GAME NOTES

<< MATCHUP HISTORY >>

The Mavericks are in a three-way tie for fourth place in the Western Athletic Conference standings and are fifth in the WAC Resume Seeding. The Thursday matchup will be important for the Resume Seeding, as the Mavericks are 0.34 points ahead of the Lancers. A Lancer win is forecasted to bring in 0.34 points for CBU, which would likely help them jump the Mavericks for fifth place.

The matchup will be the second ever in the all-time series between the two teams and the first to ever happen in Riverside. The only other game between the Lancers and Mavericks occurred last season when CBU pulled out a 74-66 victory in Arlington.

<< DOMINATION DANIELS JR. >>

Dominique Daniels Jr. has recorded three 30-point games this season, the most by an WAC player, including a season-high 39 points against Southern Utah. The 39 points was a DI program for the Lancers, surpassing Milan Acquaaah's 37 points against UKMC in 2019.

<< LOCK DOWN D >>

CBU has hung their hat on the defensive end of the court, ranking 23rd in the country in scoring defense and #1 in the conference. The Lancers hold their opposition to 64.3 points per game and has not surrendered an 80-point game this season. CBU has allowed 70 points only five times this season and has six times held an opponent under 60 points.

<< LANCERS IN THE RANKINGS >>

The Lancers rank in the top 40 in both rebounding margin and offensive rebounding. CBU outrebounds their opposition by 6.2 rebounds on average and hauls in 13 offensive boards per contest.

Hunter Goodrick and Yvan Ouedraogo both are top 60 in the country in rebounding at 40th and 58th, respectively. The Lancers are the only team in the nation with two players in the top 60 in rebounding and have the second best duo in the nation in combined rebounding behind Lassina and Aboubacar Traore from Long Beach State.

<< VIVA LAS VEGAS >>

After completing their full four-year transition from NCAA Division II to Division I, the Lancers are now eligible to participate in the NCAA Tournament if they qualify. The Lancers have enjoyed success in their first few seasons in the big leagues and look to keep it going. CBU has yet to have a losing season in D-1 and have boasted a 81-61 overall record. The Lancers won their first postseason game in 2022 as they defeated the UTRGV Vaqueros 81-80 in the opening round of the WAC Tournament in Las Vegas.

<< THE RETURNERS >>

The Lancers return four letterwinners to its 2023-24 roster with Blondeau Tchoukuiegn, Scotty Washington, Malik Wade, and Hunter Goodrick. The four combined made 36 starts and accounted for 30% of the team's points. Goodrick was the teams' leading rebounder, while Blondeau led the team in steals.

<< NEW STAFF NEW LOOK >>

The Lancers welcome in three new assistant coaches to the staff in Dave Rice, Reggie Howard, and Dominic Lippi. The three coaches have a combined 57 years of coaching experience at all levels of collegiate basketball. Dave Rice has coached at Chaffey College, UNLV (HC and AC), Utah State, BYU, Nevada and Washington. Reggie Howard has coached at Barstow College, Mt. San Jacinto, Long Beach State, and Cal State San Bernardino. Dominic Lippi has coached at UC Santa Barbara and Saint Mary's.

<< WAC-CUSA CHALLENGE >>

The WAC and Conference USA announced a multi-year scheduling partnership that includes every team in those conferences playing the opposing conference in two games per season. For the Lancers they will host Western Kentucky on December 19th and will travel to Las Cruces to take on New Mexico State on December 30.

<< CHASING CROY >>

Head Coach Rick Croy became the all-time winningest coach in CBU history at the beginning of last season with a win over NJIT. Croy achieves this feat in five fewer seasons than King and achieved it while playing in five seasons at the division 1 level. Croy has won 85 games since transitioning to D-1 and has yet to record a losing record since joining the WAC in 2018. Croy now has 217 wins as the head coach at CBU.

<< BROTHERLY LOVE >>

California Baptist University will for the third straight season have a pair of brothers from Australia on their roster. After two seasons with the Armstrong brothers, the Goodrick brothers are now in Riverside together. Hunter Goodrick is a junior forward, while Tasman is a freshman center.

<< TRIP DOWN UNDER >>

The team participated in their second foreign tour of the DI era to Australia during the summer. The Lancers played top-tier NBL and NBL1 competition on the tour facing off against Melbourne United, Tasmania JackJumpers, Southeast Melbourne Phoenix, Illawarra Hawks, and the Brisbane Bullets.

<< THUNDEROUS TRANSFERS >>

The Lancers welcome in six transfers for the 2023-24 season. Kendal Coleman and Zach Wrightsil both join the Lancers after transferring from power-6 programs with Coleman coming in from LSU and Wrightsil from Marquette.

CBU also welcomes in a pair of JUCO transfers in Chris Chiles and Dominique Daniels Jr. Dom was a scoring machine at San Bernardino Valley College where he averaged over 20 points per game in his two seasons. Chiles was a double-digit scorer at Citrus College where he spent two productive seasons with the Owls.

The other two transfers are Yvan Ouedraogo and Brantly Stevenson. Ouedraogo is an inter-conference transfer from Grand Canyon, where he spent two seasons as starting center for the Lopes. Stevenson was the leading scorer for Cal Poly last season and is a dynamic scorer who spent the last three seasons with the Mustangs.

<< Y.O. MY >>

Yvan Ouedraogo put together a hot offensive streak, setting a new career high three different times in his first season as a Lancer. A 17-point 13-rebound performance vs. Cal Poly, earned him a spot on the All-Tournament team and is his current career-high in scoring. Yvan scored the most points in a five-game span of his career with 59 to begin the 2023-24 campaign.

<< INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR >>

CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY AT A GLANCE

California Baptist University is among the nation's largest private Christian colleges and universities located in Southern California, with a fall 2022 enrollment of 11,496 students. It ranked eighth among the fastest-growing colleges in the United States during a recent 10-year period in "Almanac 2018-19" published by the Chronicle of Higher Education and reflects the institution's enrollment growth from 2006 through 2016.

In 2006, CBU enrollment totaled 3,409 students. A decade later, in 2016, enrollment at CBU was 9,157 students, an increase of 168.6 percent. The No. 8 ranking compared CBU with other private non-profit institutions classified as "Master's Colleges & Universities" in the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education. Among the 392 institutions in that classification, enrollment growth averaged 15.7 percent over the same 10-year period.

Back in September of 2019, it earned regional rankings from U.S. News and World Report as a "Best Value School," "Most Innovative School" and ranked No. 43 in the "Best Regional University" for public and private colleges in the West. It was the sixth year in a row CBU earned a top-50 ranking as a "Best Regional University." It has appeared in the Best Colleges list 14 times. CBU offers more than 150 majors, minors and concentrations as well as more than 40 graduate programs and four doctoral programs.

CBU's beautiful 160-acre main campus in Riverside, Calif., is situated in the heart of the historic Magnolia Avenue district just a short drive from popular beaches and mountain resorts. The Lancers have completed their four-year reclassification seasons to NCAA Division I after they completed a transition from NAIA to NCAA Division II in 2013-14. CBU is primarily a member of the Western Athletic Conference and are now eligible to compete in postseason play.



Rick Croy



Rick Croy was named the California Baptist University men's basketball head coach in the spring of 2013 and completely revitalized the program. In ten years, Croy's Lancers boast a 217-96 overall record, including a 139-33 mark at home.

Coach Croy guided the Lancers to a 17-16 finish on the 2022-23 season, recording the fifth-straight winning season since making the jump into the NCAA Division I ranks and the tenth straight since taking over the helm in the spring of the 2013 season. The Lancers also won their second WAC tournament game with a win over Abilene Christian 69-62 in the first round.

In 2023, Croy passed Jerry King to become the all-time winningest coach in CBU men's basketball history in a win over NJIT and currently boasts a top-20 winning percentage among active DI head coaches.

Croy helped guide the program through the DI transition and helped them post their first-ever DI postseason win in 2022 after defeating UTRGV in the first round of the WAC tournament in Las Vegas.

The Lancers also recorded their fifth major award in the WAC, after sophomore guard Taran Armstrong was named to the All-WAC Second Team after winning WAC Freshman of the Year in 2022. Armstrong joined Milan Acquah and Brandon Boyd as the three players to grab the top awards, as Acquah was named the 2019 WAC Newcomer of the Year and 2020 WAC Player of the Year, while Boyd was named 2020 WAC Newcomer of the Year. The Lancers finished the 2022 season with their second postseason bid at the College Basketball Invitational in Daytona Beach, Florida.

During the 2020-21 season, Coach Croy recorded his 300th career win as a head coach, joining an all-star cast of coaches across the country as one of the fastest to 300 wins in his career. With the win over SE Louisiana on Dec. 4, 2020, Coach Croy moved to 14th all-time among the top college basketball coaches at the NCAA Division I and NCAA Division II levels.

Over the past ten years, 23 players have earned all-conference honors, with a bunch of Lancers grabbing top honors. Taran Armstrong recently joined that group as a member of the All-WAC Second Team and as the 2022 WAC Freshman of the Year. Ty Rowell was named First Team All-WAC in the 2020-21 season, and Gorjok Gak claimed Second Team All-WAC, All-

Defensive Team, and All-Newcomer Team. Milan Acquah was named the 2020 Western Athletic Conference Player of the Year and the 2019 WAC Newcomer of the Year in his two seasons with the Lancers. Acquah was a two-time First Team selection and was named on the Lou Henson All-American team following the 2020 season. Brandon Boyd became the second Lancer to earn the WAC Newcomer of the Year award, and De'jon Davis was named on the WAC's All-Defensive Team. Michael Smith was the first Lancer to be named the PacWest Player of the Year in back-to-back seasons. Gelaun Wheelwright was named the PacWest Newcomer of the Year following the 2014-15 season, while Chris Brown picked up the inaugural Defender of the Year award in 2013-14. That year, Croy was named the PacWest Coach of the Year and a Clarence Gaines Award Finalist, while Ryan Berg became the first-ever player to be named the Player and Freshman of the Year in the same season.

During the Croy era, the Lancers have gone to the NCAA Division II tournament every year, from 2014-18, and spent 59 weeks in the NABC Top-25 Poll. CBU has won PacWest regular season and conference tournament titles, including two first-place finishes in conference.

For the first time in program history, Croy led the Lancers to win the West Regional championship during the 2017-18 season and advance to the Elite Eight. CBU finished the year with a 28-6 overall record, including a 19-2 mark in the brand new Events Center. It capped off a stellar Division II run through Croy as the Lancers begin their transition to Division I and the Western Athletic Conference in the Fall of 2018.

In 2016-17, Smith went on to be named the West Region Player of the Year after establishing himself as the all-time leading scorer in both CBU and PacWest history. That year, CBU made its fourth-straight NCAA Division II tournament appearance.

The year before, the Lancers finished with a 28-7 overall record and 15-5 conference mark for first place. It was the third-straight 20-plus win season and tied a program record with 28 wins, but the most program wins in NCAA. They went on to dominate the PacWest Conference Tournament, downing rival Azusa Pacific 101-64 in the championship game to win their first tournament title.

That year, CBU grabbed its highest NABC ranking with a No. 4 spot on Nov. 24, during its record of 14-straight weeks in the poll carried over from the 2014-15 season. Smith was named the PacWest Player of the Year, PacWest Tournament MVP, PacWest All-Tournament, All-PacWest first team, All-West Region and All-American after hitting the 1,000 career point mark in the middle of the season and leading the conference in scoring for most of the year. Wheelwright also hit the elusive 1,000 career point mark in under two seasons as a Lancer. It led to him being named All-PacWest First Team, PacWest All-Tournament, All-West Region and West Region All-Tournament.

During the 2013-14 season, his first at the helm, Croy led his team to set two new records: program-best start and longest win streak after starting the season 16-0. The Lancers went on to grab as high of a No. 7 NCAA Division II ranking and finished the year with the program's first-ever PacWest Championship title and a 24-4 overall record, 18-2 in conference.

Prior to CBU, Croy spent the past three years as the lead assistant coach at NCAA Division I St. Mary's. During his time working under Coach Randy Bennett, the Gaels went 80-22 overall, winning two regular-season West Coast Conference



championships and making two NCAA Tournament appearances.

Before St. Mary's, Croy spent five years as the head coach at Citrus College in Glendora, Calif. During his stint there, he quickly staked his claim as one of the state's best junior college coaches, compiling a 130-35 record, which included the program's first-ever state championship in 2008.

He led the Fighting Owls to three straight Western State Conference titles (2008-09-10) and an appearance in the 2010 California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCAA) Final Four. He was a three-time WSC Coach of the Year, going 92-9 in conference games in that span. Citrus was 35-1 in 2008, 28-5 in 2009 and 29-3 in 2010, the best three-year run in the state.

During his time at Citrus, 13 players moved on to the NCAA Division I level, and 97 percent (36 of 37) of his players went on to four-year schools.

Croy's ties to Riverside run deep. His first-ever coaching job was a two-year stint at UC Riverside, working under Head Coach John Masi in 2000 and 2001. He worked the 2002 season as the associate head coach at Concordia University in Irvine under Head Coach Ken Ammann, recruiting the class that went on to win the NAIA National Championship in 2003.

In 2002-03, Croy returned to UC Riverside as the top assistant to Masi for three years before taking the Citrus job. While at UCR, Croy recruited the Big West Freshman of the Year (Nate Carter), the Big West Defensive Player of the Year (Vili Morton), and UCR's all-time leading scorer (Larry Cunningham).

Croy played collegiately at San Francisco State, ranking among the program leaders in five categories, including holding the school record for 3-pointers (167). He is second in games played, third in assists and steals and eighth in scoring. Croy was a three-time All-California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) selection and led SFSU in scoring three straight years.

He earned a bachelor's degree in recreation administration from San Francisco State in 1999, and a master's in education/physical education from Azusa Pacific University in 2001. He and his wife Jamie – who played basketball and volleyball at St. Mary's – have a daughter (Kayden) and a son (J-Rob).

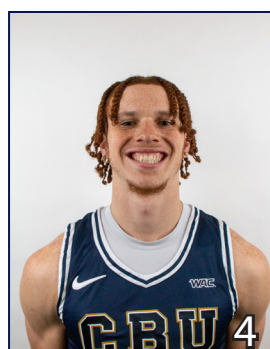
