THE MATCHUP

App State closes out its weekend in Texas on Saturday against UT Arlington at 6 p.m. EST on ESPN+.

THE SERIES

This will be the 15th meeting between the two schools, with the Mavericks holding an 11-3 edge...The two teams did not play last season and last met during the 2019-20 season, with UTA winning 66-56 in Arlington on Jan. 9, 2020 and App State winning 57-50 on Feb. 6, 2020 in Boone.

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS

App State dropped a 68-66 decision at Texas State on Thursday evening...**Adrian Delph** had 22 points, five rebounds and three assists and **Donovan Gregory** scored all 17 points in the second half and added six rebounds...Delph has now scored 20 or more points in seven games this season, including five in Sun Belt play...Over his last eight games, Gregory has scored in double figures six times and is averaging 12.9 points and 5.8 rebounds...On the season, **James Lewis Jr.** is averaging 3.0 offensive rebounds per game, which sits third in the Sun Belt...In conference play, the Mountaineers are limiting opponents to just 64.5 points, which is tops in the league.

SCOUTING THE MAVERICKS

UT Arlington's contest on Thursday with Coastal Carolina was canceled due to weather...The Mavericks fell to Texas State on Jan. 28 58-53...**David Azore** had 23 points and four rebounds, while **Patrick Mwamba** tallied eight points and five rebounds...Azore sits atop the Sun Belt in scoring, averaging a league leading 18.2 points...He is also averaging a conference-best 23.9 points in Sun Belt play...**Kaodirichi Akobundu-Ehigou** is averaging a league best 2.5 blocks, while **Javon Levi** sits second in the Sun Belt averaging 5.0 assists.

App State returns to the High Country and begins a four-game home stand on Thursday against Georgia Southern at 6:30 p.m on ESPN+.

MOUNTAINEERS OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY 8-3

• App State has opened **Sun Belt play with a 8-3 record**, marking the best 11 game conference start for the program since 2007-08 (9-2).

• App State **opened conference play with a 6-2 record in back-to-back seasons**. The **last time the Mountaineers opened conference play with a 6-2 record or better in back-to-back seasons was 2007-08** (began 6-1 through first seven SoCon games) and **2006-07** (went 5-2 through first seven conference games).

GOING STREAKING

• App State posted a **six-game winning streak from Jan. 13 to Jan. 29**, which was the longest for the program since the **Black and Gold also won six in a row from Feb. 20, 2010 to March 7, 2010** when the Mountaineers won six straight games in Southern Conference regular season and tournament play.

8-1 IN JANUARY

• With a 72-57 win over Little Rock on Jan. 29, App State **ended the month of January with an 8-1 record**. It marked the **best winning percentage in a month** (min. 5 games) since **January of the 2007-08 season**, when the Mountaineers also went 8-1.

FORREST REACHES 2,000

• With a **3-pointer at the 1:27 mark of the first half** on Jan. 27 versus Arkansas State, **Justin Forrest became the third player in program history to reach 2,000 points**. He now has **2,010 points in his career (third all-time)** and joins Ronshad Shabazz (2,067) and Donald Sims (2,185) as the only players to reach the mark. Forrest is also just the **ninth player in Sun Belt history** to reach 2,000 career points.

DELPH'S CAREER NIGHT

• **Adrian Delph** had a career night on Nov. 22 against Delaware. He finished with **career highs in points (39), field goals made (13) and 3-pointers made (seven)**. Delph started the game a perfect 10-of-10 from the field.

• His scoring output was the **most points scored by a Mountaineer** since Ronshad Shabazz tallied 47 points at ULM on Feb. 28, 2019. His mark is **tied for the 12th highest single game scoring output** in program history, tying Billy Ross who also had 39 points on Feb. 7, 1993 against Chattanooga. In addition, his 39 points are tied for the 12th most in a game in Division I this season.

DELPH NAMED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• **Adrian Delph** was named **Sun Belt Player of the Week for the second time in his career** for games played Jan. 9 to Jan. 15. In a pair of wins versus Coastal Carolina, Delph **averaged 20.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and recorded six assists**. He had 16 points, seven rebounds and three assists in App State's 61-60 home win over the Chanticleers on Jan. 13. He followed that up with 25 points (17 in the first half), six rebounds and three assists in an 84-76 overtime win in Conway on Jan. 15.

COMEBACK KIDS

• Since the start of the 2019-20, App State has **overcome 17 halftime deficits, which is tied for second most in the nation over the last 3 seasons**. App State has overcome two halftime deficits this season, eight last season and seven in 2019-20. In all, the Mountaineers are **one of 41 teams to erase 12 or more halftime deficits** in the past three seasons:

- 18 deficits overcome: UNCG
- **17 deficits overcome: Akron, App State, Colorado State**
- 16 deficits overcome: Louisiana
- 15 deficits overcome: Colorado, Drake, Niagara, South Alabama, Western Kentucky
- 14 deficits overcome: Arkansas State, Auburn, Chattanooga, Kansas, Maryland, Rutgers, St. Bonaventure, UCLA, Youngstown State
- 13 deficits overcome: Arkansas, Boise State, Boston, Bowling Green, Nicholls State, Northern Kentucky, Pittsburgh, Seton Hall, UCF, UMBC, West Virginia
- 12 deficits overcome: Clemson, Cleveland State, Eastern Washington, ETSU, Florida, Hofstra, Loyola Chicago, Montana State, Rider, Texas A&M, Winthrop

ICE IN HIS VEINS

- **Justin Forrest** has made **six shots within the final 45 seconds** in his career to either win a game or send a game to overtime, including one this season:
 - 1/20/22 at Georgia State: Made a fadeaway with 1.4 seconds to lift App State to a 61-60 victory
 - 2/26/21 at Georgia Southern: Knocked down a 3-pointer with 38 seconds left to tie the game at 72-72 in overtime. App State went on to win 84-78 in double overtime
 - 1/4/20 vs. Georgia Southern: Hit three with 0.9 seconds left to give App State a 74-72 win
 - 1/16/20 vs. Arkansas State: Hit a three with 12.4 seconds left to force overtime; App State went on to win 83-80
 - 2/8/20 vs. Texas State: Drained a three with 19.1 seconds left to give App State a 60-57 lead. The Mountaineers won the game by that score
 - 1/29/17 vs. Texas State: Broke a 62-62 tie with a 3-pointer with 18 seconds left; App State went on to win 66-62

MOUNTAINEERS LOCK DOWN ZIPS

- App State **limited Akron to 45 points** in a 57-45 win on Nov. 23 at the Gulf Coast Showcase. The 45 points were the **lowest a Division I opponent has scored** against the Mountaineers since The Citadel also **scored 45 points on Feb. 6, 2014.**

FORREST SETS PROGRAM RECORD FOR GAMES PLAYED

- With his appearance on Dec. 13 against Erskine, **Justin Forrest appeared in the 132nd game** of his career. The appearance marked a **new career program record for games played**, passing Kellen Brand, who played in 131 games from 2006-10.

HOLMES SWEET HOLMES

- App State stands a **9-2 on the season** in the Holmes Center. The Mountaineers went 5-1 at home during non-conference action, marking the sixth straight season they have posted a winning mark at home in non-conference play.
- Since the Holmes Center opened for the 2000-01 season, App State has posted a **186-110 (.628) record**. During that span, the Black and Gold have posted a **winning record at the Holmes Center 13 times**, including a Holmes Center record 14 victories in the 2009-10 season.
- App State had an **announced attendance of 3,401** on Nov. 12 against ETSU. It marked the **largest home crowd** for the program since 3,476 saw the Mountaineers take on Western Carolina on **Jan. 21, 2012**.

2021 SUN BELT TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- App State won **four games in four days** to capture the program's **first ever Sun Belt Tournament title** and **punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 2000**. The Mountaineers defeated **West No. 5 seed Little Rock 67-60** on March 5, **West No. 1 seed Texas State 76-73 in overtime** on March 6, **East No. 2 seed Coastal Carolina 64-61 in overtime** on March 7 and **East No. 1 seed Georgia State 80-73** on March 8.
- The Sun Belt Tournament Championship marked the **seventh tournament title** for the program and **third as a member of Division I**. App State won North State Conference Tournament championship in three consecutive seasons from 1948-50 in the NAIA, the **Carolinas Conference Tournament championship** in 1967 as a member of the NAIA and captured the **Southern Conference Tournament title** in 1979 and 2000.
- During the run to the Sun Belt Tournament title, App State drained a **tournament record 44 3-pointers**. The mark bettered the previous record of **37 made threes**, set by ULM during the 2019 tournament.
- After defeating Little Rock 67-60 on March 5, App State **won a Sun Belt Tournament contest in back-to-back seasons** (W, 70-65 vs. Coastal Carolina last season). The win marked the first time the Mountaineers have won a conference tournament game in two straight seasons since **2011-12 (W, 93-81 vs. College of Charleston)** and **2012-13 (W, 74-60 vs. Furman)**, as members of the Southern Conference.

ALMONACY NAMED MOST OUTSTANDING PLAYER; FORREST NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- At the Sun Belt Tournament last season, **Michael Almonacy** was named **Most Outstanding Player** after a strong four days. He averaged **21.8 points, 3.8 assists and 6.5 rebounds** in four games. In addition, he knocked down a **tournament record 20 3-pointers**, including five or more in three games. In the Sun Belt Tournament title game, he finished with a **career-high 32 points**, knocking down six 3-pointers, and seven rebounds to help App State punch its ticket to the NCAA Tournament. He became the **fourth player in program history** to be named Most Outstanding Player of a conference tournament, joining Darryl Robinson (1979), Marshall Phillips (1999) and Tyson Patterson (2000).
- For his efforts at the Sun Belt Tournament last season, **Justin Forrest** was named to the **All-Tournament Team**. He averaged **20.0 points and 3.4 rebounds** in four games. He **scored over 20 points in two games**, including a **season-high 28 points** in the Mountaineers victory over Texas State in the quarterfinals.

Dustin Kerns was named the 22nd head coach in App State men's basketball history on March 28, 2019.

In his first two seasons at the helm of the Mountaineers, Kerns has led App State to 35 wins and back-to-back winning records for the first time since 2009-10 and 2010-11. In addition, Kerns has guided the Black and Gold to 23 Sun Belt victories and has recorded 11 true road wins, which are the most for a coach in his first two seasons since the 1940-41 and 1941-42 seasons.

In 2020-21, Kerns led App State to a 17-12 record, culminating with the program's first ever Sun Belt Tournament title and first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2001. The Mountaineers won four games in four days at the Sun Belt Tournament to punch the program's ticket to the NCAA Tournament. Michael Almonacy was named Most Outstanding Player of the tournament, becoming the fourth player in program history to earn the honor. During the season, App State was ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 for the first time since 2010. App State started the season 12-5, marking the program's best start through 17 games since the 2006-07 season.

Defensively, App State once again established itself as one of the top defensive teams in the Sun Belt. For the second straight season, the Mountaineers finished second in the league in opponent scoring, holding teams to 64.1 points, which was the lowest since the 1980-81 season. In all, the Mountaineers held 12 opponents under 65 points in a game during the season. Additionally, App State shot 74.2 percent from the free throw line, which led the conference and marked the first time the Mountaineers have finished atop the conference in free throw shooting as a Division I member (1972-73 season). Individually, App State saw three players (Michael Almonacy, Adrian Delph and Justin Forrest) land All-Sun Belt honors. It marked just the fourth time in program history that three players have been named all-conference in a season.

In his first season at the helm of the Mountaineers, Kerns led App State to its best season in a decade. The Black and Gold posted its most wins (18) since 2009-10 and most Sun Belt wins (11) ever. App State went 6-5 in non-conference play, marking the first time App State finished with a non-conference winning record since 2007-08. The Mountaineers also won 10 contests in the Holmes Center, which was the most for the program since the 2012-13 season. App State posted its second highest finish ever in the Sun Belt that culminated with a come from behind 70-65 win over Coastal Carolina in the Sun Belt Tournament. Kern's 18 victories in his first season at App State were the most by a first year head coach for the Mountaineers since 1942. In addition, the Black and Gold posted a +7 win turnaround, which ranked as the third highest in the nation.

On the court, App State established itself as one of the top defensive teams in the Sun Belt and nation. The Mountaineers held opponents to just 67.3 points, which ranked second in the conference. In addition, App State held 13 opponents to under 60 points, which marked the most for the program since the 1979-80 season. Individually, Justin Forrest was named First Team All-Sun Belt, marking the first First Team All-Sun Belt honor for the program since joining the league in 2014-15. Forrest was also tabbed as Sun Belt Player of the Week twice.

Off the court, Kerns has seen the Mountaineers excel in the classroom and in the community. The program achieved its highest team GPA in program history of 3.42 during the fall semester in 2020. App State also ranked 10th nationally in community service hours for Division I men's basketball during 2019-20.

A native of Kingsport, Tenn., Kerns came to the High Country from Presbyterian, where he served as head coach for two seasons. Inherited a Presbyterian program that had yet to achieve a winning record in 12 seasons at the Division I level and was coming off a five-win campaign in 2016-17. He immediately led the Blue Hose to a six-win improvement in his first year before breaking through in 2018-19.

Kerns guided the Blue Hose to their first winning record (20-16) and first postseason appearance (CIT) as a Division I program in just his second year on the job. PC's 12-3 record at home and 9-7 mark in Big South Conference play are also its best since joining the Division I ranks. Kerns' team advanced to the quarterfinals of the CIT after garnering road wins at Seattle and Robert Morris. For his efforts, Kerns was named as a finalist for both the Hugh Durham Award (top mid-major coach) and the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year.

Highly regarded for both his recruiting acumen and player development, Kerns and his staff mentored 2018-19 Big South Freshman of the Year Adam Flagler, who led the Blue Hose with 15.9 points per game and

a school-record 108 3-pointers made. In Flagler and forward Cory Hightower, PC boasted two of the league's five all-freshman honorees. Point guard Davon Bell led the league in assists (6.5/game) and made the All-Big South second team.

Presbyterian established itself as one of the premier 3-point shooting teams in the country in 2018-19. The Blue Hose's 394 total trifectas currently rank second-most in the nation behind NCAA Sweet 16 contender Auburn. Kerns' team didn't just shoot the ball prolifically, but also efficiently. The team's 3-point field-goal percentage ranks among the top 25 nationally, and PC's assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.58 is fifth-best in the country. For his efforts this past season, Kerns has been named a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year and for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major National Coach of the Year. The winners of each award will be announced next weekend at the Final Four.

A 2002 graduate of Clemson, Kerns climbed the coaching ranks on staffs with Buzz Peterson at Tennessee, Mike Young at Wofford and Kerry Keating at Santa Clara.

From 2013-17, he served as associate head coach at Wofford, helping the Terriers claim back-to-back Southern Conference Tournament titles and NCAA appearances in 2014 and 2015. He was instrumental in the development of guard Fletcher Magee, who this year broke the record for most 3-pointers in NCAA Division I history. Kerns received national recognition as one of college basketball's top assistant coaches and recruiters, earning the No. 4 Low-Major Recruiter ranking from CoachStat.net and the No. 20 Mid-Major Assistant Coach ranking.

Kerns was an assistant coach at Santa Clara for five seasons from 2008-13, where he helped the Broncos claim the third-most wins in the West Coast Conference behind Gonzaga and Saint Mary's during that span. He helped Santa Clara win 26 games in 2012-13 and capture the College Basketball Insider (CBI) title, as well as a 24-win season and a CIT title in 2010-11. He had previous stints as director of operations at Santa Clara (2007-08), assistant coach at Wofford (2004-07), graduate assistant at Tennessee (2003-04) and director of basketball operations at Tennessee Tech (2002-03).

During his coaching career, Kerns has seen 37 players play professionally.

Kerns graduated from Clemson in 2002 with a degree in secondary education. As an undergraduate, he worked as a student assistant for the men's basketball program and was selected to coach at the prestigious Michael Jordan Flight School for three summers from 2001-03.

Kerns played basketball at Kingsport's Dobyns-Bennett High School, a national powerhouse at the prep level and alma mater of former App State and current NFL offensive lineman Daniel Kilgore.

Kerns is married to the former Brittany Wright, and the couple has a daughter, Emory, and a son, Riggs.

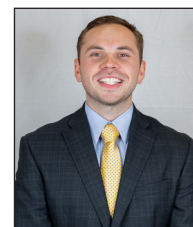
