LAST TIME OUT

CHRISTOPHER SCORES 1,000 IN LADY MOCS' WIN OVER PORTLAND STATE AT ST. MARY'S CLASSIC

After getting off to a slow start behind the steady play of first-time starter junior Ashlen Dewart the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga women's basketball team came away with a 68-59 win over Portland State in the opening game of the St. Mary's Hilton Concord Thanksgiving Classic at McKeon Pavilion. The Lady Mocs improve to 4-0 on the year, their best start since the 1999-2000 season when UTC started the season at 4-0 in Head Coach Wes Moore's second season. Portland State falls to 3-1 on the year. Dewart kept Chattanooga in the game scoring 13 of Chattanooga's first 15 points just over halfway through the opening stanza. Dewart's first layup tied the game in the opening minute at 2-2 but the Vikings scored the next six to get an 8-2 lead at the 17:48 mark. Dewart and Portland State traded buckets over the next couple of minutes before a couple of free throws put the Vikings up 16-8 with 14:42 to play in the first. Dewart and sophomore Ka'Vonne Towns combined on a 6-0 run to cut the lead to just two, 16-14 at the 10:22 mark of the first. Dewart would get one more point in the half, but it would be senior Kylie Lambert down the stretch with 12 points behind a pair of 3-pointers and 6-of-8 shooting from the charity stripe. Chattanooga took the lead for good on Lambert's final free throw of the period and solidified it with a layup from Towns to make it 35-32 at the break. The Lady Mocs started the second half on a 17-7 run to take a 52-39 lead with 13:05 to play. Portland State would only get as close as eight points twice more in the contest. Dewart added 10 second half points to end up with a game-high 23 points. That is a season-high for the transfer, the most she has scored at UTC and one point shy of the most points scored in a game by a UTC player this season. Junior Taylor Hall and junior Meghan Downes have each tossed in 24 points for the Lady Mocs. Lambert added six second half points to her total and posted a double-double for the first time this season and the fifth of her career with 18 points and 10 boards. She also added a career-high five steals in the game and was 10-of-12 from the free throw line, a career-best effort. Senior Kayla Christopher became the 25th member of the Lady Mocs' 1,000-Point Club Friday with eight points and was 2-of-4 from beyond the arc to move to fourth place all-time on the UTC women's basketball all-time 3-pointers made list with 171, surpassing Miranda Warfield on the spot. She had a season-high five assists on the day and recorded two steals. Chattanooga outscored Portland State in the paint 24-12 and held a 20-11 advantage on points off turnovers forcing 26 by the Vikings. The Lady Mocs were outrebounded 40-39 but pulled down 16 offensive boards that translated into 17 second chance points. The Lady Mocs recorded 19 steals, the most since getting 15 against Wofford on December 9, 2009. Towns and Hall each snared four steals apiece. Chattanooga shot 34.9 percent for the game after shooting 40 percent in the first half and was 4-of-19 from the 3-point line while making 20-of-27 free throws. Portland

State shot 42 percent for the game (21-50) and was 5-of-12 from beyond the line while making 12-of-16 from the charity stripe. Portland State had three players in double figures led by Kate Lanz with 11 points and eight rebounds.

UP NEXT...

SCOUTING ST. MARY'S

The Lady Mocs and St. Mary's have never played before despite UTC participating in the 2004 St. Mary's Classic. The Gaels are 1-2 on the season with losses at Washington and California with their only win a double-overtime victory at Oregon. St. Mary's is outscored 62.3-76.0 (-13.7) by its opponents but hold an 8.0 advantage on the boards. From the field, SMC is shooting 33.5% and averaging 24.5% from beyond the arc. From the free throw line, the Gaels are shooting 72.7%. Jackie Nared leads the team in scoring with 16.7 points per game and has 9.7 boards. Morgan Hatten is leading the team off the glass with 10.3 rpg and 6.0 ppg while Danielle Mauldin is crashing the boards with 10.0 per game and 11.3 rebounds an outing.

HOT OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

The Lady Mocs started the season with an 80-71 win over Tennessee, marking the first win over the Lady Vols in 19 tries. UTC followed that with an 84-54 win at Belmont then topped the 80-point mark for a third straight game defeating ETSU 81-48.

BEST START SINCE 1999-2000

The Lady Mocs have started the 2012-13 season with four straight wins, marking its best start since 1999-2000, Moore's second season when UTC started the turnaround season at 4-0. Chattanooga's best start in school history was a 5-0 beginning to the 1977-78 season under Sharon Fanning, and posted a 19-7 record.

CHRISTOPHER MAKES THE 1,000-POINT MARK

Senior Kayla Christopher scored eight points in UTC's win over Portland State to reach her 1,000th career point. She is the 25th member of the Lady Mocs' 1,000-Point Club. She has 41 points this season for an even 1,000. Through 99 games with UTC, she has made 339 field goals, of which 171 are 3-pters.

CHRISTOPHER CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Senior Kayla Christopher continues her climb through the Lady Mocs all-time Top 10 3-pointers made chart. She made two 3-pointers in UTC's win over Portland State to move past Miranda Warfield for fourth on the all-time list at UTC.

LADY MOCS RECEIVE VOTES IN AP TOP 25

After winning the season opener against No. 20 Tennessee, the Lady Mocs received 10 votes in the AP Top 25 Poll. In the poll released Nov. 19, Chattanooga is 35th with 12 votes.

LADY MOCS NINTH IN THE MID-MAJOR POLL

The Lady Mocs received 444 votes in the Mid-Major poll on Nov. 20 and ranked ninth. Green Bay, with five first place votes, is ranked first with 735 points followed by Gonzaga with 15 first place votes and 724 points. Delaware dropped to third with 665 points and seven first place votes followed by Princeton (654). Middle Tennessee moved up to fifth in the poll with three votes and 631 points.

HALL NAMED SOCON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Taylor Hall was selected the Southern Conference Player of the Week after leading the Lady Mocs to an 80-71 win over No. 20 Tennessee in the season opener. She tied her career-high with 24 points and hit career-bests in assists, steals and blocked shots. She pulled down nine rebounds and ranks among the league's Top Five in 10 categories with top rankings in scoring (24), assist-turnover ratio (999.0) and blocked shots (3.0).

HALL NAMED COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS SOCON & MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Taylor Hall tied her career-high in scoring with 24 points to lead the Lady Mocs to an 80-71 win over No. 20 Tennessee in the season opener at the Roundhouse. She had nine rebounds and posted career-highs in assists (5) and steals (4) while tying her career-best in blocked shots with three while committing no turnovers. Hall was 9-of-12 from the field and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc while making 3-of-5 from the free throw line.

ALL-VOLUNTEER STATE LINEUP

With the addition of Alex Black (Memphis) and Faith Dupree (Knoxville) to the Lady Mocs starting lineup, that makes an all-Tennessee starting five. The duo join Kayla Christopher (Oliver Springs), Kylie Lambert (Etowah) and Taylor Hall (New Tazewell). Alicia Payne (Memphis) is the only other Tennessee resident on the roster.

DEWART SHINES IN FIRST START AT UTC

Junior Ashlen Dewart made 57 starts in her two seasons at Appalachian State. With the loss of classmate Faith Dupree to injury, Dewart was called upon to make her first start as a Lady Moc and took advantage. She put up large numbers against Portland State at the St. Mary's Classic with a season-high 23 points and eight rebounds.

LAMBERT RECORDS DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior Kylie Lambert recorded her fifth career double-double with a season-high 18 points and 10 rebounds against Portland State at the St. Mary's Classic. She also had a career-high five steals and was 10-of-12 from the free throw line.

DOWNES TALLIES CAREER NIGHT AGAINST ETSU

Junior Meghan Downes has proved over the last two years that she likes to shoot against East Tennessee State. After hitting an at-the-time-career-high 18 against the Lady Bucs in Johnson

CHATTANOOGA PICKED THIRD IN POLLS

The Lady Mocs were selected to finish third by both the conference coaches and the SoCon Media Preseason polls. Davidson received five first place votes from the league coaches for 94 points while the Mountaineers garnered four first place votes and 91 points. Chattanooga snapped up the remaining two votes and had 86 points for third. Samford was selected fourth while Elon and Furman tied for fifth with 61 points each.

CHRISTOPHER, HALL ALL-CONFERENCE

Senior Kayla Christopher and junior Taylor Hall were selected to the SoCon Coaches All-Conference team. Christopher and Hall were both named all-conference last season by the league coaches and accounted for nearly 30 percent of the Lady Mocs offense and 32 percent of the rebounding. They are two of three returning starters, joined by senior Kylie Lambert. Christopher is a two-time all-conference performer and Hall earned her first nod last season. Hall was selected to the league's all-tournament team last year while Lambert was named to the same team in 2011.

HALL HAS CAREER NIGHT AGAINST UTK

Junior Taylor Hall (New Tazewell, Tenn.) tied her career-high with 24 points in the Lady Mocs' win over Tennessee. She was 9-of-12 from the field and 3-of-5 from the 3-point line. She just missed a double-double with nine rebounds. She had career-highs for assists (5), steals (4), minutes (31), field goals made (9) and tied her career-best for blocked shots with three.

DUPREE MAKES FIRST START AGAINST UTK

Junior Faith Dupree grew up in the shadow of the Lady Vols and signed to play for Summitt out of high school. After a year-and-a-half, she transferred down the road and has faced her former team twice. Last season in Knoxville, she led the Lady Mocs with 17 points off the bench and this season made her first collegiate start, matching up against the Lady Vols. She played 24 minutes scoring six points and grabbing three rebounds.

A SEASON ON THE ROAD

The Lady Mocs will play 16 games on the road this season including 10 Southern Conference contests, a Thanksgiving tournament at St. Mary's in San Francisco, Calif., and four non-conference games. UTC's first road game was a 30-point win at Belmont. In December, the Lady Mocs will travel to the state of Alabama to take on Alabama and Auburn and then face off against UAB just after the New Year.

HOT FROM BEYOND THE ARC

UTC has made at least one 3-point shot in 404 consecutive games dating back to December 31, 1999 against Appalachian State in Wes Moore's second season. Chattanooga broke its own *Southern Conference and school single-game 3-point record* with 16 treys in a televised game against Georgia Southern on Dec. 4, 2010. Samford tied the record last season with 16 against Jacksonville State on Nov. 30. The previous record of 15 was reached twice by the Lady Mocs and once by Samford. The most UTC has made in a season was 257, accomplished twice with the latest in 2009-10.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE NEWCOMERS

Freshmen Tatianna Jackson (Atlanta, Ga.) and Alicia Payne (Memphis, Tenn.) join the Lady Mocs lineup this season. Tatianna Jackson, a four-star rated player from The Lovett School and led her team to the state finals her senior year. She was a three-time all-state performer and scored 1,812 career points ... Alicia Payne, a three-star rated player, led her team in assists for two seasons and was a two-time all-region selection for White Station.

MOORE ADDS SIX IN EARLY PERIOD

Head Coach Wes Moore added six new faces to the 2013-14 roster in the early signing period. Dade County's Ansley Chilton, a 6-2 forward, is expected to redshirt her first season to gain size and experience behind Faith Dupree and Ashlen Dewart. Moses Johnson, a 6-0 guard from Greenforest-McCaleb in Georgia, has over 1,000 points through three years and was an all-state honorable mention pick last year. Whitney Hartlage, a 5-8 guard from Mercy Academy in Kentucky, helped her team to the 2010 Kentucky state title. Aryanna Gilbert, a 5-10 forward from Columbia Central transfer, led her Lawrence County team to the Class AAA state tournament with a 27-7 record. Jasmine Joyner from Southaven, Miss., was named to the *Clarion-Ledger* Mississippi Girls "Dandy Dozen". Point guard Chelsey Shumpert from Tilghman High School in Kentucky has been a member of the varsity squad since her seventh grade year. She averaged 25.4 points per game as a junior with 4.2 assists and 3.7 steals and helped her team to a 29-6 overall record.

DEWART NOW IN THE LADY MOC MIX

Dewart, sister of former Lady Moc Bailey Dewart, transferred from SoCon rival Appalachian State after helping the Mountaineers to the Southern Conference regular season title. As a freshman, she led ASU to the Women's Basketball Invitation title and was named Most Outstanding Player. She topped the 1,000-point mark as a sophomore and was selected all-conference by the league coaches and media. As a freshman she was named to the league's all-freshman team and received a second-team all-conference nod by the media.

HOME COURT WIN STREAK CLIMBS

The Lady Mocs posted a perfect 13-0 record at the Roundhouses last season. UTC has won both games this season at McKenzie and has run its win streak to 15 games.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL IN MCKENZIE

The Lady Mocs played their first game in the UTC Arena on Dec. 3, 1983 and posted a 74-66 win over Tennessee Tech. Over the next 15 years, the Lady Mocs continued to call Maclellan Gym home and played just a handful of games in the Roundhouse. However, with the arrival of Wes Moore in 1998, the women made the move to the arena playing half of the 1998-99 schedule in the larger building. By Moore's second season, all but two of Chattanooga's home games have been played at the McKenzie Arena. Those two games were both played in the 2004-05 year in Maclellan Gym. UTC has now topped the 200 mark for games played in the Roundhouse since that first year and have a 181-43 record spanning three coaches and 28 years. UTC went 13-0 at home last year and is 2-0 this season.

HOT HISTORY AT HOME

The Lady Mocs went undefeated at the Roundhouse last year posting a 13-0 record. According to RPI Ratings.com, the Lady Mocs have posted a 115-22 (.8394) record in the McKenzie Arena since the 2001-02 season, Moore's fourth year, through last season. That ranks ninth among all Division I women's teams with Tennessee holding the top mark with a 341-20 mark (.9446).

LADY MOCS PLAY 39TH SEASON

2012-13 marks the 39th season of varsity women's basketball at Chattanooga. Through 38 years UTC's record is 707-404. In 1974, Grace Keith was named the head coach of the Mocettes. Over two years, she posted a record of 21-23. Sharon Cable Fanning, a former player, followed and changed the nickname to Lady Mocs. In 11 years she led UTC to four SoCon titles and the 1984 NWIT finals. Craig Parrot led Chattanooga for 11 season and took the Lady Mocs to their first NCAA tournament. During his tenure UTC won one SoCon title, two tournament crowns and went to the NCAA Tournament twice. Wes Moore returns for his 15th season. He led UTC to 11 consecutive crowns, 12 20-win seasons in 13 years, including 11 straight, and 12 postseason appearances including eight trips to the NCAA tournament.

LADY MOCS ON THE AIR WITH LARRY WARD

For the 12th straight year, Larry Ward, "The Voice of the Lady Mocs" will broadcast each and every Chattanooga women's basketball game. This season, the Mocs Sports Network will air most games on the UTC flagship station ESPN Radio 105.1 The Zone. When the men's and women's times conflict, they will broadcast on WPLZ 95.3 FM. Stick around after the women's games and listen to Ward and Head Coach Wes Moore discuss the stats and plays. The postgame show is broadcast live over the public address system at the McKenzie Arena except on doubleheaders.
