- · App State puts its five-game winning streak on the line Sunday in a game that was postponed by a day because of winter weather and travel issues.
- The Mountaineers' 5-1 start in league play is their best since joining the Sun Belt and best since opening Southern Conference play 6-1 in 2012-13.
- The team's five-game winning streak in league play is also its best since joining the Sun Belt in 2014. Last year, the Mountaineers won their final three regular-season games before winning their first two at the Sun Belt Tournament. In their last 12 games against Sun Belt opponents dating back to last year, the Mountaineers are 10-2.
- This game features the current No. 1 (App State) and No. 2 (UTA) teams in the Sun Belt standings.
- Last time out, App State erased a 15-point, fourth-quarter deficit to win 70-68 at Coastal Carolina. Janay Sanders scored the Mountaineers' last six points of a 14-1 closing run, including a game-winning floater with three seconds left on the clock.
- This is the second of four straight road games for App State before a three-game home stretch to close out conference play.

- App State forces 21.0 turnovers per game, good for 19th in the nation. UTA comes in with the fewest turnovers in the SBC, only averaging 13.9, good for 39th in the nation.
- The Mountaineers are not afraid to shoot from deep, topping the Sun Belt and ranking 23rd in the country with 526 3-point attempts this season.
- Alexia Allesch, a transfer from Seton Hall, leads the team with 13.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. She has been on fire in Sun Belt play, averaging 16.7 points and 10 boards per outing, good for fourth in the league in both categories.
- Preseason All-Sun Belt third teamer **Michaela Porter** averages 13.1 points (9th in SBC), while adding 5.8 rebounds, 2.1 assists and a league-best 2.6 steals.
- Janay Sanders is third on the team and ranks 16th in the Sun Belt with 11.6 ppg, including a
 career-high 22 at Mercer, 19 at Duke and 18 at Coastal Carolina.
- Freshman **Emily Carver** is tied for third among Sun Belt players with 1.7 three's made per game.
- Faith Alston sets the table with a team-high 3.2 assists per outing, sixth-best in the Sun Belt.
- This is the 15th matchup between the Mountaineers and Lady Mavs. UTA leads 13-1, but App State won the last meeting 54-46 in the quarterfinals of last year's SBC tourney.
- Head coach **Angel Elderkin** is in her eighth season at the helm and is looking to lead App State to its second straight winning season and third in four years.

An App State win would...

- Improve App State to 12-8 overall and 6-1 in league action, extending its best conference start since joining the Sun Belt in 2014.
- Be the team's sixth consecutive victory, a school record in Sun Belt play, the longest win streak of the Elderkin era, and the longest since the 2012-13 season.
- Give the Mountaineers their second straight win over the Lady Mavs.
- Even App State's record in road games to 5-5 this season.

Sanders Hits Game Winner in Epic Comeback

- In their last outing, App State erased a 15-point, fourth-quarter deficit to win 70-68 at Coastal Carolina.
- Janay Sanders scored the Mountaineers' last six points of a 14-1 closing run, including a
 game-winning floater with three seconds left on the clock.

Allesch Earns Sun Belt Weekly Honor

- After averaging a double-double of 18.5 points and 13.0 rebounds in wins over Louisiana and ULM, Alexia Allesch was named Sun Belt Player of the Week, the first App State player to win the award since Lainey Gosnell in March 2021.
- The Basking Ridge, N.J., native had 14 points and 10 boards vs. Louisiana before posting 20 and 16 (both career highs) in the win over ULM.

Double-Doubles for AA

- Alexia Allesch has become a double-double machine for the Mountaineers, especially of late.
- She has six double-doubles in 13 games played, including five in her last seven outings.
- Her six double-doubles are tied for fourth-most among league players.
- She scored a career-high 20 points in consecutive outings against ULM and Coastal Carolina, pulling down 16 boards 11 boards in those games, respectively.
- She is averaging a double-double in Sun Belt play at 16.7 ppg and 10.0 rpg, both 4th in the SBC.

Career-high performances highlight season's non-conference play

- In the Mountaineers' 80-66 win over NC Central, Michaela Porter scored a career-high 21 points (6-10 FGs, 9-9 FTs) - including 19 in the first half - and Faith Alston added a career-high 17 points.
 Porter pulled down 10 rebounds as well to secure her first double-double of the year.
- In the 61-57 loss at Mercer, **Janay Sanders** dropped in a career-high 22 points (9-16 FGs), nearly willing App State to victory with clutch baskets down the stretch.
- App State used a balance attack to defeat Lees-McRae 75-41 in the season opener, but it still
 featured a then career high-tying 13 points from Alston and a career-high six steals from Porter.
- In the 81-53 victory over ETSU, Alexia Allesch tallied her first double-double of the year with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

• Michaela Porter scored her second career high of 22 points (9-14 FGs, 2-4 FTs) - including 10 in the first half - in the defeat against Davidson.

Michaela Porter named Preseason All-Sun Belt

• Michaela Porter was named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt third team on Oct. 21. Last year she averaged a career-high 8.7 points and 6.7 rebounds per game. The Pittsburgh, Pa, native was one of the top defensive players in the league, as her 53 steals and 1.9 steals per game were both second in the league. Because of her defensive prowess, Porter was nominated for Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Year.

2020-21 in a Nutshell

- Last year's squad finished 15-12 overall and 10-8 in Sun Belt Conference play.
- App State's 10-8 league record last season matched its best since joining the Sun Belt.
- The Mountaineers advanced to the Sun Belt Tournament semifinals for the second time in three seasons.

Pre Stanley Playing in Greece

• In July, former App State standout **Pre Stanley** signed a contract with PAOK KYANA for the 2021-22 season. She had a two-game stint with the WNBA's Washington Mystics during the preseason, where she averaged 6.0 points, 1.0 assist and 1.0 steal with a plus/minus of plus-7. The Rockledge, Fla., native was the first player in program history to sign a WNBA preseason contract, coming off a 2020-21 season in which she was named All-Sun Belt first team after averaging 15.7 points per game.
