HEAD COACH

MARK GUHNE (Chattanooga '84) just finished his fifth year as a head coach, all at Chattanooga. The Mocs have won 14 team titles under his watch, including three SoCon titles, and he has been named SoCon Coach of the Year three times (2006, 2007, 2008) and PING East Region Coach of the Year once (2009).

FOURTH NCAA APPEARANCE

The Mocs made their fourth straight NCAA Regional appearance for the Mocs (4th all-time) finishing 12th at the Southwest Regional outside San Diego, Calif. In the previous three appearances, the Mocs stayed in the East Regional twice (2007, 2008) and the South Central (2009) once.

AWARD WINNERS

The Mocs garnered significant notice for their play in 2009-10. Sophomore **Stephan Jaeger** was named Southern Conference Player of the Year. He joins former teammate **Jonathan Hodge** (2007, 2008) as the only Mocs to earn the honor. For the second straight year, Jaeger was selected to the PING All-East Region team along with **Derek Rende**. It was Rende's third consecutive nod. The duo also repeated on the All-SoCon team as Rende made all four years of his career. **Steven Fox** earned a spot on the All-Freshman team.

TWO WINS IN 2010

The Chattanooga program won one team title and had one medalist this season. The Mocs won the 2010 Cleveland Golf Palmetto Intercollegiate (more later) and in the very next event, Steven Fox tied for medalist honors at the Furman Intercollegiate with 2009 U.S. Amateur runner-up Ben Martin of Clemson. Fox fired three par or better rounds of 70, 68 and 72 shooting six-under par 210. Fox was tied for 10th in the Cleveland Golf Palmetto to help key that win.

JUNE

ROLLERCOASTER RIDE

It was a Jekyll & Hyde kind of season for Chattanooga. The Mocs have been ranked as high as No. 1 and as low as 44. The Mocs claimed the 2010 Cleveland Golf Palmetto Intercollegiate title by seven shots over No. 18 Clemson and 16 strokes over No. 12 Virginia while finishing second at the prestigious Carpet Capital Collegiate, Brickyard Collegiate (tie) and Furman Intercollegiate. On the flip side, the Mocs also struggled from time to time including a seventh-place ending at the Southern Conference Championship.

PAR OR BETTER

The Mocs recorded 10 par or better rounds as a team with a low round of 277 in the second round at the Cleveland Golf Palmetto and Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiates.

SENIOR LEGACY

Fourth-year seniors Derek Rende and **Fredrik Qvicker** are leaving quite a legacy behind. The duo have had their share of highs, but there is no denying the fact that the Mocs finished the year ranked in the top 25 (12 - 2008, 25 - 2009) twice in their four years. Transfer **J.T. Clendenin** ended his three-year career as a key contributor as well especially solidifying the lineup in the Spring of 2008. This group of seniors have set a standard for the upcoming classes to follow.

JAEGER LEADS THE WAY

Jaeger led in virtually every category for the Mocs with 104 birdies and 381 pars recording just 108 bogeys and 15 others. Rende led the team in Eagles with six, while Jaeger was second with four.

NO. 1...AGAIN

For the second straight year, UTC was ranked No. 1 in the country during the fall. This year Golfstat's first ranking (9/23) had the Mocs at No. 1, while the *Golfweek/Sagarin* Ratings placed Chattanooga at No. 4.

FEELS LIKE HOME

Chattanooga claimed second place while defending its 2008 title in the prestigious Carpet Capital Collegiate at the Farm Golf Club in Rocky Face, Ga. The event was a "who's-who" of college golf with two teams in the top five in the *Golf World/Nike Golf Coaches' Poll* (4 - Georgia, 5 - Alabama) and seven teams overall in the top 25 and five more receiving votes - which accounts for all 12 teams entering the event. Four of the schools (Georgia, Clemson, Georgia Tech & Alabama) finished 2008-09 in the *Golfweek/Sagarin* Ratings Index top 10, with eight overall in the top 25, including the Mocs at No. 25. UTC did not have a drop score higher than 75 at the Carpet Capital. In fact, Chattanooga's 54-hole drop score total of 225 would have finished third on two of the 12 teams and fourth on four teams, including champion Tennessee. Only Georgia Tech had all five players beat the Mocs' drop score of 225.

FOX'S SOLID IN FIRST EVENT

Fox made his collegiate debut at the Farm. Fox counted two of three rounds in shooting 75, 72 and 73 finishing tied for 24th at four-over par 220. He posted 11 birdies and 30 pars playing par or better on 75.9 percent of his holes. Fox later tied for medalist honors at the 2010 Furman Intercollegiate with 2009 U.S. Amateur finalist Ben Martin (Clemson). For his efforts, he was named SoCon Golfer of the Week (3/24) and also nabbed March Golfer of the Month in the league.

NEW FACES

Freshmen **Chris Robb** (Aberdeenshire, Scotland) and **Benjamin Weilguni** (Langelois, Austria) were new arrivals for the Spring semester as both enrolled in school in January. Both also sat out from competing in the Spring semester to get acclimated to college and life in the states. Chattanooga also signed three regional players during the two signing periods. In the Fall, the Mocs inked **Davis Bunn** (Knoxville, Tenn.) and **McKeehanon Rue** (Athens, Tenn.). Bunn was one of three DI signees from Farragut High School joining Brandon Rogers (Tennessee) and Hayden Anderson (Georgia Southern). Bunn led the team to back-to-back state titles and had three junior wins in 2009. **Jackson Lockhart** (Brownsboro, Ala.) who fired a final round 66 (-6) in finishing second in the Alabama High School Championship.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP HOSTING

The 2010 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship returned to one of the top amateur golf venues in the world June 1-6 at the Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tenn., suburban Chattanooga. The Pete Dye-designed course hosted the 1996 National Championship as well as the U.S. Amateur, U.S. Mid-Amateur and Tennessee Amateur among its many events. Augusta State defeated Oklahoma State 3-1-1 to claim the title in match play, while Illinois' Scott Langley was the medalist.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT COMPLEX

Chattanooga opened the new Player Development Complex during the 2009-10 season. A co-operative effort between UTC, The First Tee of Chattanooga and the city, the Player Development Complex will provide a consistent practice home for the Chattanooga golf programs.
