Butler Opens Home Slate Against Chattanooga

HOME START: Butler, coming off a tough road loss, will try to get its first 2011-12 win when it hosts Chattanooga on Tuesday, Nov. 15. The home-opener, slated for 7 p.m. (ET) at Hinkle Fieldhouse, is part of the five-team, Hoosier Classic tournament. Butler has home games against Chattanooga, Savannah State (Nov. 21) and Gardner-Webb (Nov. 23) in the event, before closing the tournament at Indiana on Sunday, Nov. 27. Chattanooga (0-1) dropped a 78-53 decision at Indiana on Sunday (Nov. 13) in the first round of the Hoosier Classic. The Mocs led through much of the first half, but Indiana closed the opening period with an 11-0 run to take a 36-24 halftime lead. The Hoosiers then put things away with a 25-9 run in the second half. The Mocs tied for the Southern Conference North Division title a year ago, and head coach John Shulman returns four starters from that squad. Senior forward Omar Wattad, who scored 24 points at Indiana on Sunday, has been named Player of the Year in the Southern Conference by several preseason publications. The Bulldogs are trying to bounce back from an 80-77 loss in overtime at Evansville on Saturday (Nov. 12). That setback was Butler's first loss in a season-opener under head coach Brad Stevens and the program's first since 2005. The Bulldogs will continue their four-game homestand with a game against No. 9 Louisville on Saturday, Nov. 19. That game at Hinkle Fieldhouse will tip at 2 p.m. (ET).

Butler was 12-2 in Hinkle Fieldhouse in 2010-11.

FRENETIC FINISH: Butler appeared to have won its season-opener at Evansville twice in the closing seconds, but ultimately the Bulldogs left the court with a three-point overtime loss. Evansville, trailing 69-68, missed a final shot in the closing seconds and Butler looked to have survived as the ball bounced loose. But the Bulldogs were called for a foul on the scramble for the loose ball with 0:00.9 left. Evansville scoring leader Colt Ryan made one of two free throws to tie the game. Butler's **Emerson Kampen** then threw a full-court pass to junior **Andrew Smith**, who turned and laid it in the basket as the final buzzer sounded. The Bulldogs' celebration was cut short, when the officials huddled and ruled that Smith was fouled with 0:00.2 left, before the shot. The Butler center missed both free throw attempts, sending the game into overtime.

FIRST LOOK: Sophomore **Chrishawn Hopkins** was the lone Butler player making his first collegiate start when the Bulldogs took the floor at Evansville. It didn't take him long to establish his credentials. The 6-1 guard, who sat out Butler's two exhibition games after sustaining a concussion in practice, led the Bulldogs with a career-high 22 points and a career-high five assists. The 22 points were just 10 shy of Hopkins' entire season total from a year ago. In addition to his points and assists, Hopkins recorded career-highs for field goals (8), field goal attempts (19), three-point field goals (3), three-point field goal attempts (8), rebounds (3) and minutes played (39). Hopkins averaged less than six minutes per game in 21 outings a year ago.

LEAD ROLE: Junior **Andrew Smith**, who started 32 games for the Bulldogs a year ago, has established himself as a major presence in Butler's first three outings this season. He led Butler in scoring in both preseason exhibition games, and he turned in the second-highest scoring performance of his career in the Bulldogs' season-opener

at Evansville. The 6-11 center scored 19 points in each of the Bulldogs' two preseason contests, and then he opened the season with a 21-point performance at Evansville. He hit six of eight shots from the floor, including a pair of three-point field goals and seven of 12 from the free throw line. The Butler center led both teams with nine rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots in the game, and he added two assists and a steal. His 21 points at Evansville were one shy of his career-high, set against Cleveland State last year. Smith was Butler's third-leading scorer (8.5) and second-leading rebounder (5.6) last season.

Andrew Smith finished second in the Horizon League in field goal shooting (.593) in 2010-11.

SHORT BENCH: Three Butler players were unavailable for the Bulldogs' game at Evansville. Head coach Brad Stevens announced prior to the game that freshmen **Kameron Woods** and **Elliott Kampen** would not play against the Aces for failure to "strive to meet the high expectations of the program." A third player, freshman **Roosevelt Jones**, sat out the game with an injury sustained prior to tip-off. All three players are expected back for this week's games at Hinkle Fieldhouse.

NEW SEASON: The Bulldogs have just two seniors, **Ronald Nored** and **Garrett Butcher**, on this year's squad and just five players who boast more than one season of experience. Gone from last year's 28-10 team, which won the Horizon League regular season and tournament championships and advanced to the national title game for a second straight year, are starters Matt Howard, Shelvin Mack and Shawn Vanzant, top reserve Zach Hahn and four-year letterwinners Grant Leiendecker and Alex Anglin. Howard finished his career as Butler's third all-time leading scorer and rebounder, while Mack was taken by the Washington Wizards in the second round of the NBA Draft. The six departures accounted for 64% of Butler's scoring and 48% of the squad's rebounding a year ago. This year's squad features eight returning letterwinners and six freshmen.

HOMECOMING: Butler will play seven of its next eight games at Hinkle Fieldhouse, beginning with the Chattanooga contest. The Bulldogs won their final four home games last season and have been successful in 27 of their past 29 home contests. Butler is 56-5 at Hinkle Fieldhouse in four seasons under head coach Brad Stevens.

Butler has won 14 of 15 non-league games at home over the past three years.

Butler Tabbed As League Favorite

For the third consecutive year, Butler has been picked as the preseason favorite in the Horizon League. The Bulldogs picked up 28 first place votes and edged Detroit as the favorite to win this year's title, according to the league's preseason poll of coaches, media and sports information directors. Butler received 468 total votes in the poll, while Detroit received 19 first place votes and 453 points.

•Senior **Ronald Nored**, who had four assists at Evansville, has moved into 10th place on Butler's all-time assist chart. Nored boosted his Butler career total to 308 assists, and moved ahead of Brandon Miller (305, 2000-03) on the all-time list.

•Butler's **Ronald Nored** is one of 30 candidates nominated for the 2011-12 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The award is presented to one senior who has shown notable achievement in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. Former teammate **Matt Howard** was one of 10 finalists for the award a year ago.

•**Ronald Nored** has been named to the 25-player Lou Henson Preseason All-America Team. The ColleagueInsider.com team honors the top Mid-Major players in the nation. Nored joined Detroit's Ray McCallum as the lone Horizon League player selected to this year's preseason squad. Butler's **Matt Howard** was named the Lou Henson Player of the Year last season.

•Center **Andrew Smith** recorded his first collegiate three-point field goal in Butler's game at Evansville. Smith hit two of three attempts from beyond the three-point arc against the Aces. He had just one three-point field goal attempt all of last year.

•**Andrew Smith** was the lone Butler player named to the preseason All-Horizon League team. The 6-11 Butler center earned second team All-League recognition on the preseason squad chosen by league coaches, media and sports information directors.

•Junior **Chase Stigall** had a career-high six rebounds at Evansville. He played a career-high 35 minutes in the game.

•Freshman guard **Jackson Aldridge** came off the bench with seven points, three rebounds and three assists in 27 minutes at Evansville. Aldridge, who played on the Australia team at last summer's FIBA U19 World Championship, was playing in his first collegiate game.

•Evansville made 32 of 43 free throws against the Bulldogs, including 20 of 25 after intermission. The 43 attempts were the most against the Bulldogs since last year's road-opener at Louisville (43). Butler hit 15 of 24 free throws against the Aces.

•The Bulldogs are 50-4 in regular season play under coach Brad Stevens when hitting nine or more three-pointers. Butler hit eight three-pointer field goals at Evansville.

SUCCESS STREAK

The Bulldogs have averaged 29.2 wins over the past five seasons, including two 30-win campaigns, and had posted a winning percentage of .820. Only three teams in the nation, Kansas (165), North Carolina (150) and Duke (147), have more wins than Butler (146) over the last five seasons. Since 1996-97, Butler has compiled thirteen 20-win seasons and made ten NCAA Tournament appearances.

•Butler is 1-4 in its last five overtime games. That one victory came against #15 Florida in the Elite Eight of last year's NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

•Butler is one of just three NCAA Division I schools to win at least 25 games in each of the last five seasons. The other two are Kansas and BYU.

•Butler head coach **Brad Stevens** landed three recruits on the first day of the NCAA's fall signing period. Joining the Bulldogs' 2012-13 freshman class were 6-5 **Kellen Dunham** of Pendleton Heights, 6-3 **Devontae Morgan** of Tampa, Fla., and 5-11 **Chris Harrison-Docks** of Okemos, Mich. Dunham averaged 23.6 points and shot 43% from three-point range as a junior at Pendleton Heights High School, while Morgan averaged 17.3 points and 8.2 rebounds during his junior season at Tampa Prep. Harrison-Docks averaged 23.0 points at Okemos High School.

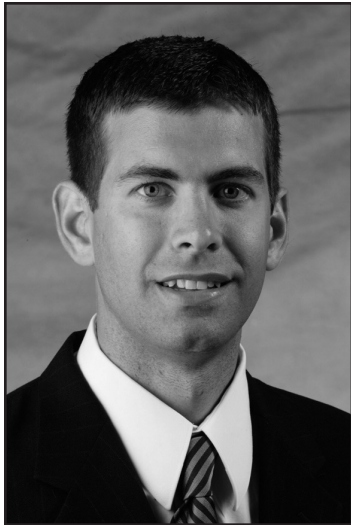

Brad Stevens

Head Coach, Butler University



In just four seasons as a collegiate head coach and 11 years after leaving a business position as a marketing associate, Brad Stevens sits on top of the list for best basketball coaching starts in NCAA history.

Stevens, who owns two Horizon League Coach of the Year awards, has guided the Bulldogs to 117 wins in his brief career, breaking the previous four-year NCAA Division I record of 107 wins set by Everett Case of North Carolina State from 1947 to 1950. He also holds the NCAA three-year record with 89 victories, and he's second on the two-year list with 56 wins. Last season, he guided Butler to a 28-10 campaign, the school's league-record fifth consecutive Horizon League regular season championship, a second straight Horizon League Tournament title, a fifth consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament and a second straight national runner-up finish.

In 2009-10, Stevens engineered the most remarkable season in Butler basketball history! The Bulldogs posted a 33-5 overall record, the Horizon League's first 18-0 conference mark and fourth overall unbeaten record, a fourth consecutive league regular season championship, a second Horizon League Tournament crown in three years and a national runner-up finish in the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs were nationally-ranked for the fourth straight year, and Butler compiled a school-record, 25-game winning streak, the longest winning streak in the nation! The Butler coach was named NABC All-District

12 Coach, and he was a finalist for several additional national coaching awards. Butler ended the season as the No. 2-ranked team in the final ESPN/USA Today national poll.

In his debut season in 2007-08, Stevens helped Butler become the first team in school and Horizon League history to record 30 wins. The 30-4 Bulldogs captured the Great Alaska Shootout, won a second consecutive Wooden Tradition trophy, and wrapped up Horizon League regular season and tournament championships. Butler won a first-round NCAA Tournament game, before falling in overtime to #5 Tennessee in the second round. The Bulldogs were ranked in the "Top 25" of the A. P. and ESPN/USA Today national polls for 19 consecutive weeks, including a record three weeks in the "Top 10." Butler set school- and league-records for regular season wins (27) and became just the second team in league history to record 16 league victories.

Only three coaches in NCAA Division I history - Bill Guthridge, North Carolina (34), Bill Hodges, Indiana State (33) and Jamie Dixon, Pittsburgh (31) - posted more first-year wins than the Butler coach. And at 31, Stevens became the third-youngest Division I coach to guide his team to 30 wins - the youngest in more than half a century!

In addition to becoming the first men's basketball coach in Butler history to lead the Bulldogs to 30 wins, Stevens broke the 34-game Butler coaching record (28-6) shared by three coaches. He moved into seventh place on Butler's all-time list for coaching victories after just one season.

His second season produced perhaps an even more remarkable record! He guided a Butler team picked fifth in the Horizon League, with no seniors and just one returning starter, to 26 wins, a "Top 25" national ranking, a second consecutive Horizon League regular season championship and another trip to the NCAA

Tournament. He recorded his 50th career win faster than any other coach in Butler men's basketball history, and faster than all but four coaches in Division I history! One coach in NCAA Division I history - Bill Guthridge of North Carolina (58-14, 1998-99) - posted more wins in his first two seasons! Stevens was the mid-season recipient of the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year Award, and he was cited as the Horizon League Coach of the Year.

Stevens, 34, was introduced as the new men's basketball head coach at Butler University on April 4, 2007, just three days after his former boss, Todd Lickliter, was named head coach at the University of Iowa. Stevens became the third consecutive former Butler assistant coach to be named head coach of the Bulldogs, and he served under the previous two - Thad Matta and Lickliter.

Stevens worked with Lickliter for six seasons, 2001-07. During his tenure as an assistant coach with the Bulldogs, Butler compiled a 131-61 record, won three Horizon League regular season championships and made four trips to postseason tournament play. In 2006-07, Butler compiled a 29-7 record and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs won the NIT Season Tip-Off at Madison Square Garden in New York, and the team was ranked in the "Top 25" of both the Associated Press (A.P.) and ESPN/USA Today national polls for 16 consecutive weeks.

Stevens joined the Bulldogs' staff in 2000-01 as coordinator of basketball operations, handling a variety of administrative duties. He was offered a full-time assistant coaching position by Lickliter in 2001-02.

The Butler coach left a position as a marketing associate at Eli Lilly and Company in Indianapolis to pursue a career in basketball coaching. He served in a volunteer capacity in Butler's basketball office during the summer of 2000, before eventually gaining a full-time administrative position under Matta.

Stevens, who's in his first year as member of the NABC Board of Directors, earned a B.A. degree in economics from DePauw in 1999. He was a four-year member of the basketball team at DePauw, earning the squad's "Coaches Award" in 1998-99. He and his wife, Tracy, have two children, son Brady and daughter Kinsley.

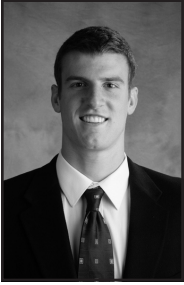
