OPENING TIPS

- What's in a name? Depends on who you ask, but as far as the references to the Mocs, the official school name is the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. The preferred name is simply Chattanooga while the abbreviated form is UTC. There is no hyphenated version (i.e. UT-Chatt, Tenn.-Chatt, Tennessee-Chatt, UT Chatt, etc.). The nickname is simply Mocs. For more information on the unique nickname, please see page 24 of the media guide.
- The game is being televised on the Big 10 Network with Chris Denari (PxP) and Quinn Buckner (analysis) providing commentary. Fans in the Chattanooga area can watch the game on Comcast (742), DirectTV (610), Dish Network (439), AT&T U-Verse (650) and EPB (630).
- Chattanooga is 25-9 in season openers in the DI era, 6-9 away from McKenzie Arena.
- This is just the second meeting between the two schools. The last meeting was Nov. 12, 2007, a 99-79 Hoosiers win. The Mocs led 50-46 at the half before Eric Gordon, playing in his first collegiate game, took over the contest on both ends of the floor. Gordon scored 18 of his game-high 33 keying the second half surge.
- This is the second time Shulman has coached UTC against the Hoosiers. He is 0-3 against Big 10 schools including losses at Ohio State (84-67, 11/27/04) and Minnesota (67-46, 11/26/05).
- Chattanooga is 2-16 against Big 10 schools. The last win came in Charlotte, N.C., on March 16, 1997. The 75-63 final clinched UTC's spot in the NCAA Sweet 16.
- The Mocs open the season on the road for the second straight year and third time in four seasons. After games at Indiana and Butler, the team returns home to the Scenic City for a four-game home stand hosting Kennesaw State (11/18) and Warren Wilson (11/21) before the Chattanooga Bracket of the Hoosier Classic commences on the 25th. The Mocs host Savannah State on the 25th and Gardner-Webb on the 27th, while the Tigers and Bulldogs square off on the 26th.

• UTC is 1,169-940 in its 91st season of basketball. The Mocs made the move to DI in 1977-78 after winning the 1977 DII National Championship. In the DI ear, Chattanooga is 641-391, 347-190 in the Southern Conference. The program has posted 27 winning ledgers in 34 DI seasons with 10 trips to the NCAA Tournament.

• The Mocs tied for the Southern Conference North Division title with Western Carolina in 2010-11. It was the third division championship in four years for **John Shulman's** squads, the most of any team in the league. UTC returns four starters from that squad while adding seven new faces.

• Chattanooga has been the dominant program since joining the SoCon in 1977-78 after winning the 1977 NCAA Division II title. The Mocs have won 28 championships in 34 seasons in the league including 10 regular-season (prior to division play starting in 1994-95), eight division and a league-tying 10 tournament. Davidson is second during that span with 17, 10 of which are of the division variety.

• The Mocs 20 regular-season/tourney titles are far and away the most through those 34 campaigns followed by East Tennessee State (now in Atlantic Sun) with eight (3 reg season/5 tourney) and Davidson with seven (1 reg season/6 tourney). UTC has won a title of some kind in 19 of its 34 years in the SoCon.

• Chattanooga was on the forefront of mid-major March Madness shockers reaching the Sweet 16 in 1997. The 2011-12 season is the 15th anniversary of that feat and the 30th of the Mocs' second SoCon Tournament title & first NCAA win over N.C. State in 1982.

LAST GAME - UTC 82, TENNESSEE WESLEYAN 64

- Chattanooga used a first half 11-0 run to take the lead for good. In the midst of the run, Ronrico White hit a three-pointer at 2:50 to make it 25-23. Tennessee Wesleyan would get no closer than four the rest of the way.
- With 4:58 remaining in the game, a 10-0 run put the game away for UTC giving it a 24-point margin on a Keegan Bell trey at 2:02, 82-58.
- Of the Mocs' 82 points, just 18 came in the paint while 45 came from 15-24 (62.5%) shooting from 3pt line.
- Trio of guards score in double digits led by Bell's 21...Bell was 7-10 from the field with all 21 points coming on a 7-9 performance from beyond the arc...also had 4 assists and a steal.
- Ricky Taylor had 17 points on 7-11 from the field, 2-3 from 3pt range and 1-1 at the FT line...tied for game-high honors with 7 rebounds...team-high 2 steals.
- White had 15 points and five assists against zero turnovers in 26 minutes of action...had to backup Bell at point after a first-half injury to Dontay Hampton... was 5-10 from the field, 5-9 from 3pt.
- Freshman Lance Stokes started for an injured Omar Wattad.
- Only three Mocs - Bell (32), White (26) and Taylor (22) - played more than 19 minutes.

• Shulman returns for his eighth season on the bench. Under his tutelage, the Mocs have won or shared four SoCon North Division titles including three of the last four, the most in the league during that span. The four division crowns during his tenure are the most in the league along with Davidson. He has led UTC to two NCAA Tournaments with SoCon Tournament titles in 2005 and 2009.

• Chattanooga has won an amazing 95.6 percent of its games under Shulman when leading with five minutes to play, a 109-5 record. When the score is within five points, leading or trailing, with five to go, Shulman and his charges are 47-22 (.681) including 12-1 (.923) in 2010-11.

• The Mocs return four starters and six of top nine in rotation from Southern Conference North Division Co-Champs. They also return two All-SoCon performers (**Keegan Bell**, **Omar Wattad**) and the top four scorers (Wattad – 14.3 ppg, **Ricky Taylor** – 13.0 ppg, Bell – 9.7 ppg & **Chris Early** – 9.3 ppg).

• Wattad was named preseason SoCon Player of the Year by College Sports Madness along with other publications. The online publication also predicted 2nd team all-league finishes for Bell and Taylor, while Wattad was also posted on its All-Mid Major fourth team.

• Bell (Vanderbilt), Wattad (Georgetown) and Early (Oklahoma) all signed high major out of high school and are now seniors for the Mocs.

- Mocs' top offensive threat entering season in the post.
- 476 career points, 326 rebounds.

Ricky Taylor (Brownsville, Tenn.)

- Has started 56 games at the 2 over the last two years.
- 164 points shy of 1,000 for his career. He would be the 18th UTC student-athlete in the DI era (1977-78) to accomplish the milestone.
- Currently 27th all-time in scoring, 12 behind Maurio Hanson's (1994-95) 848 and 18 short of Isaac Conner's (1995-99) 854 in 25th.
- 14th all-time in 3pt FG Made with 111 which is five shy of Hanson in 13th.
- Led the Mocs in each of the last two seasons in free throws made (151 total).

Omar Wattad (Johnson City, Tenn.)

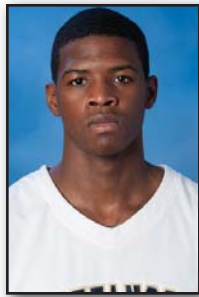

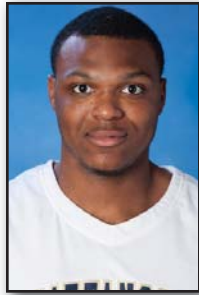
