun Belt Championship will be based on overall conference winning percentage. However, teams will be required to play a minimum of 80% of the average number of conference games played in order to use their overall conference winning percentage for seeding in the conference championship. Teams falling below the 80% threshold will be seeded at the bottom of the championship bracket with overall conference winning percentage, among the teams that fall below the threshold, being used to determine their seed for the tournament.
