NUMBERS TO KNOW



The Trojans are currently boasting a 11-game win streak. Troy's previous longest win streak of the season was eight games, spanning from Dec. 11 to Jan. 8.

The Trojans have taken claim to the Sun Belt regular season or tournament title in five of the last seven seasons.

Jhileiya Dunlap has led the Trojans in both tournament games so far. Dunlap posted a career-high 20 points to lead the Trojans against Coastal Carolina and 19 to down Little Rock.

Troy looks to be the Sun Belt's NCAA Tournament Qualifier for third straight seasons. The 2019-20 NCAA Tournament did not take place due to COVID-19.

QUICK HITTERS

- ON THE BOARDS: Last season, the Trojans were only outrebounded or tied in rebounds four times through all 25 games. This season, Troy is 6-5 when being outrebounded.
- **BUT STILL ON THE TOP:** Despite having been outrebounded in 11 games, as per usual, the Trojans lead the nation in rebounds and offensive rebounds.
- **STREAKING:** The Trojans have won 29 of their last 32 Sun Belt Conference games. Louisiana and Little Rock are the only teams to have beat the Trojans this season.
- WHEN YOU THINK OF THE BEST: When you think of the best in college football, you think of Nick Saban. When you think of the best in Sun Belt women's basketball, you think Chanda Rigby. Nick Saban is 42-5 (.894) in his last 47 games vs SEC teams. Chanda Rigby is 49-6 (.890) in her last 55 games vs Sun Belt teams.
- AT THE TOP: The Trojans rank inside the top-10 nationally in defensive rebounds (1st), free throw attempts (1st), free throws made (1st), offensive rebounds (1st), rebounds (1st), rebounds per game (1st) and scoring offense (4th).
- **PICKED FIRST, FINISHED FIRST:** The Trojans were picked to win the conference and did. Despite winning the conference outright by two games, Troy did not earn any of the top players and coaches awards for the Sun Belt.
- **STRAIGHT DOMINANCE:** For the third straight season, the Trojans have closed out conference play with just two losses inside league action.

- Troy was the one of two Sun Belt schools represented by three players on the preseason all-conference teams.
- Troy, the defending Sun Belt Tournament champions, received 11 of the 12 first place votes by the league's head coaches (coaches could vote for their own team) and received 142 total points, while Louisiana was picked to finish second with 124 points and the other first place vote
- Troy was ranked No. 24 in the World Exposure Report Preseason Women's Basketball Top 25 Poll.
- The Trojans was also ranked in the Preseason Mid Major Top 25 Poll. Troy comes in ranked at 23rd and is the only team from the Sun Belt that is ranked.

Newcomer File

- Cartagena is one of the top talents in the state of Georgia for the 2021 class. She was rated as a 3-star recruit by Prospects Nation and earned a national ranking of 37 by MaxPreps. Cartagena led Jackson High School to the Sweet 16 for the first time in 20 years. She averaged a double-double with 26.7 points and 13.2 rebounds per game while adding 2.4 assists, 2.9 steals and 1.2 blocks per contest.
- Tina Stephens, a highly sought-after studentathlete her entire career, chose Troy over nationally ranked Rutgers and Ole Miss. In two seasons at Kansas, Stephens averaged 10.6 points and 6.6 rebounds per game while shooting just under 50 percent from the floor. She also recorded 62 career steals, 44 assists and 13 blocked shots.
- Za'Nautica Downs, who was a teammate of recent signee Tina Stephens at Florida Southwestern, comes to Troy after a successful season at UNC-Wilmington where she was named the Sixth Women of the Year in the Colonial Athletic Association while also earning Third Team All-CAA recognition.
- Amber Leggett, a highly decorated studentathlete while at Sam Houston State, had an incredible junior season with the Bearkats where she was named the Southland Conference Player of the Year, earned First Team All-Southland Conference honors and was named to the Southland All-Tournament team. During the 2020-21 season, Leggett averaged a SLC best, 20.0 points per game which set a singleseason program record for scoring average.
- Jada Walton comes to Troy following two seasons at Texas Tech after transferring from Texas A&M. Walton didn't play in any games for the Red Raiders due to transfer rules and injury. She spent two seasons (2017-19) at Texas A&M where she played in 58 games making two starts. She earned 22 steals and dished out 29 assists while blocking nine blocked shots in her career.
- Brianna Harris comes to Troy after three seasons at Louisiana Tech. The Mobile native had a breakout junior campaign in 2020-21 where she averaged 10.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game, both career-highs.
- Hollings comes to Troy after playing two seasons at EMCC. Hollings was a standout post player for East Mississippi where she was a two-time All-MACCC selection and a two-time All-Region 23 honoree. The two-year starter shot 60 percent from the field and 72 percent from the charity stripe and guided EMCC to a 36-8 record. Hollings was a four-time MACCC Player of the Week honoree, led EMCC in both steals and blocked shots back-to-back seasons and was named to the 2021 NJCAA All-Region 23 Tournament Team.

Mary Delgado | 5'7 | Guard | Miami, Fla.

Delgado comes to Troy out of Iowa Western after spending a year at the University of New Orleans. The Miami, Fla. native ranked 20th in the scoring in the Southland Conference, averaging 10.3 points her sophomore season. Delgado recorded seven double-digit scoring games, including two games with 20-plus points.

Tai'Sheka Porchia | 6'1 | Forward | Camden, Ark.

Porchia comes to Troy out of Pensacola State College, where she has suited up for the Pirates in 22 games. During her freshman campaign, Porchia averaged 13.9 points with a 48.8 field goal percentage. The Camden, Ark. native was a three-year letter winner out of Camden Fairview High School, where she was a two-time all-conference selection and tabbed a member of the all-state team her senior year.

Jashanti Simmons | 5'7 | Guard | Eatonton, Ga.

The reigning Georgia Collegiate Athletic Association (GCAA) Women's Player of the Year Jashanti Simmons comes to Troy out of Georgia Highlands College, where she was also dubbed the GCAA Freshman of the Year and a WBCA First Team All-American. Simmons set Georgia Highlands' single-game points record posting 39 points against South Georgia Technical College. The Eatonton, Ga. native tallied 1,541 points over three seasons in high school, including a career-high 43 points in a single-game.

Mesi Triplett | 6'3 | Forward | Orlando, Fla.

Triplett will head to Troy after her first season with St. Petersburg College. The forward helped lead her high school, West Oak Academy, to a 2018-19 Florida SIAA Championship. During the championship run, Triplett led the squad in blocks per game (5.4) and rebounds per game (9.4). The team's co-captain also received student of the month honors with a stellar 3.7 GPA. Triplett boasted a memorable senior season after being named an ISL Preseason Player of the Year. The Orlando, Fla. native was voted a top-20 post player out of central Florida and became the Flames best all-time rebounder.

Ke'Aija Williams | 6'2 | Forward | Montgomery, Ala.

Williams heads to Troy out of Shelton State, where she racked up Freshman Region XII Tournament MVP honors and was a Top-40 NJCAA All-Star Team selection. In her freshman season with the Bucs, Williams shot 50.6 percent from the floor and lead the squad in rebounds. The Montgomery, Ala. native was a standout out of Jeff Davis High School, where she led the team in scoring, rebounding and steals her junior and senior seasons.

Troy & NCAA Record: 192-116 (10th Season in 2021-22) Career Collegiate Record: 420-214 (18th season in 2021)

Entering her 10th season at Troy in 2021-22, Chanda Rigby has built the Trojans into the premier program in the Sun Belt Conference, winning four championships in six years and producing the most conference wins (68) since 2017 regardless of gender. Since taking over the

program in 2012, Rigby has made Troy a perennial championship, and NCAA Tournament, contender.

Rigby's impressive resume includes six 20+ win seasons, three Sun Belt Tournament Championships, a Sun Belt Regular Season Title, three trips to the NCAA Tournament, five postseason appearances, 18 all-conference selections, five Sun Belt Post Season Award winners, a Sun Belt Player of the Year honoree and a Sun Belt Coach of the Year honor.

The 2020-21 season was another one for the record books for Rigby. She led her program to its third NCAA Tournament appearance, the program's third Sun Belt Tournament Championship and sixth 20+ win season. She was honored by the League's head coaches and media members for the first time as she was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year. The individual awards didn't stop with Rigby though. She guided Alexus Dye to the Sun Belt Player of the Year award, the first player of the year honoree in program history, and Felmas Koranga to Newcomer of the Year honors. Under the leadership of Rigby, Dye was named a First Team All-Sun Belt performer, Koranga and Jasmine Robinson were second team honorees and Tiyah Johnson was a third team member. Troy's four All-Sun Belt performers were the most in a single season in program history and the most in the Sun Belt since 1998. Statistically, the 2020-21 season was one of the best in Rigby's career. Troy ranked third in the NCAA in scoring offense at 86.0 ppg (the highest total of her career), first in rebounds (52.1) and defensive rebounds per game (32.8), first in both free throws made (477) and attempted (653), second in total rebounds (1,458) and offensive rebounds per game (19.3), fifth in total steals (291) and 12th in total assists (471). Troy made national headlines in the NCAA Tournament against No. 2 seed Texas A&M when the Trojans almost earned the first win for a 15 seed in NCAA Tournament history, erasing a 16-point deficit to lead the Aggies late in the fourth quarter before narrowly falling by just four points. Troy's 80-points scored was the third-most points scored by a 15 seed in tournament history.

Troy put together its most successful season in program history during the 2019-20 campaign. Rigby led Troy to a program-record 25 victories and the program's first-ever Sun Belt Regular Season Championship after posting a 16-2 conference record.

Although the season was cut short due to COVID-19, the Trojans earned the No. 1 seed in the SBC Tournament. Rigby guided three players to all-conference honors, the most honorees in a single season in program history. In December Troy earned its highest RPI rating in program history (36) before ending the season with an RPI of 44, the highest in the SBC. Under Rigby's leadership, the Trojans led the NCAA in total rebounds (1,595), rebounding margin (+15.4), rebounds per game (55.0), offensive rebounds per game (22.2) and defensive boards per game (32.8).

In 2018-19, the Trojans earned their first-ever invitation to the WNIT. Rigby guided Sky'Lynn Holmes to the SBC Defensive Player of the Year, the first such award as SBC members. Holmes was also named to the All-Sun Belt Second Team. Once again, Rigby's squad was one of the best offensive teams in the country, averaging 82.3 points per game average and a +10.3 rebound margin, finishing fifth-best in the NCAA in both stats. The Trojans finished first nationally in offensive rebounds and first in the country in rebounds per game at 50.48.

In 2017-18 Rigby's Trojans finished 18-13 overall after the departure of seven seniors from the previous season. The Trojans led the Sun Belt in scoring (81.9) and the NCAA in rebounding (49.5) joining Baylor as the only schools in the nation to lead its conference in both categories in each of the last six seasons. Sophomores Amber Rivers and Kayla Robinson earned Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors while junior Sky'Lynn Holmes was named Sun Belt Newcomer of the Year.

Troy won its second consecutive Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship in 2016-17 earning a second straight bid to the NCAA Tournament. Forward Caitlyn Ramirez was named first team All-Sun Belt Conference and SBC Tournament MVP. For the fifth straight season, the Trojans led the league in scoring and finished top 10 in the nation with 82.5 points per game. Troy was second in the NCAA with 50.15 rebounds per game including an 86-rebound performance against Arkansas State in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament quarterfinals, the second-most in NCAA history.

In 2015-16, the Trojans finished 20-13, won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament and qualified for the NCAA Tournament for just the second time in program history. Ashley Beverly Kelley was named First Team All-Sun Belt Conference and SBC Tournament MVP.

Caitlyn Ramirez took home third team All-Sun Belt honors as well. Rigby's squad led the conference in scoring for the fourth consecutive season.

Troy's 2014-15 team won 20 games for just the fourth time in program history and made the second postseason appearance in program history and making a WBI Tournament appearance, their first postseason tournament since 1997. Ashley Beverly Kelley and Ronita Garrett were both named to the All-Sun Belt First Team, giving Troy two first team selections for the first time in over a decade.

In 2013-14, Rigby coached her first, First Team All-Sun Belt performer when Joanna Harden became the first All-Sun Belt First Team member under Rigby when she led the Sun Belt in scoring at 25.1 points per game. Harden finished seventh in the NCAA in scoring, was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award given to the nation's top point guard. During the year Troy averaged 80.4 points per game and became just the second Sun Belt team since 2000 to average over 80.0 points per game.

In Rigby's first season at the helm in 2012-13, Troy won seven games, a five-win improvement from the year before and tying the total number of wins Troy won over the previous two seasons combined. It was also Troy's first season playing its home games in the newly constructed Trojan Arena.

Before taking over the Trojan program in 2012-13, Rigby spent 12 years at the junior college level. She spent seven seasons at Pensacola State where she coached three WBCA All-Americans as well as one McDonald's All-American and four NJCAA All-Americans. She guided the Pirates to a combined 64-6 record over the last two seasons with two trips to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Final Four and earned two third-place finishes. Before Pensacola State, Rigby led Holmes Community College to four straight winning seasons and spent one season at NAIA Tabor College where she transformed a last-place team into one of the top teams in the conference. Rigby began her head coaching career at Northwest Rankin High School in Mississippi in 1992 before returning to her home state of Louisiana to coach at Loranger High School from 1996-2000.

Rigby graduated from Southeastern Louisiana University with a bachelor's degree in English education in 1990 and a master's degree in secondary education in 1998. She earned her doctorate in higher education leadership from Nova Southeastern University in July of 2017.

She is married to Ed Rigby, a high school football head coach and Athletic Director. The couple has two sons, Ramsey and Randon.


